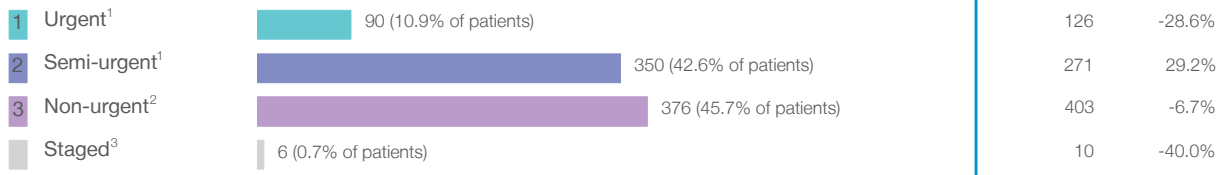

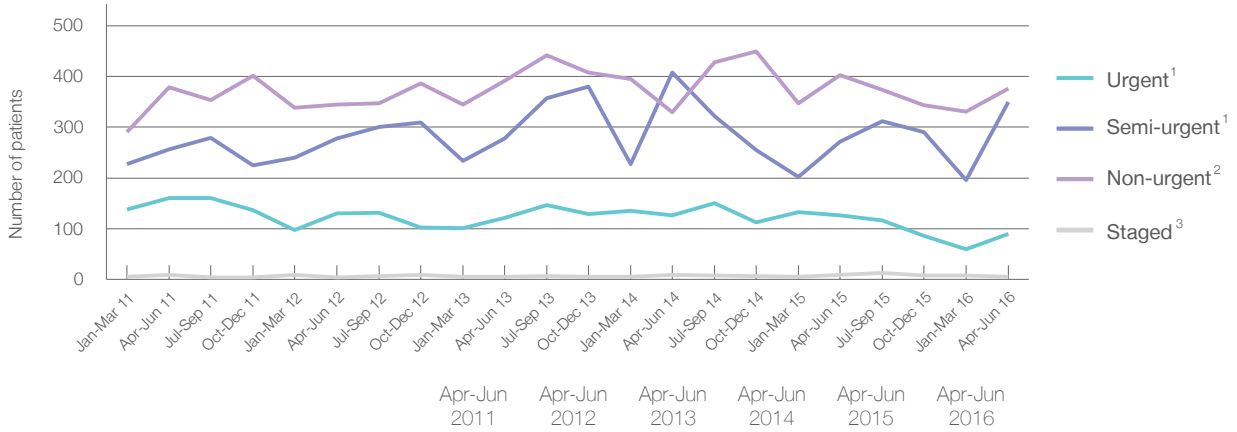

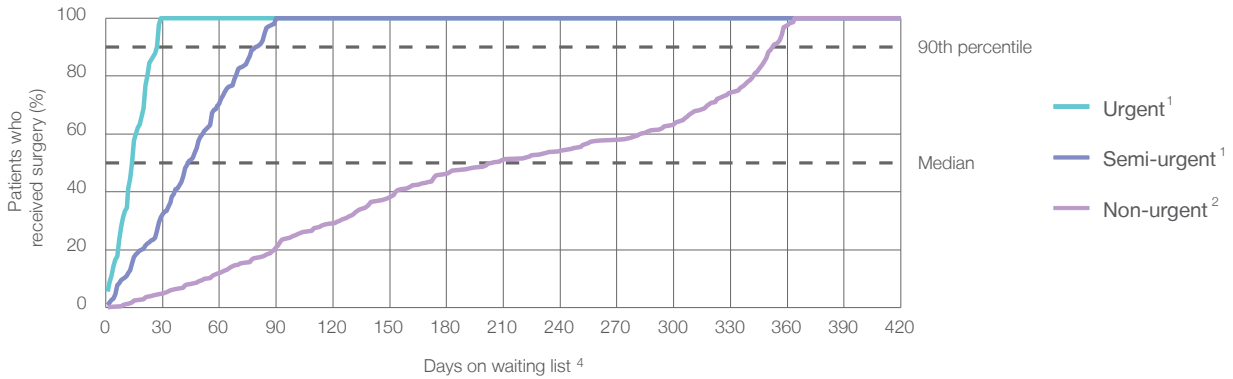

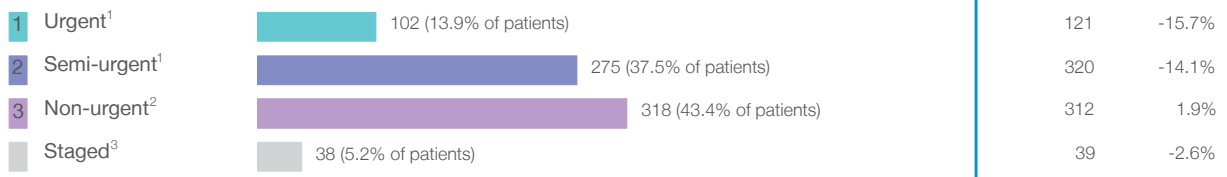

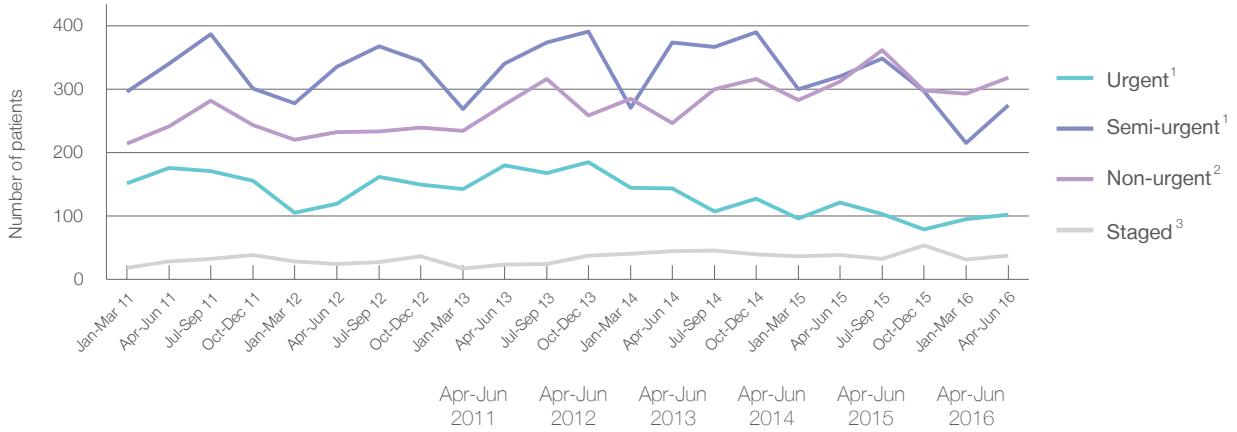

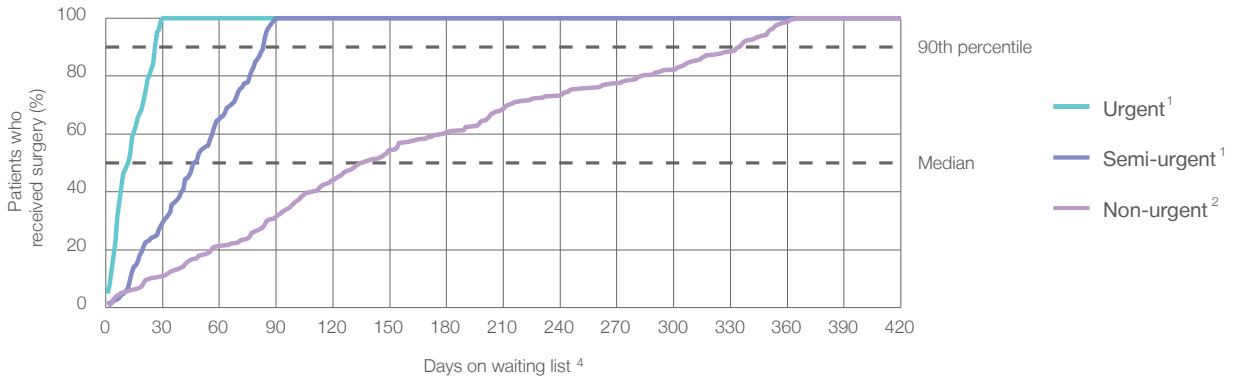

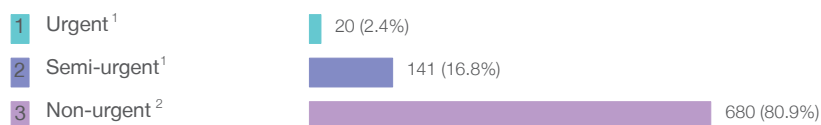

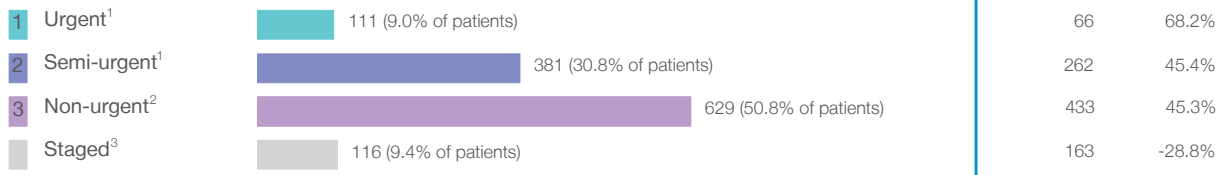

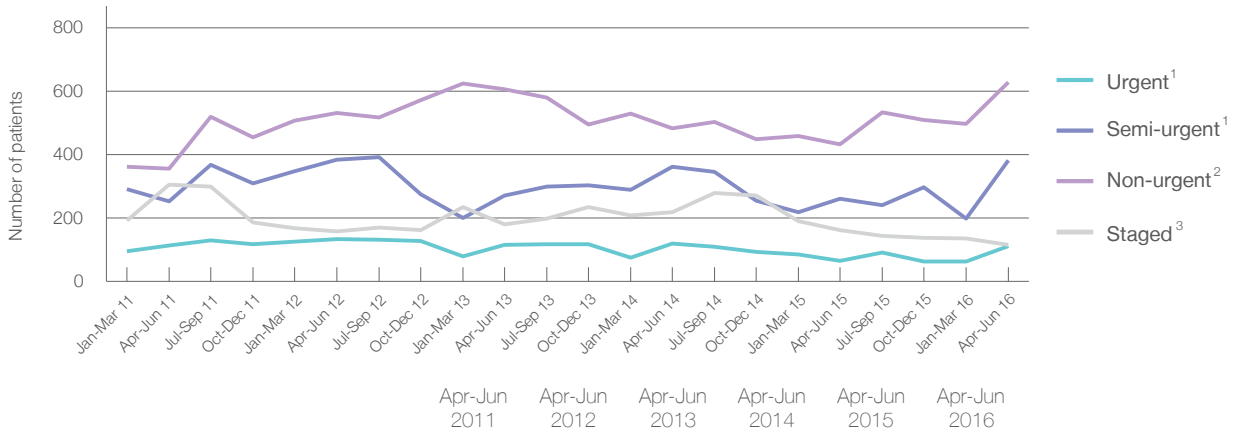

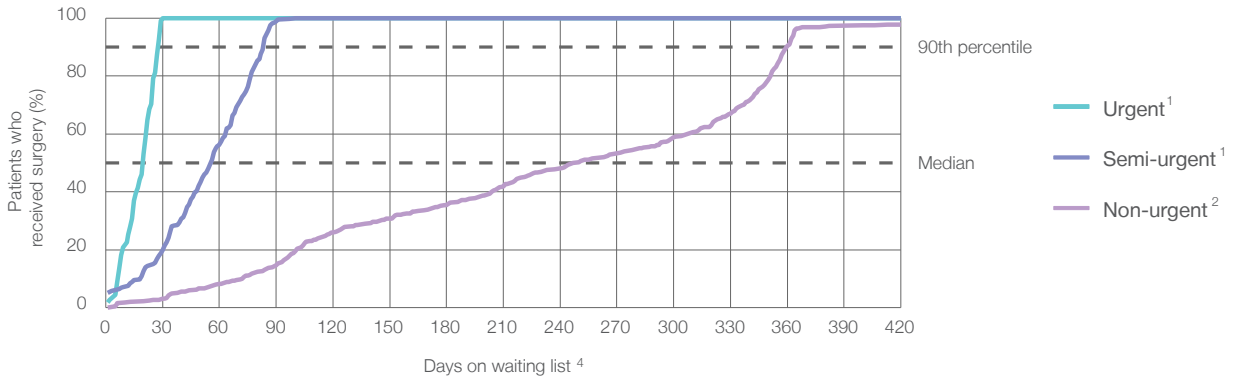

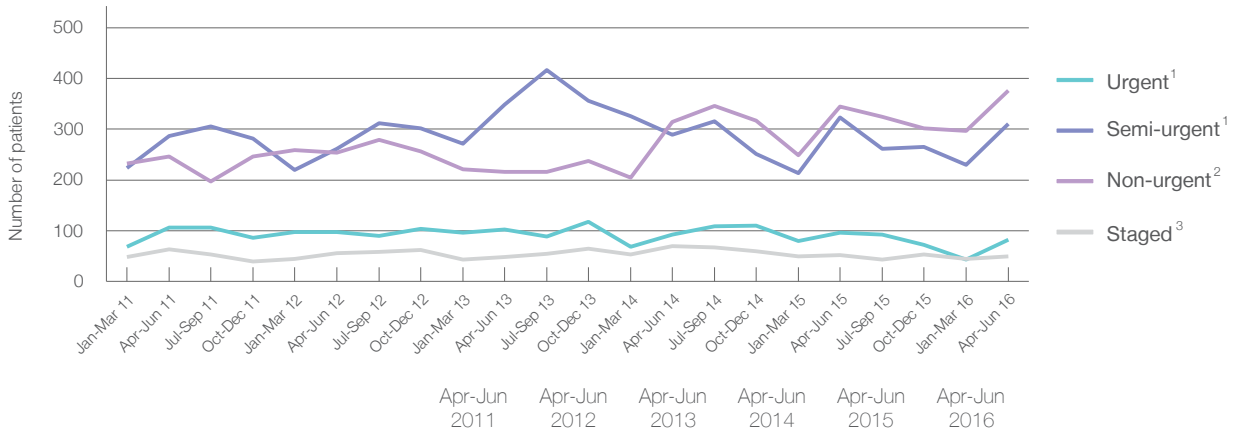

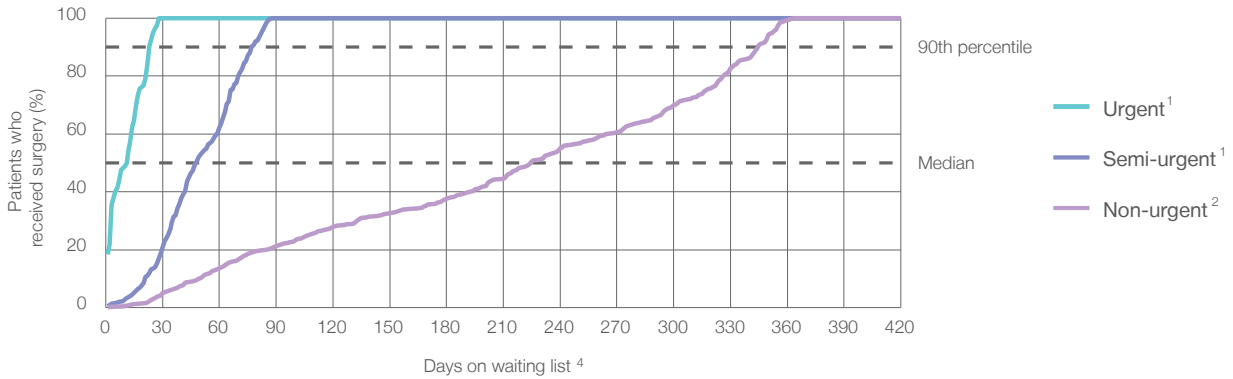

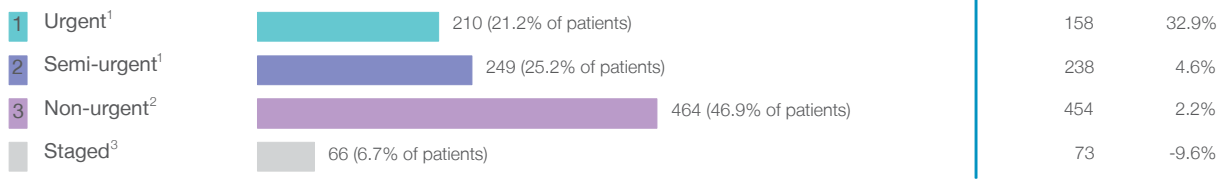

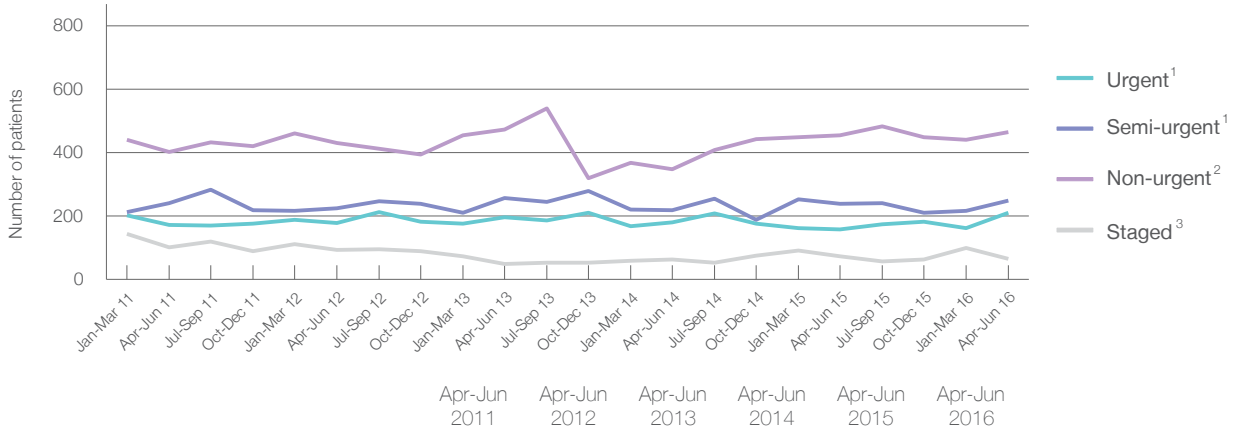

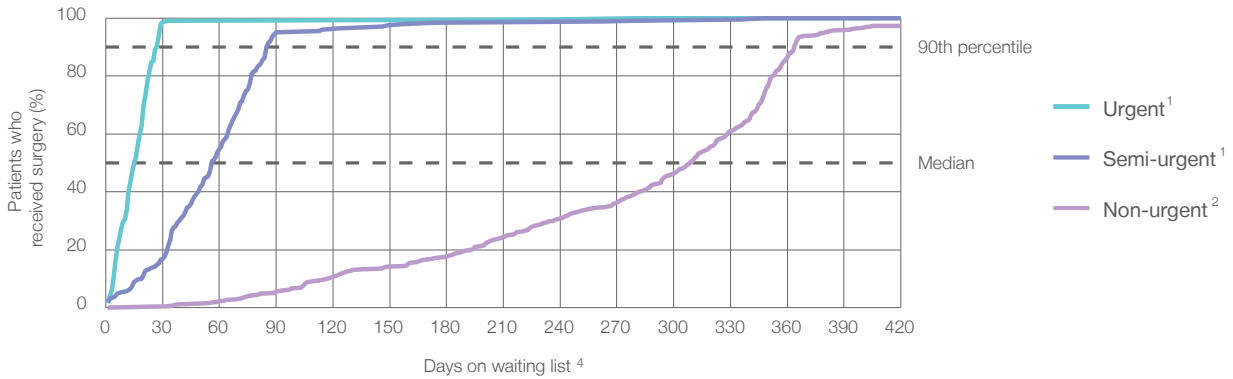

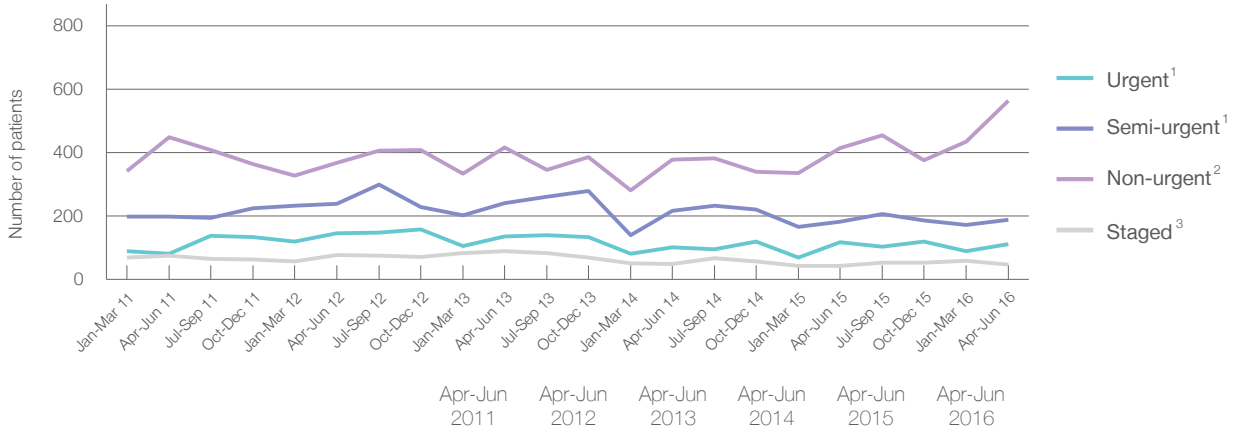

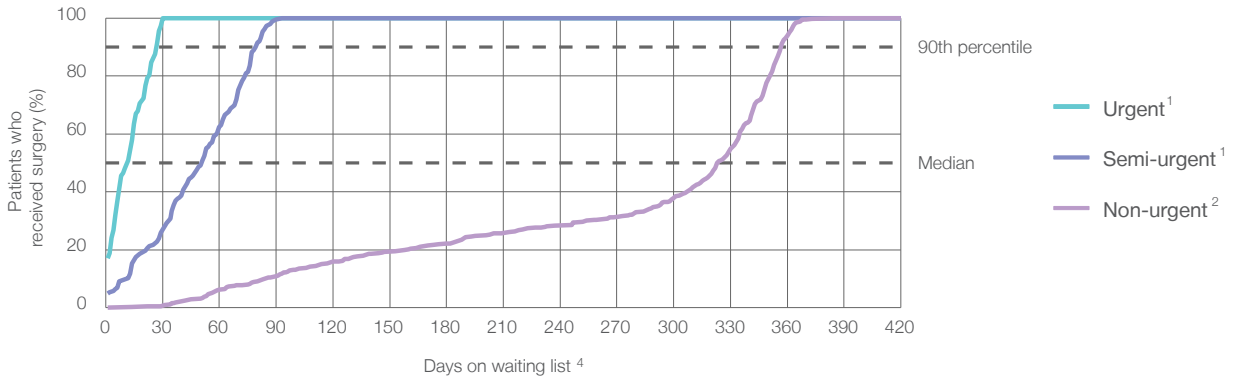

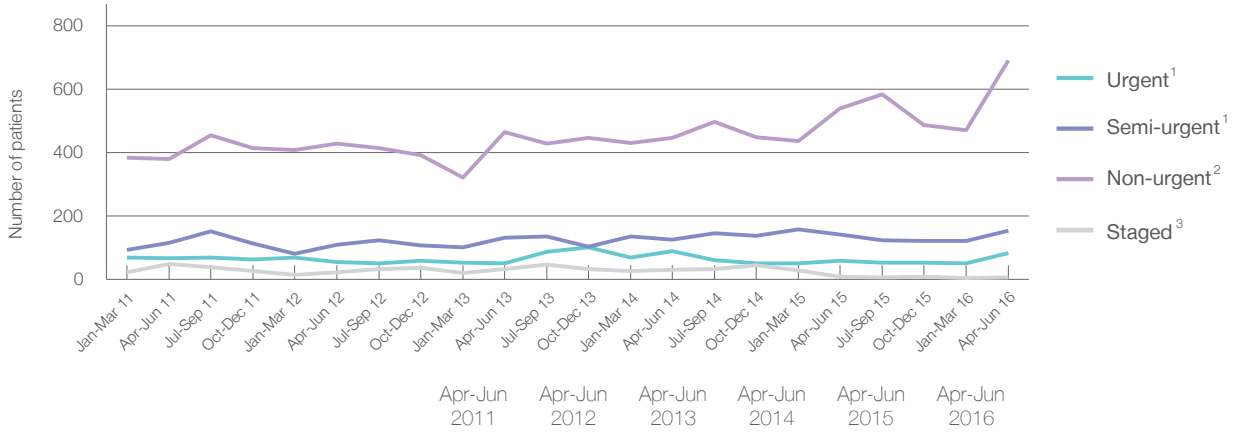

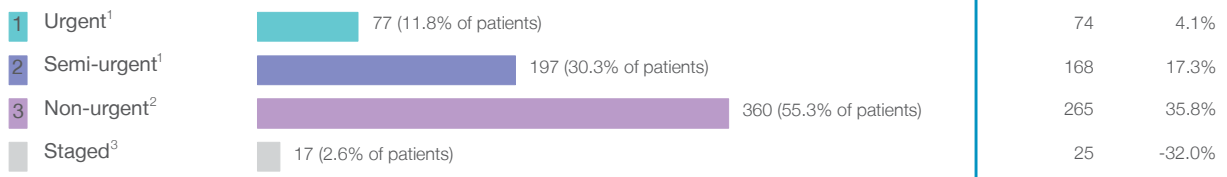

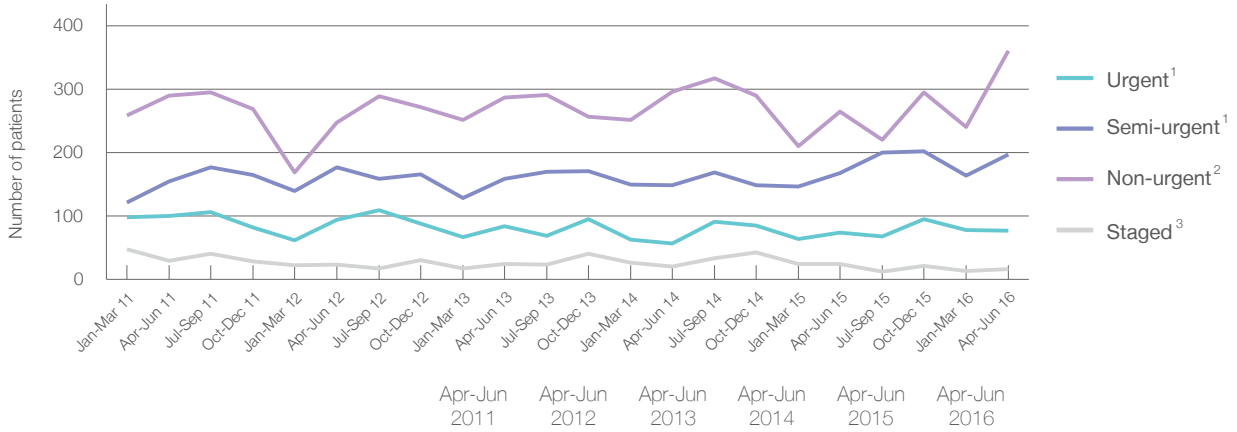

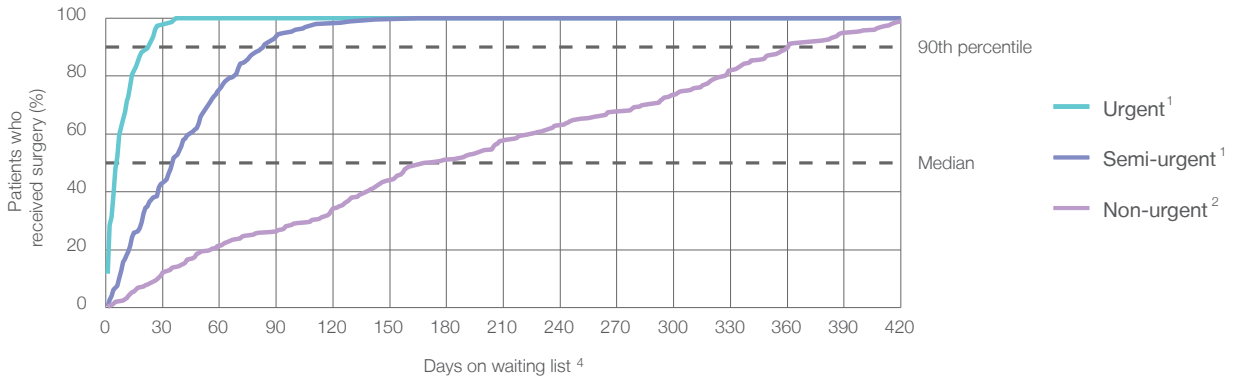

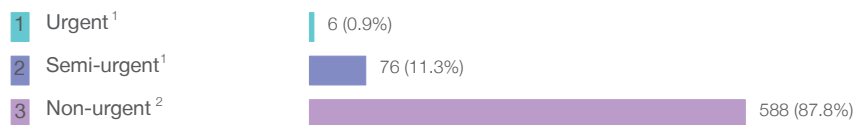

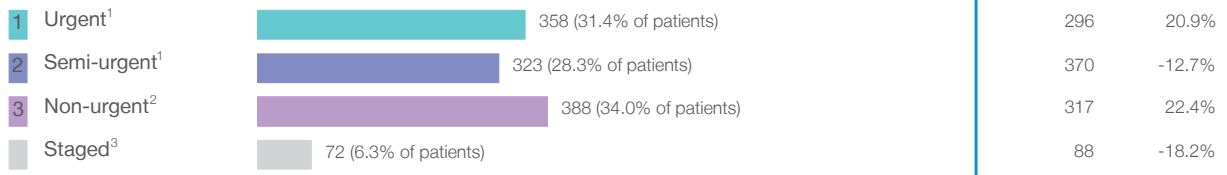

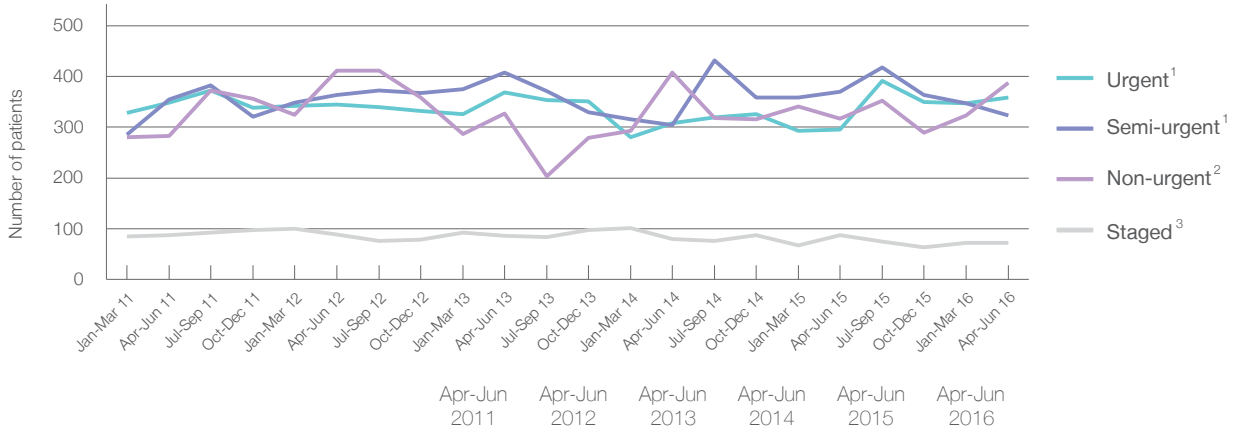

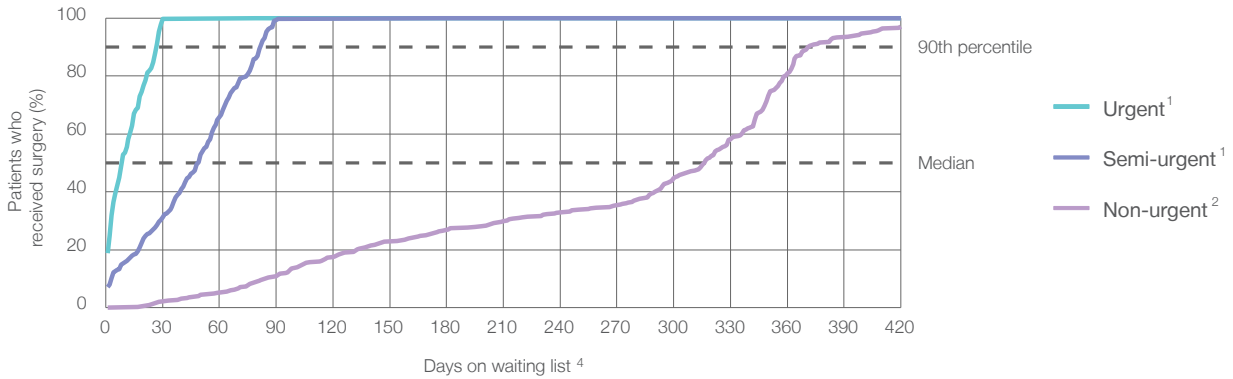

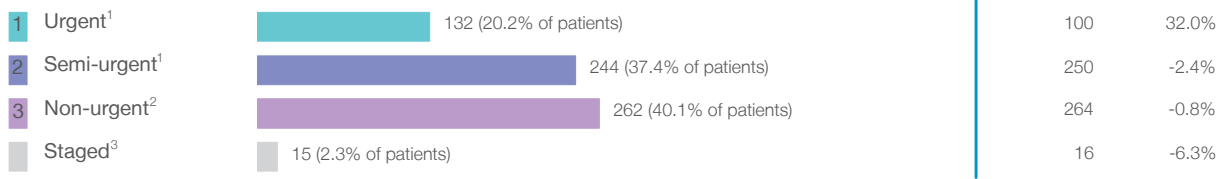

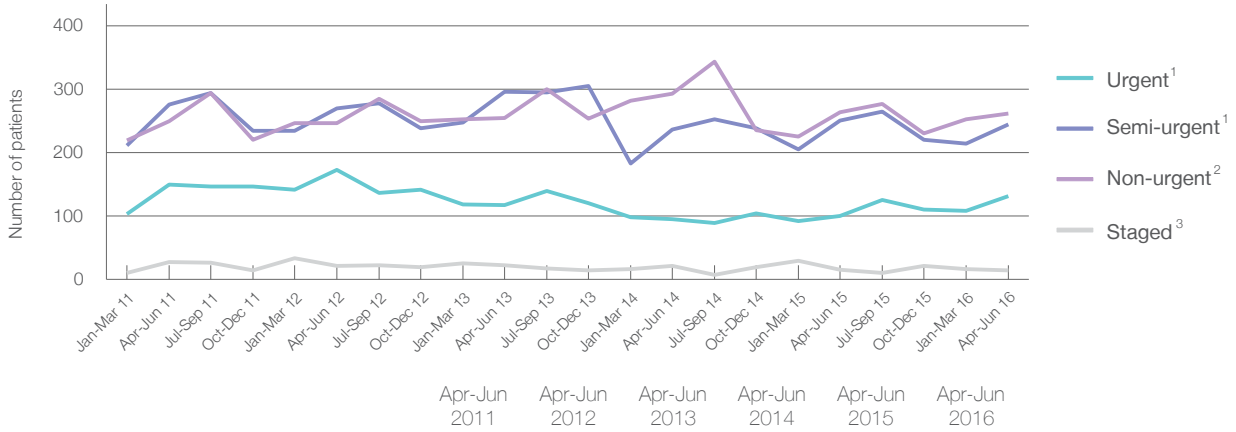

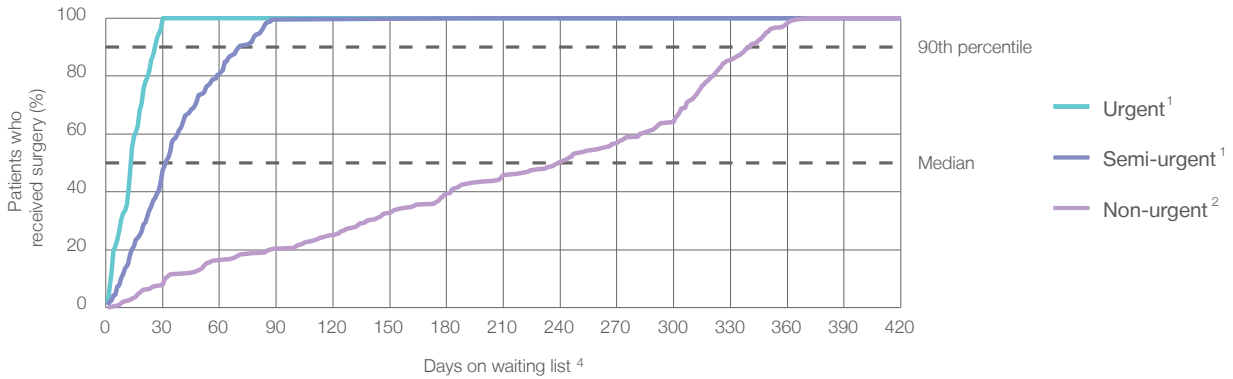

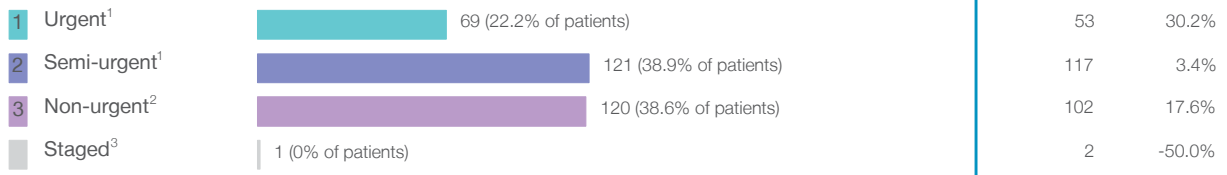

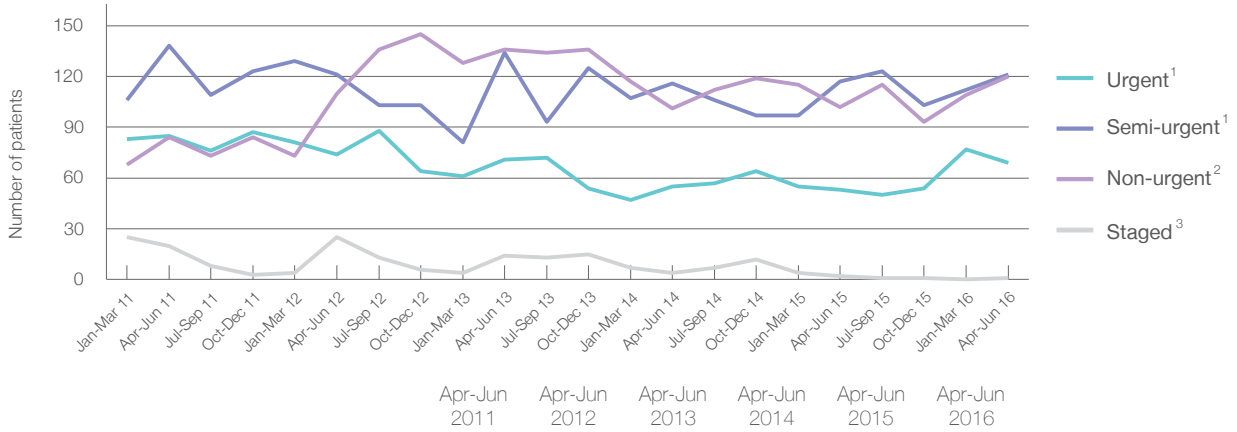

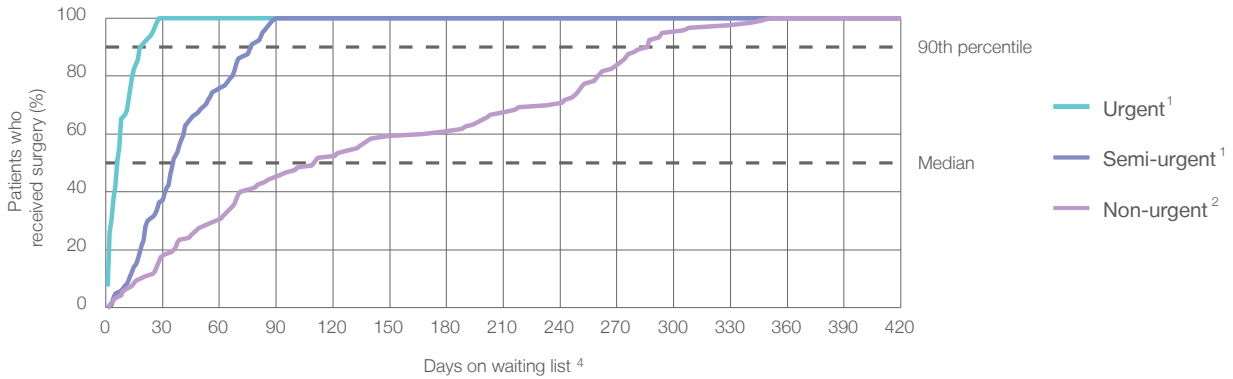

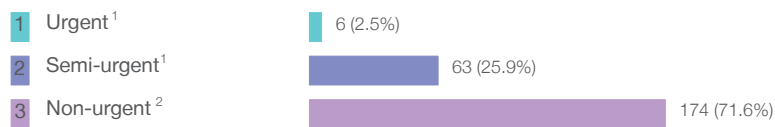

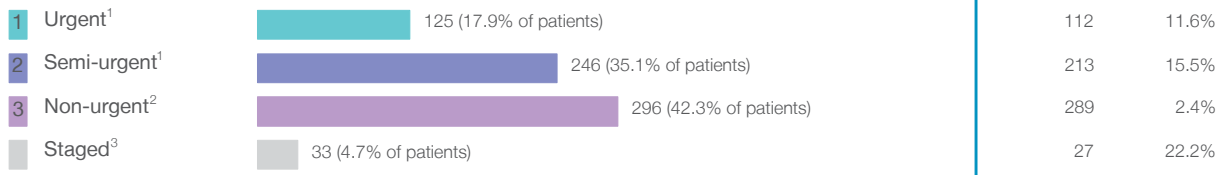

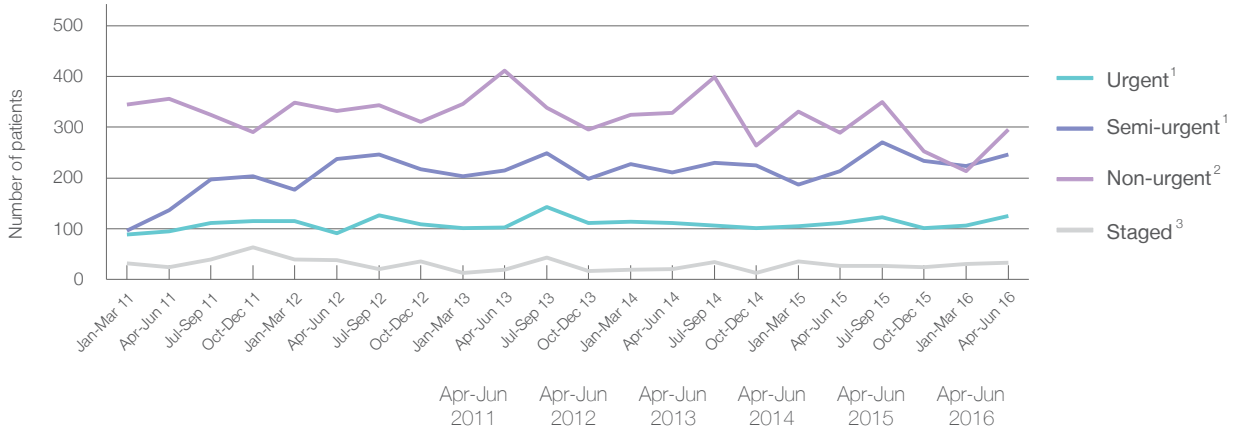

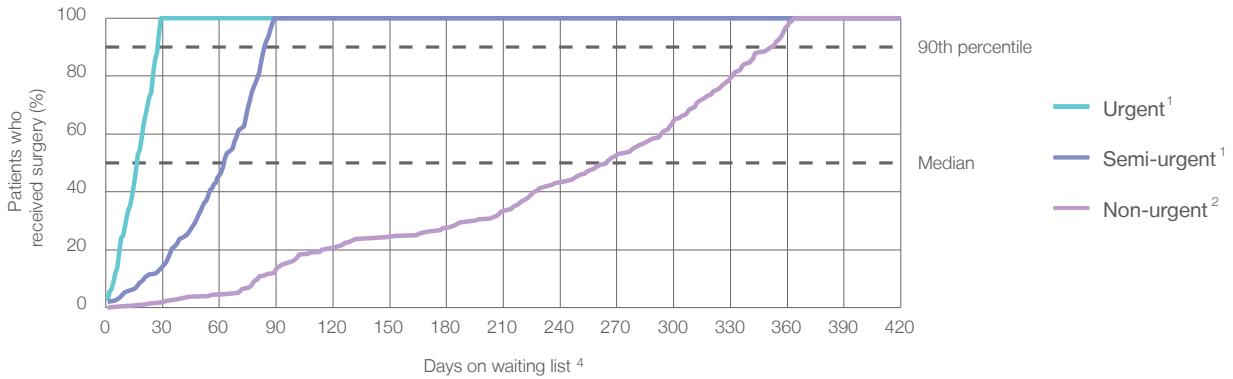

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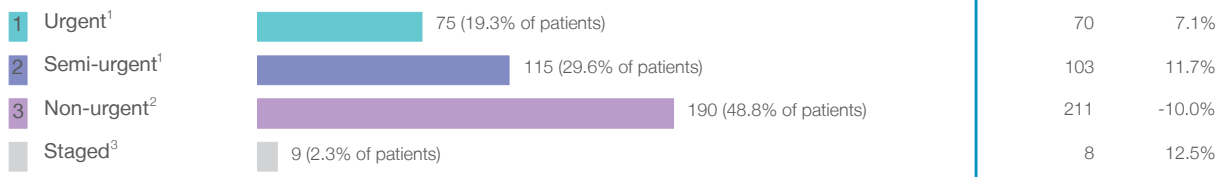

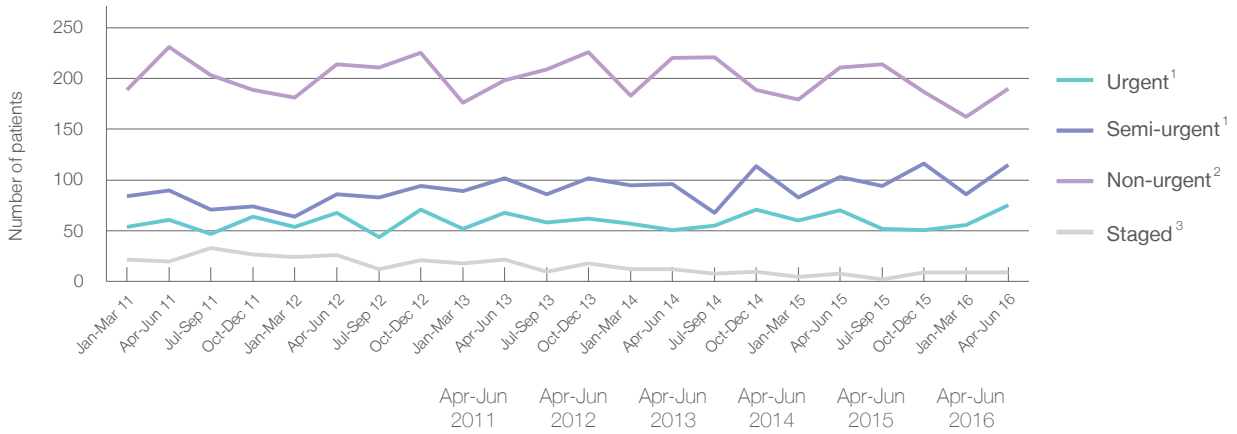

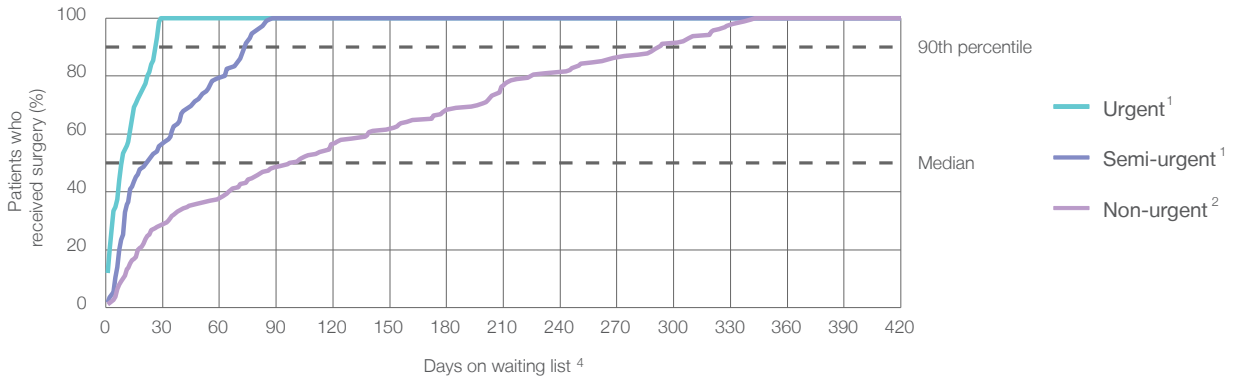

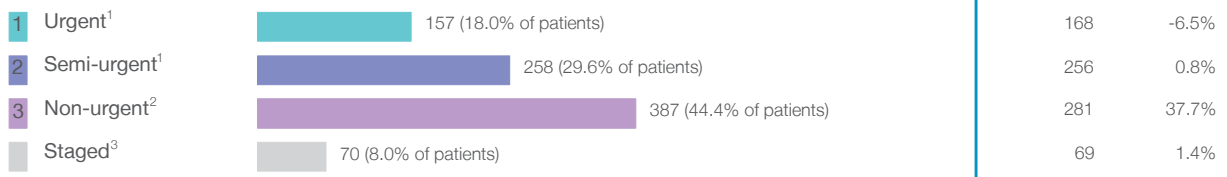

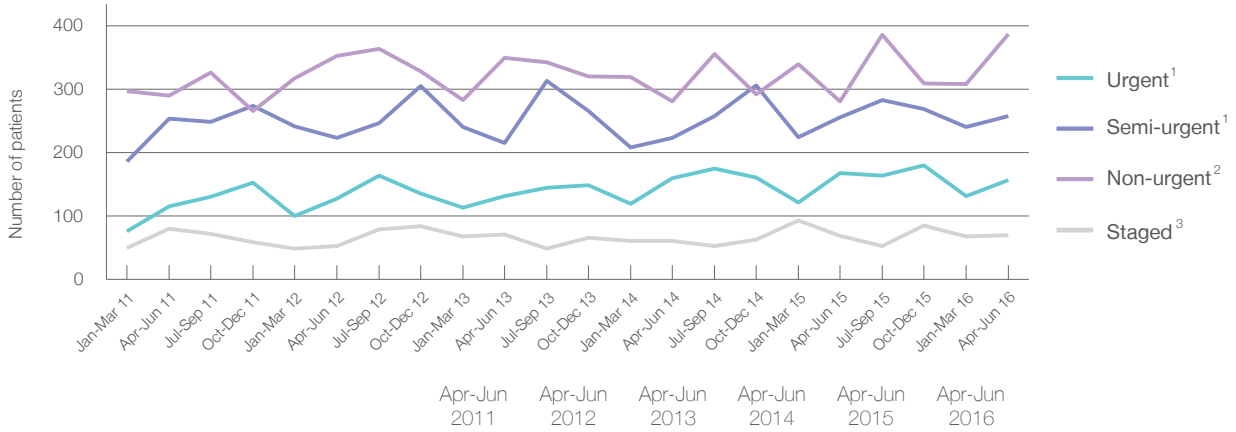

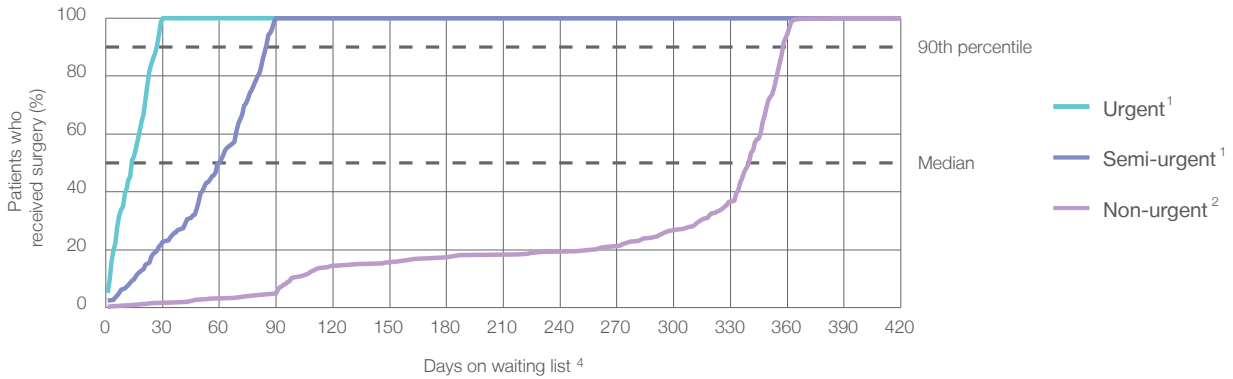

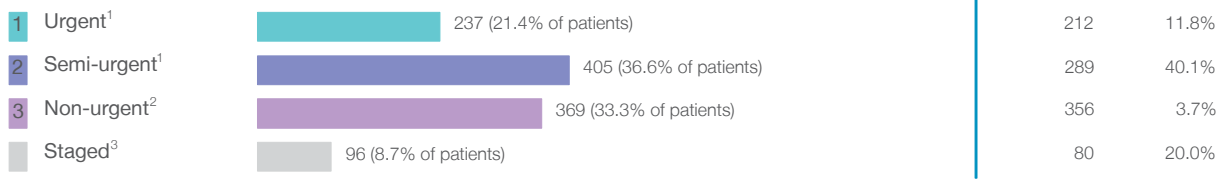

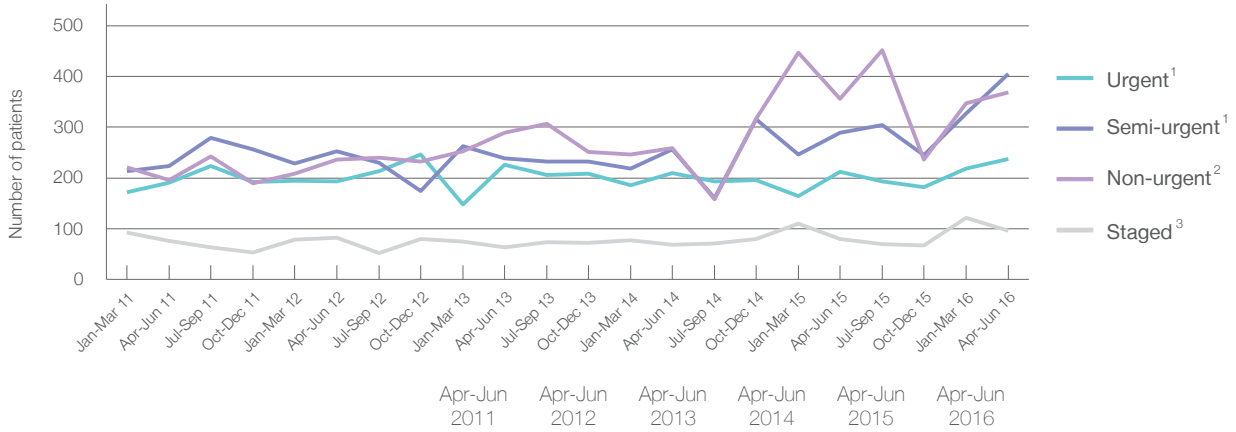

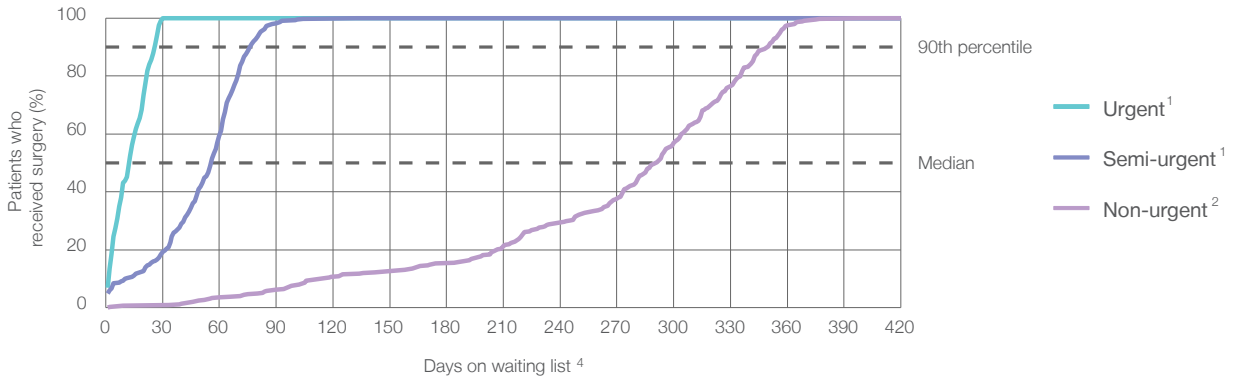

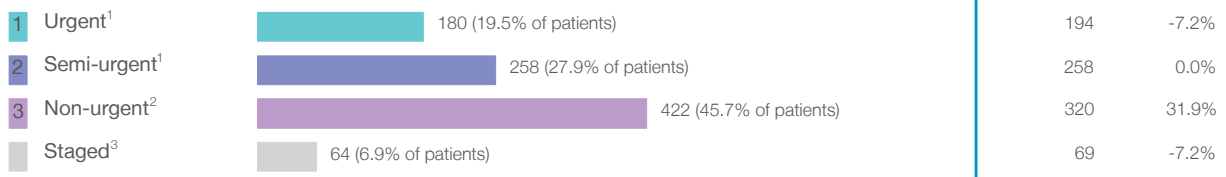

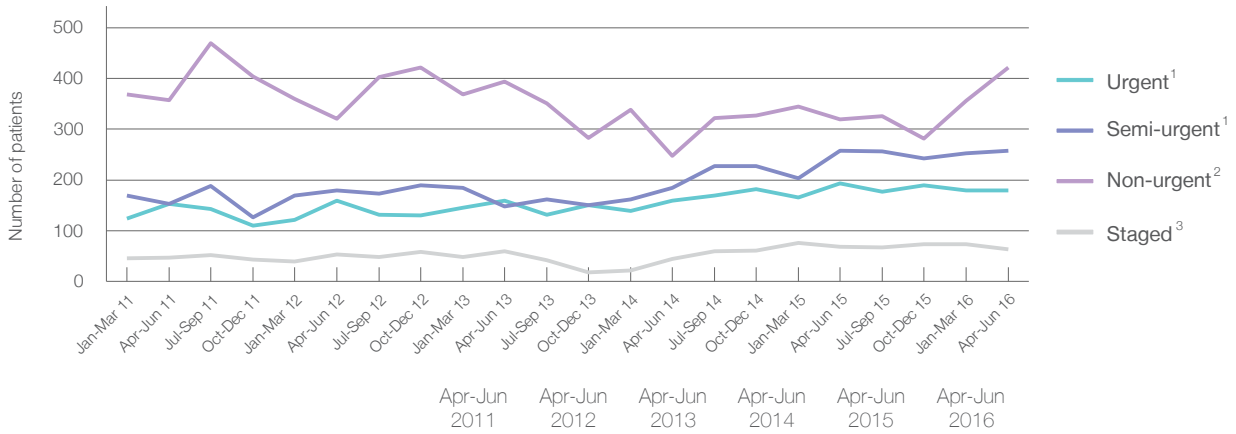

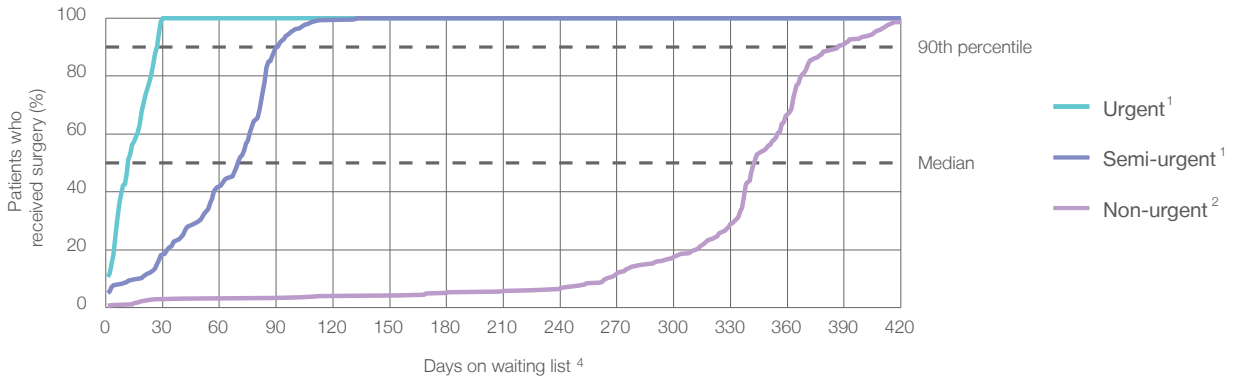
Shoalhaven District Memorial Hospital: Time waited to receive elective surgery

April to June 2016

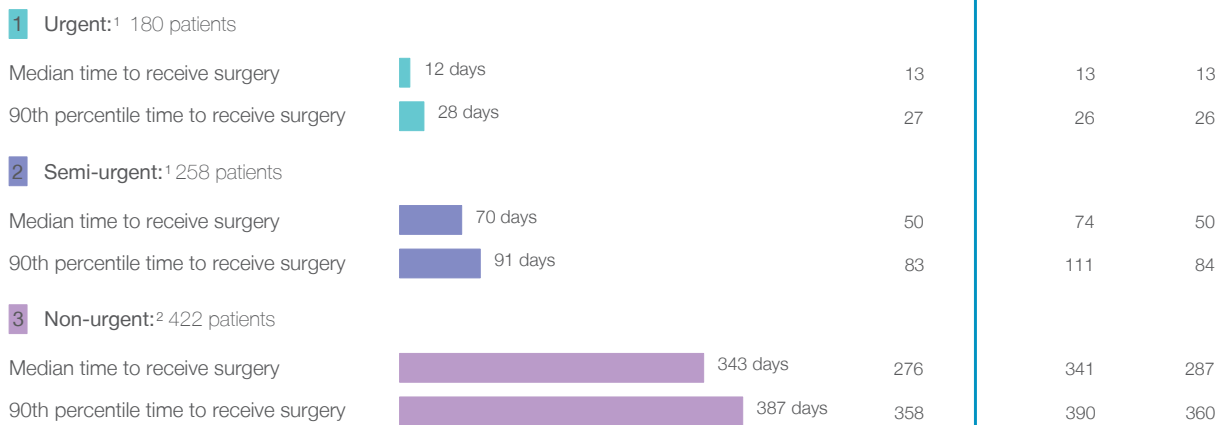
Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

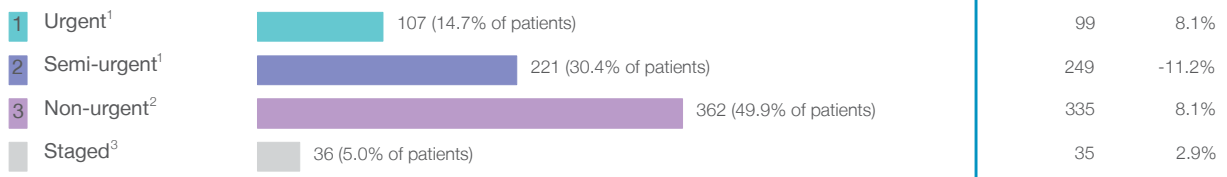

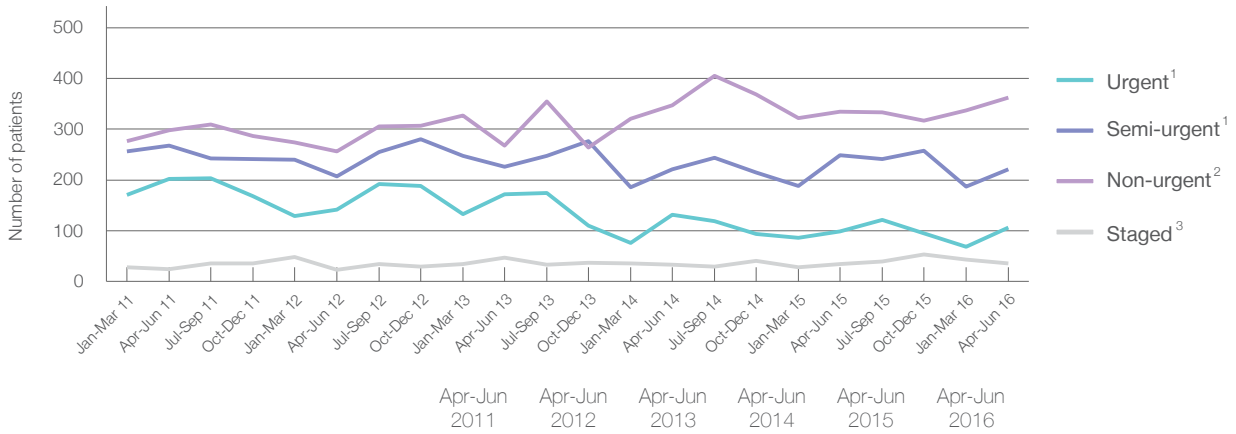

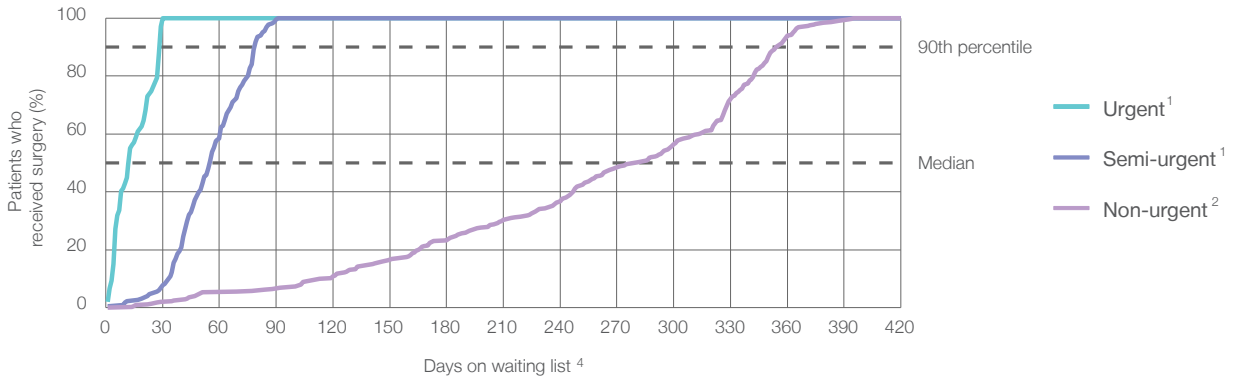

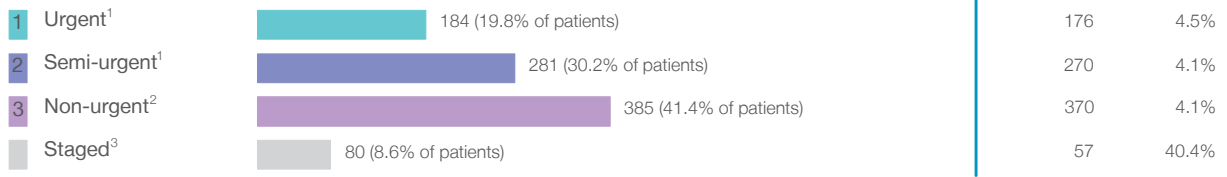

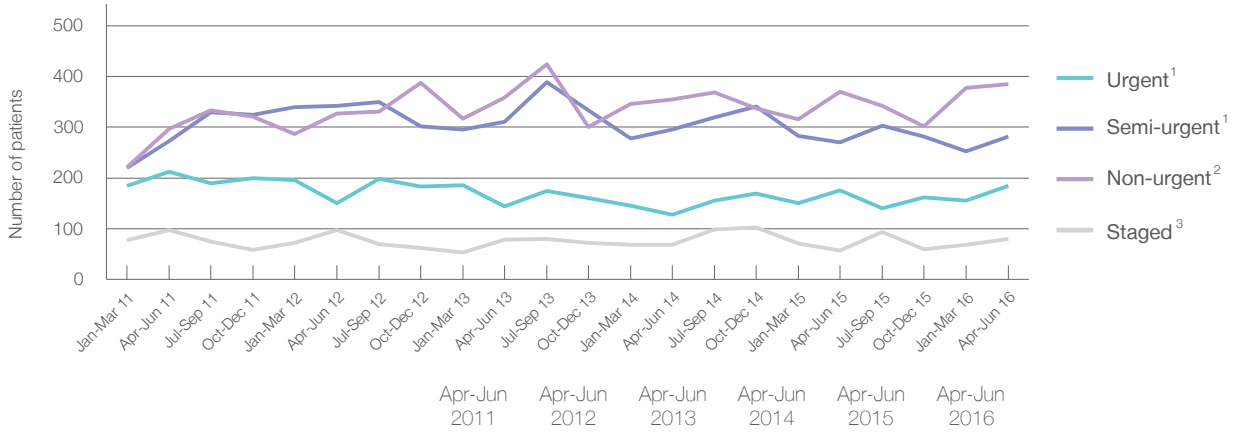

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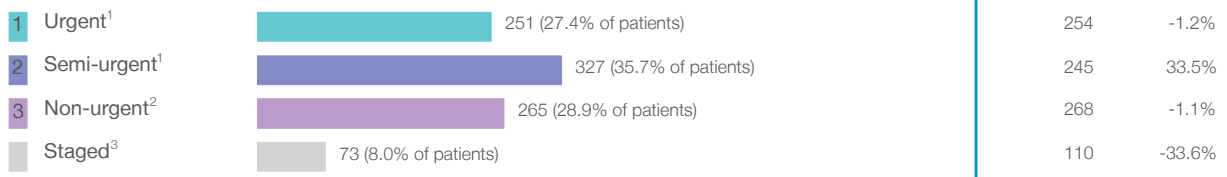

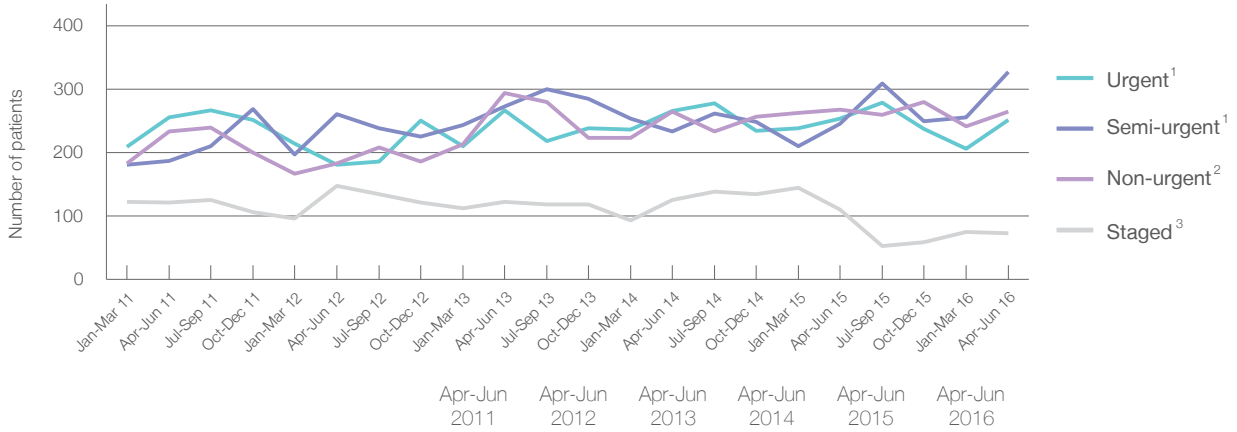

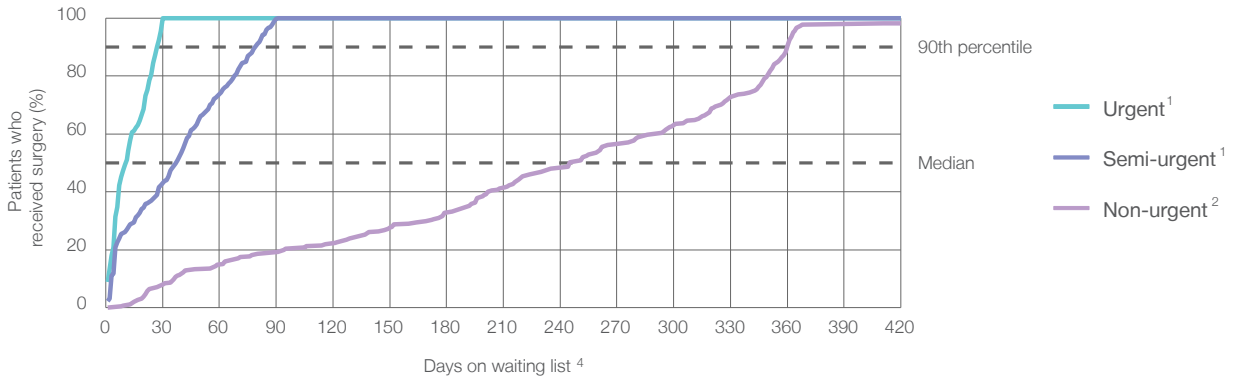

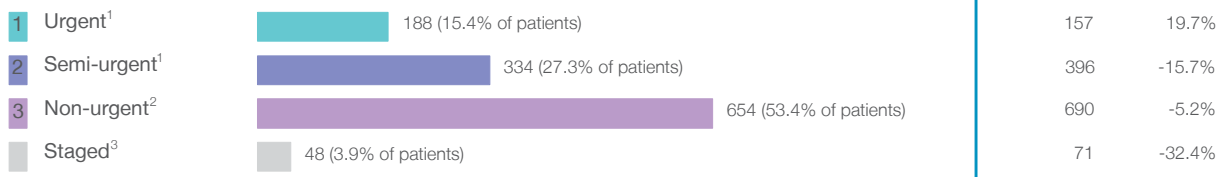

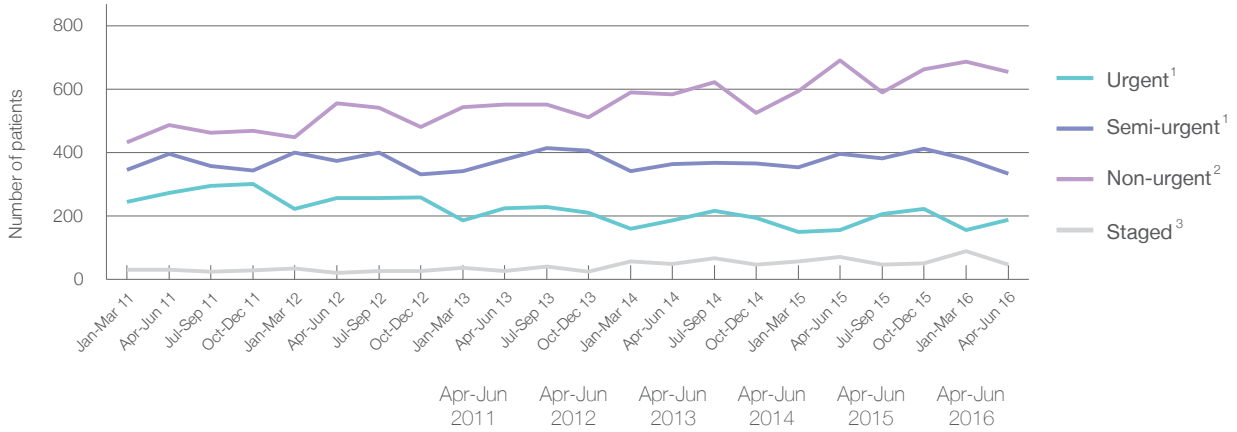

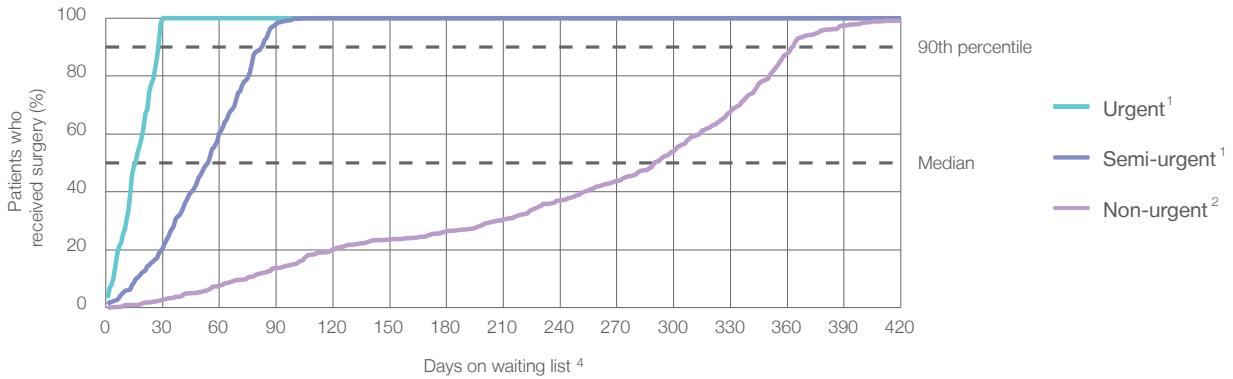

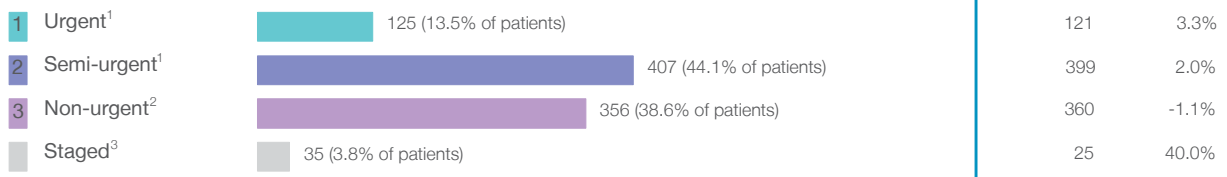

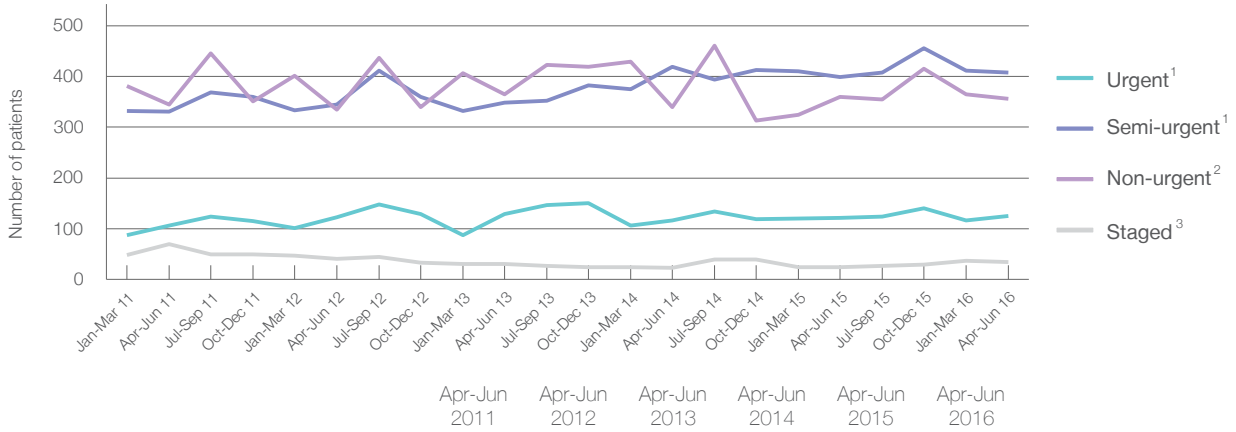
Wyong Hospital: Elective surgery performed

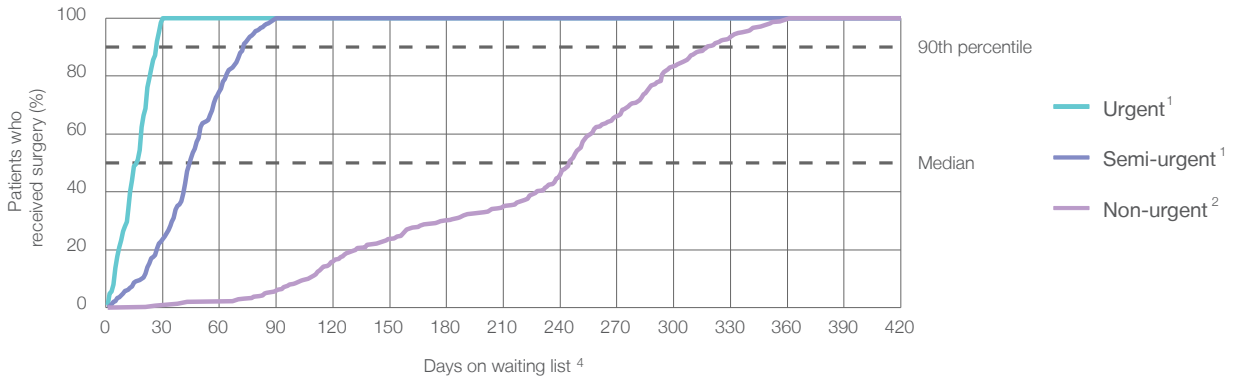

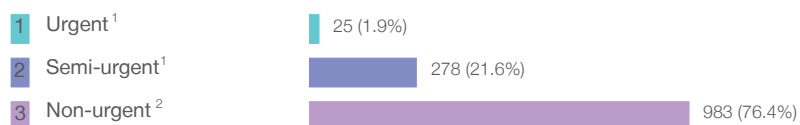
