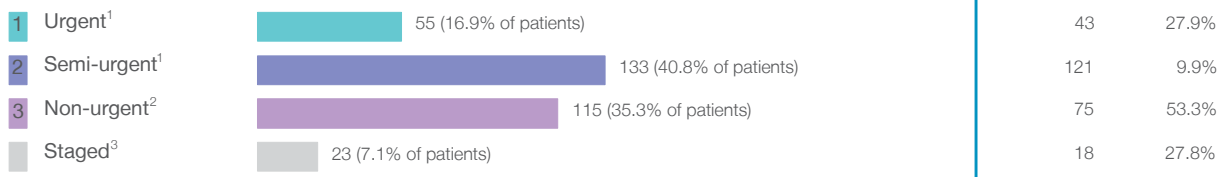

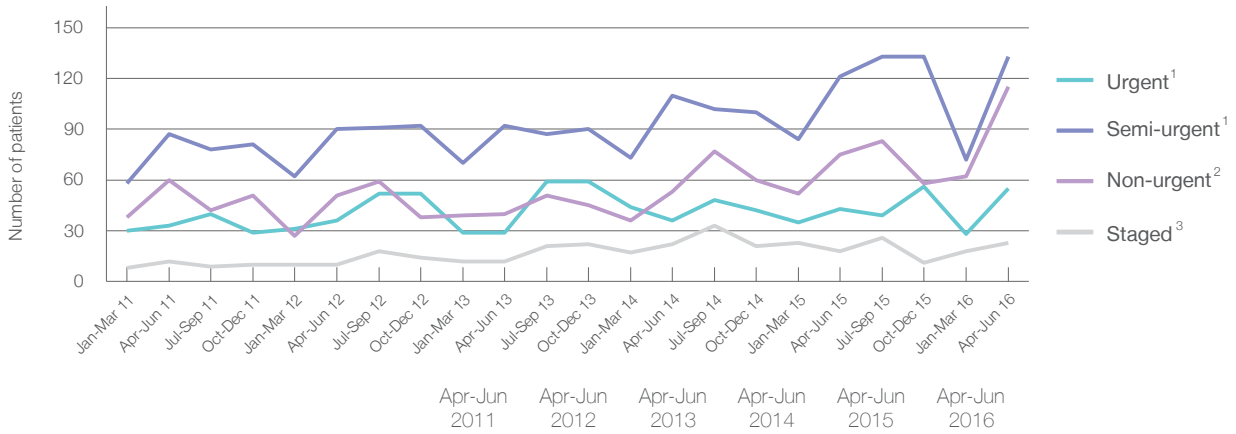

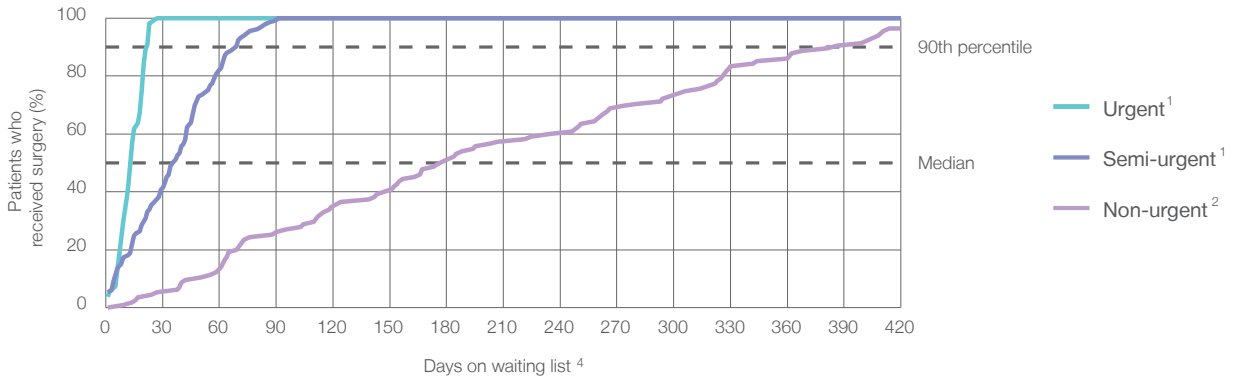

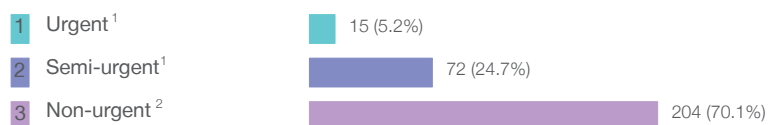

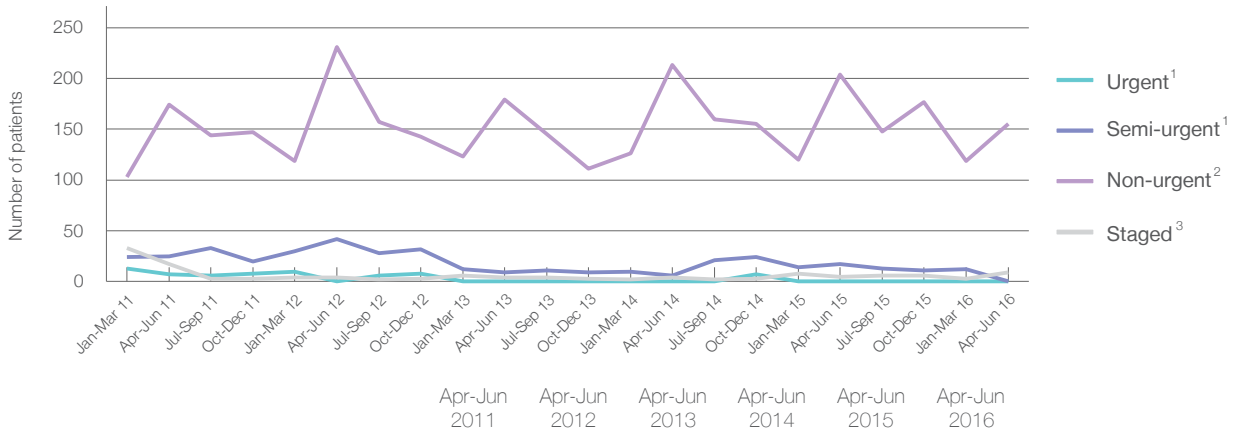

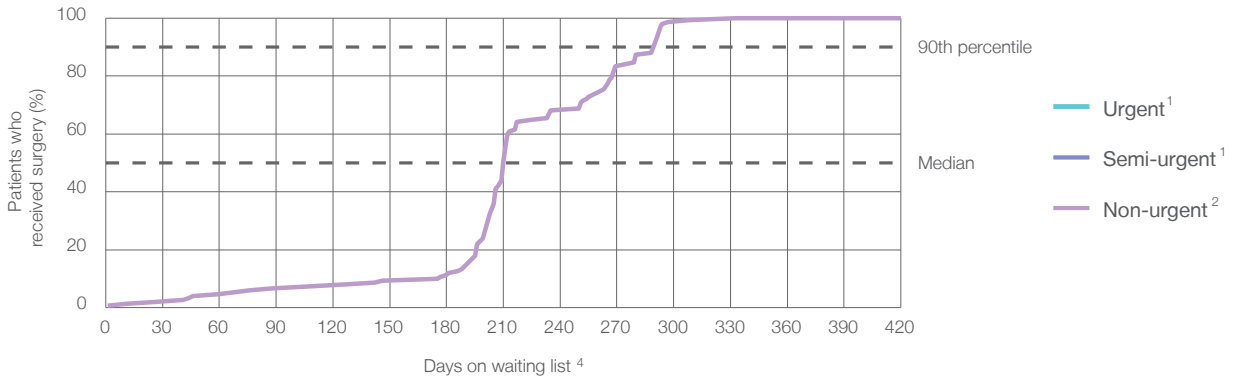

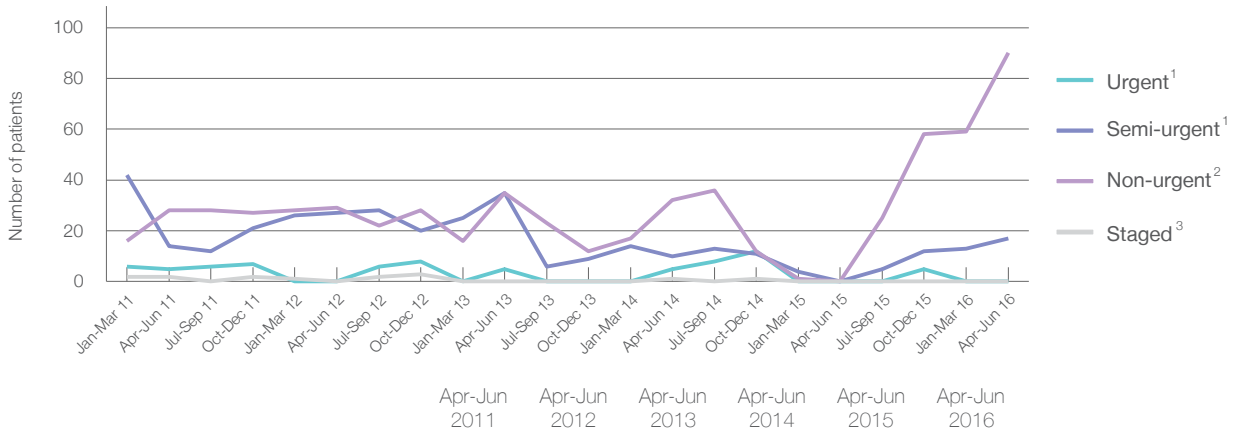

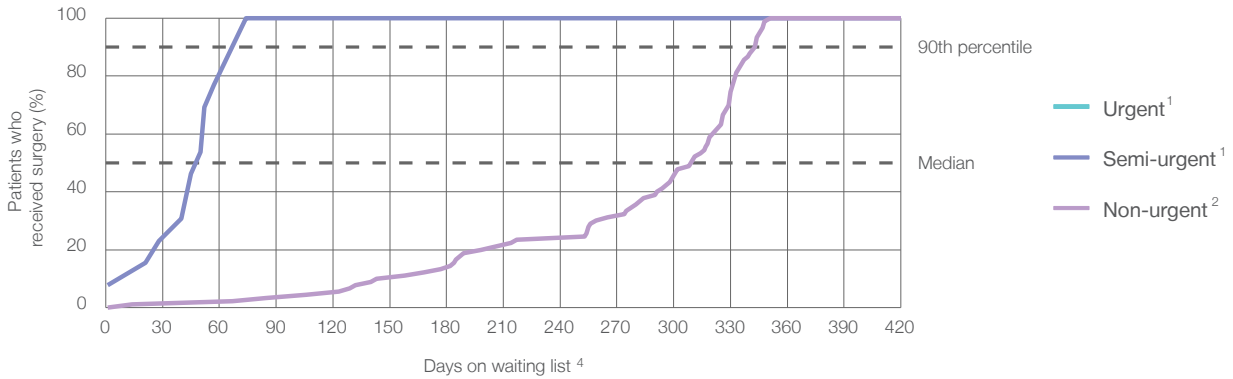

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)





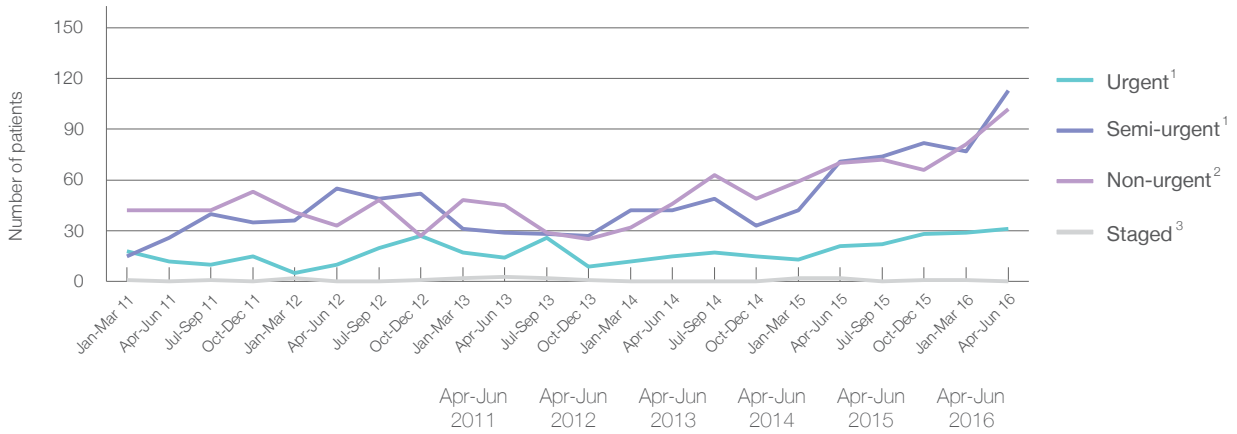

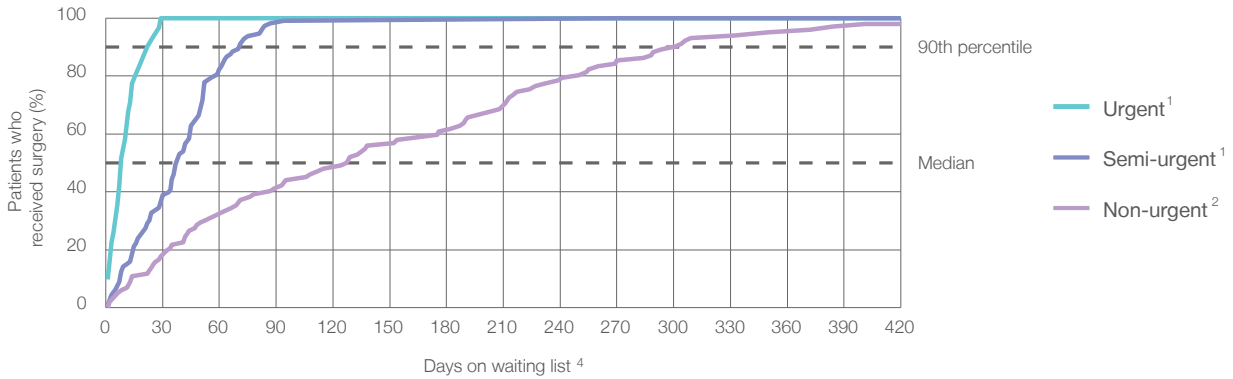

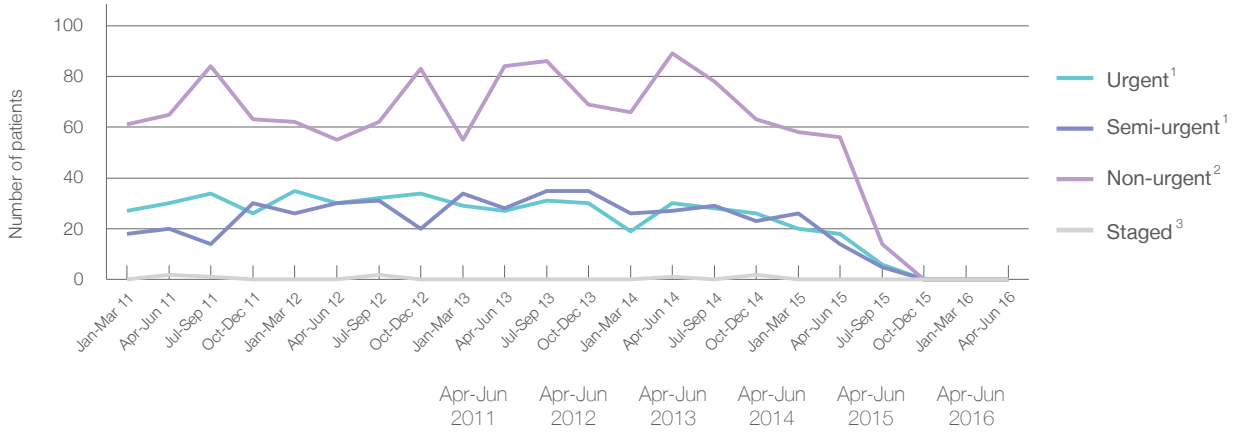

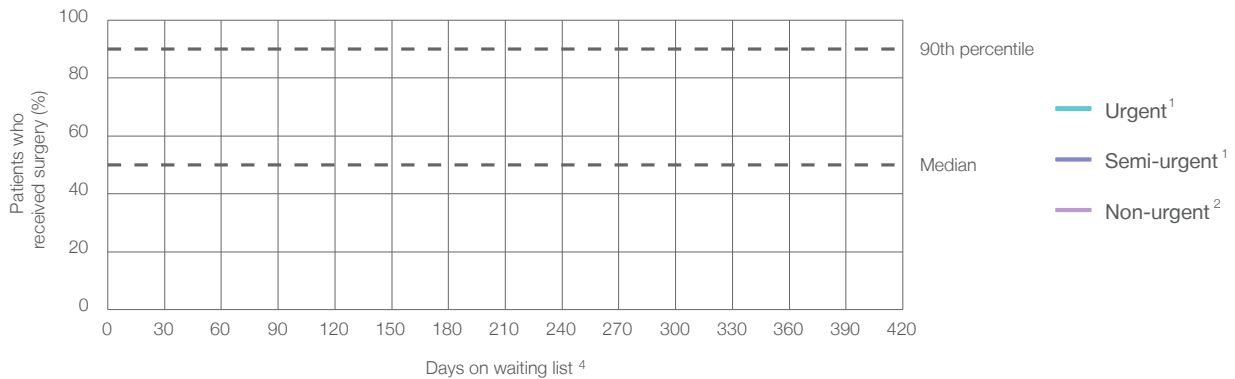

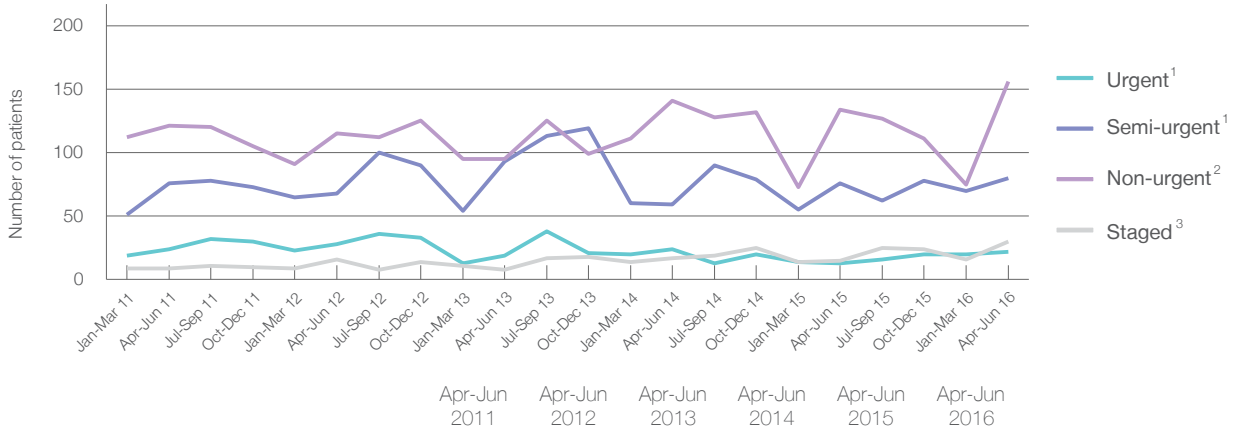

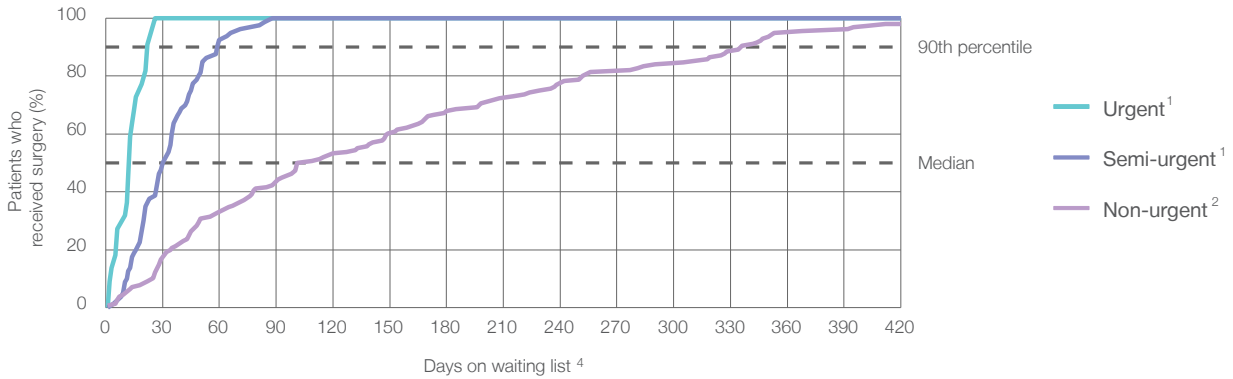

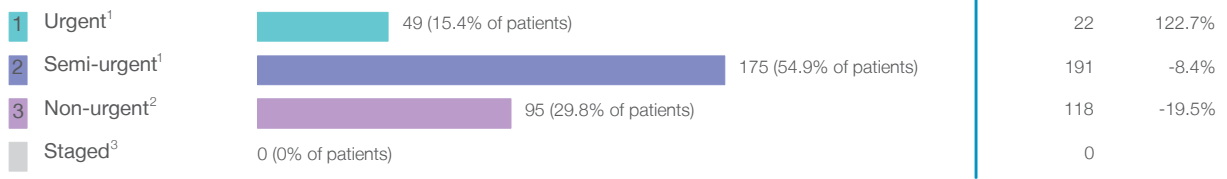

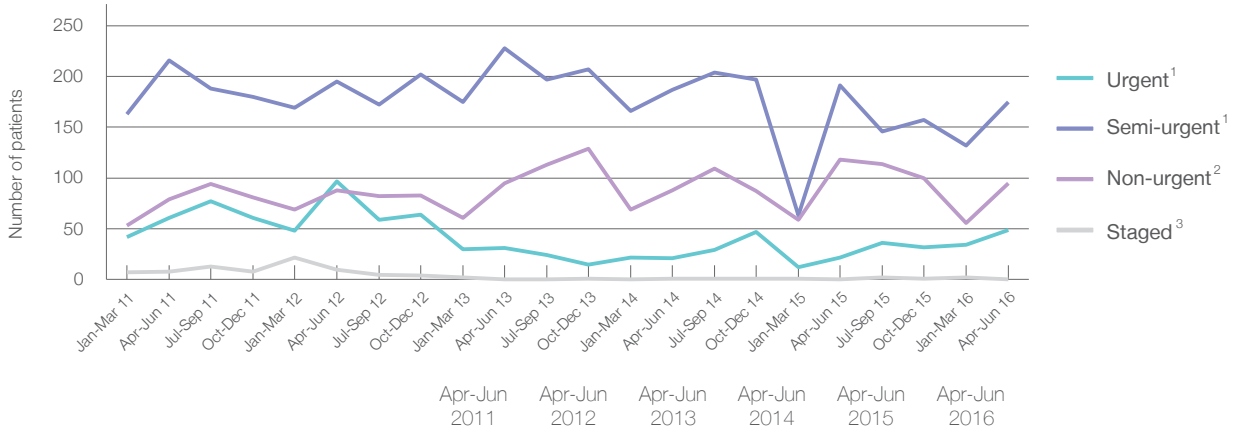

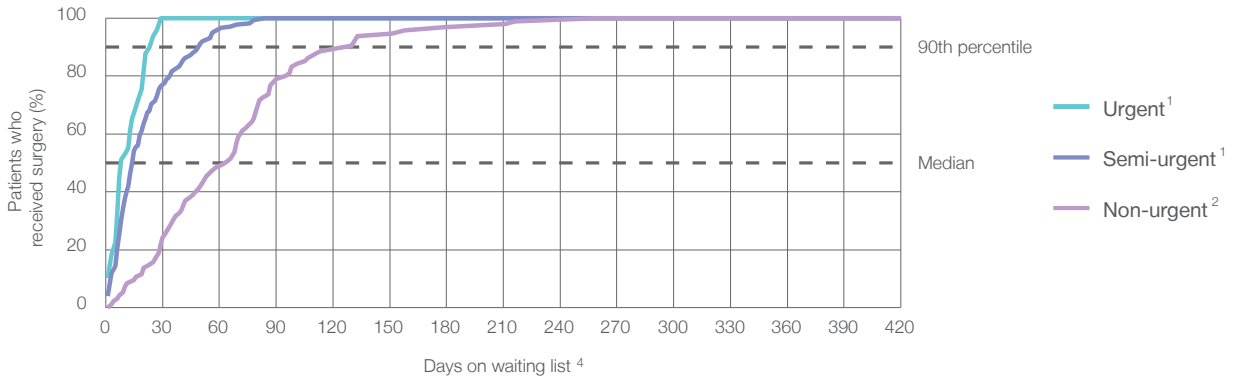

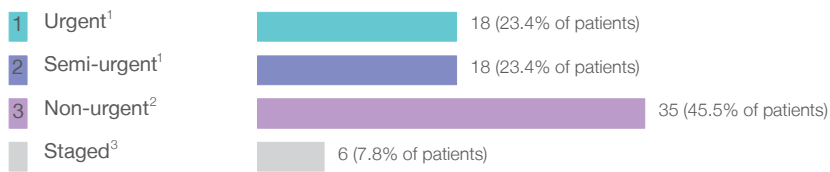

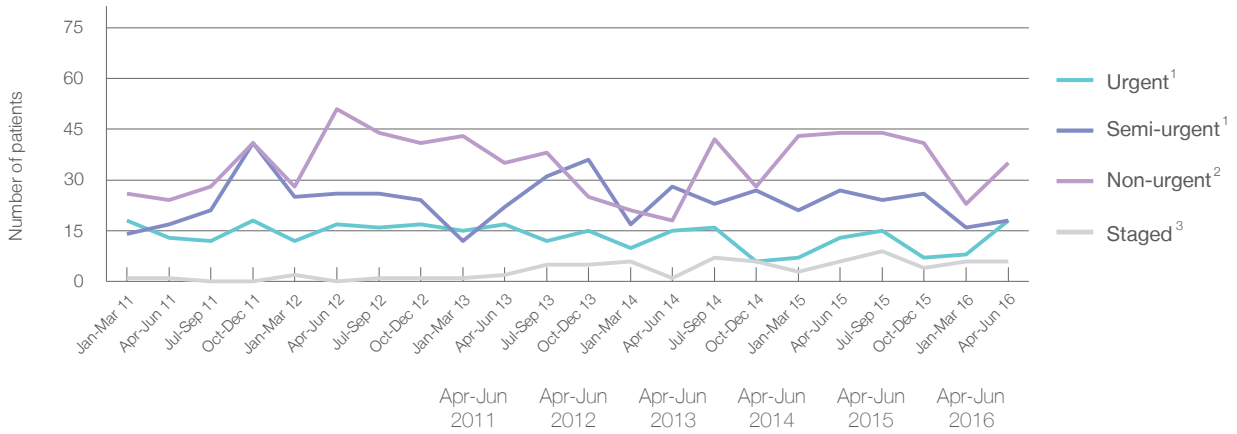

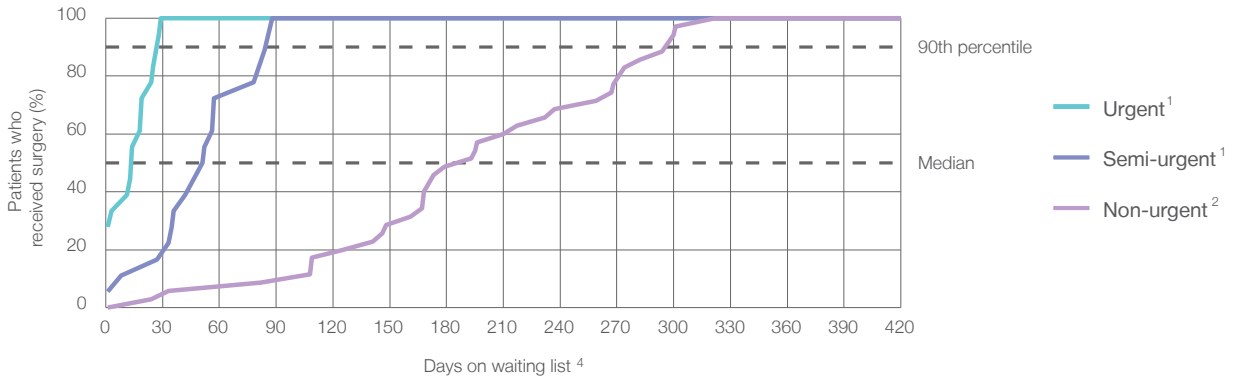

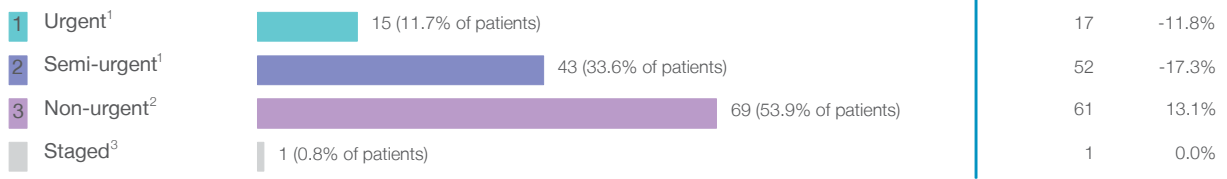

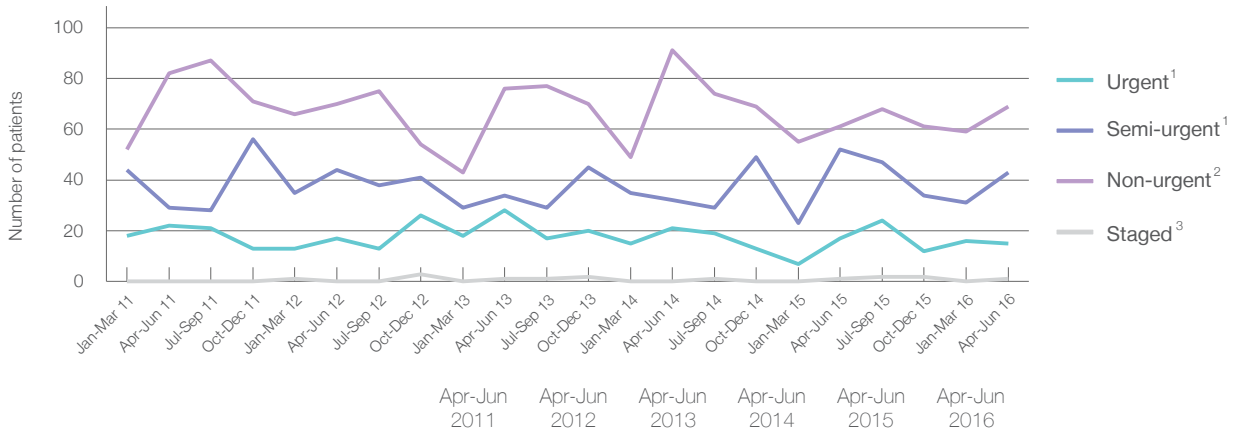

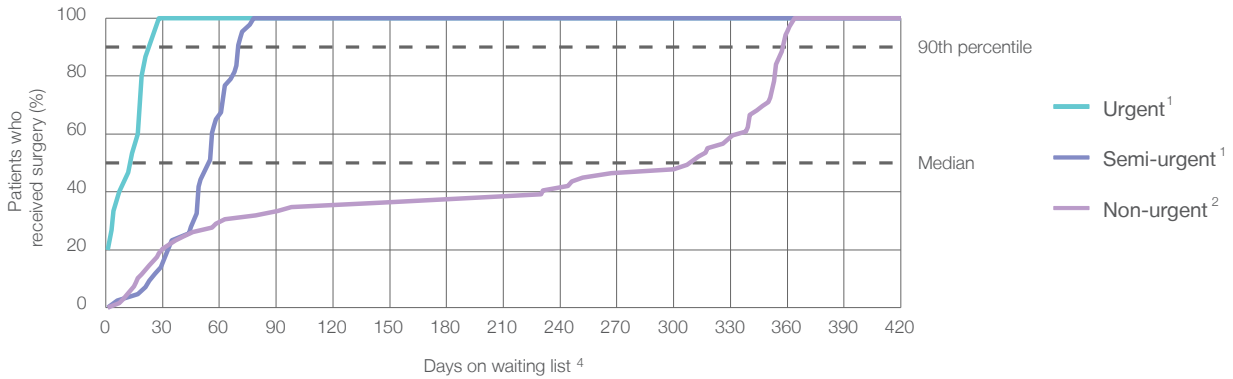

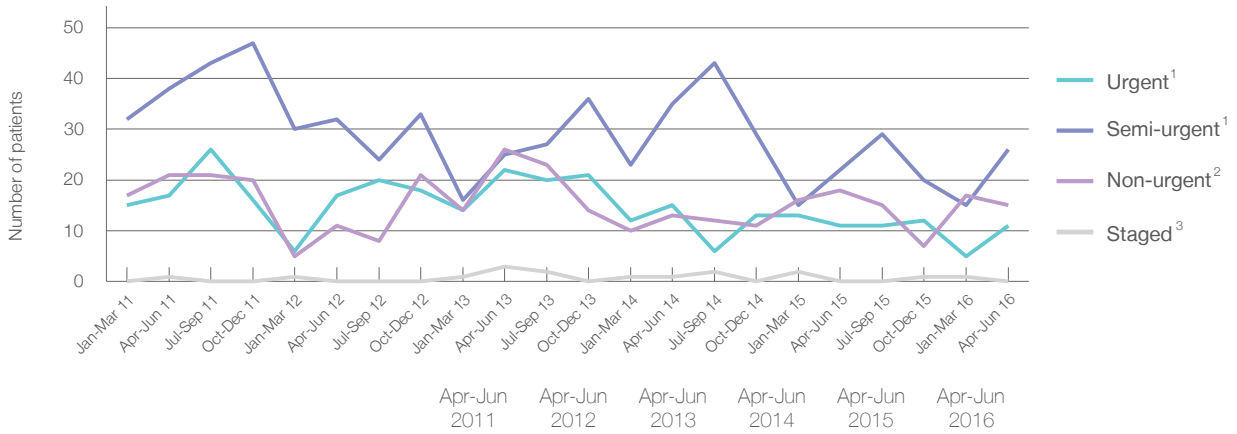

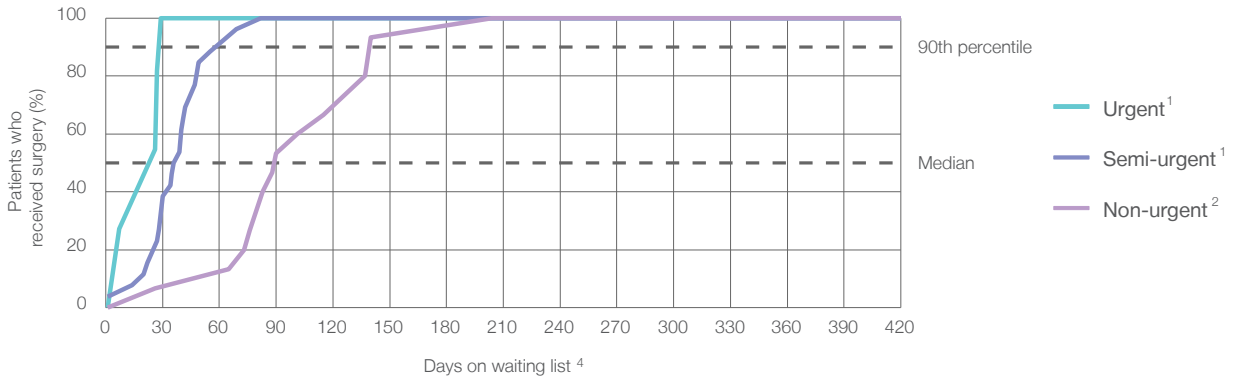

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)



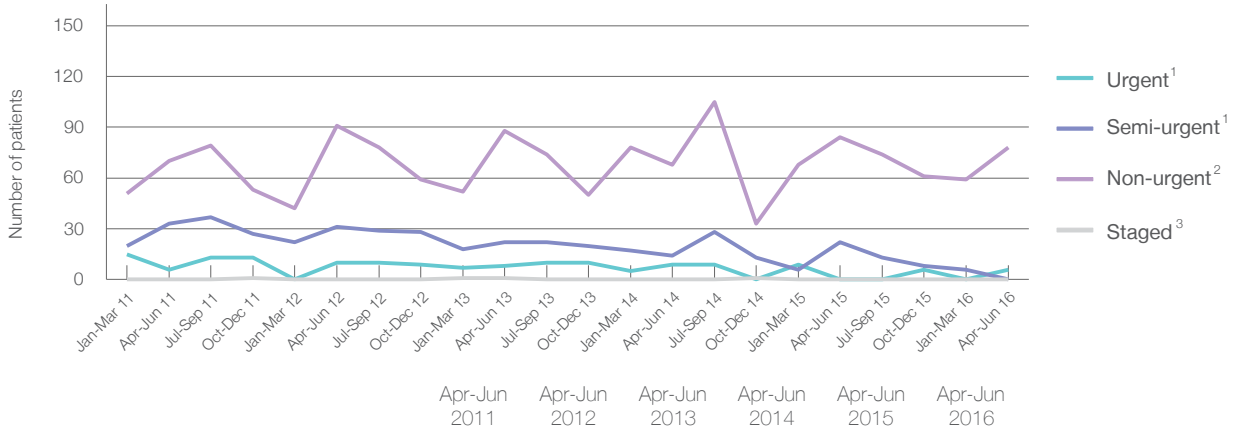

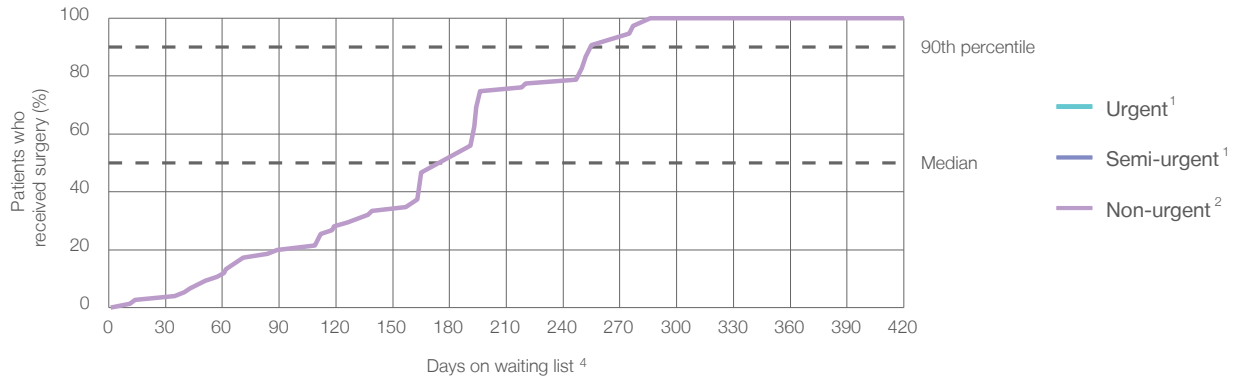



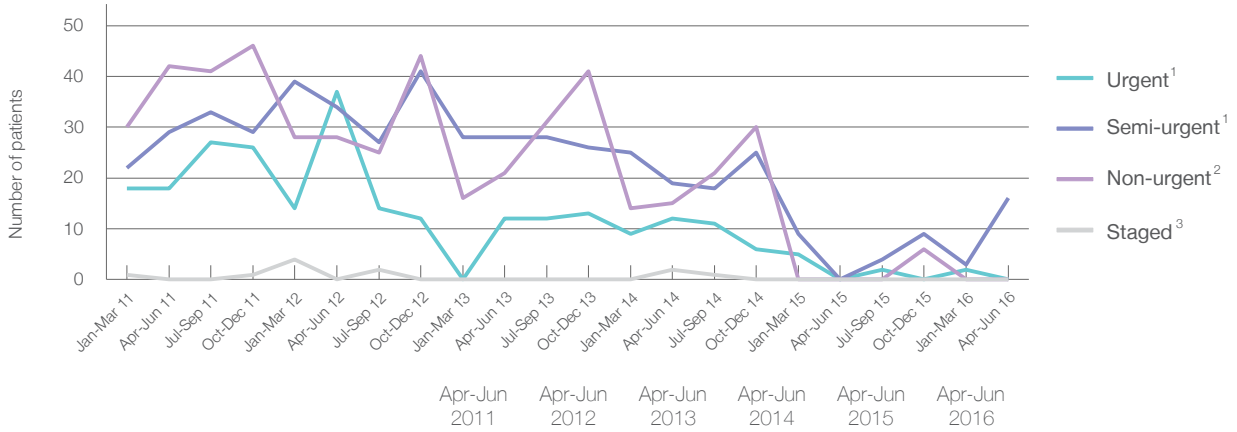

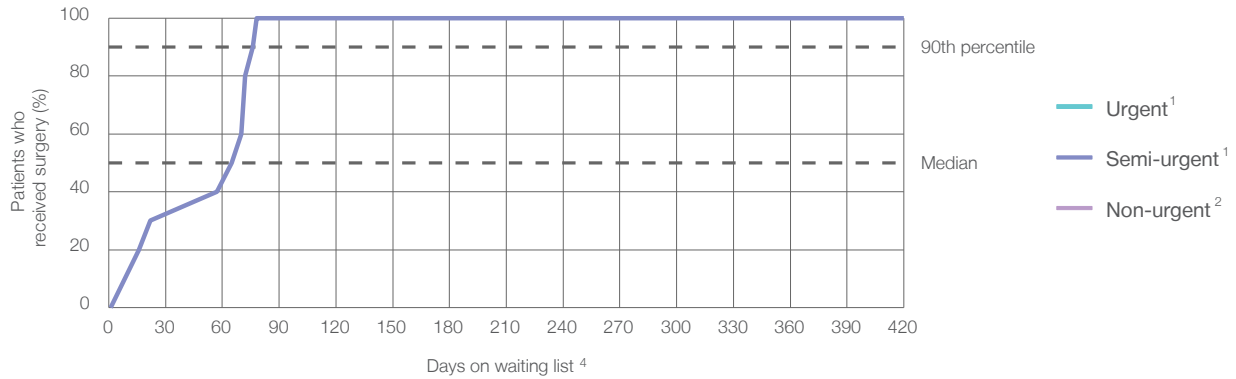

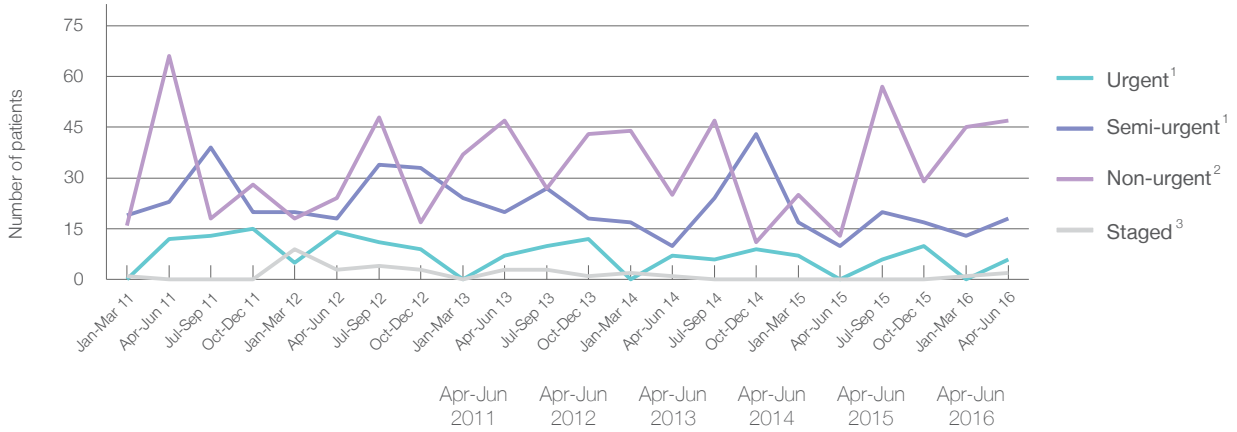

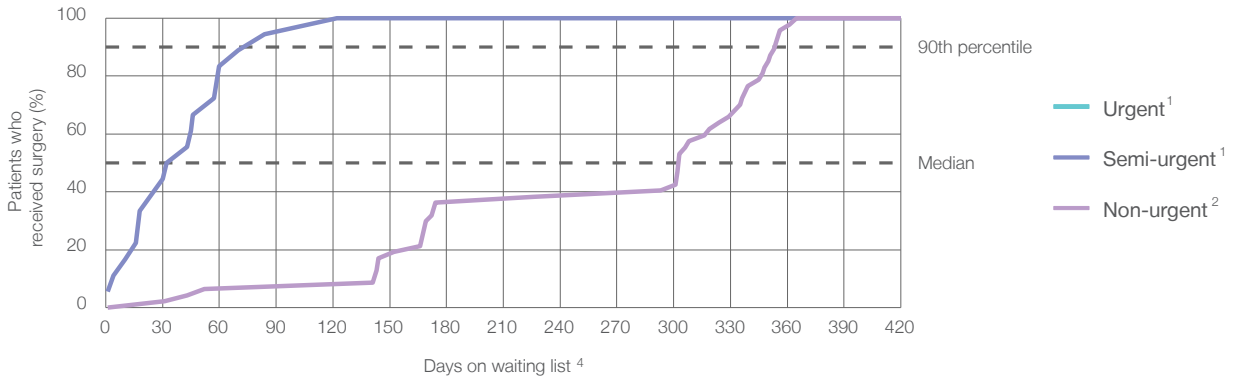

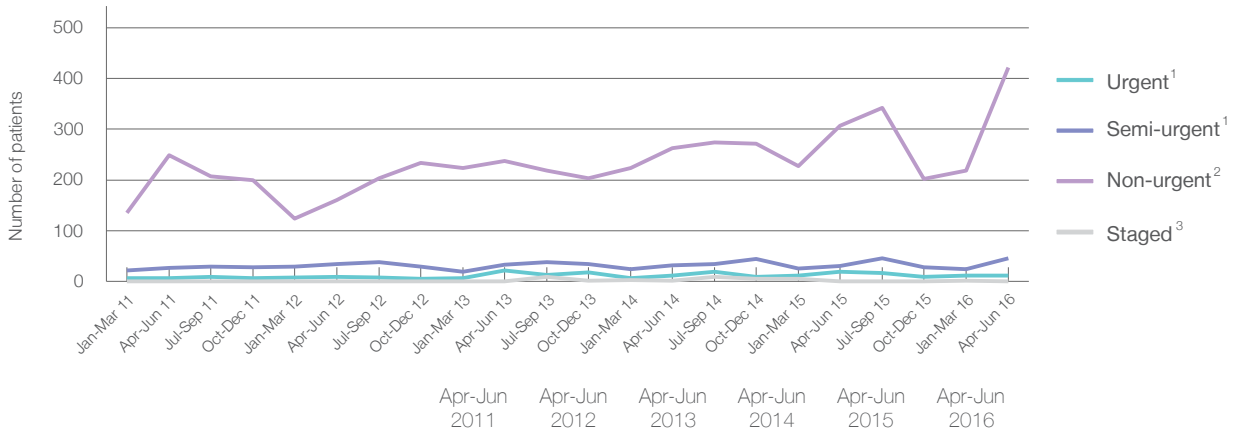

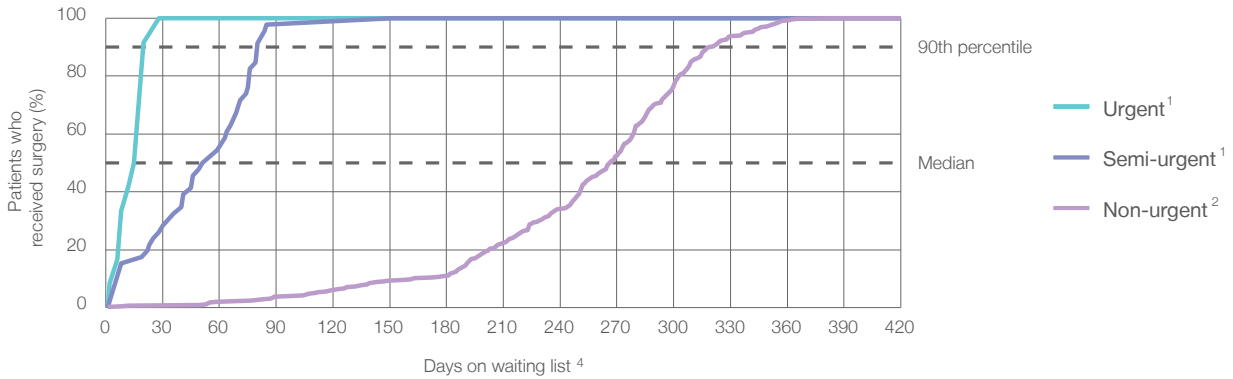



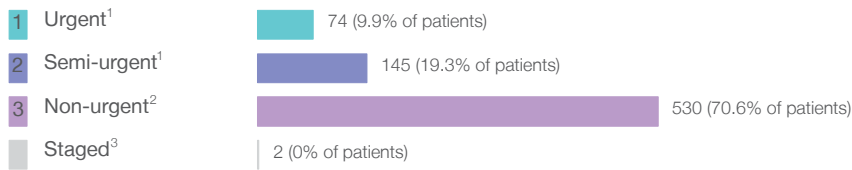

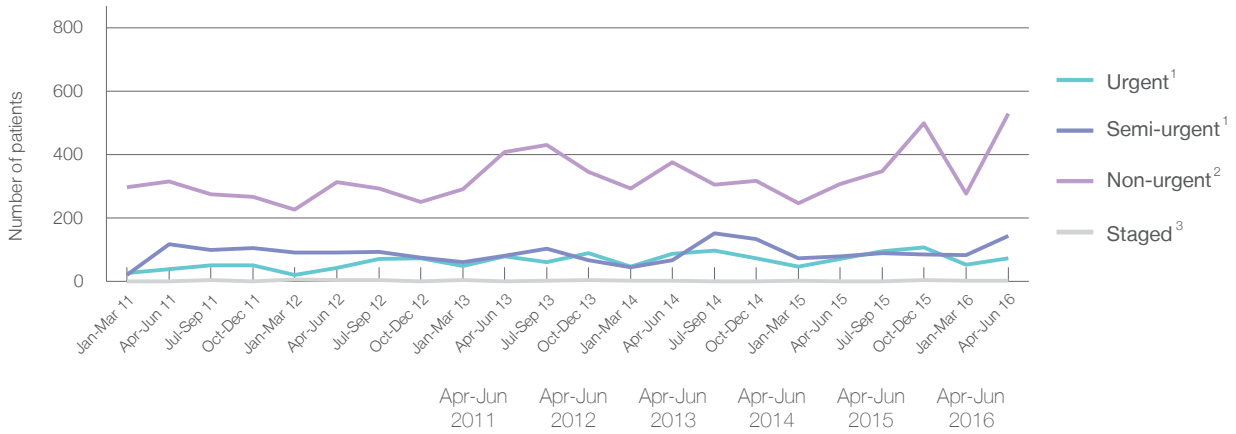

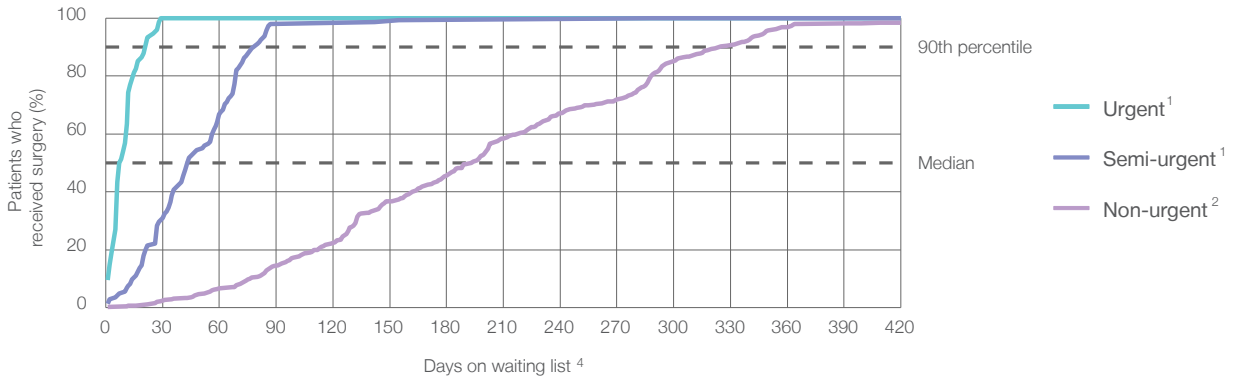

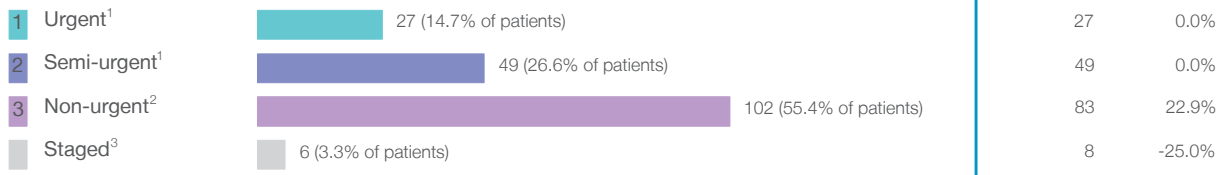

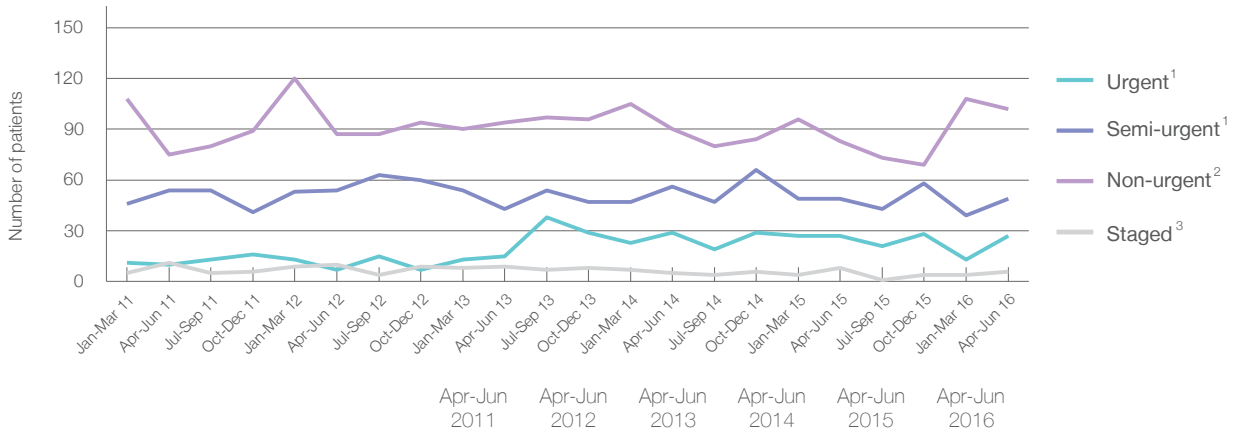

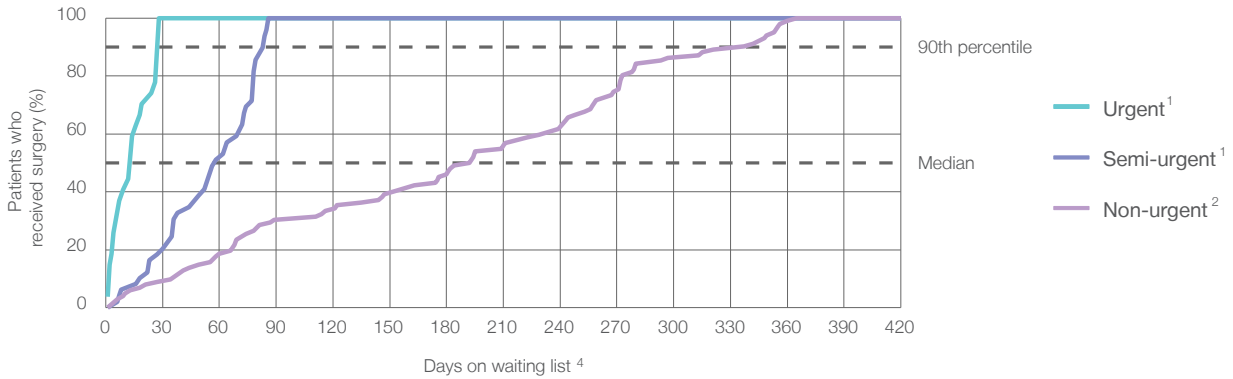

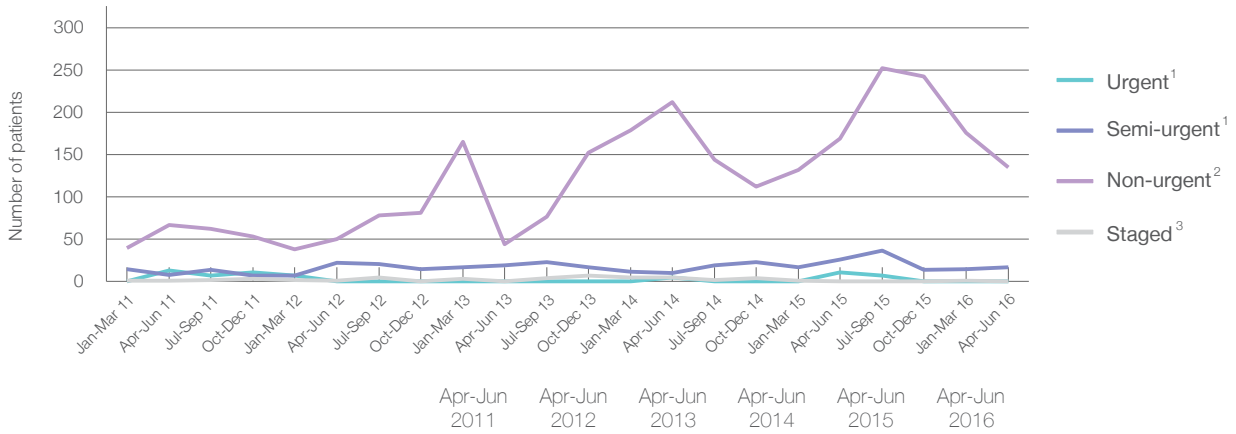

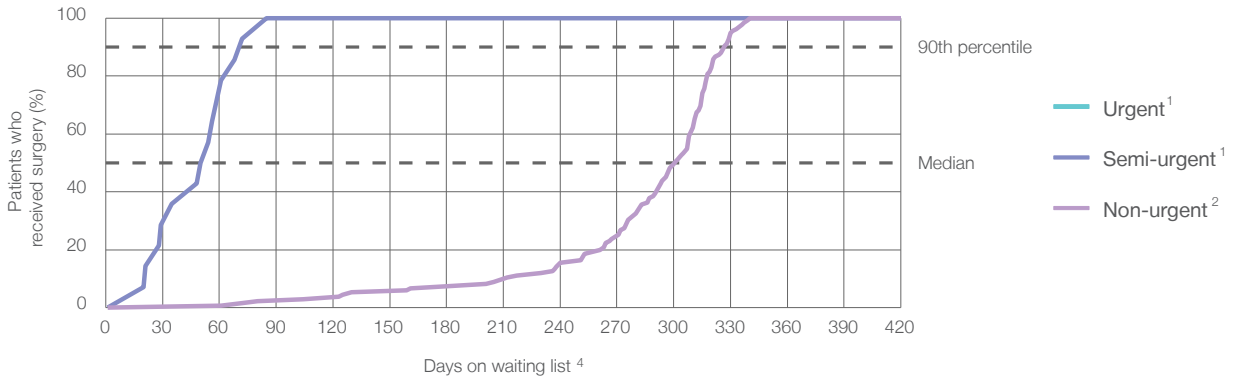

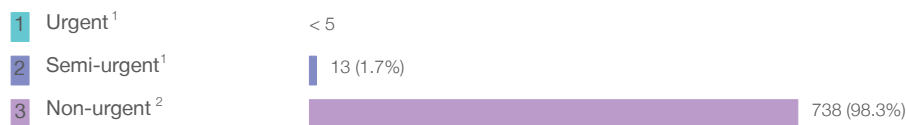

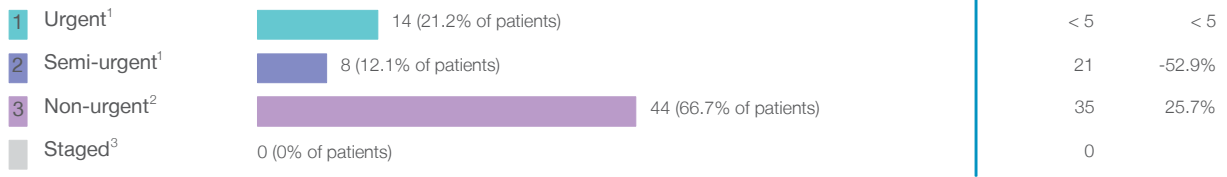

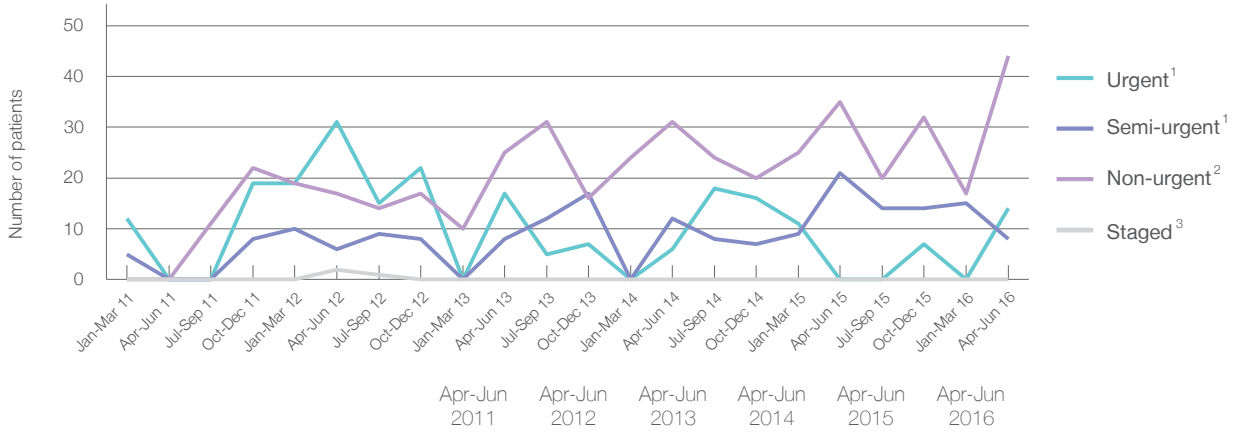

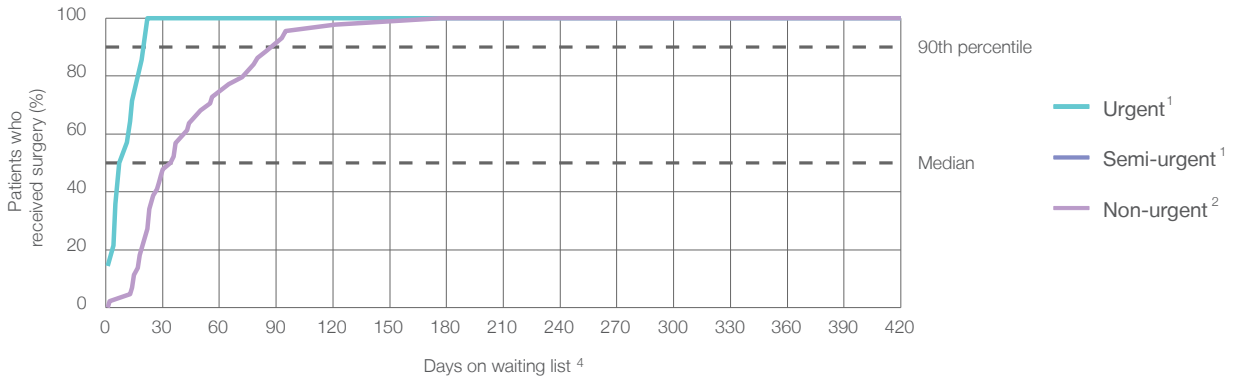

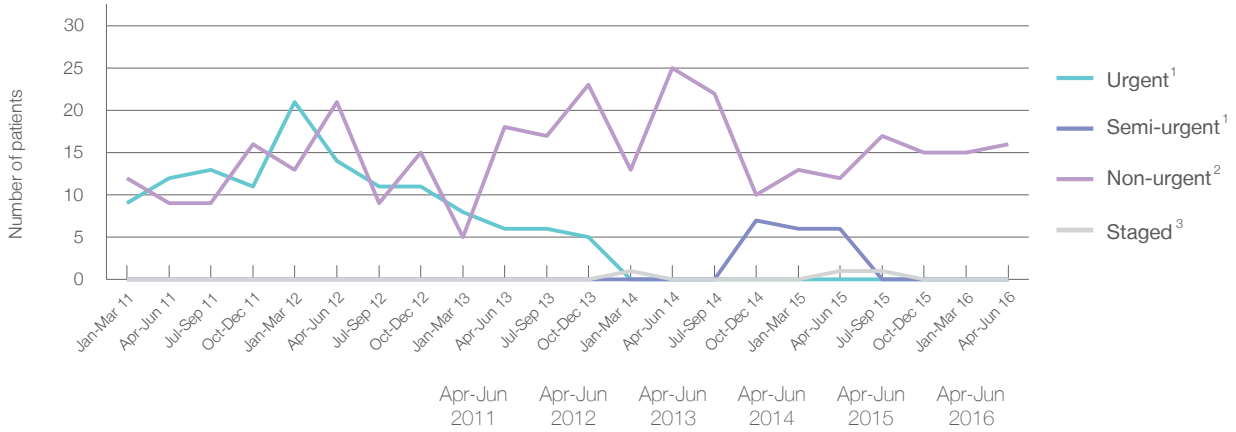

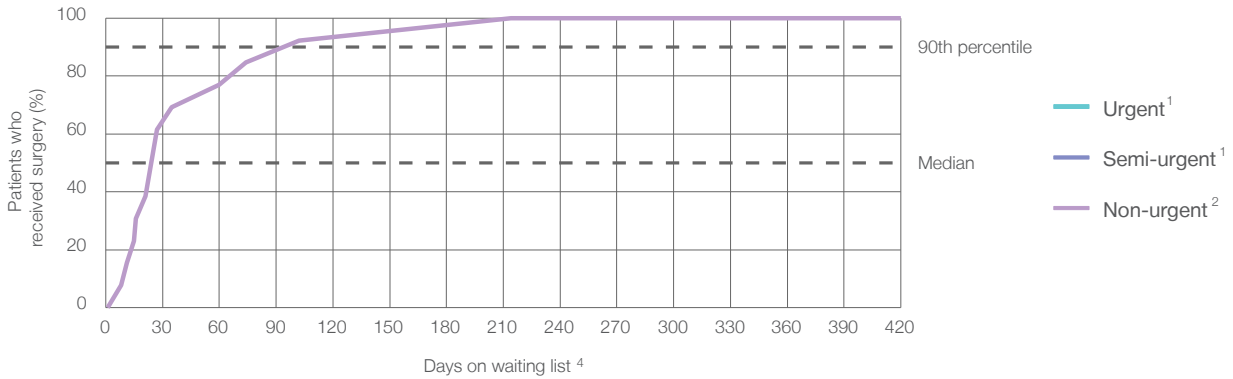

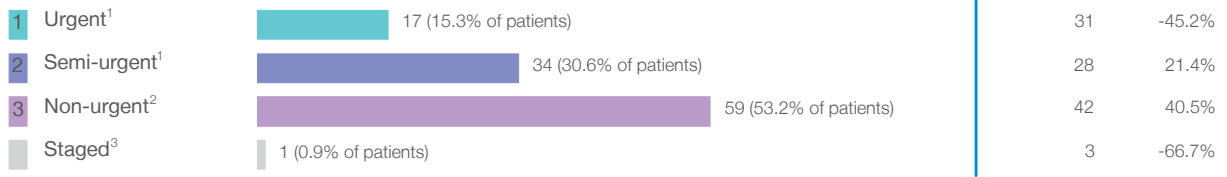

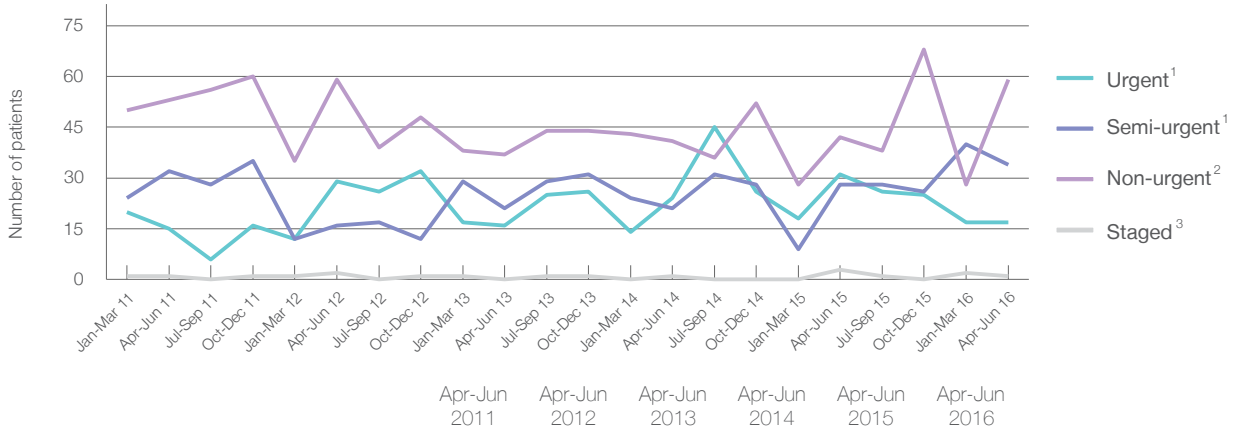

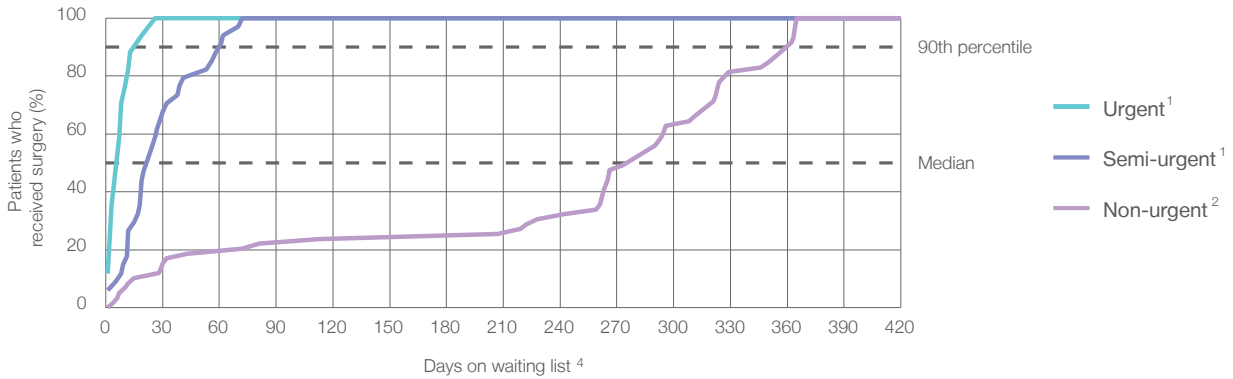

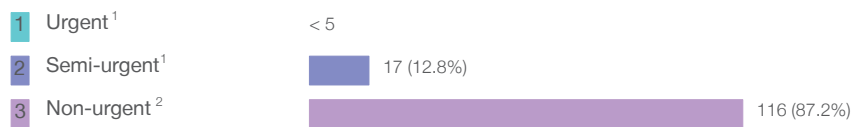

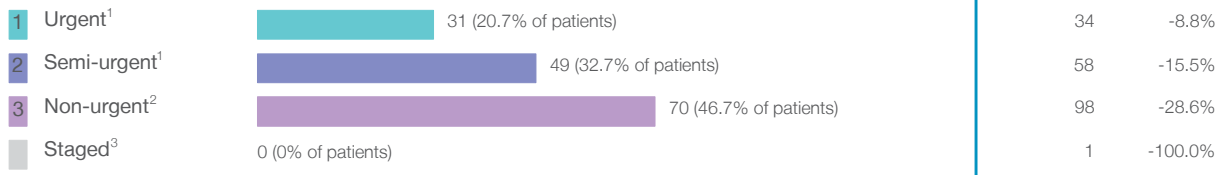

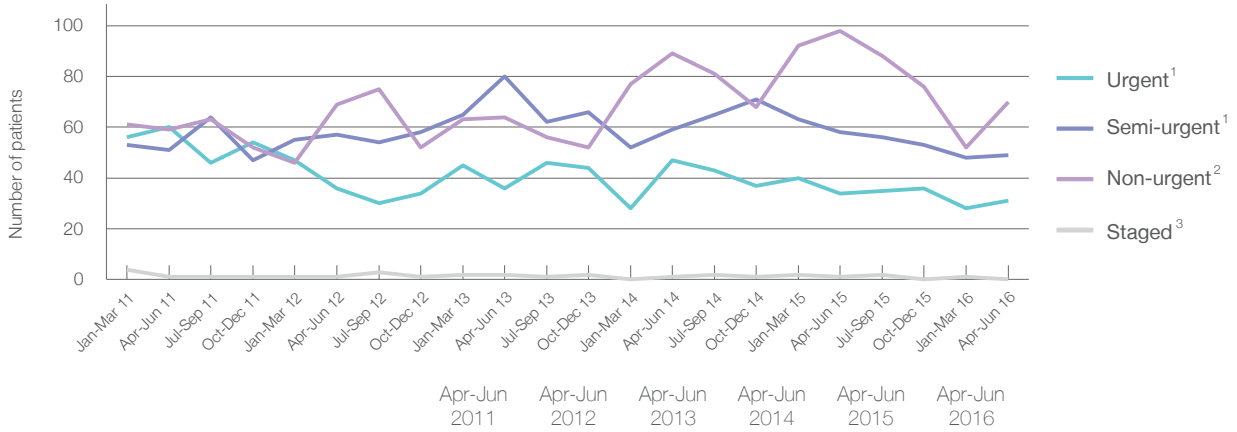

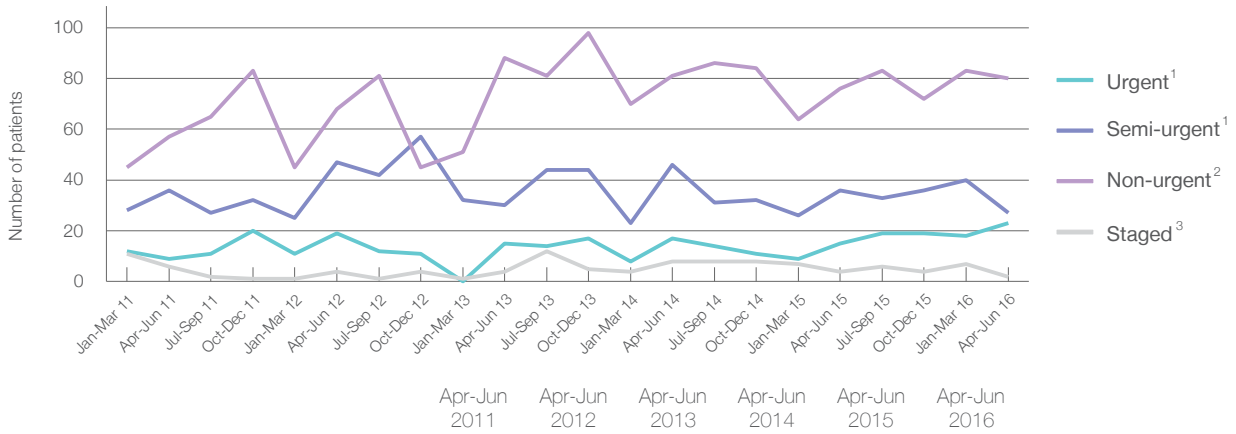

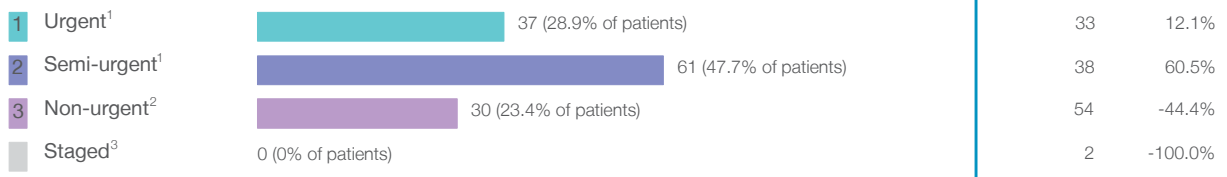

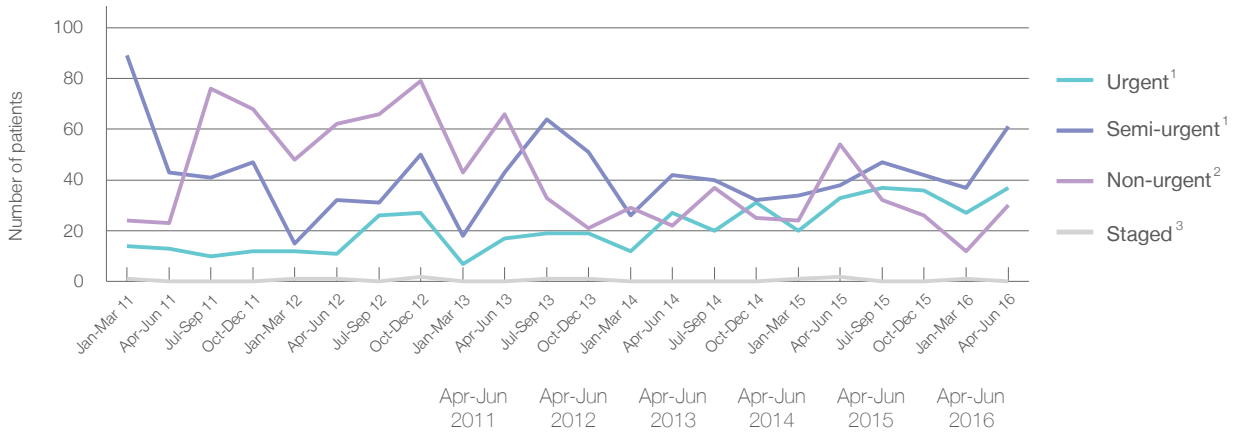

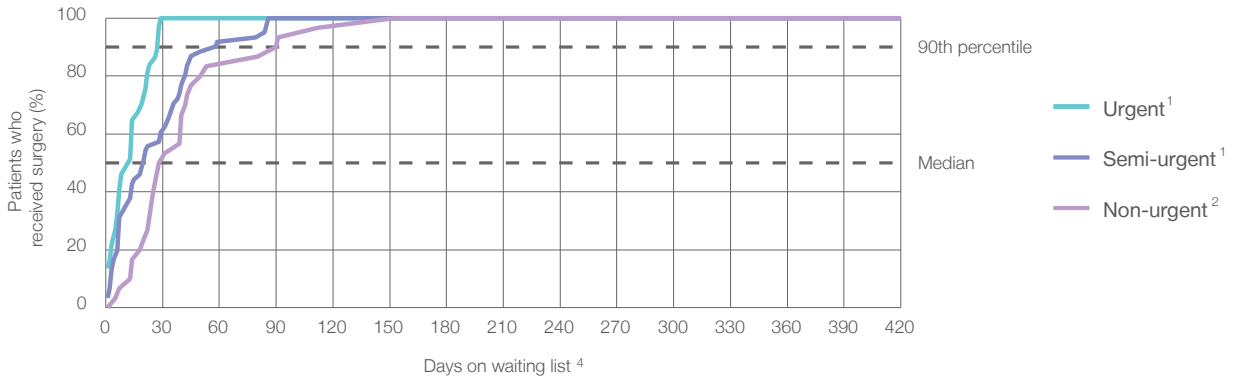

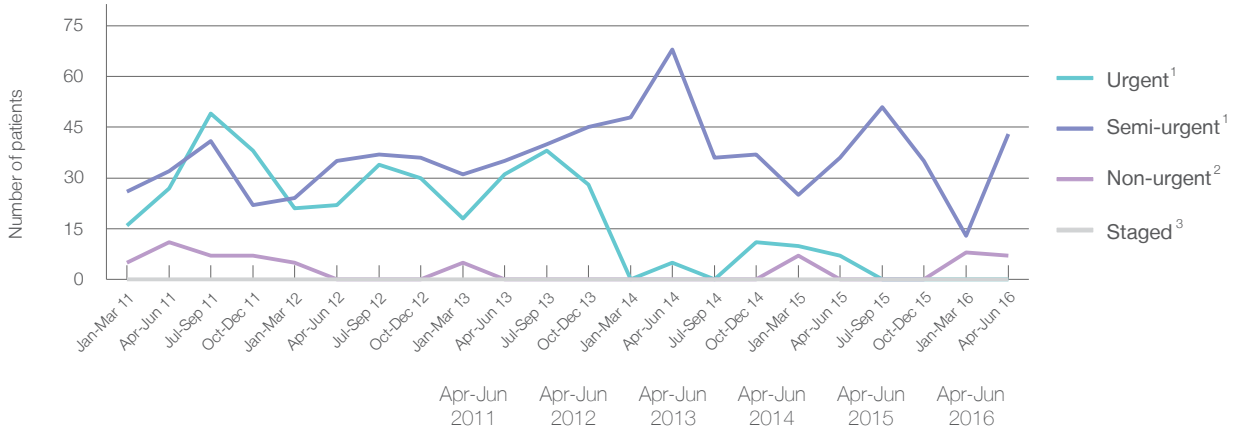

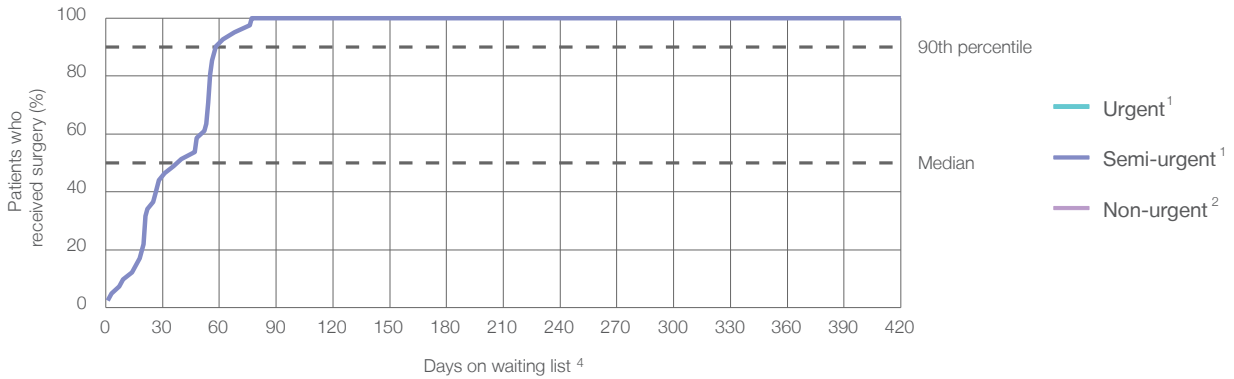

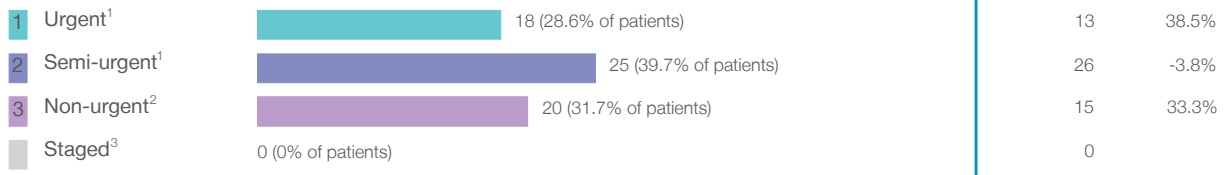

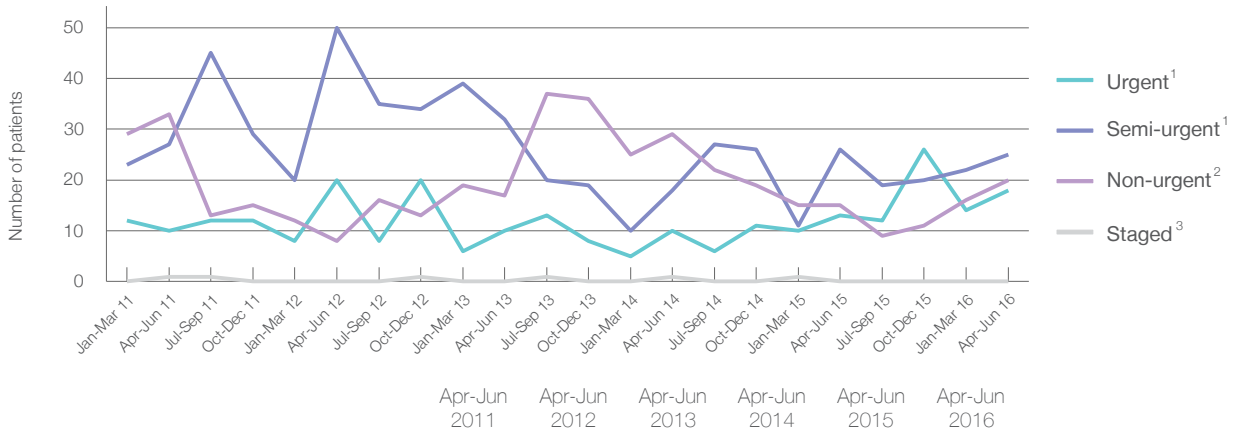

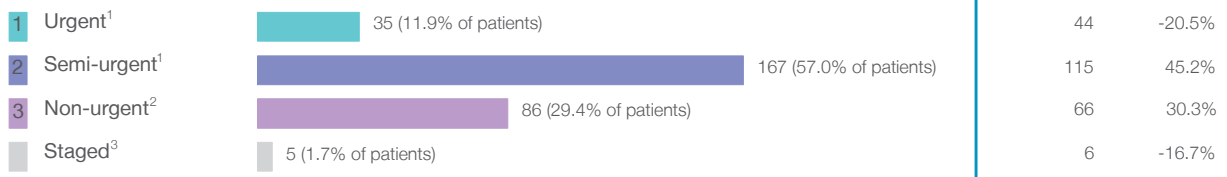

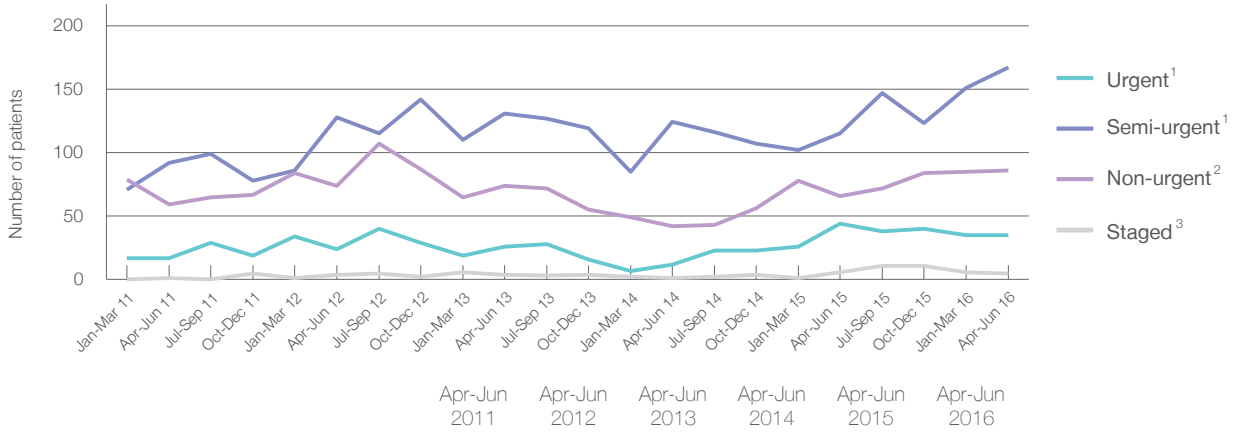

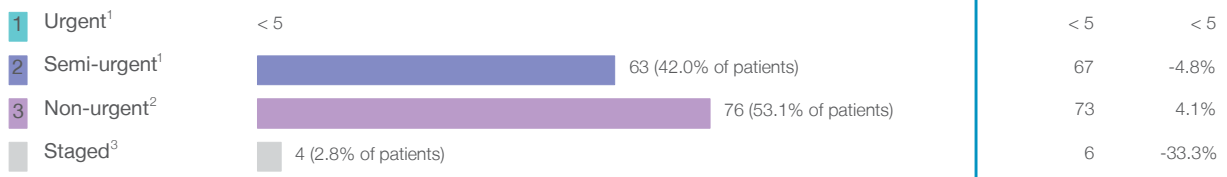

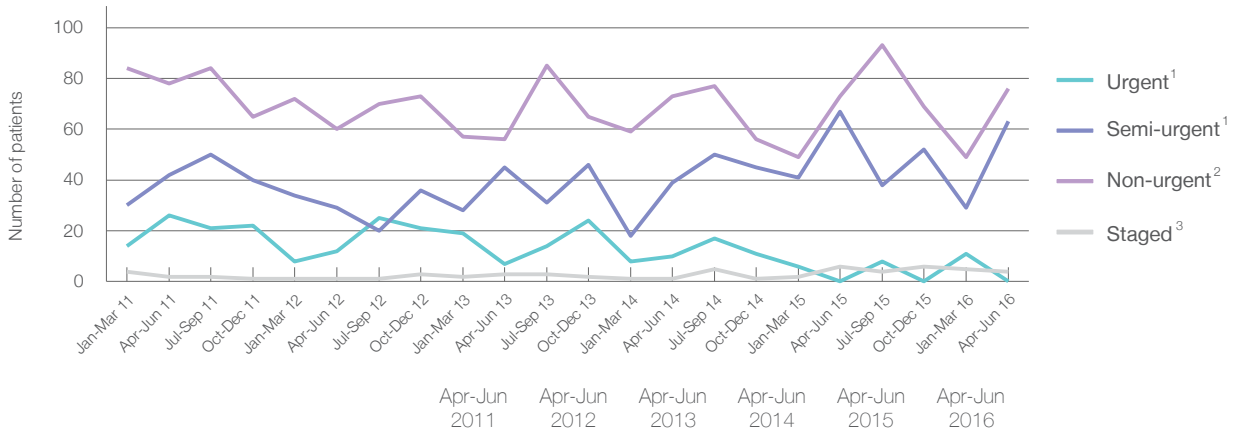

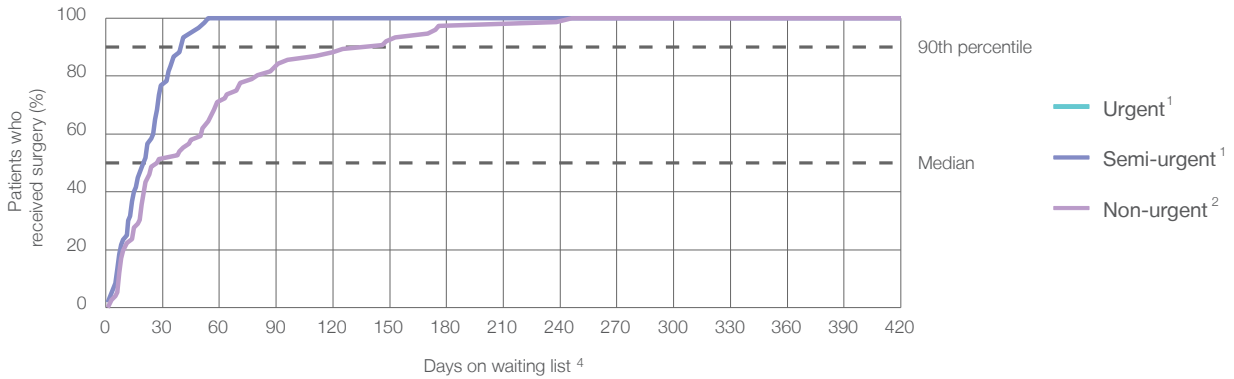

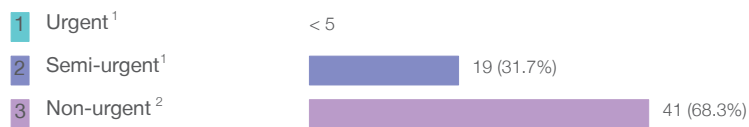

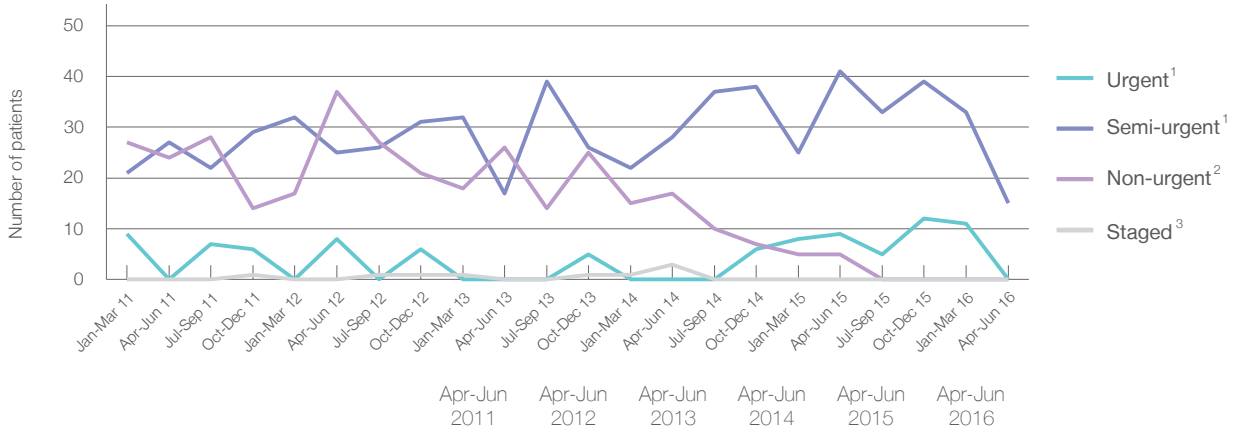

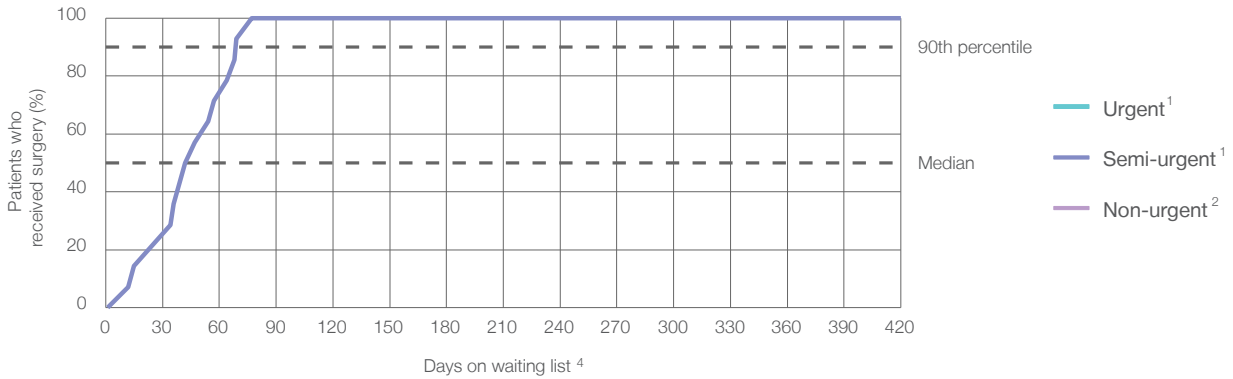

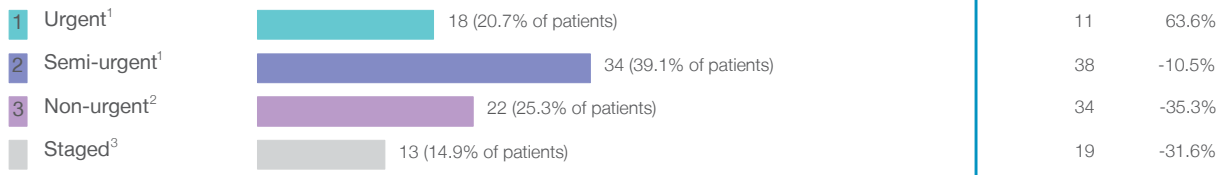

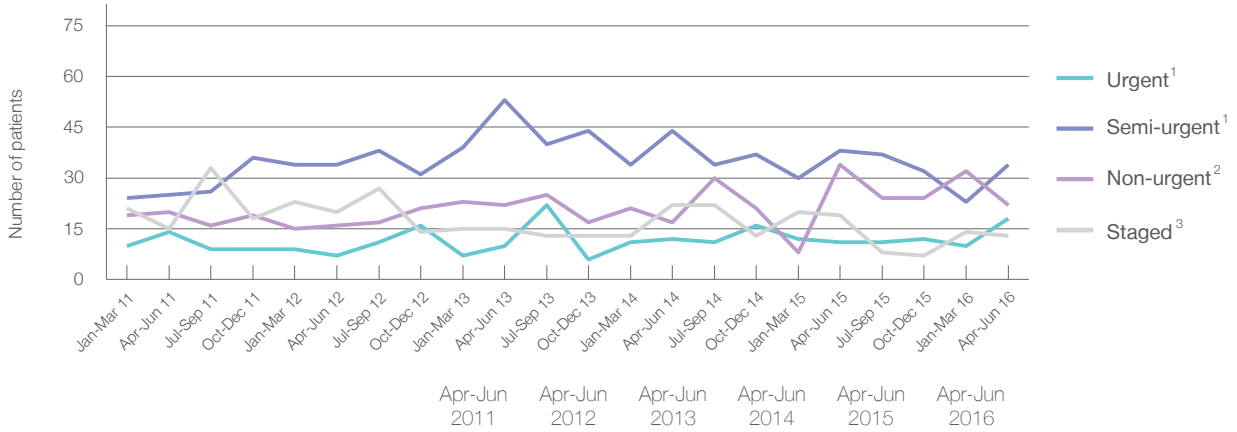

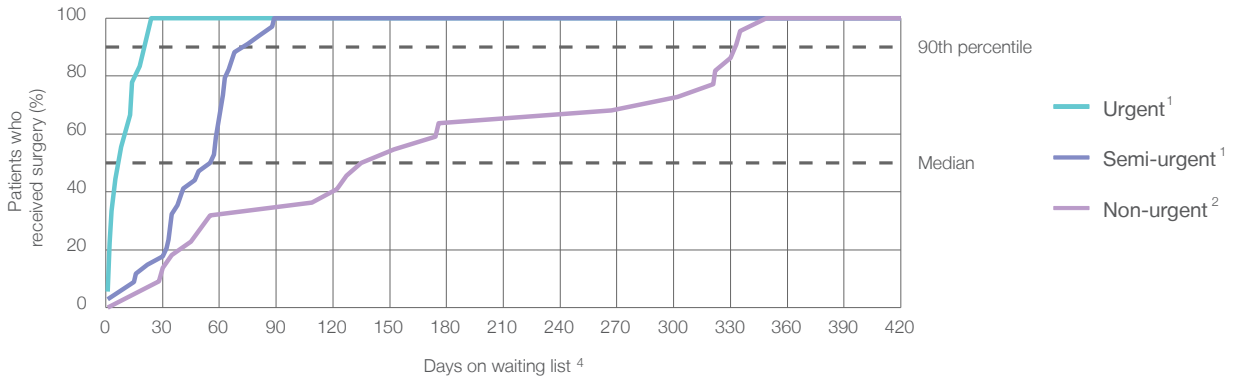
