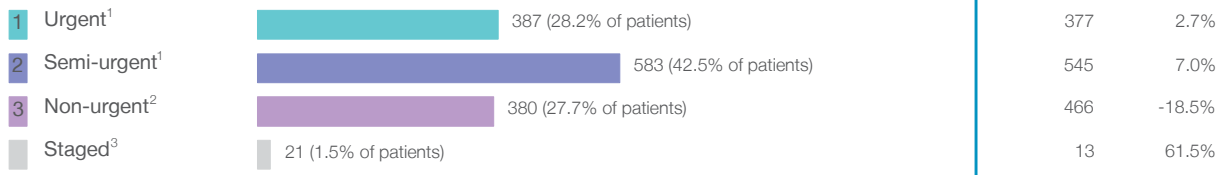

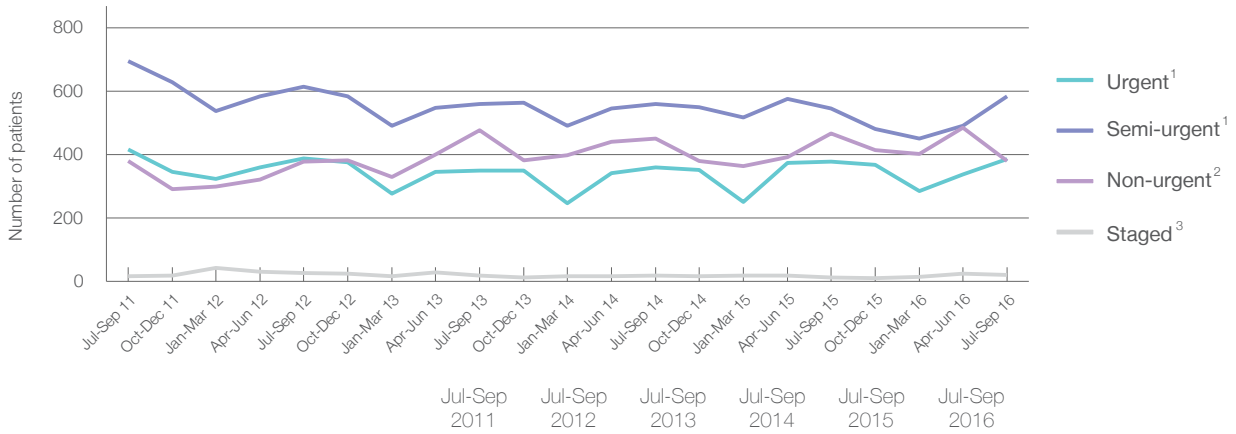

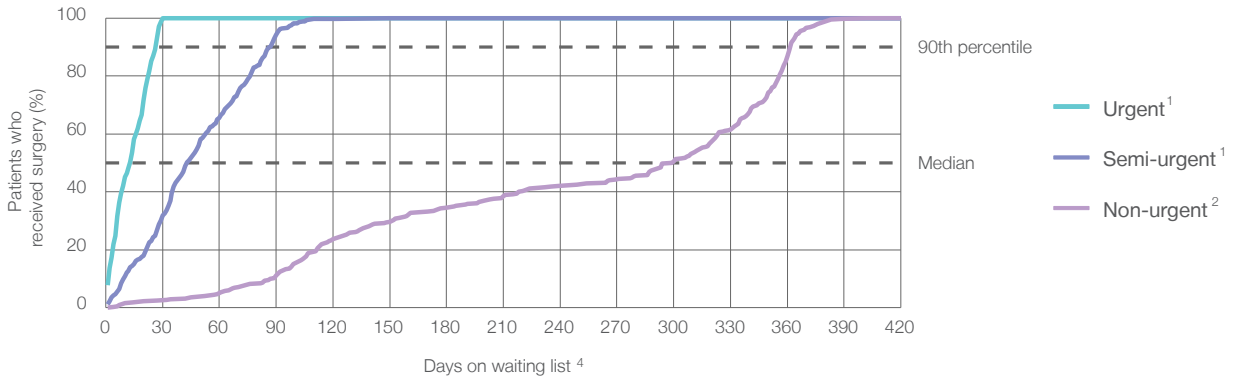

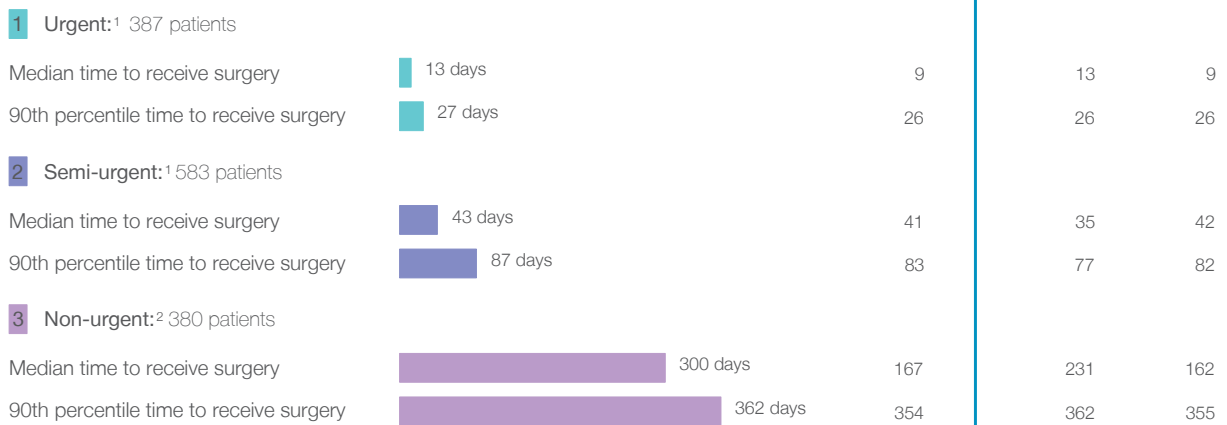
### Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

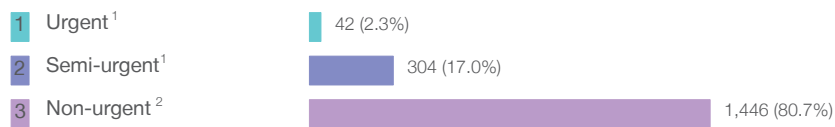

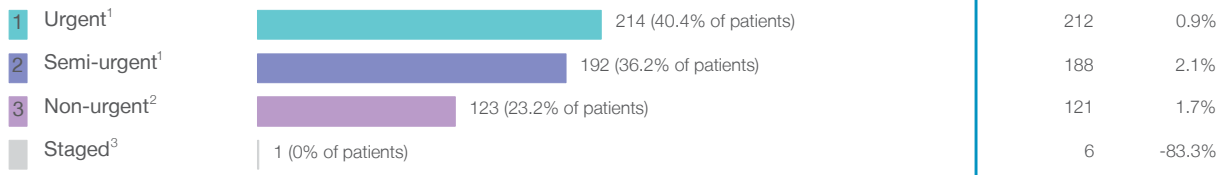

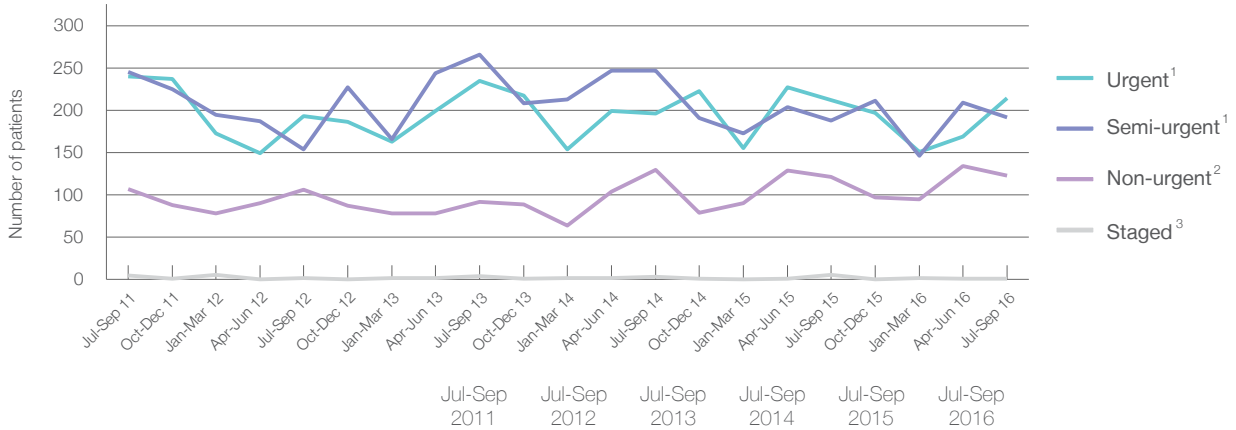

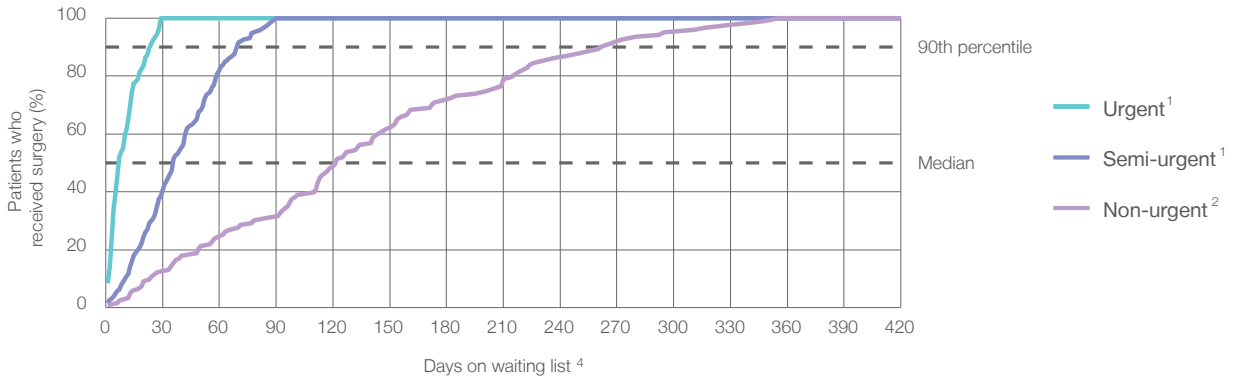

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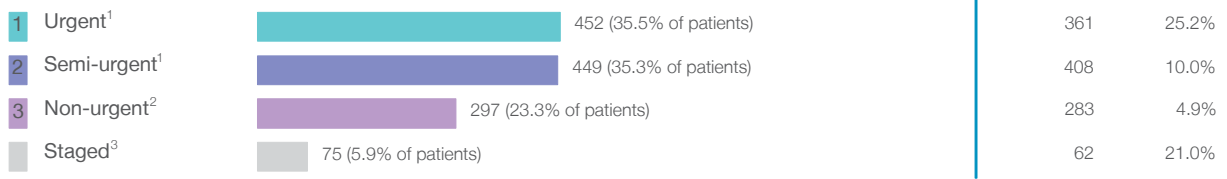

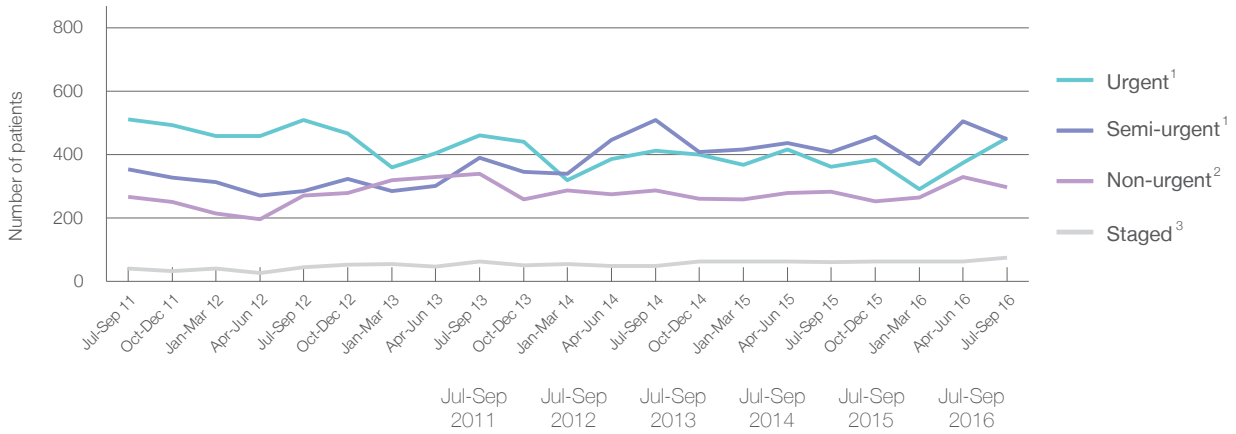

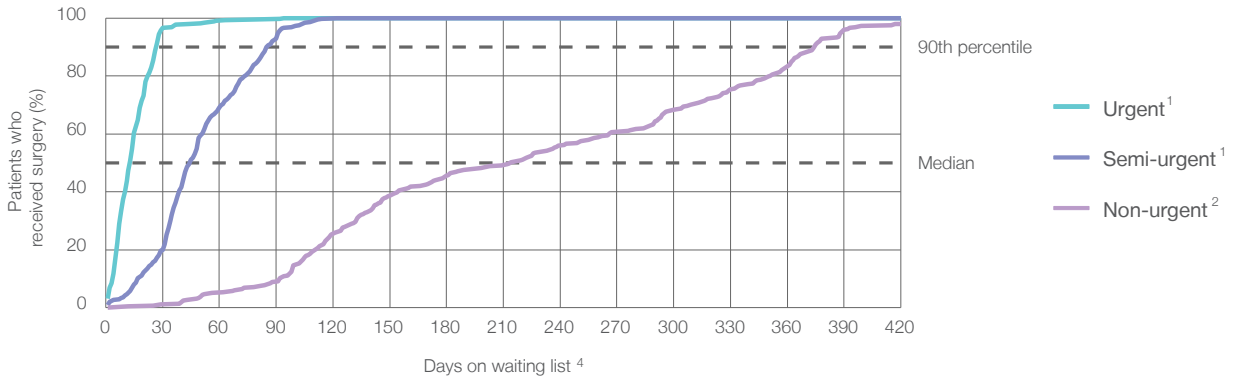

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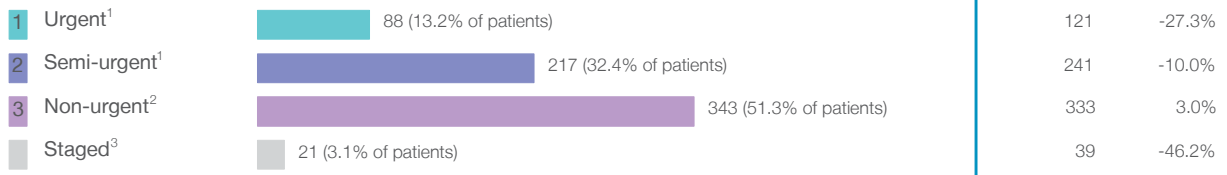

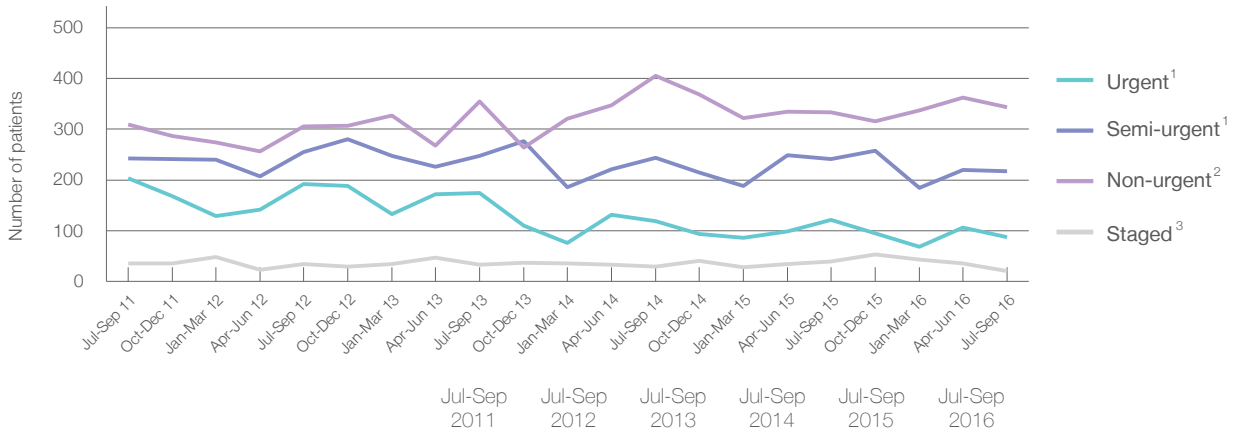

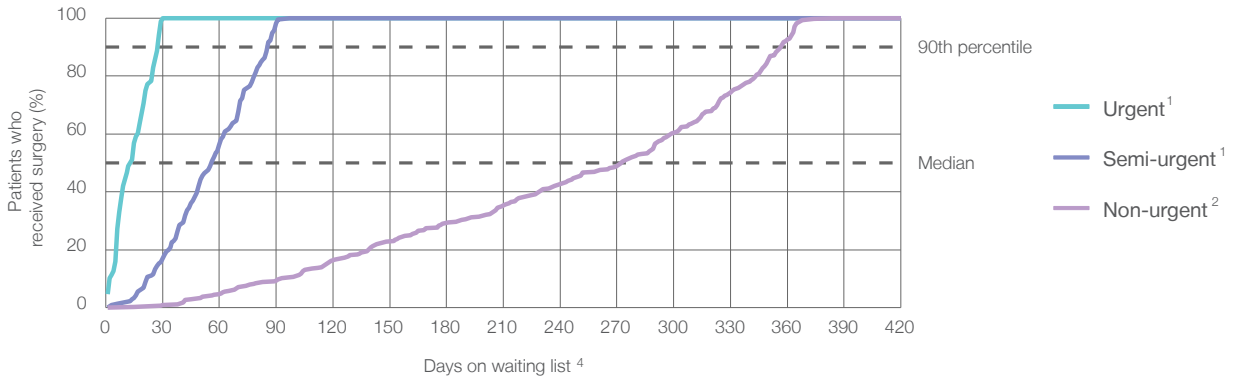

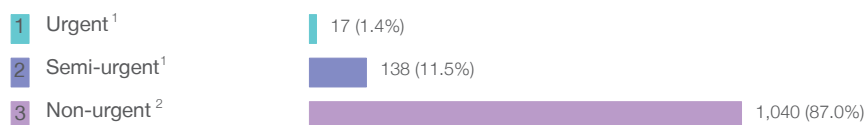

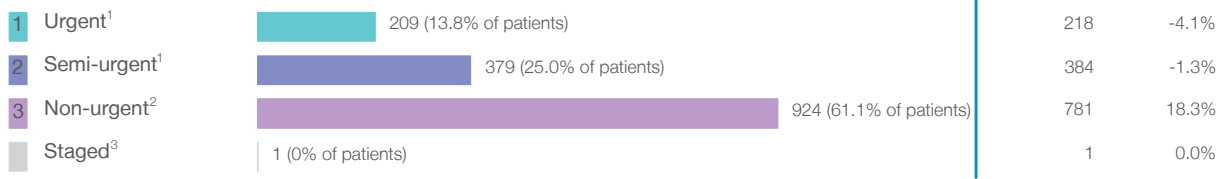

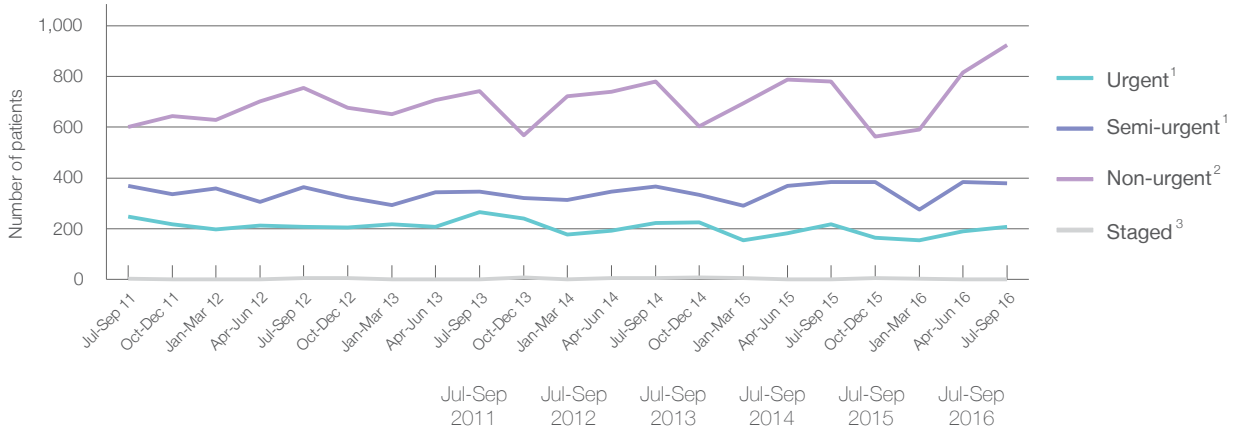

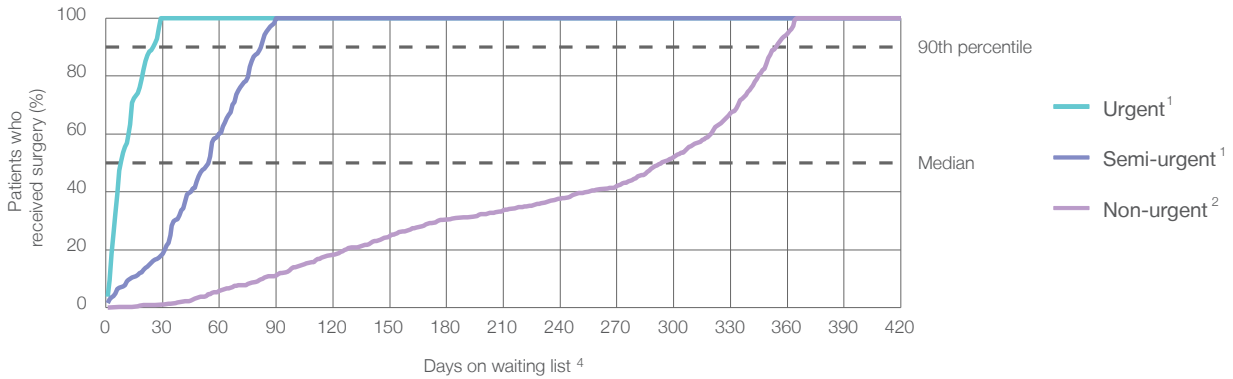
