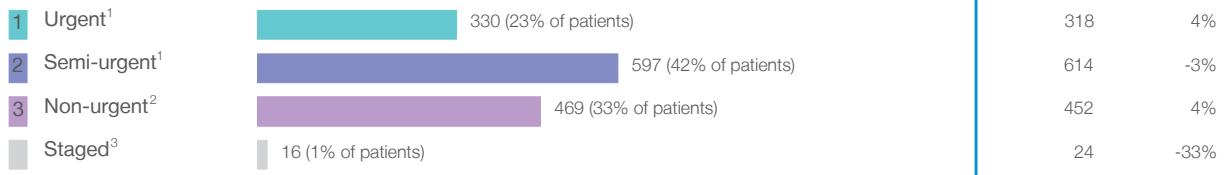

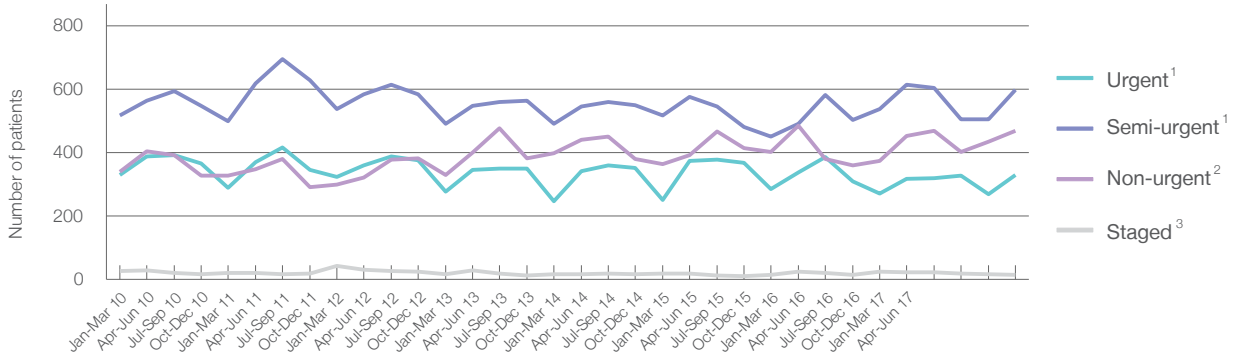

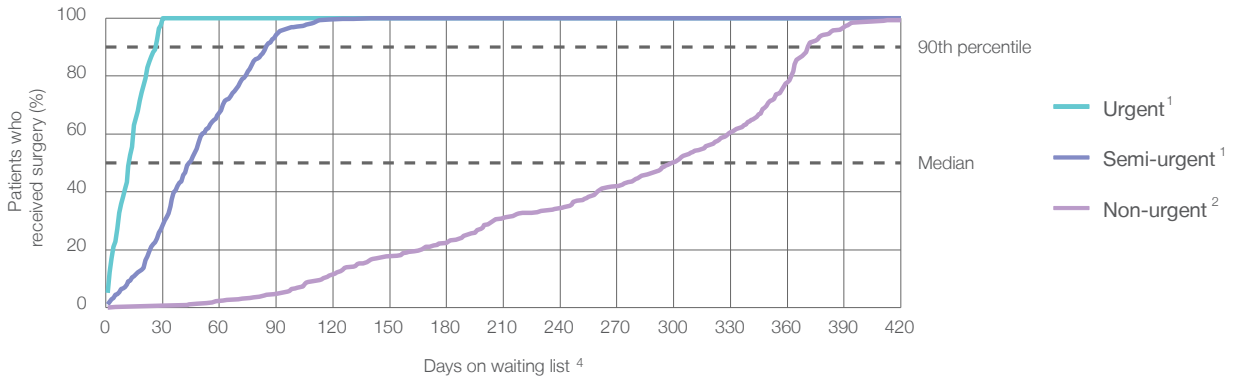

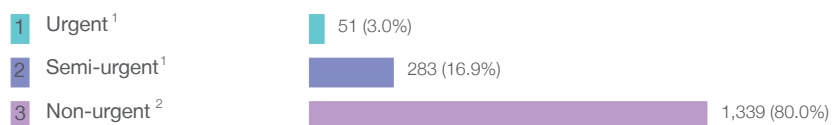

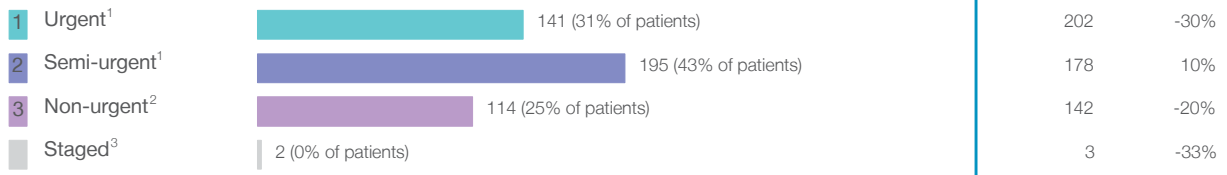

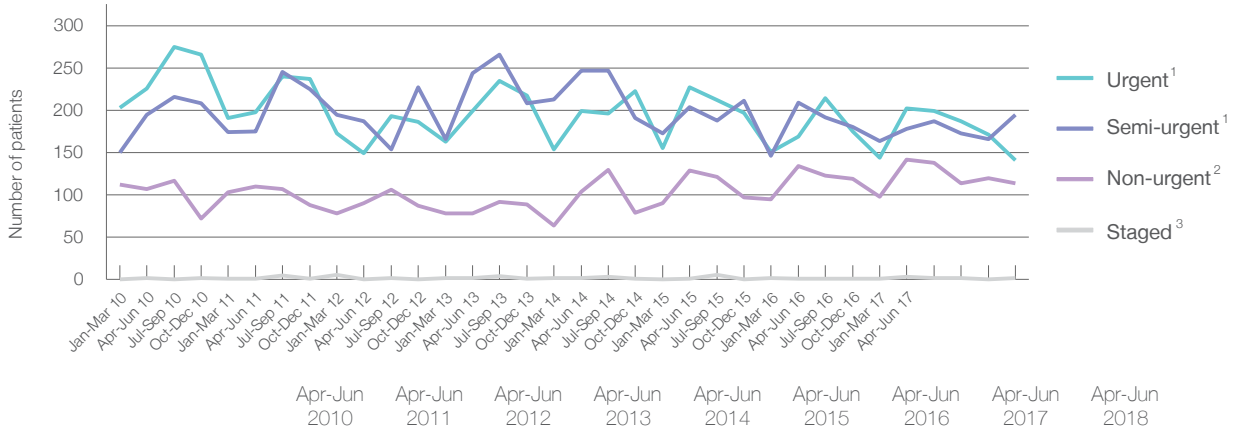

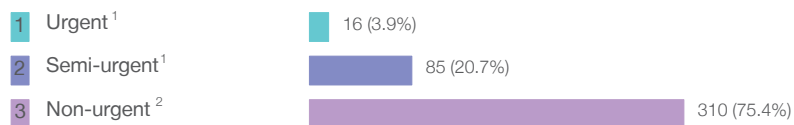

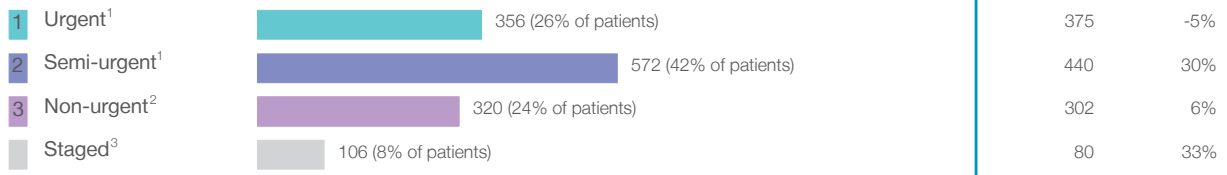

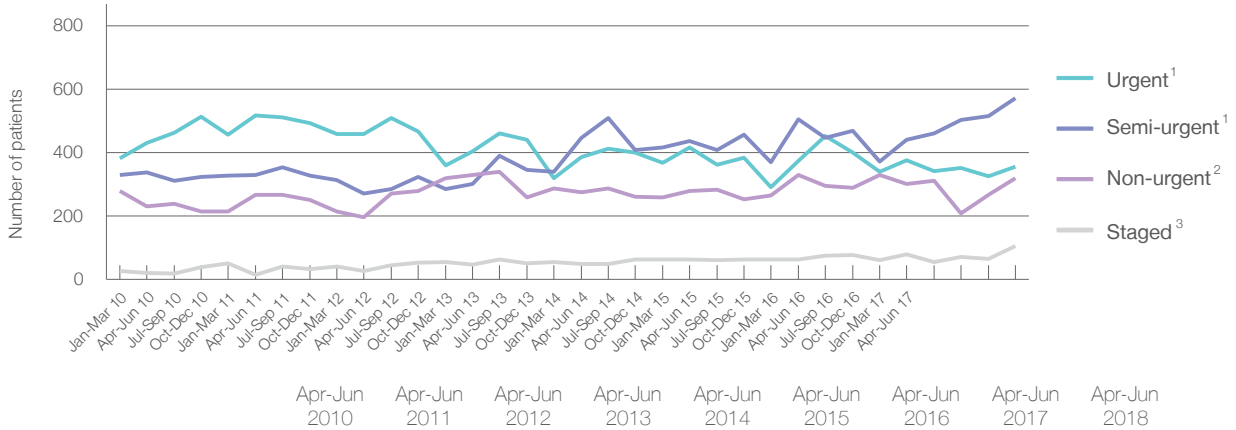

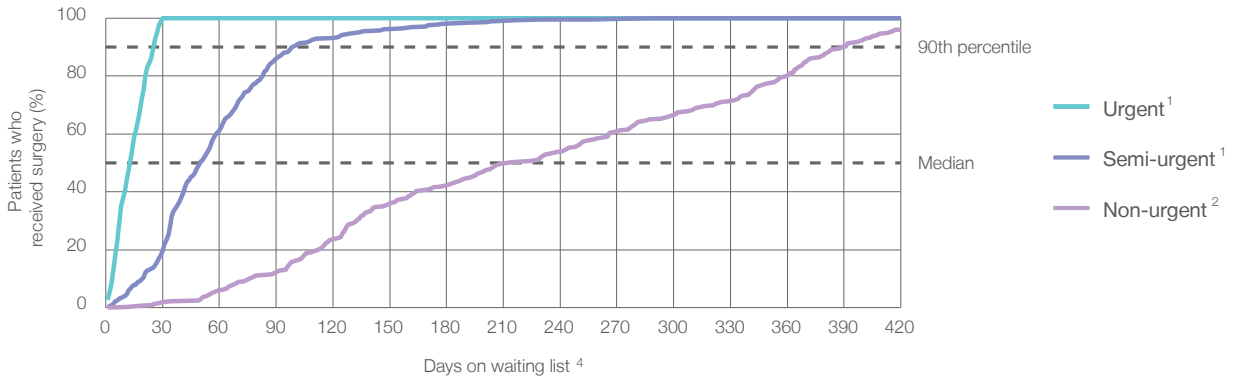

April to June 2018

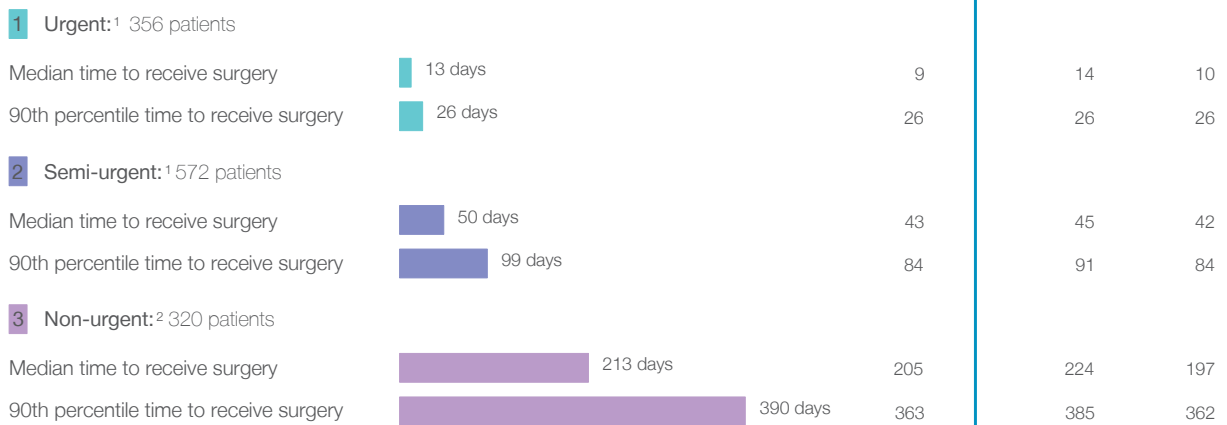
Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

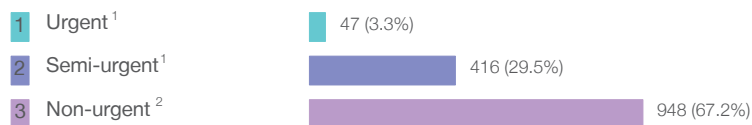

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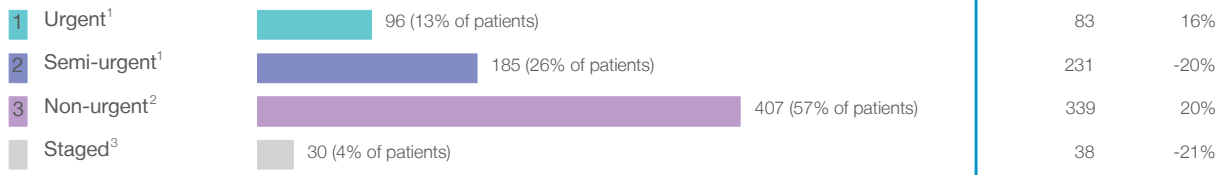

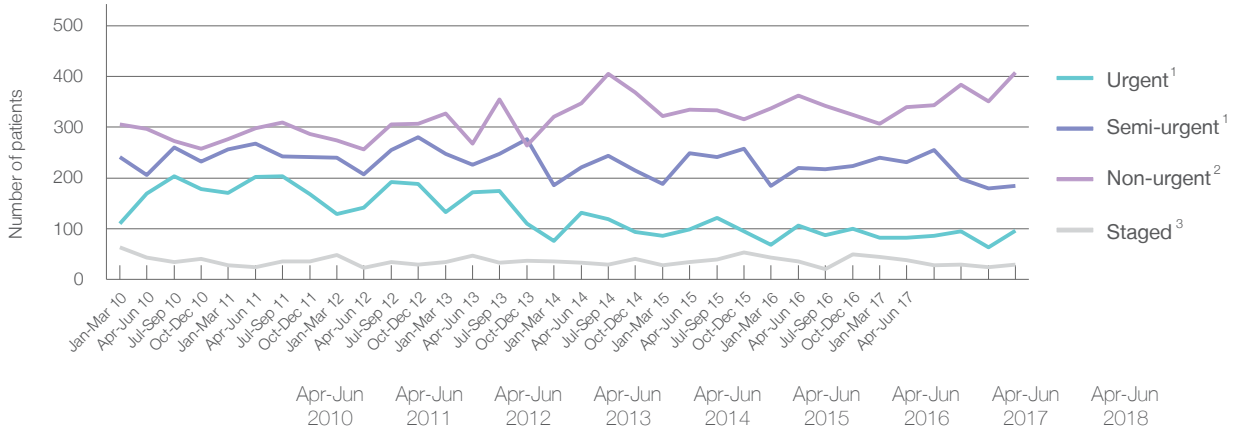

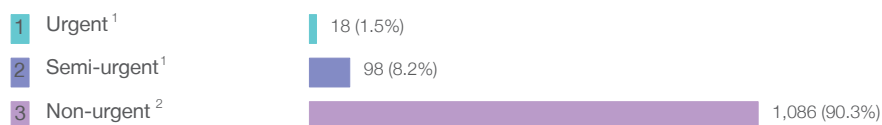

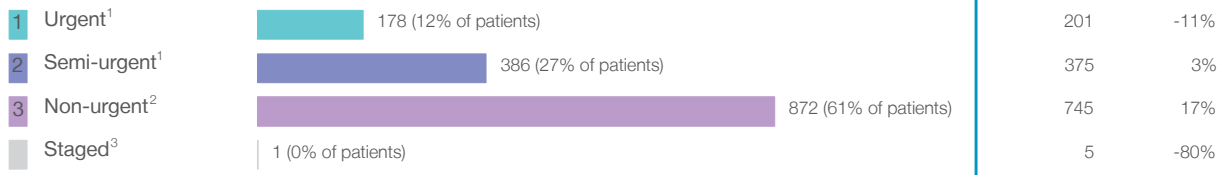

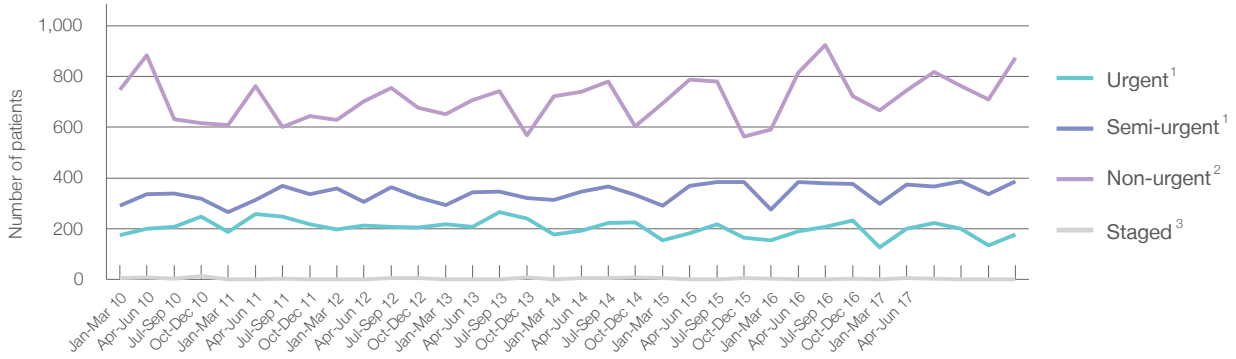

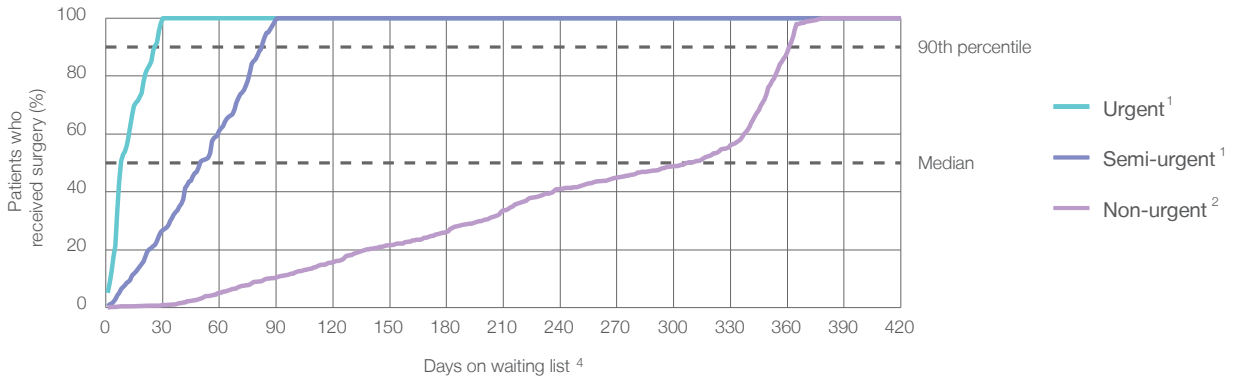
