






Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016







January to March 2016




Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016







Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016





























January to March 2016




Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016



January to March 2016




Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016





Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016











Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016











Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016













January to March 2016




Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2011 to March 2016
