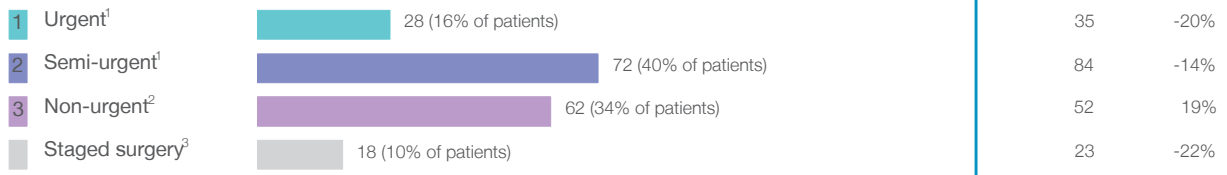

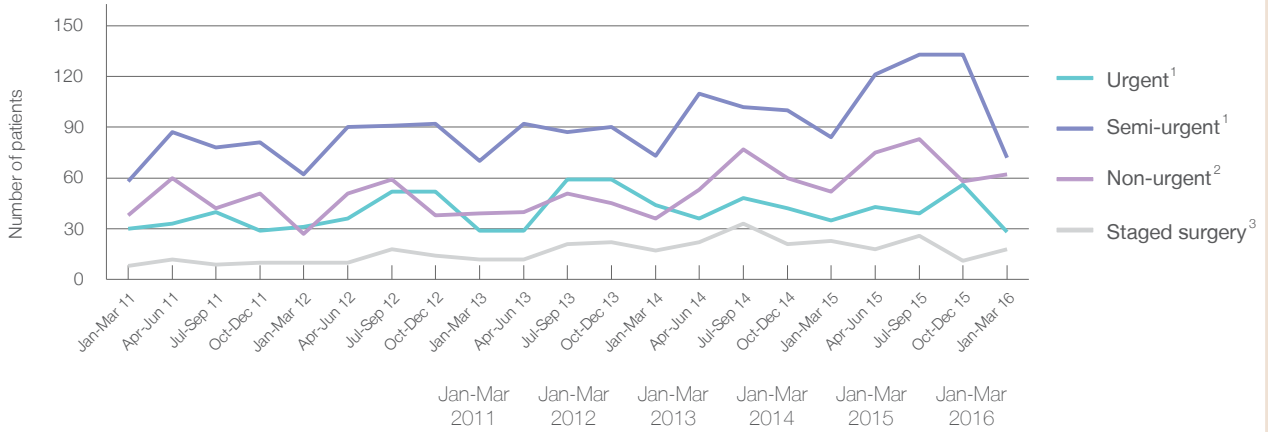

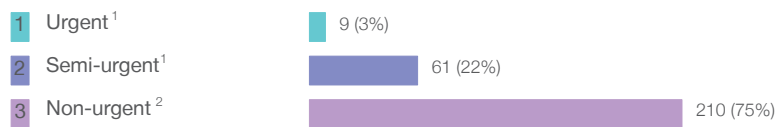

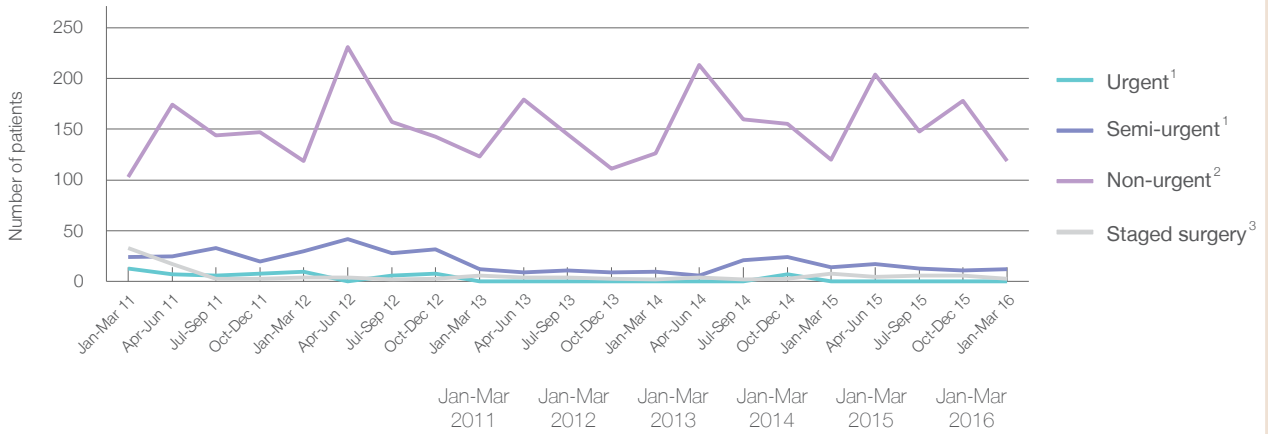

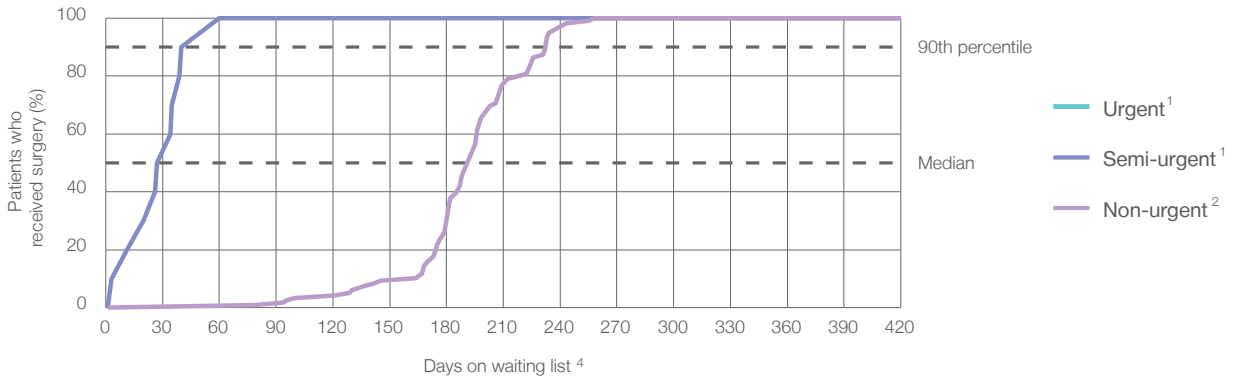

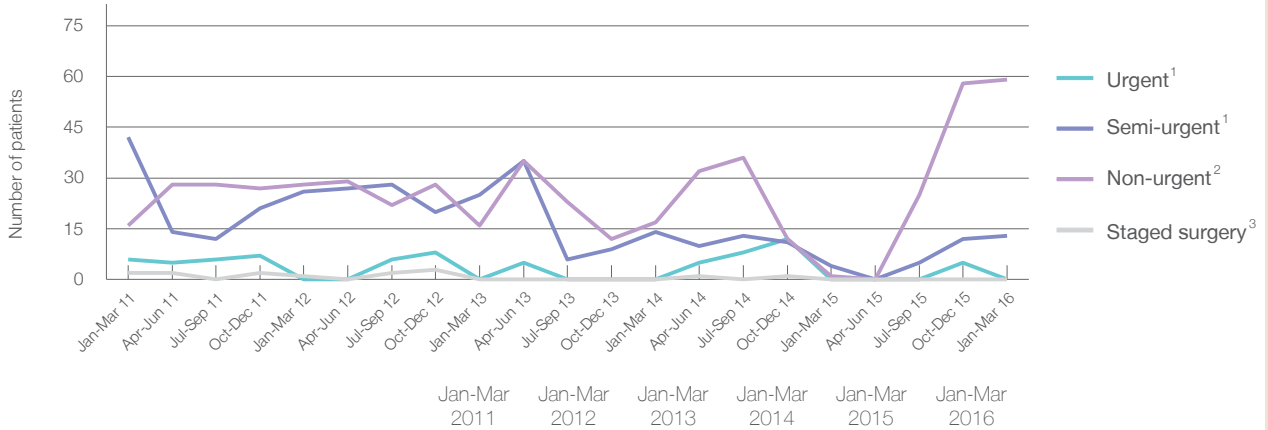

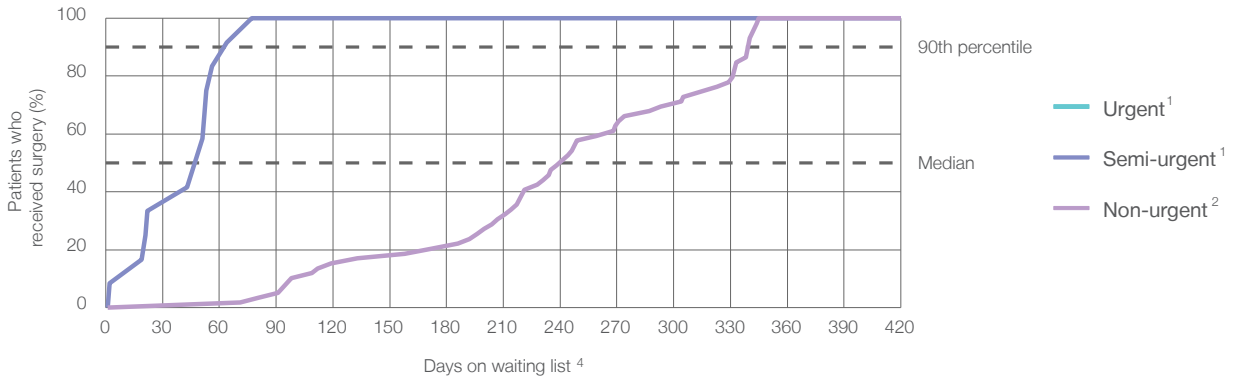
Bellinger River District Hospital: Time waited to receive elective surgery

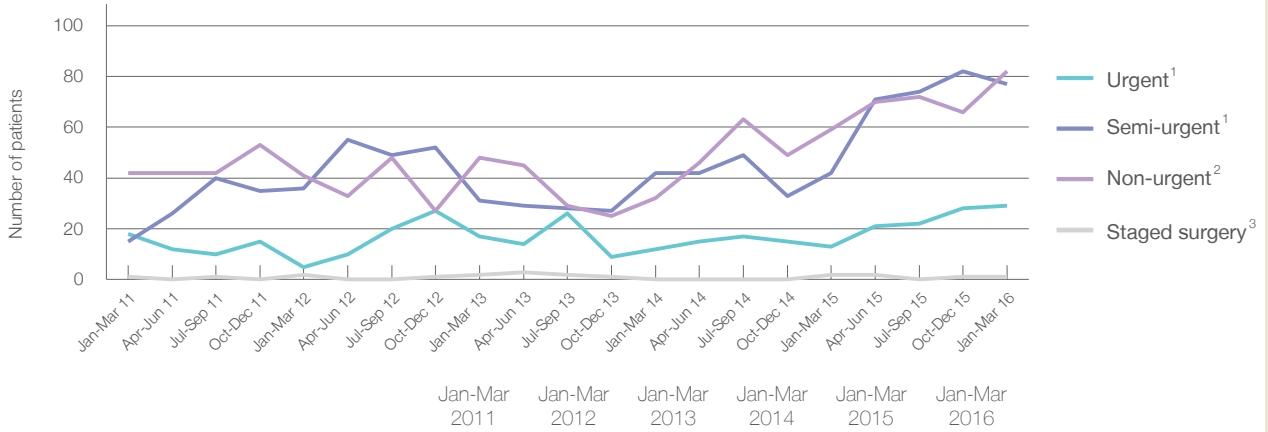

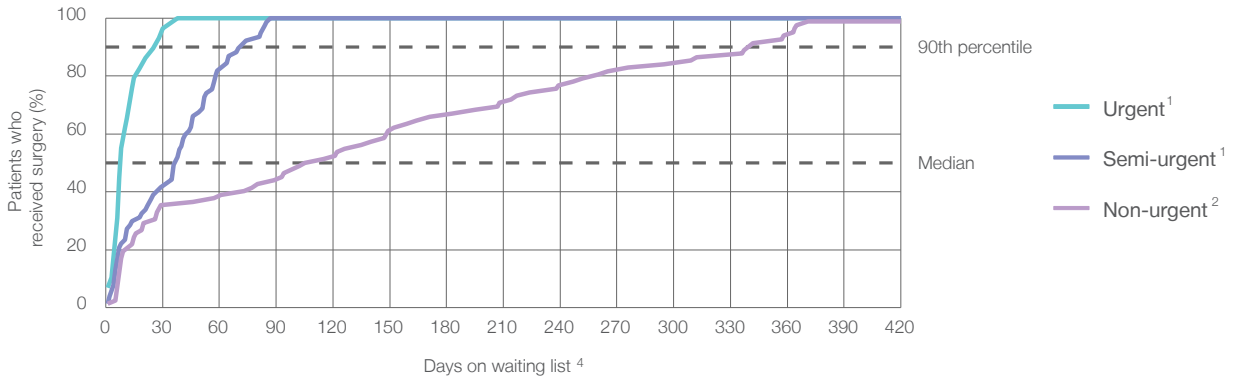

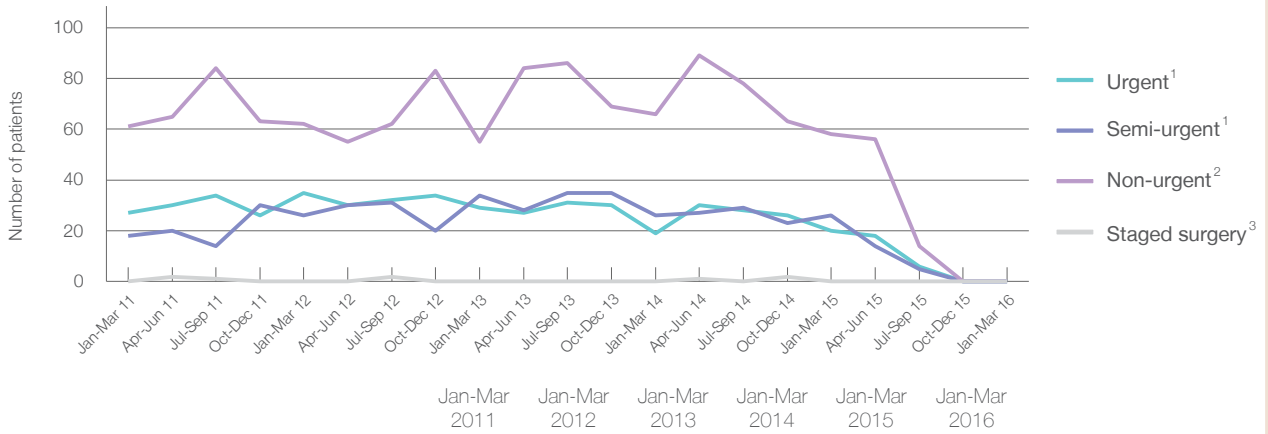

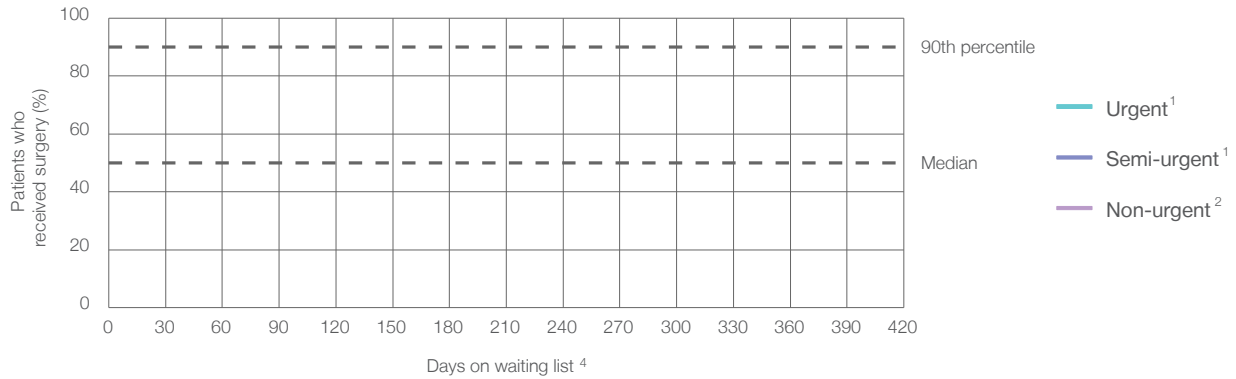

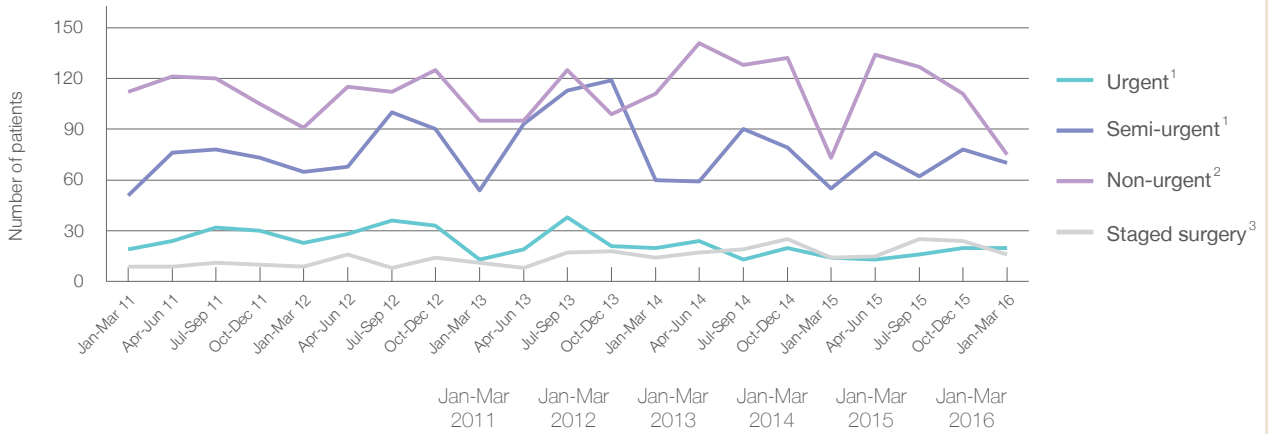

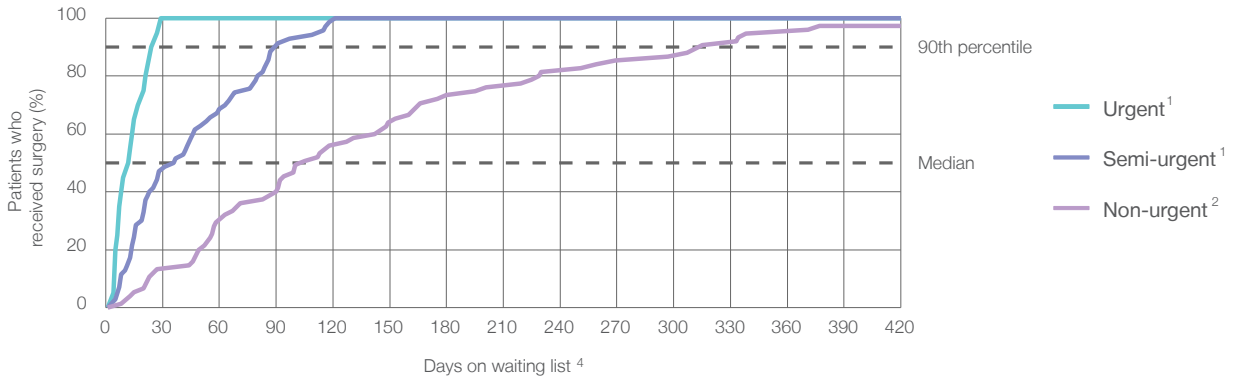

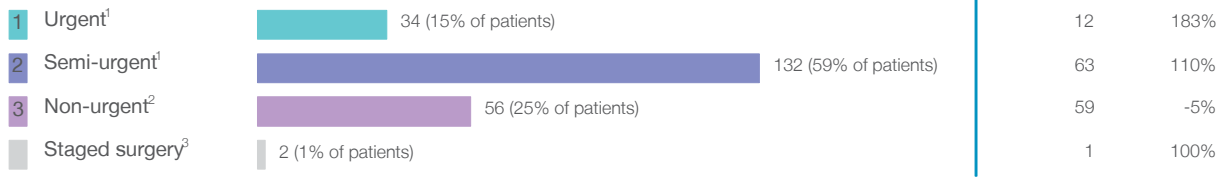

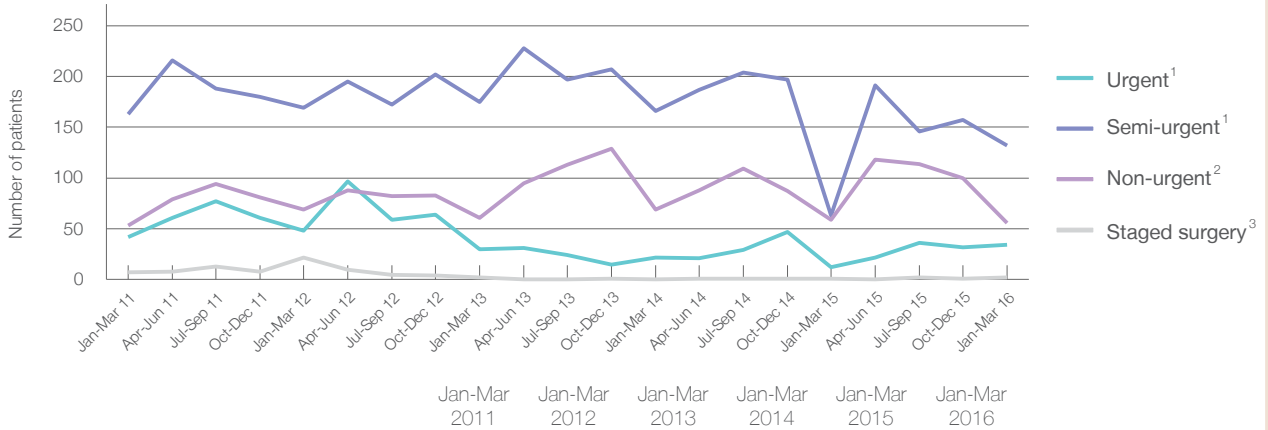
Cessnock District Hospital: Elective surgery performed

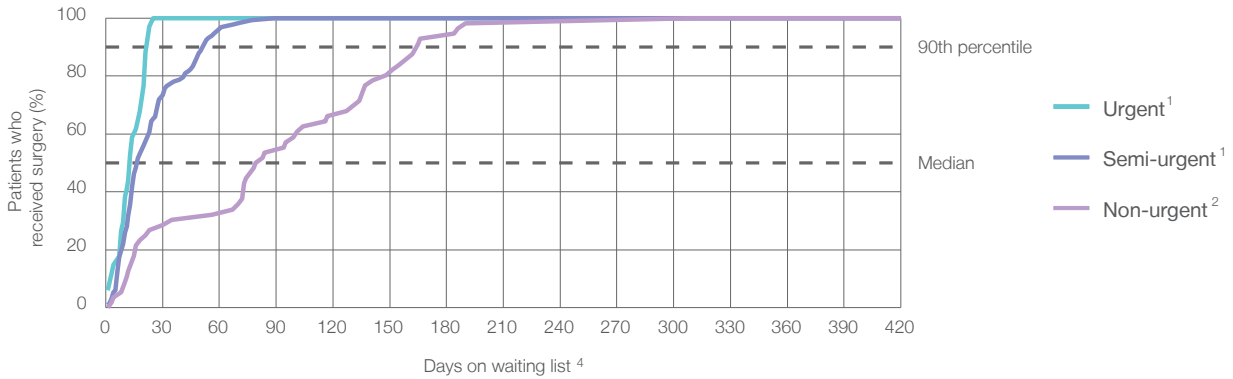

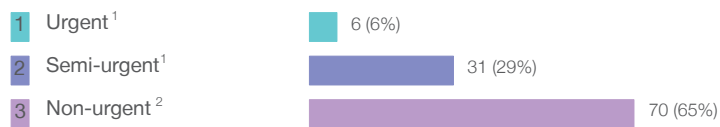

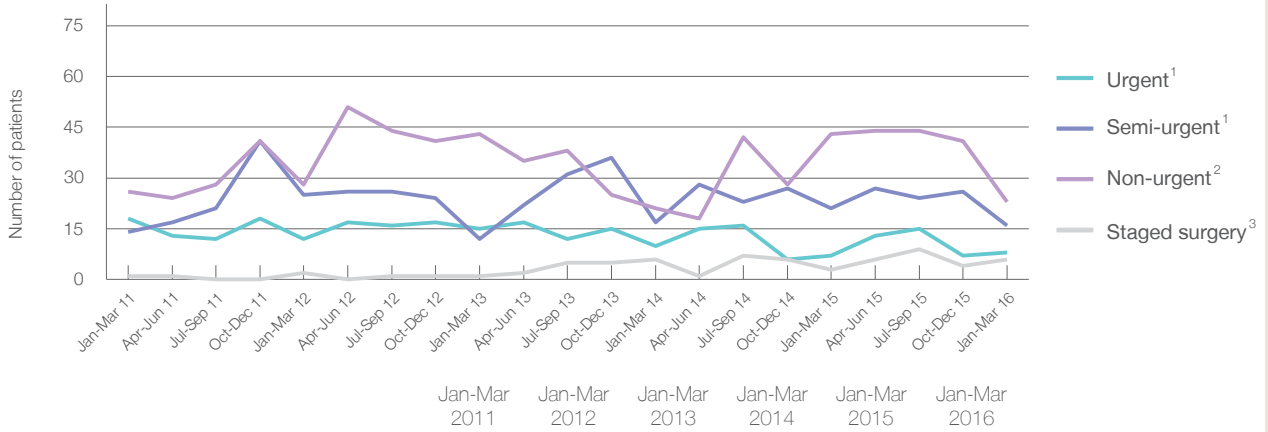

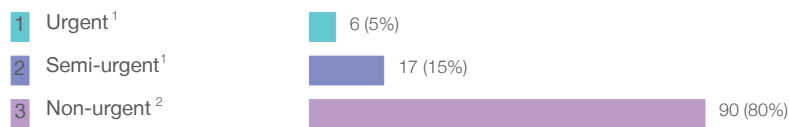

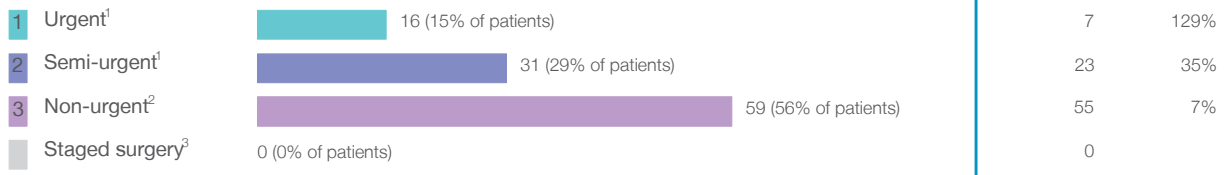

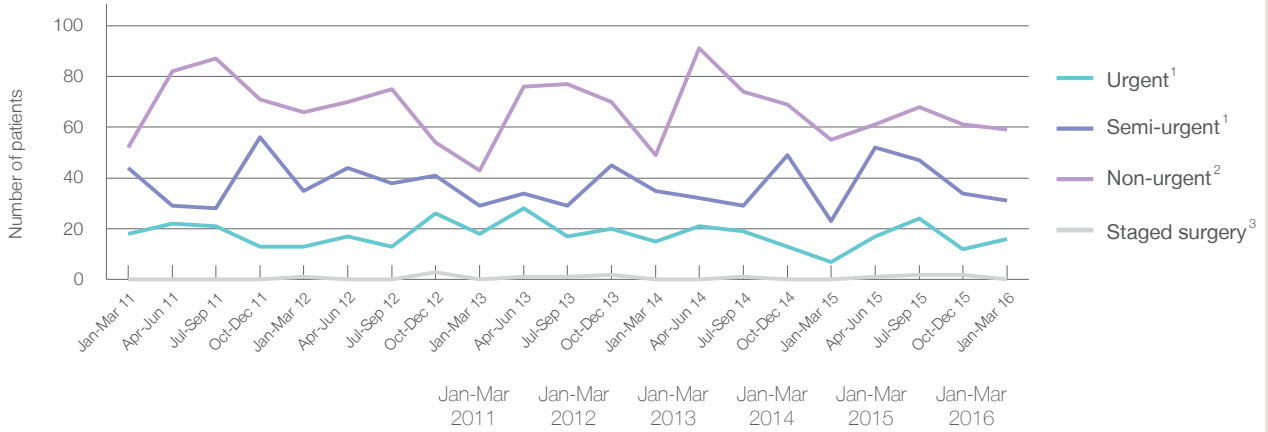

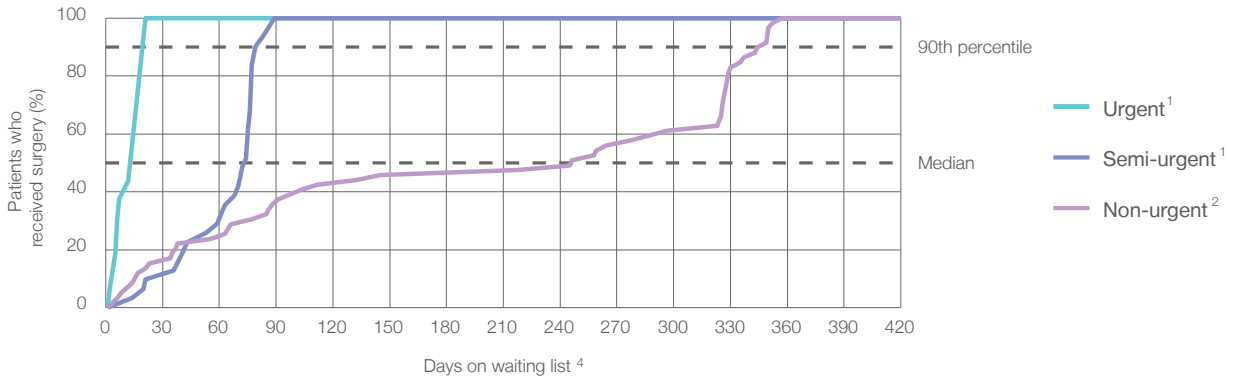

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)




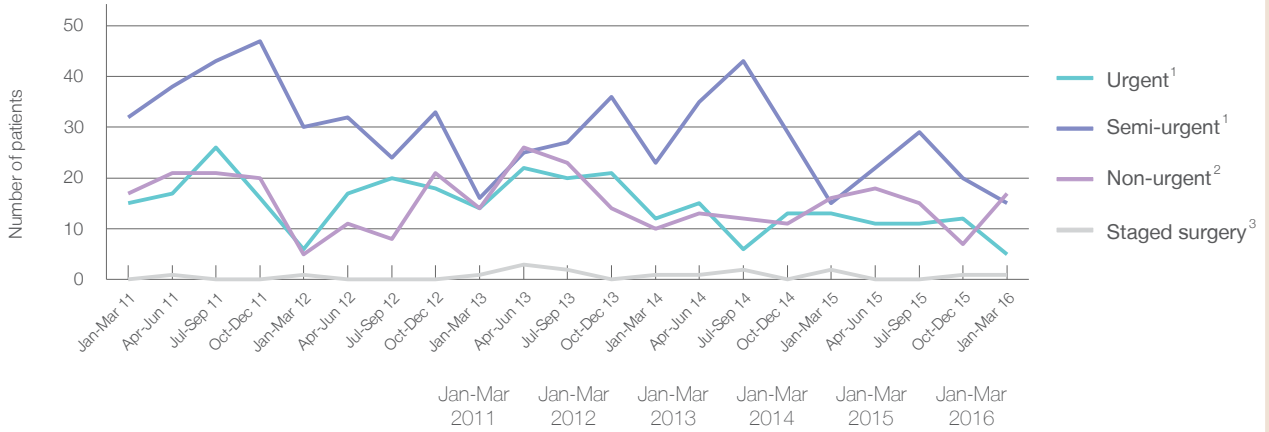

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)



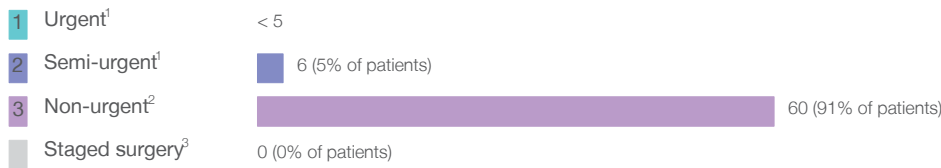

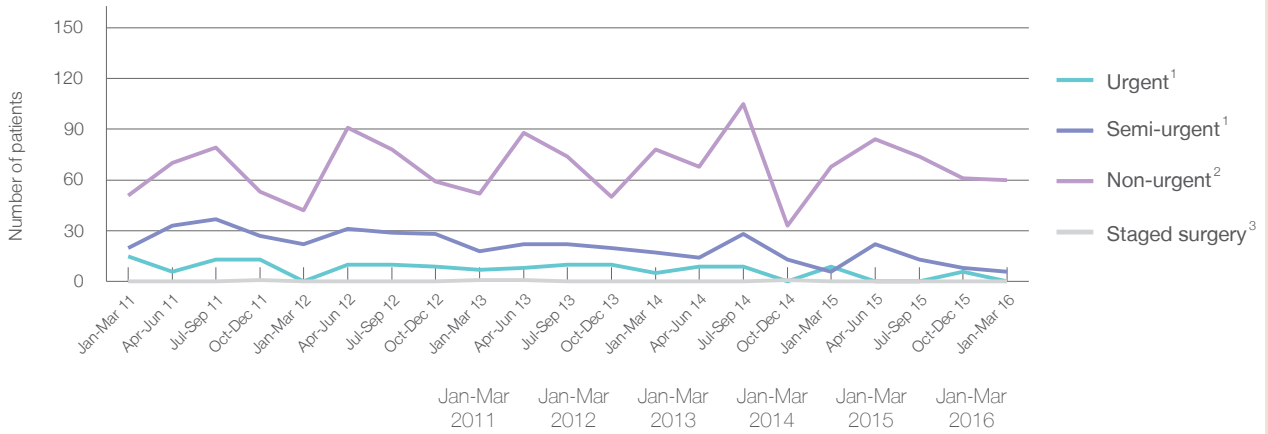

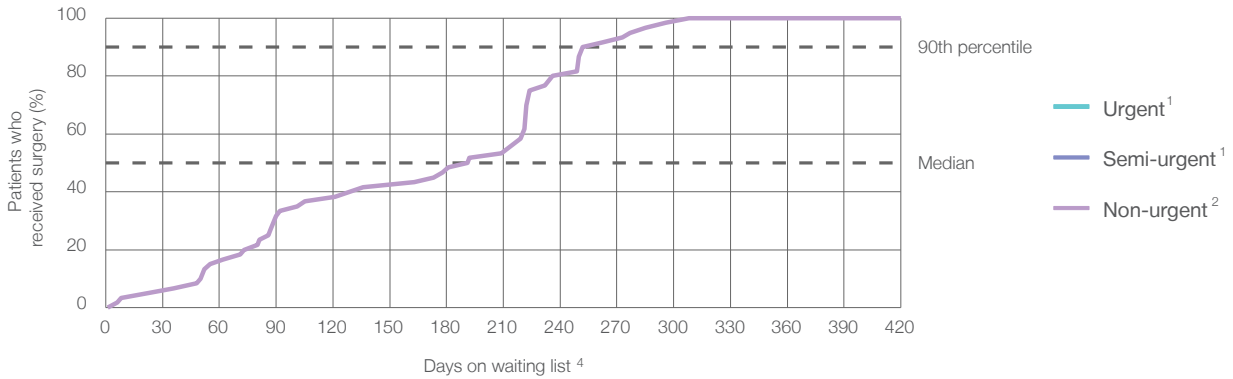

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)




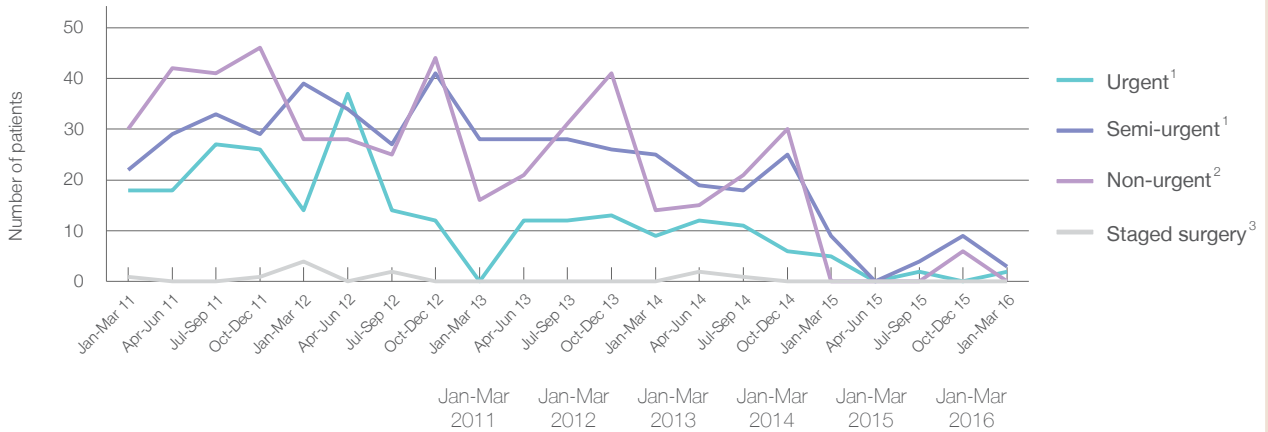

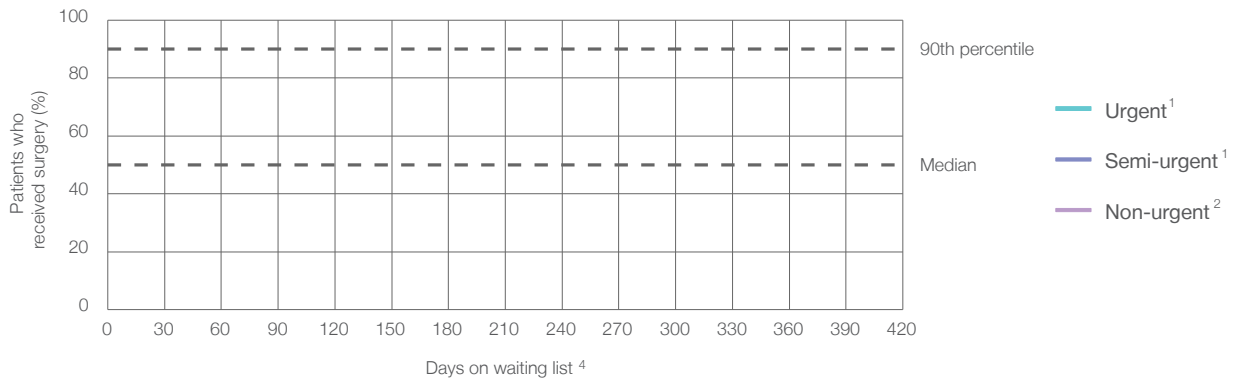

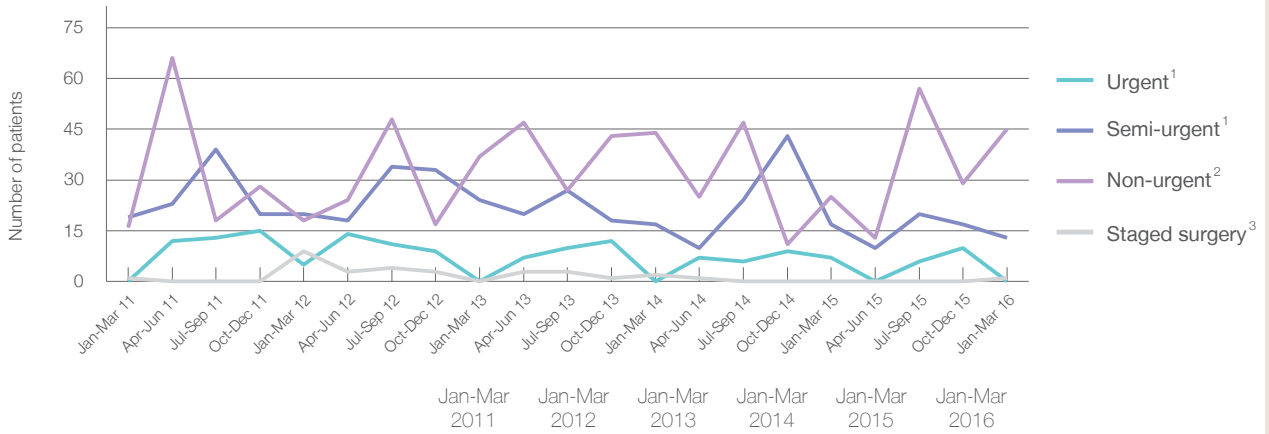

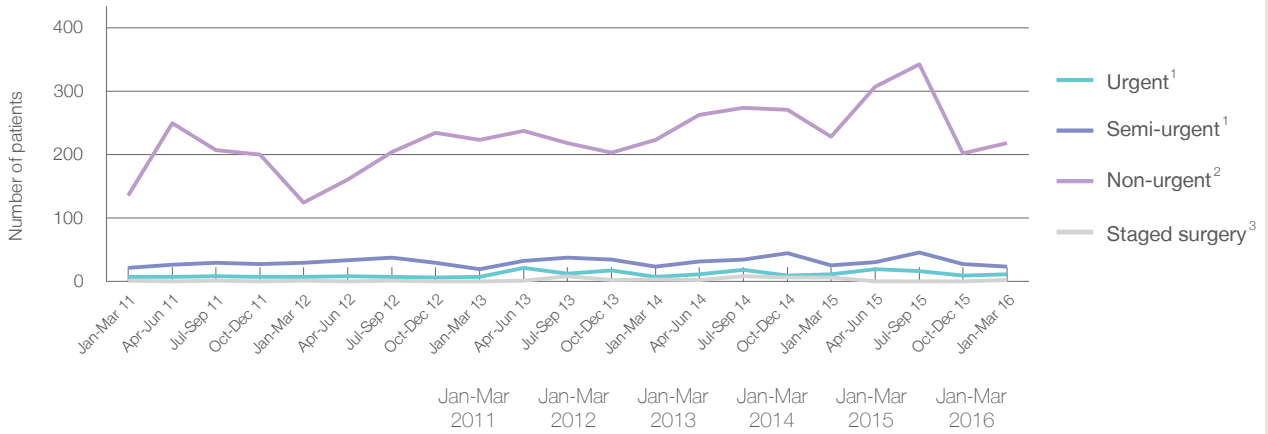

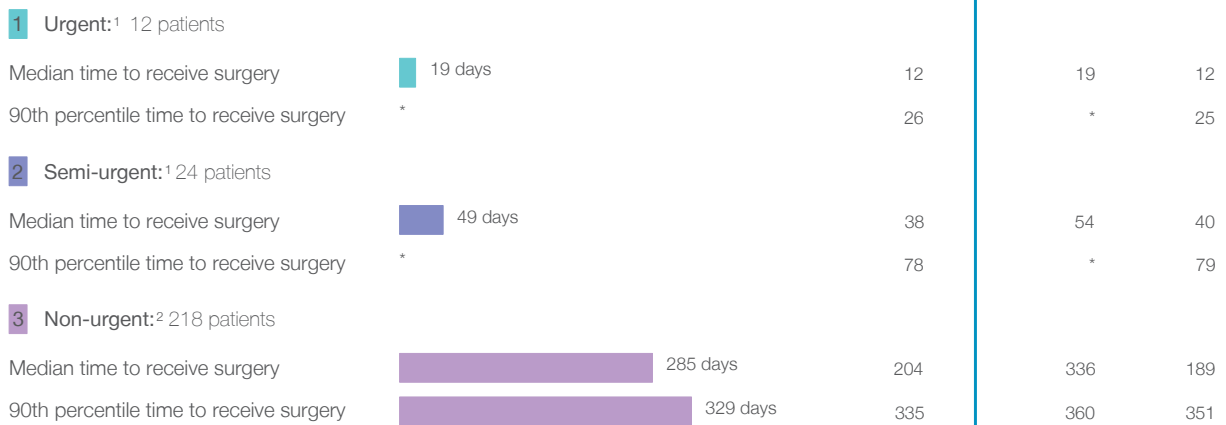
Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

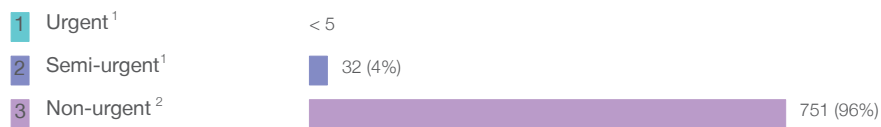

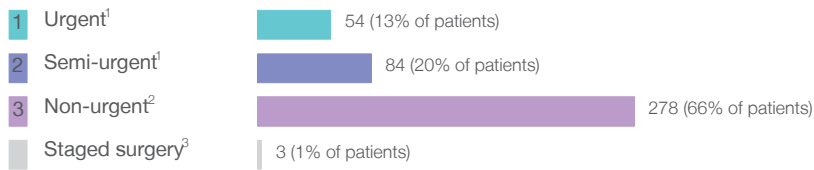

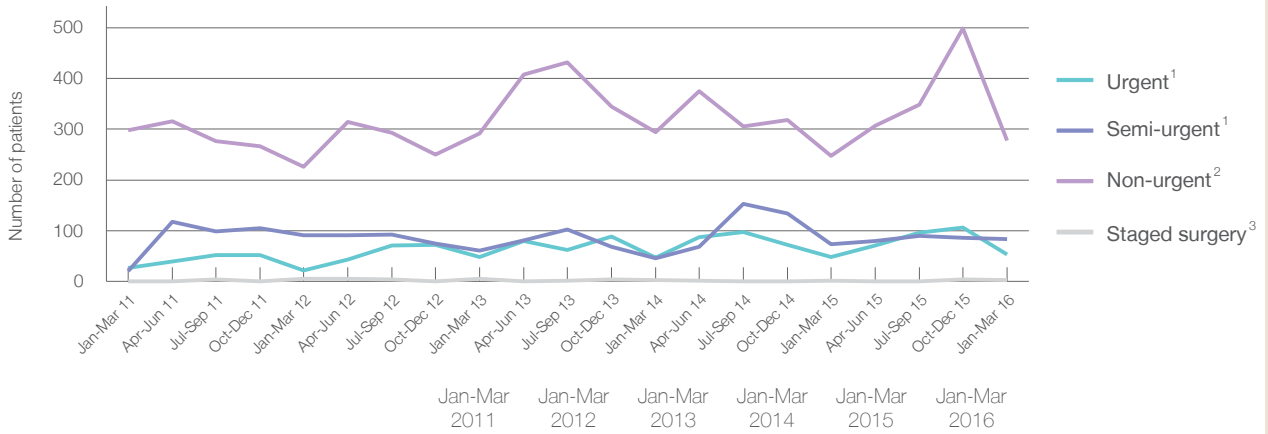

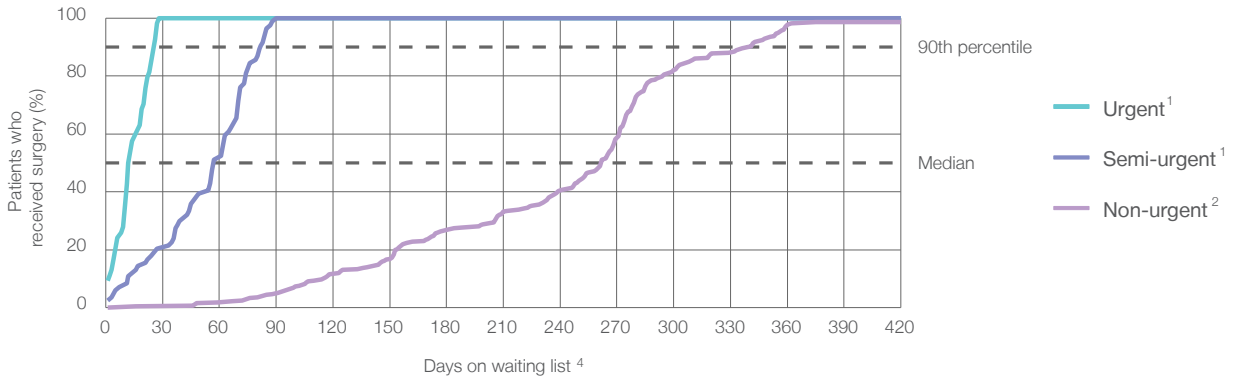

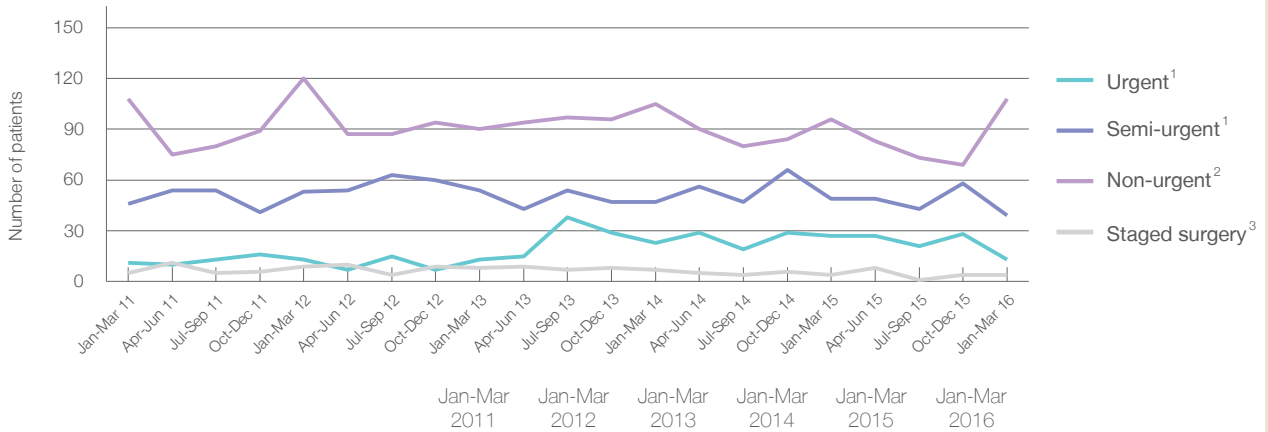

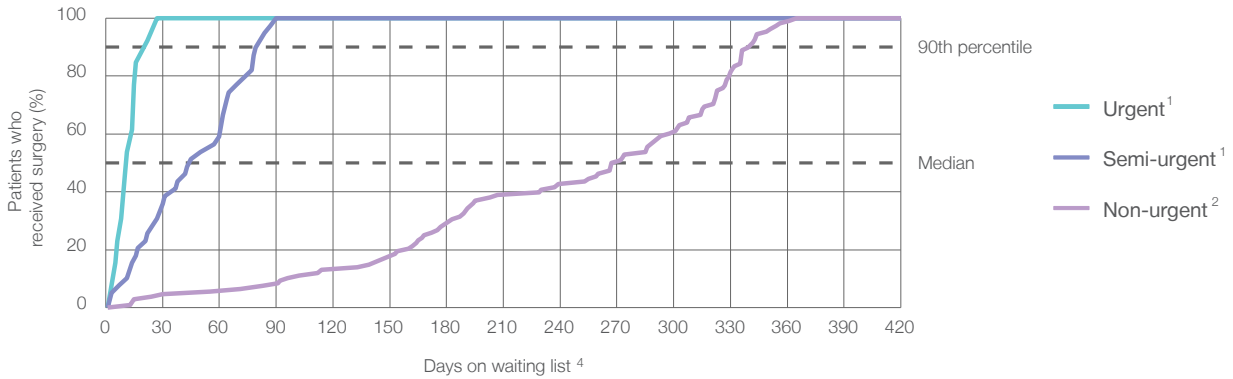

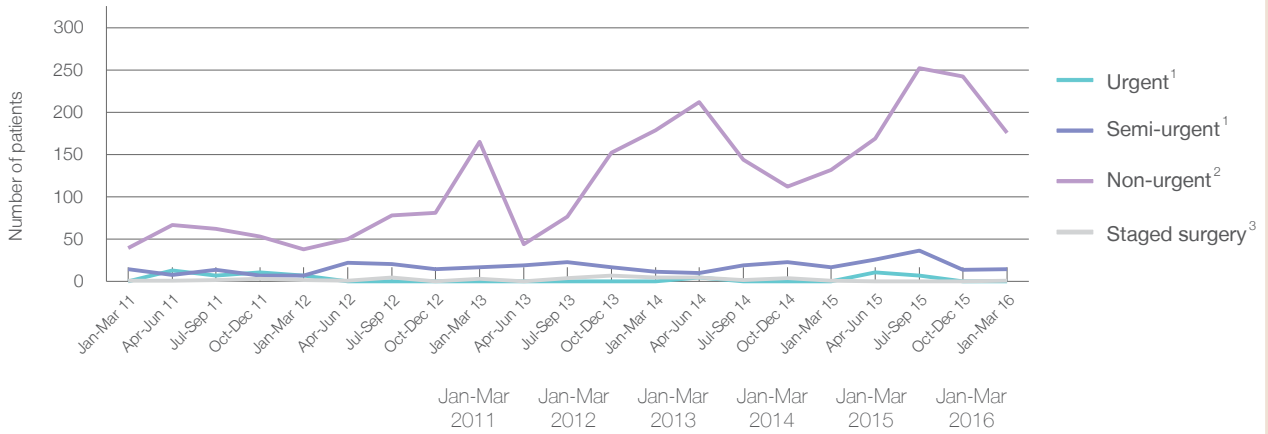

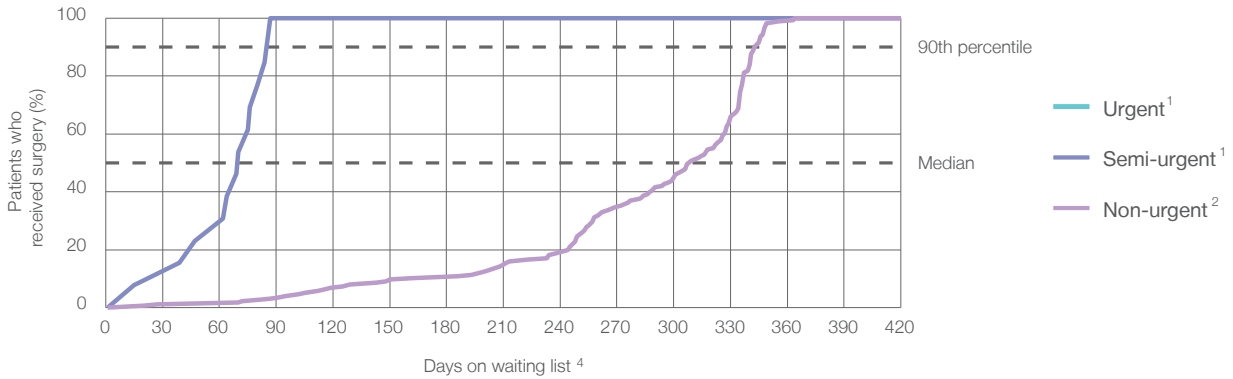

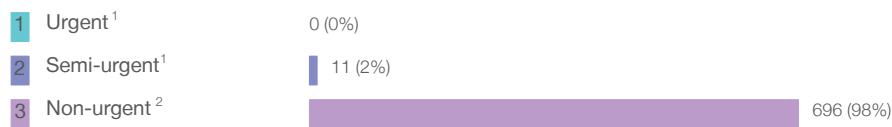

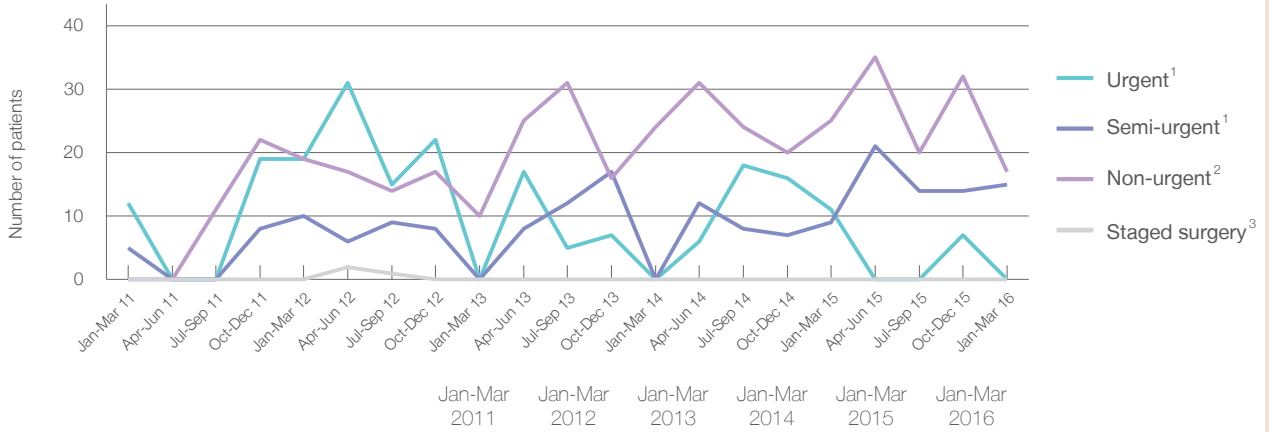

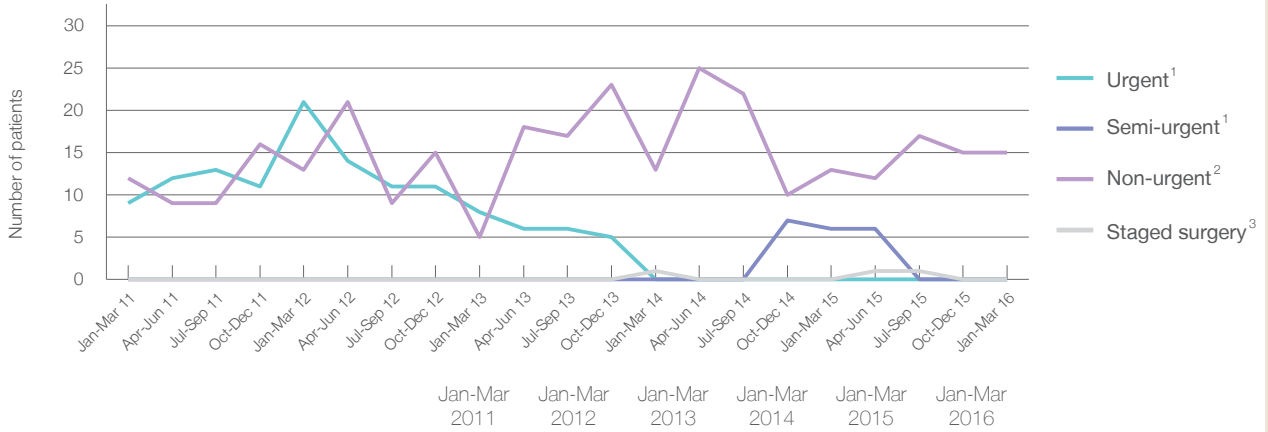

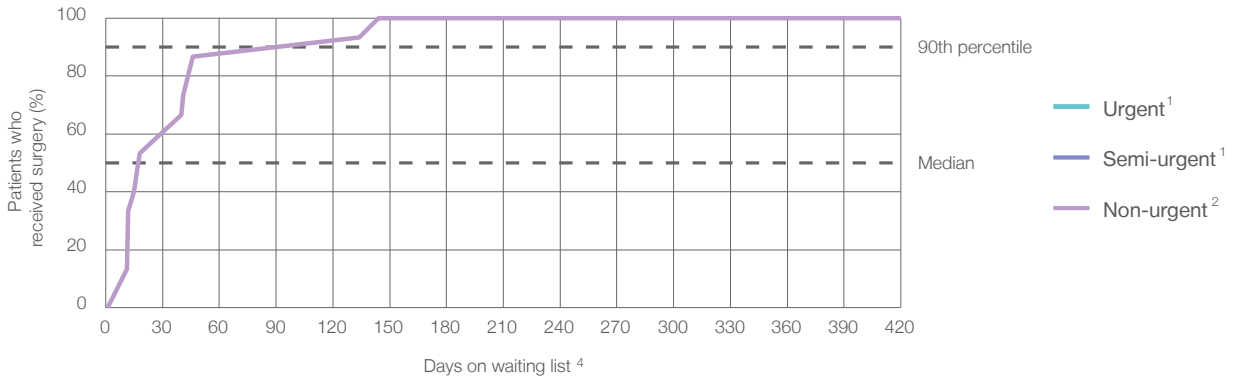

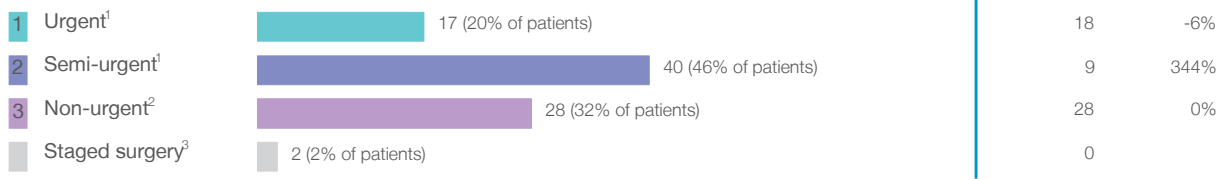

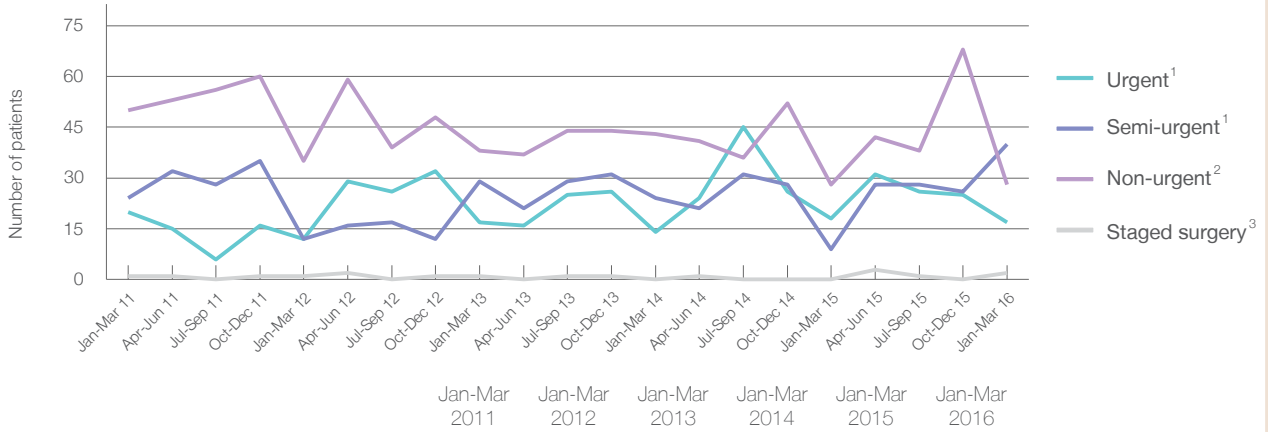

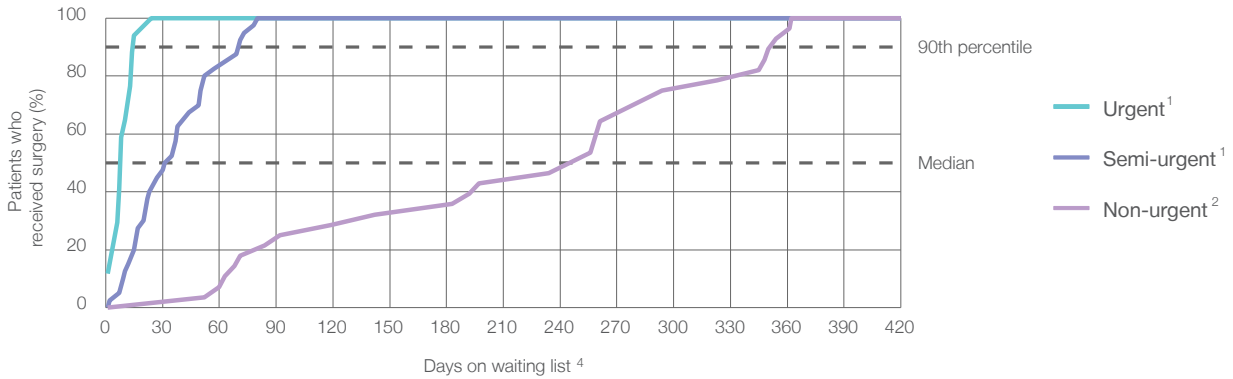

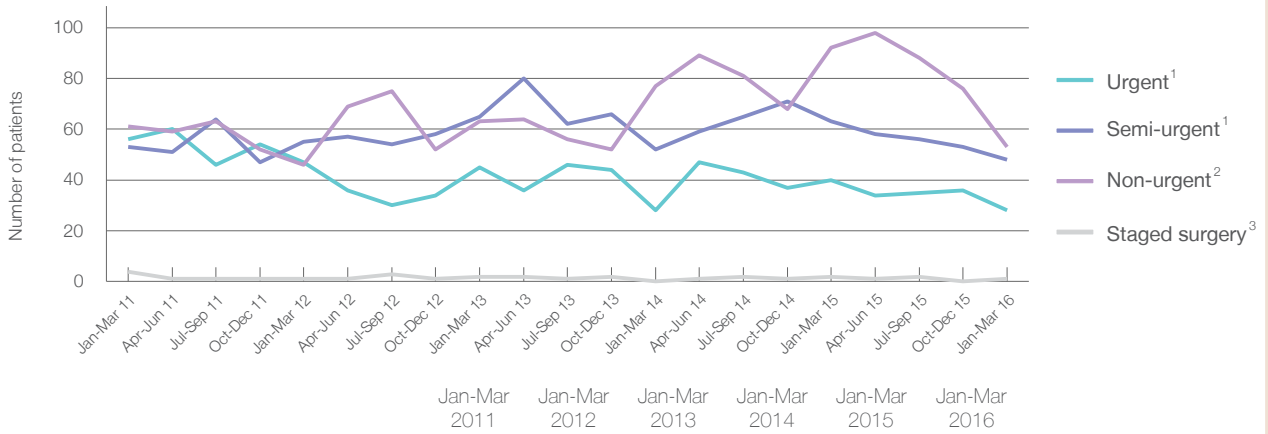

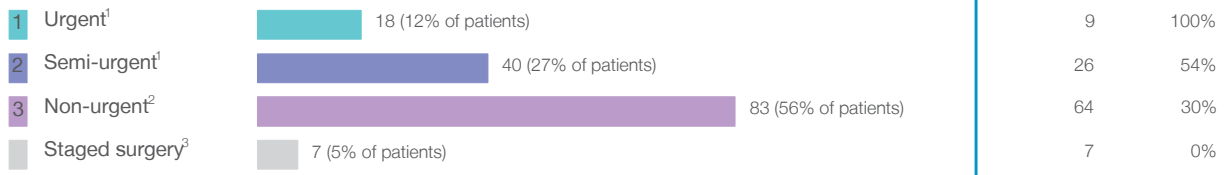

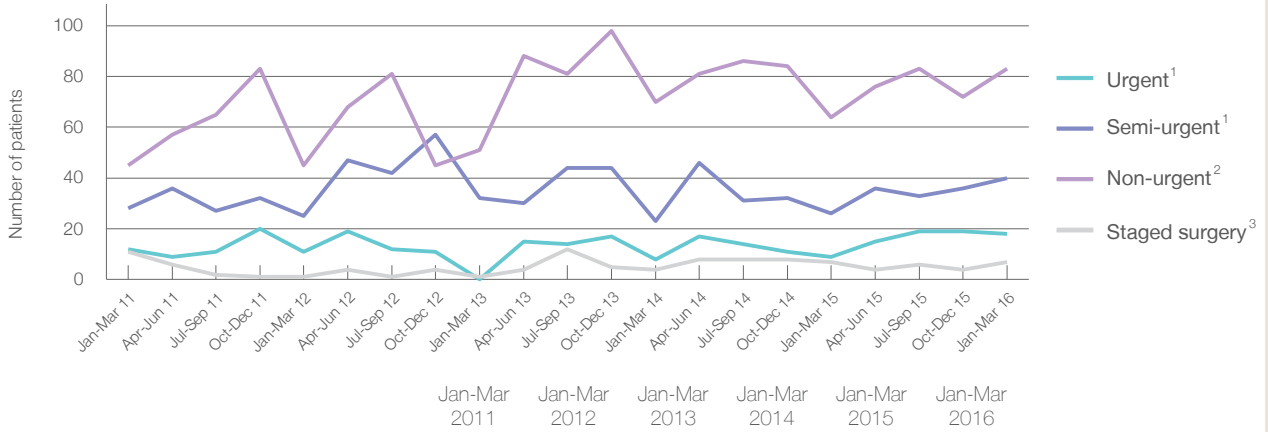

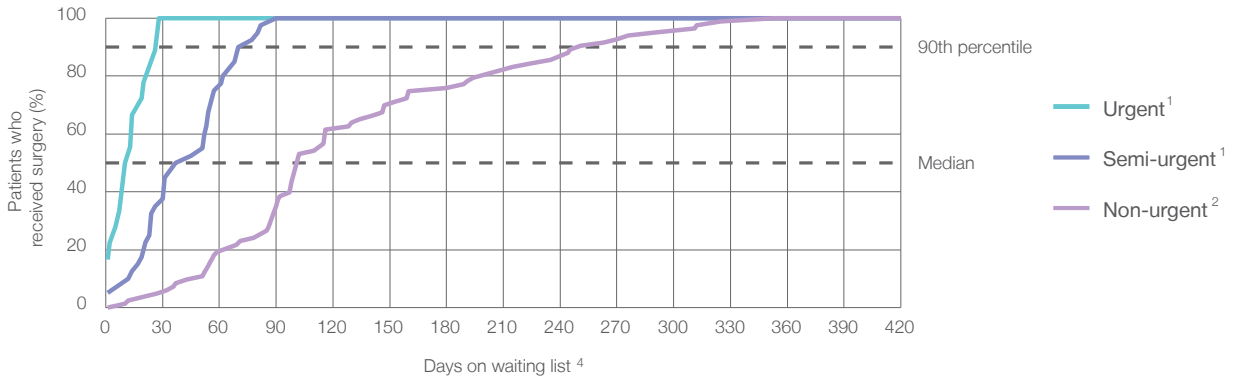

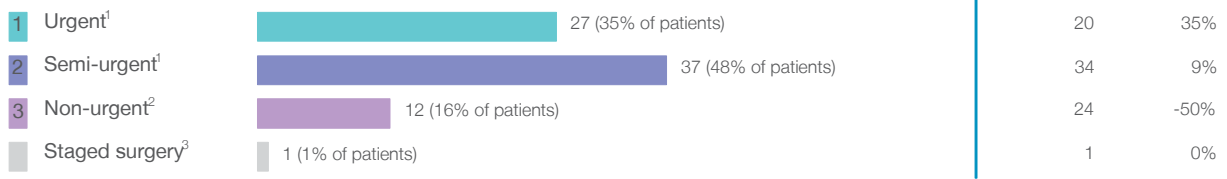

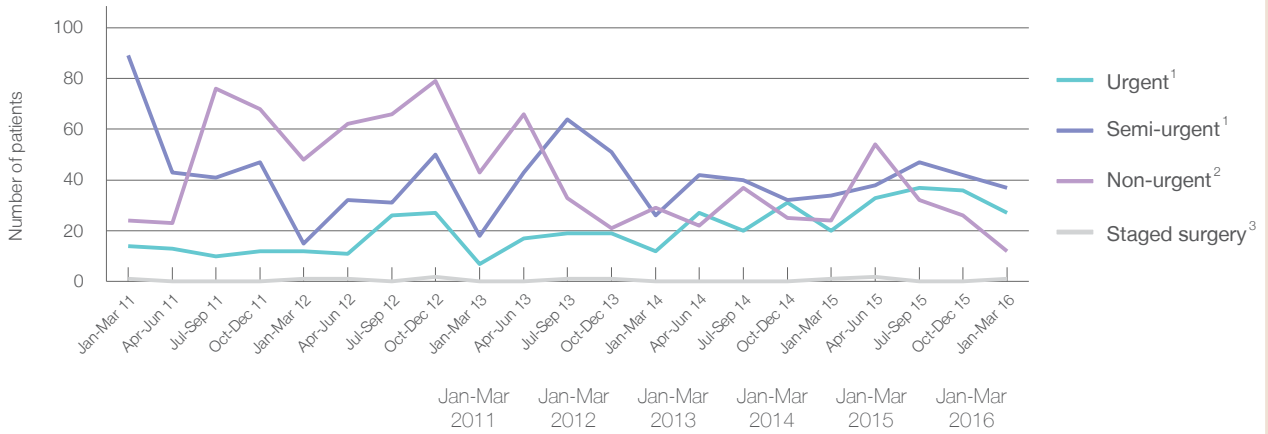

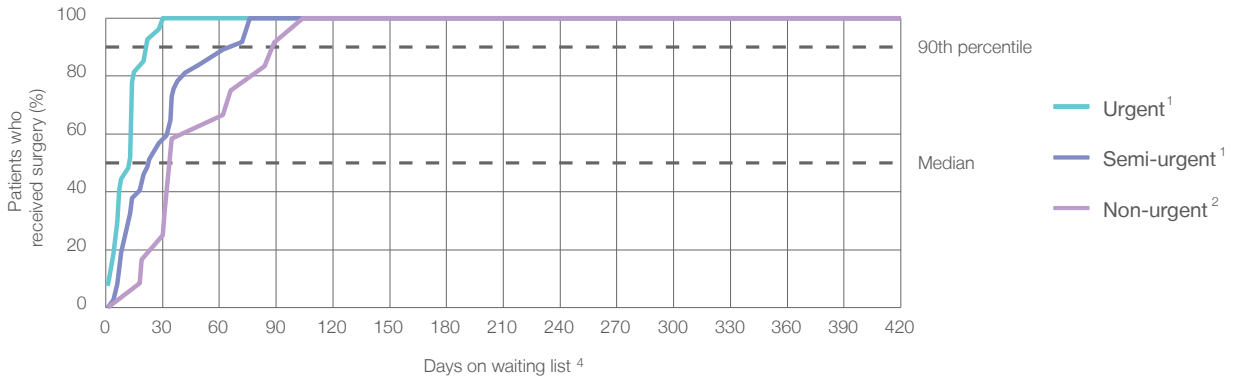

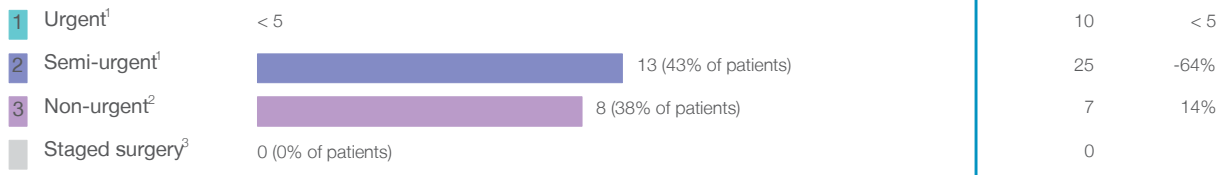

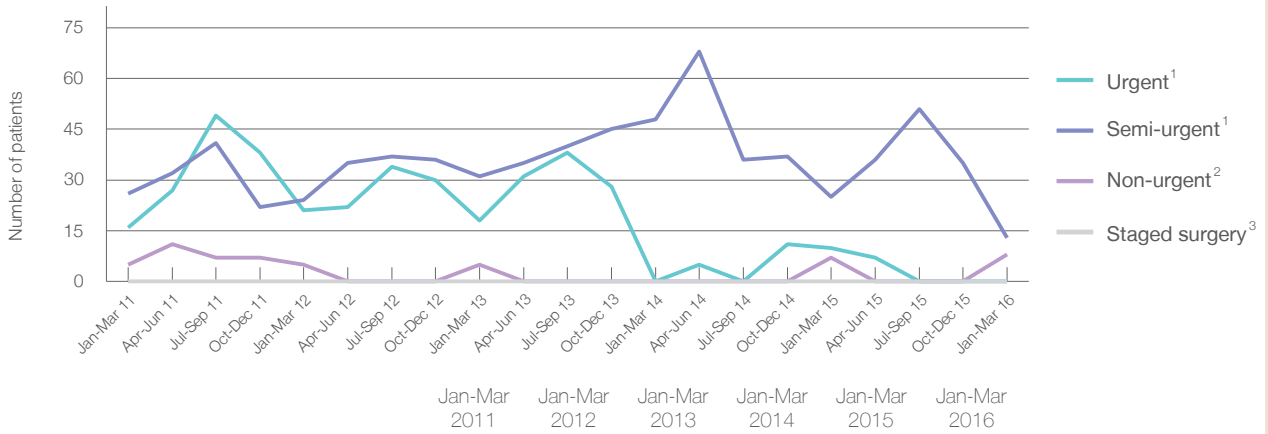

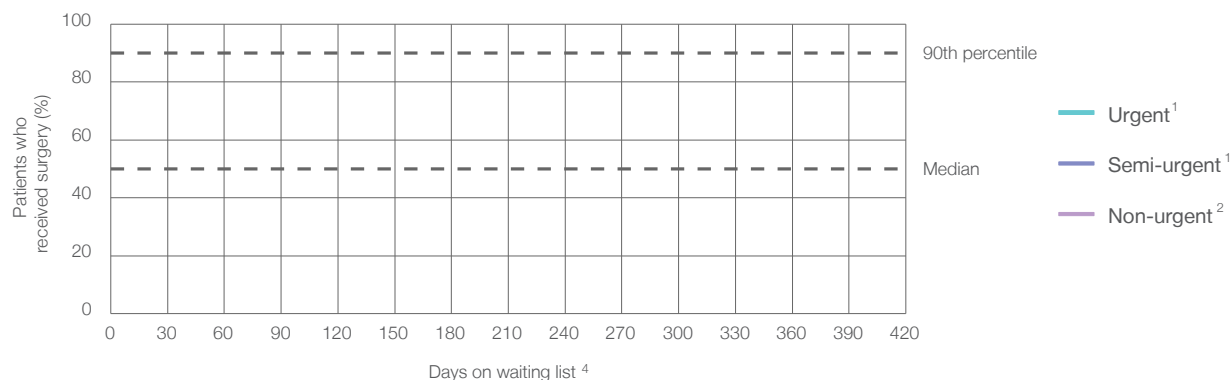

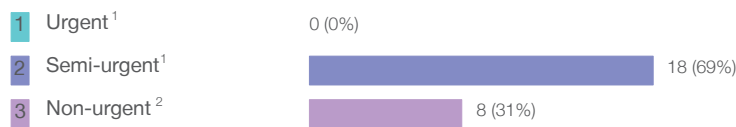

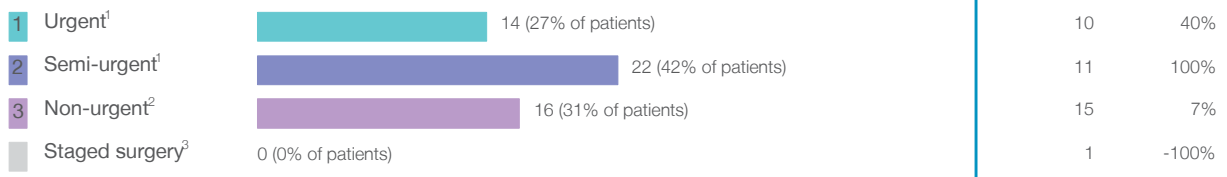

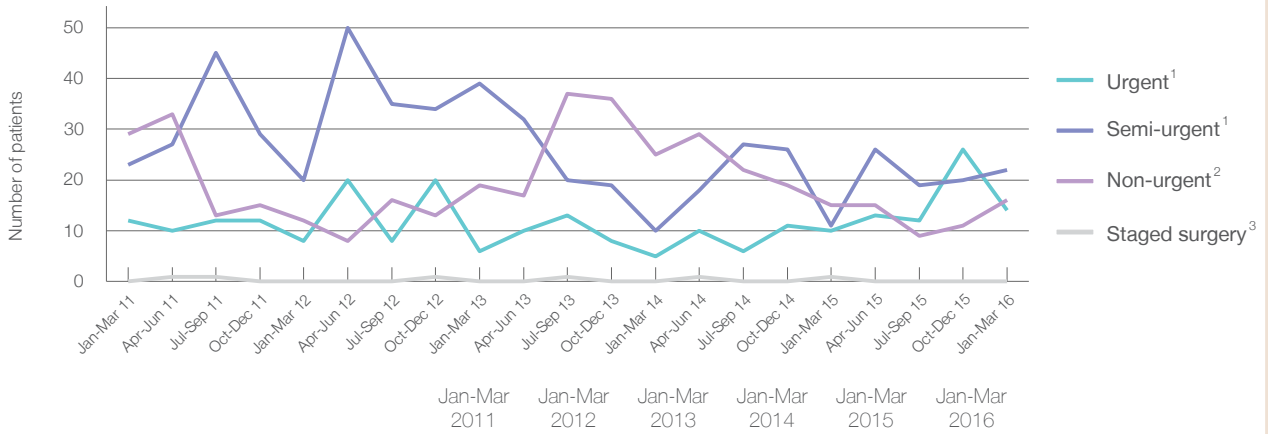

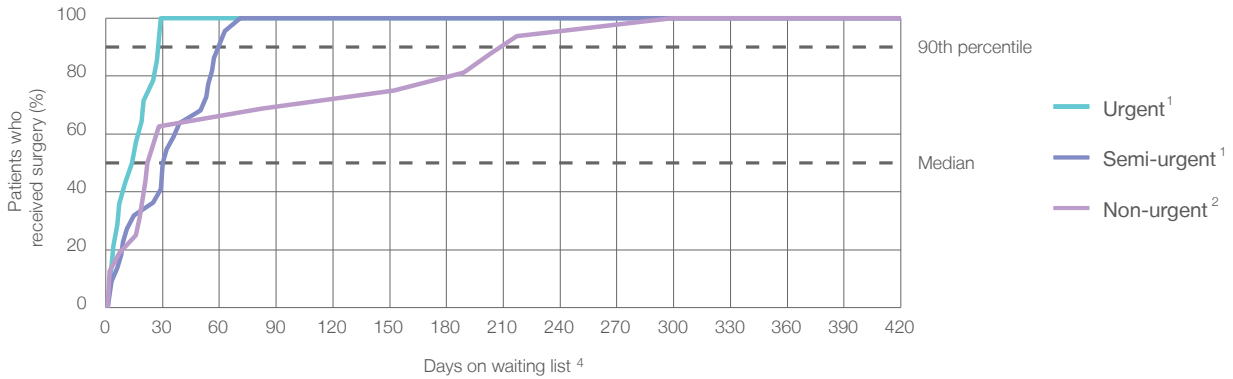

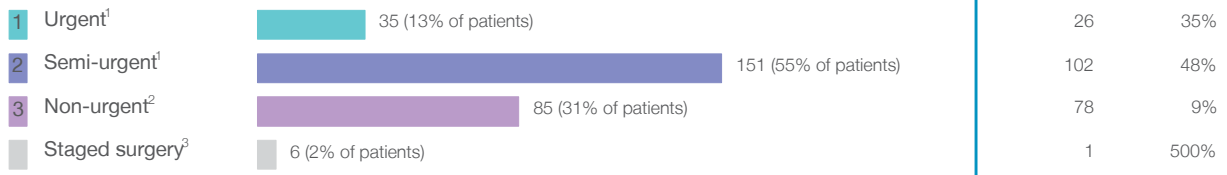

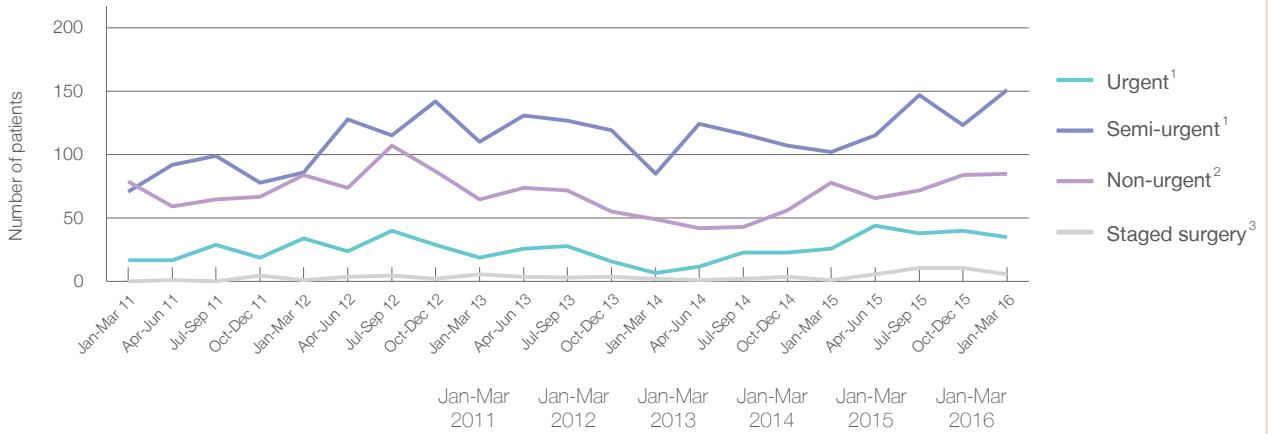

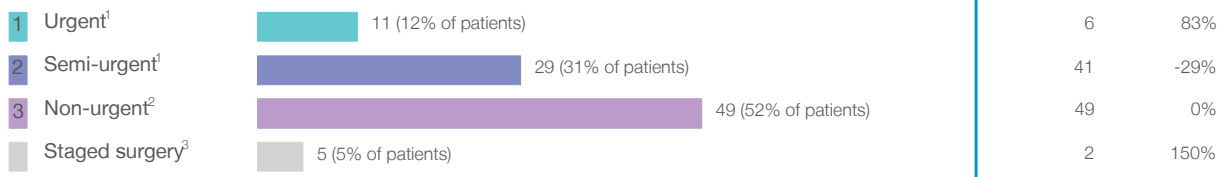

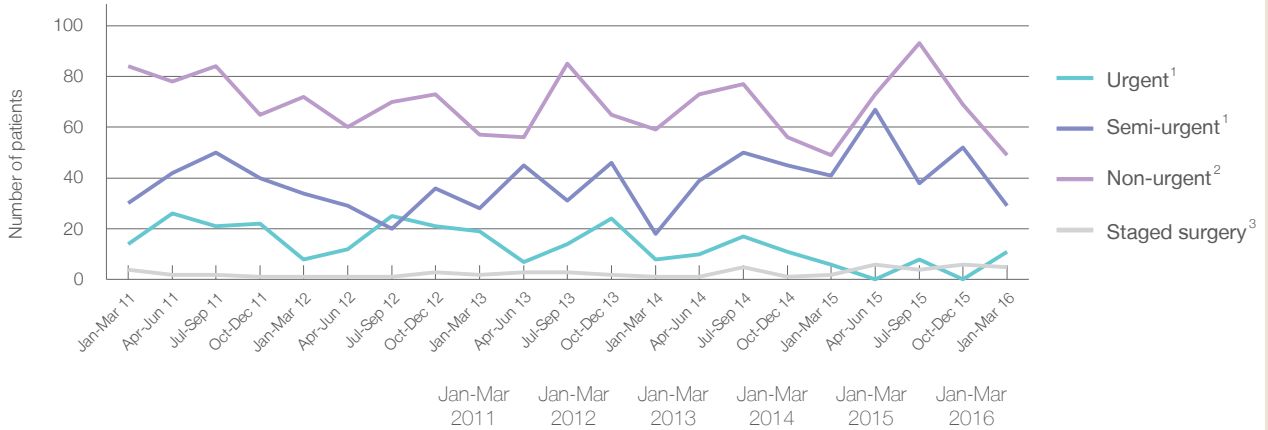

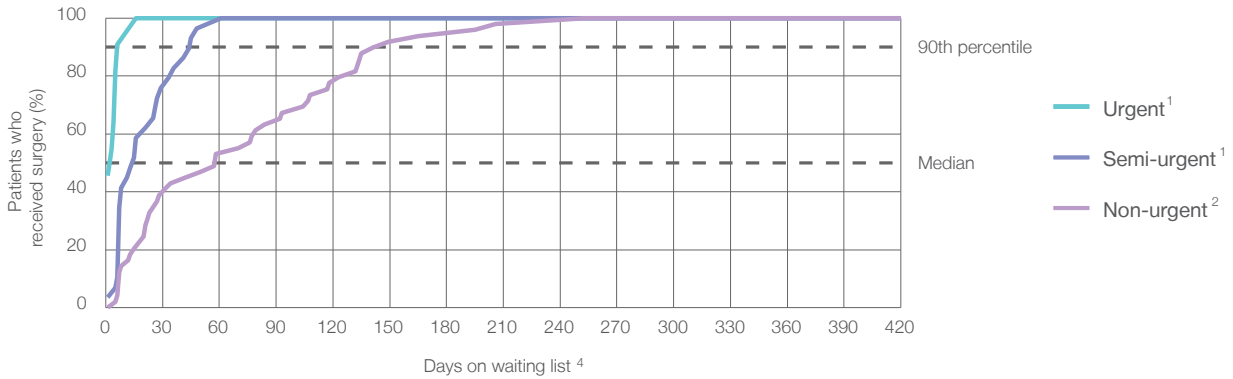

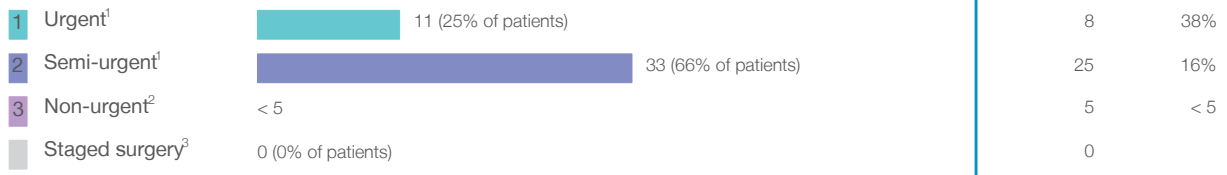

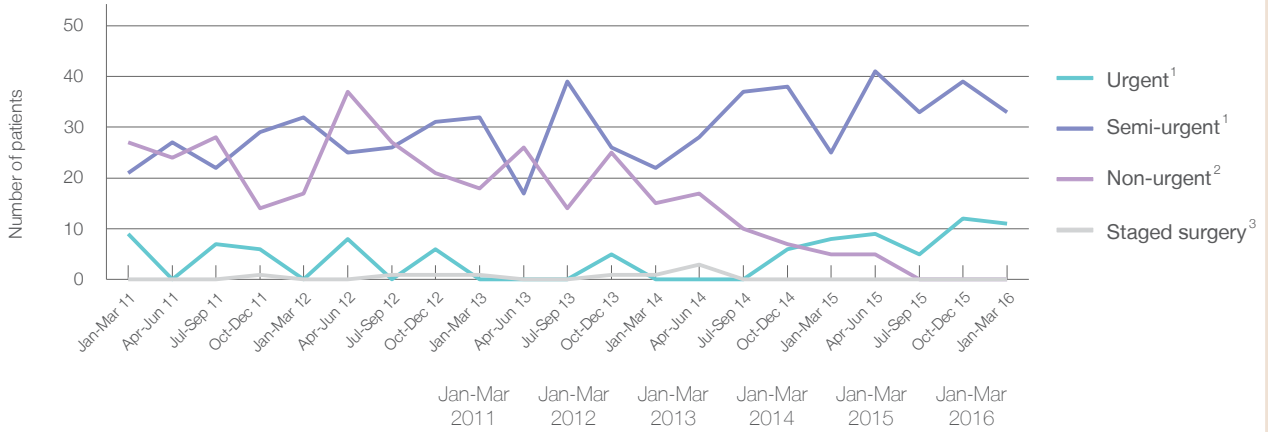

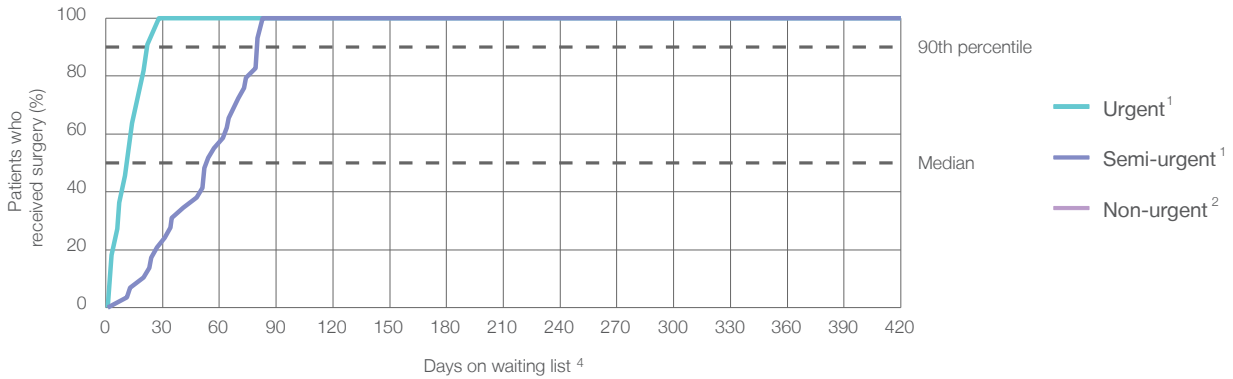

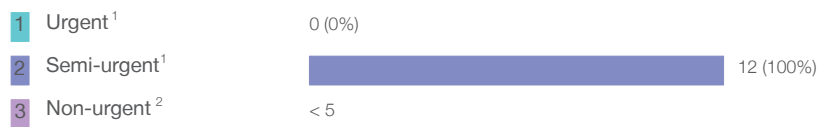

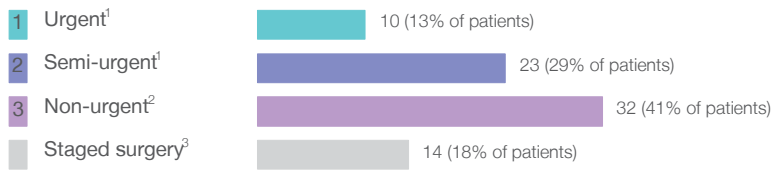

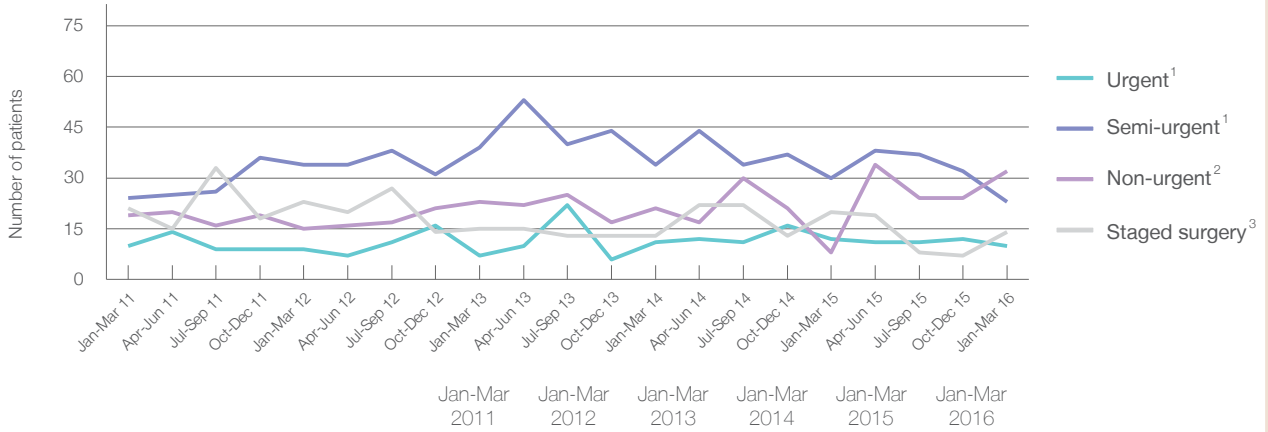

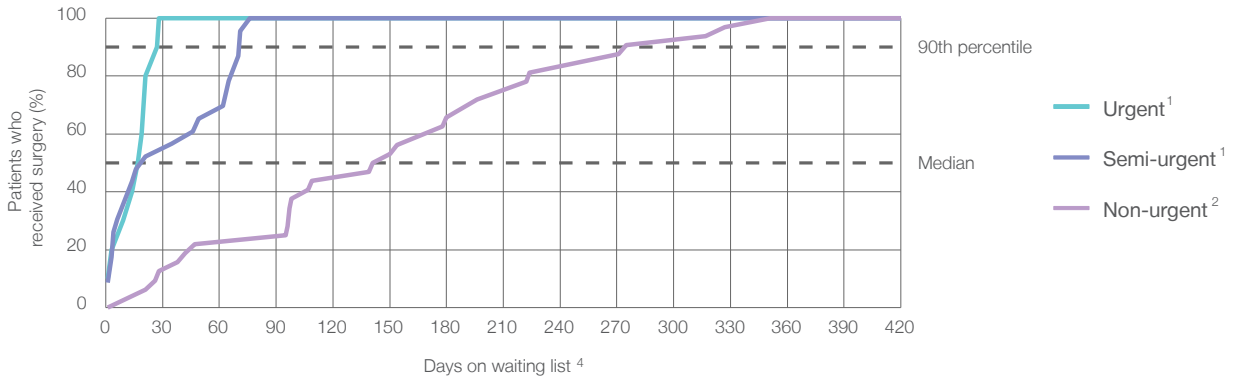

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)




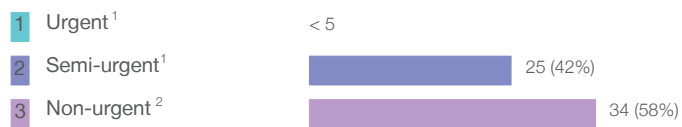
