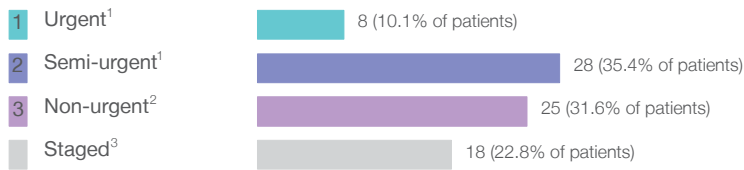

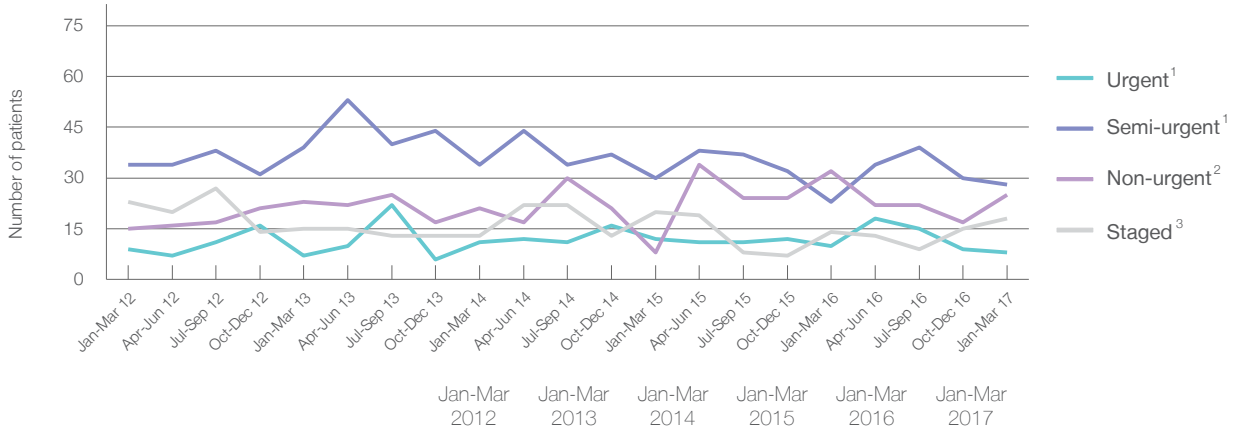

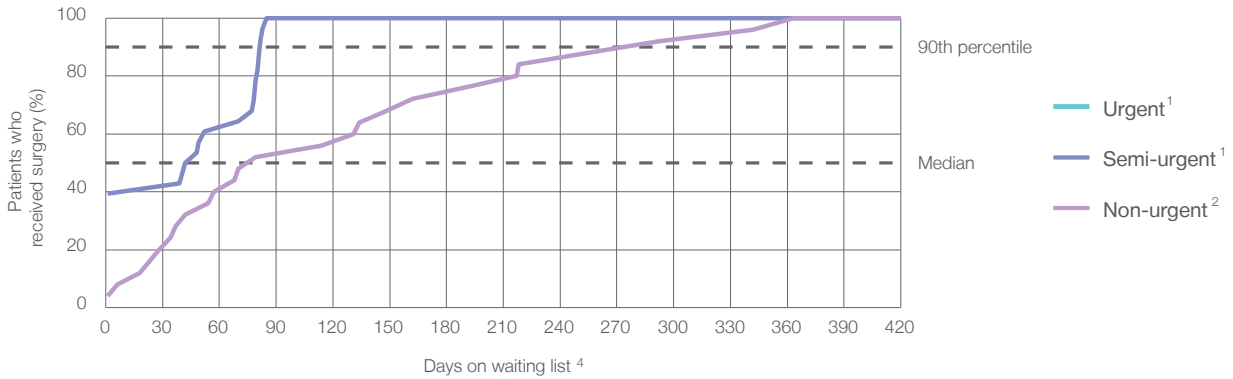

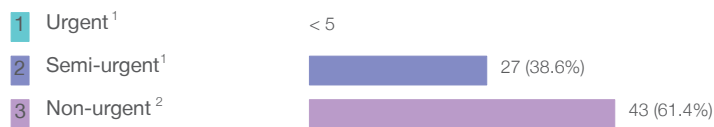

6. This is the number of days it took for 90% of patients who received elective surgery during the period to be admitted and receive their surgery. The final 10% of patients took equal to or longer than the 90th percentile.

8. Includes staged procedures, non-urgent cystoscopy, and patients currently not available for personal reasons.
