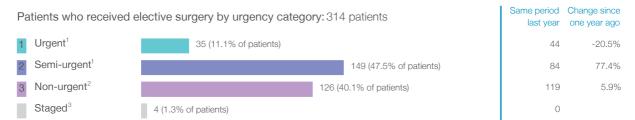





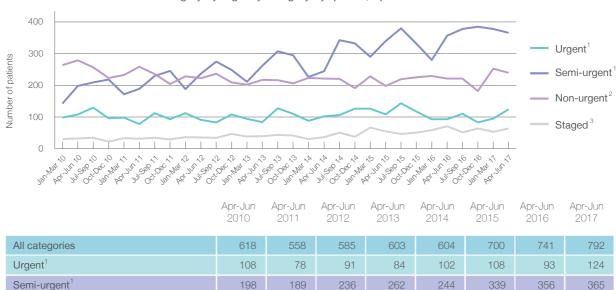





















April to June 2017






#### Ryde Hospital: Elective surgery performed






