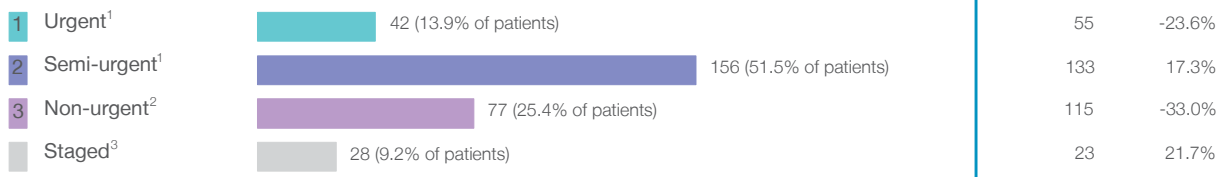

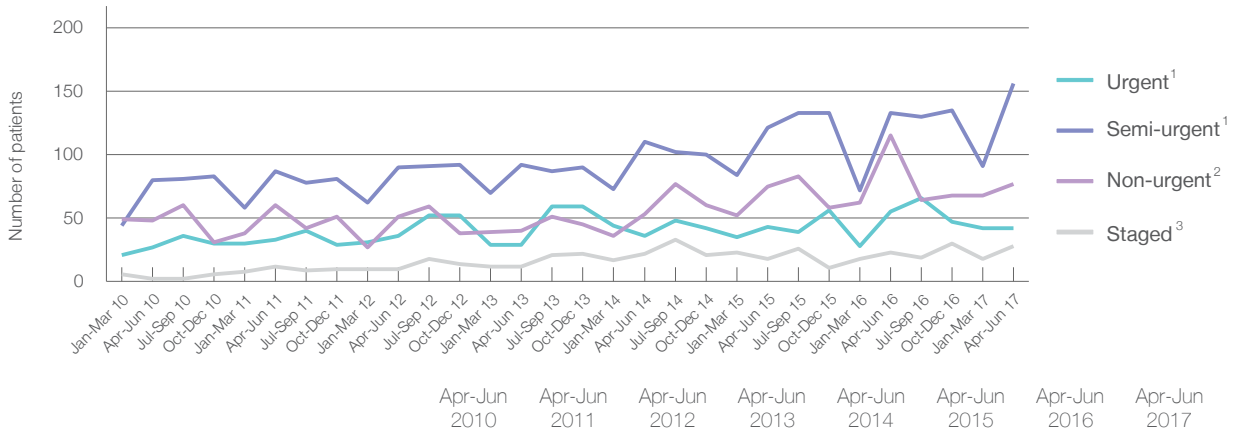

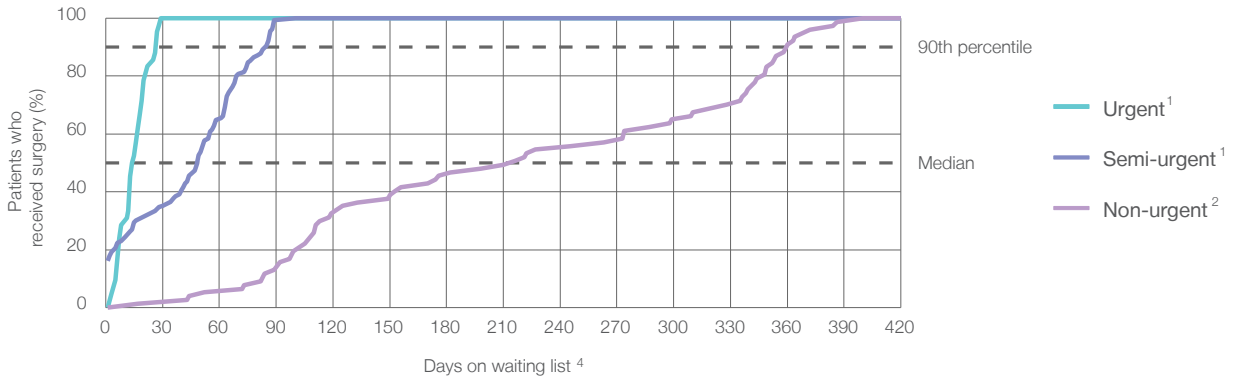

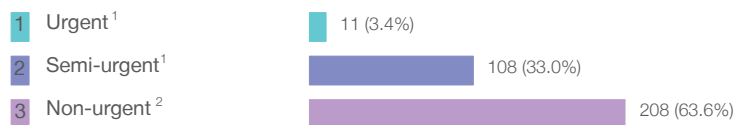

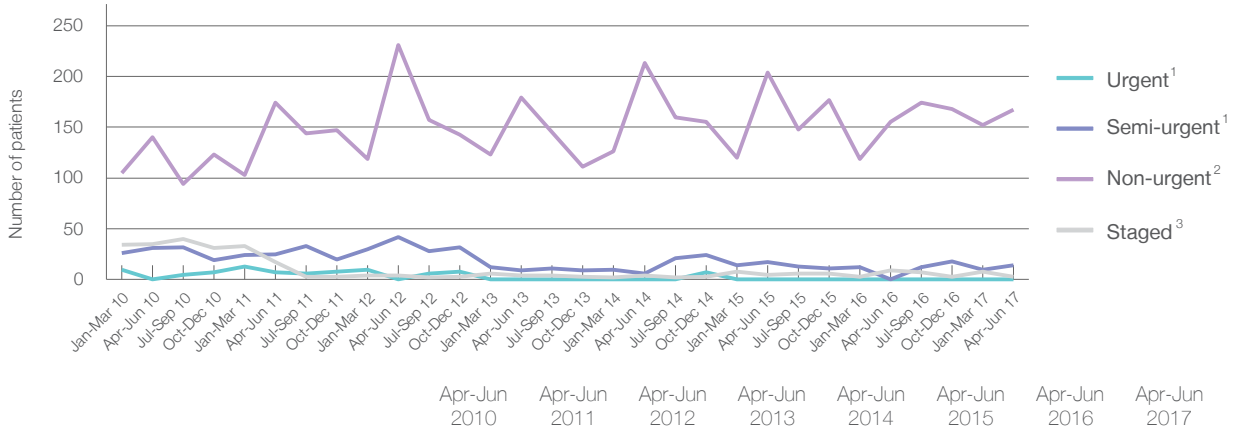

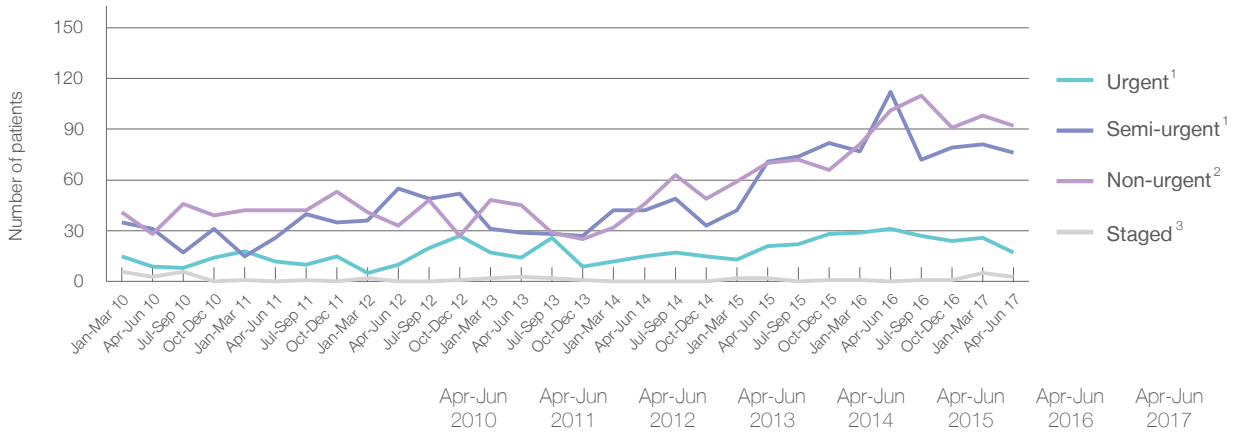

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)









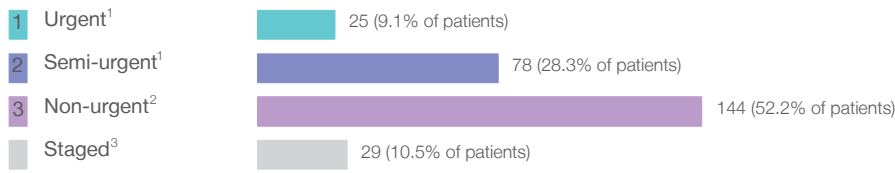

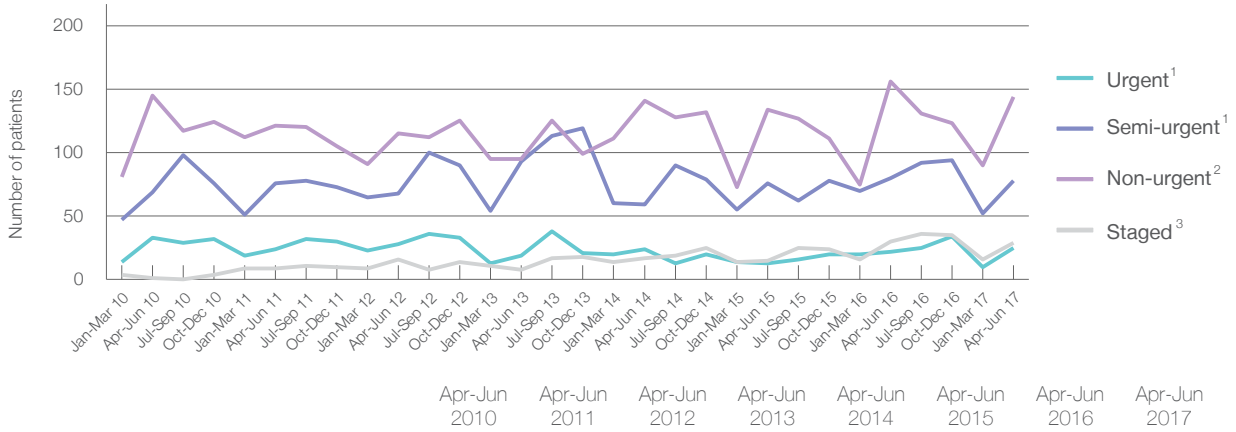

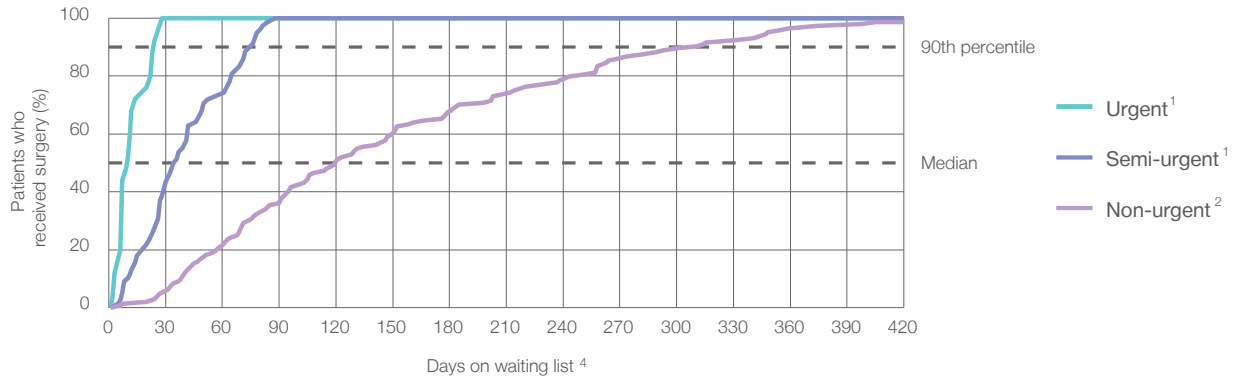

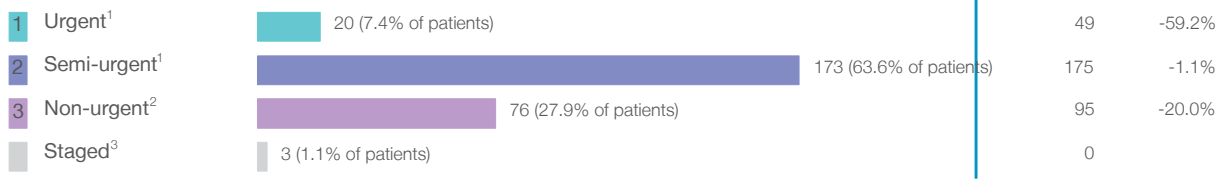

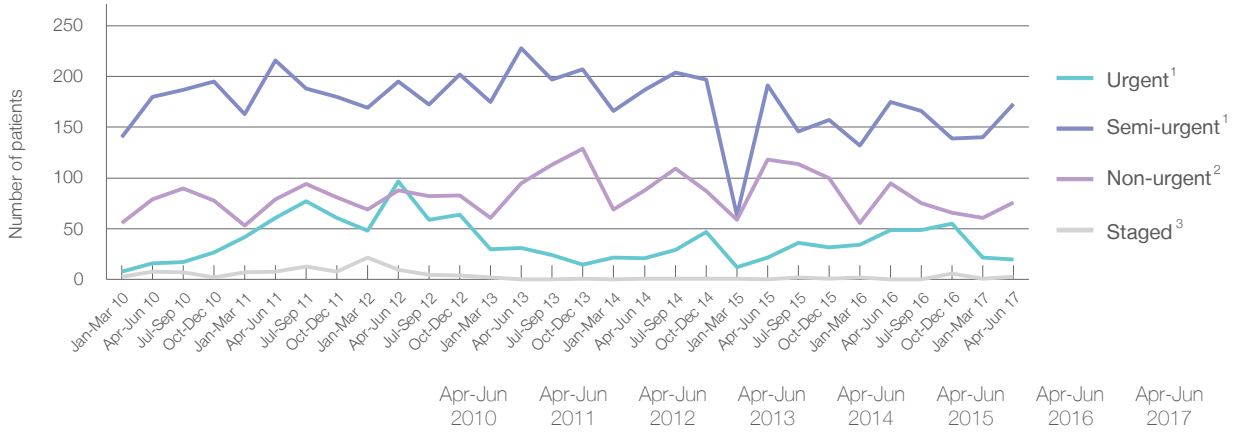

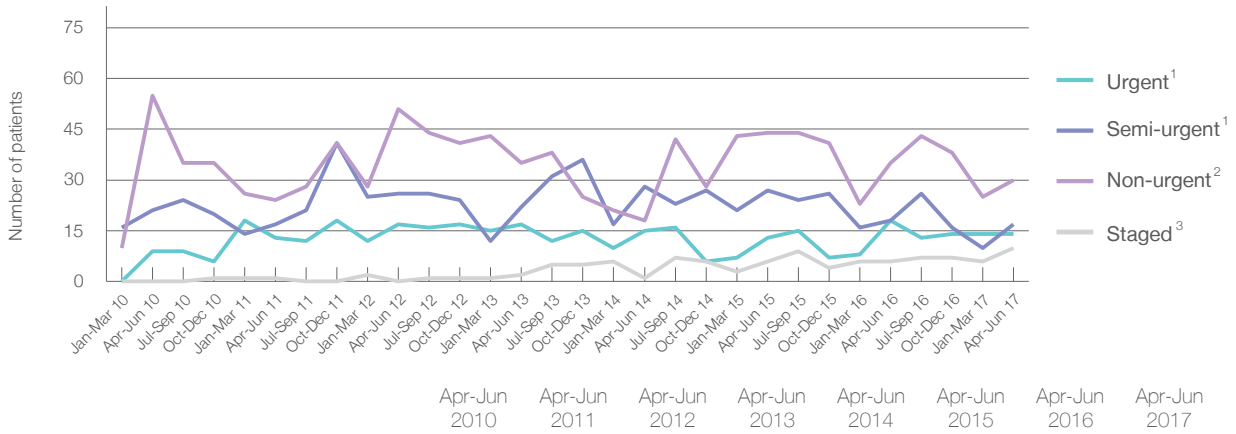

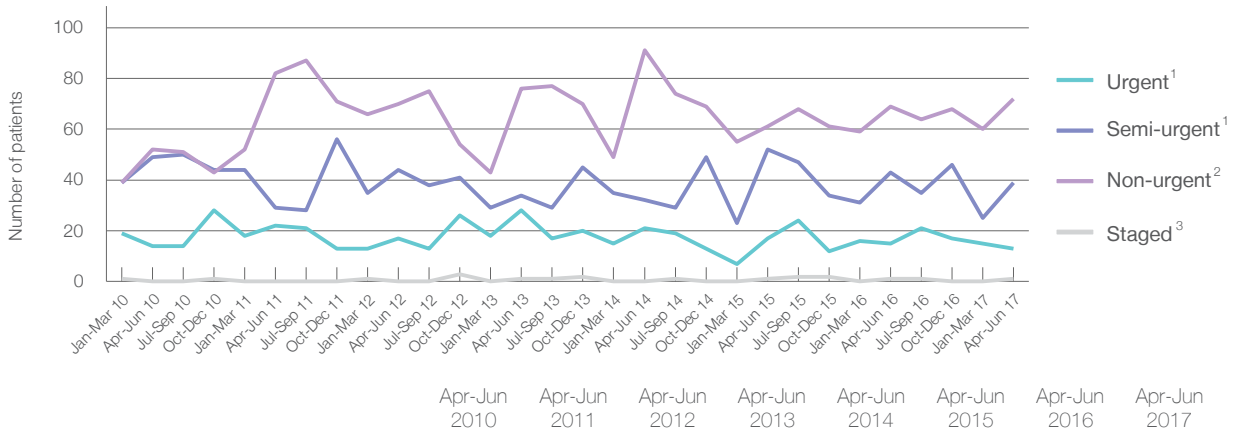

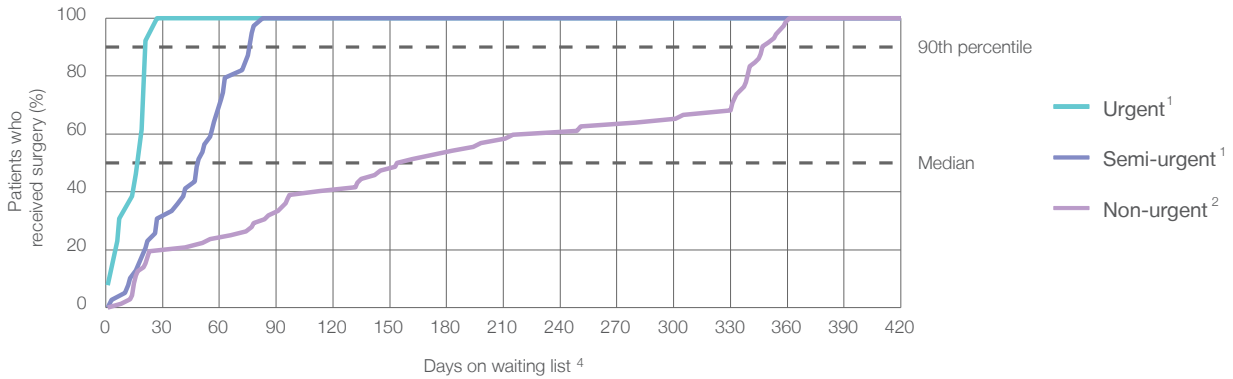

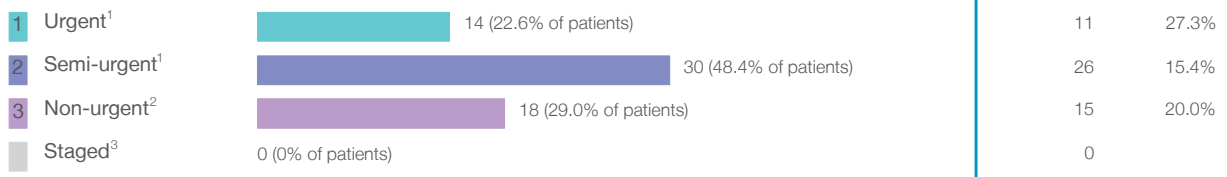

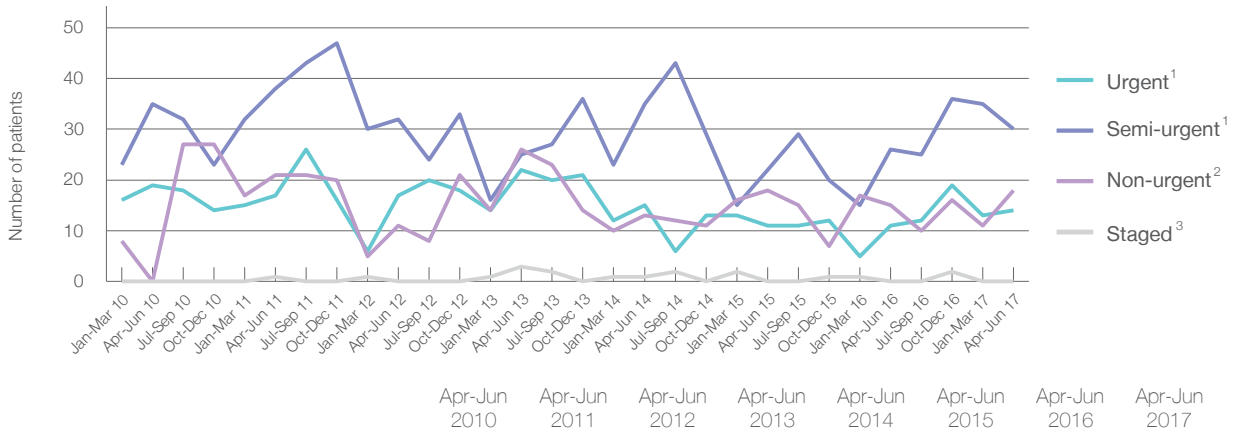

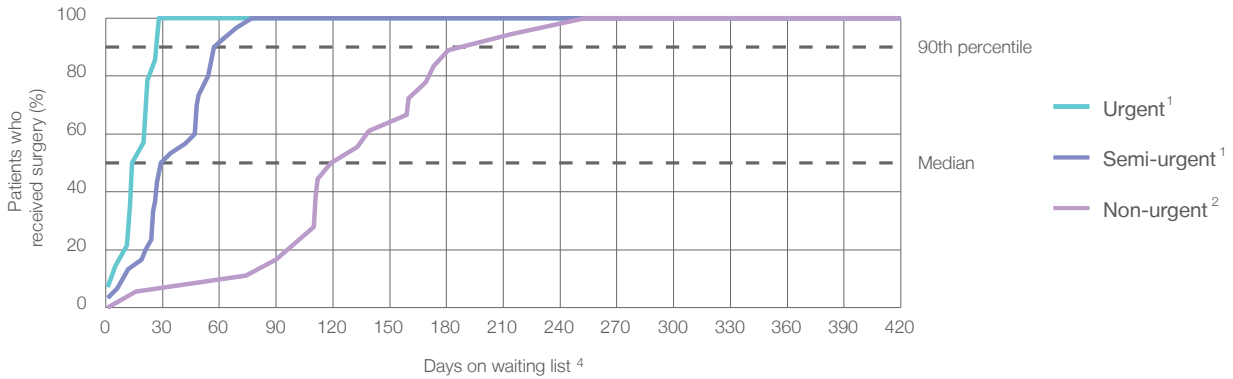

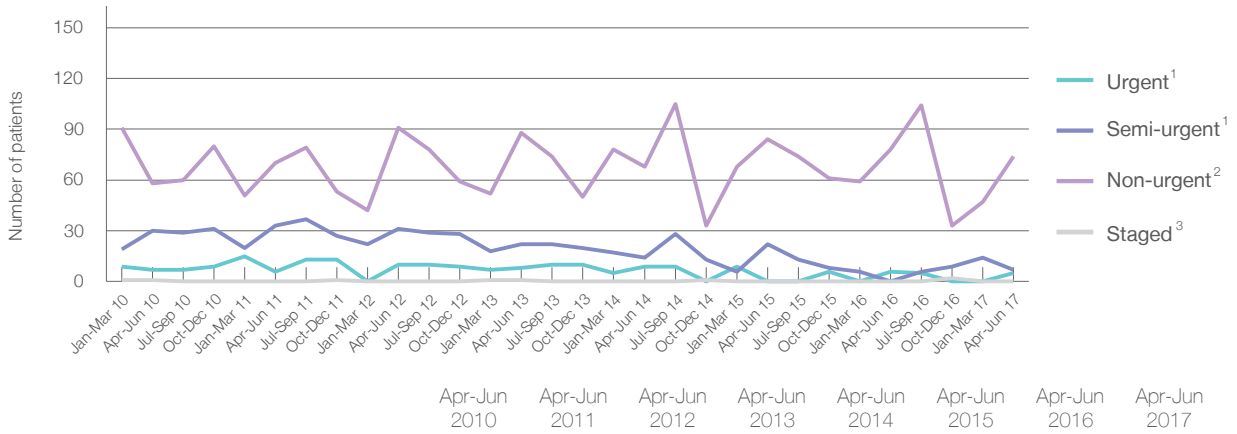

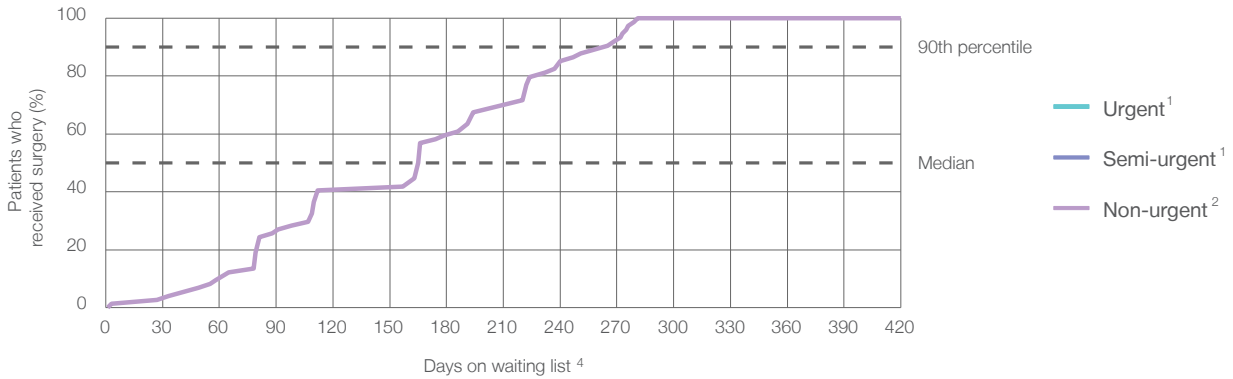

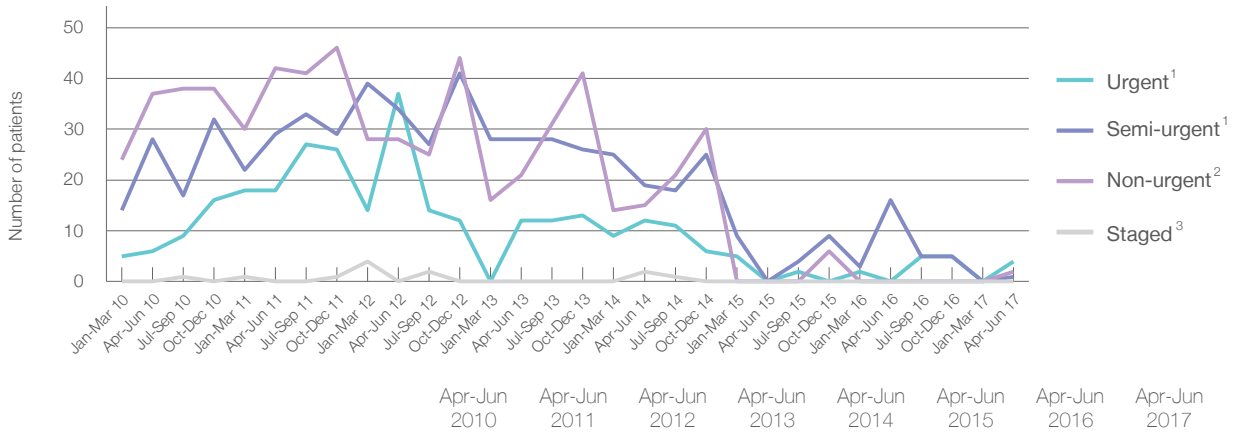

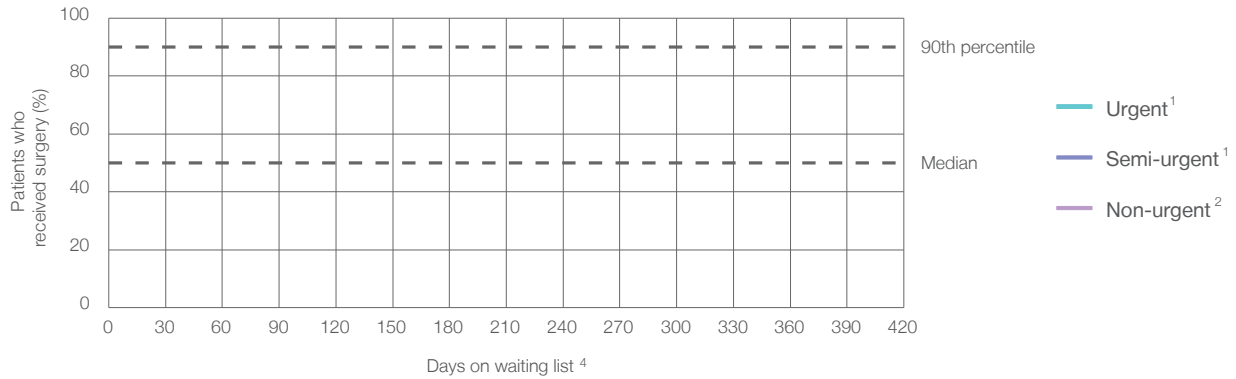

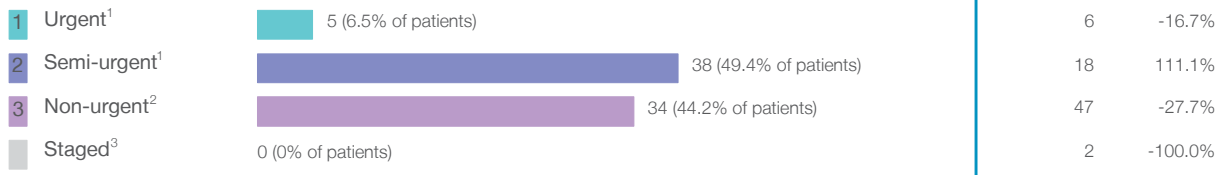

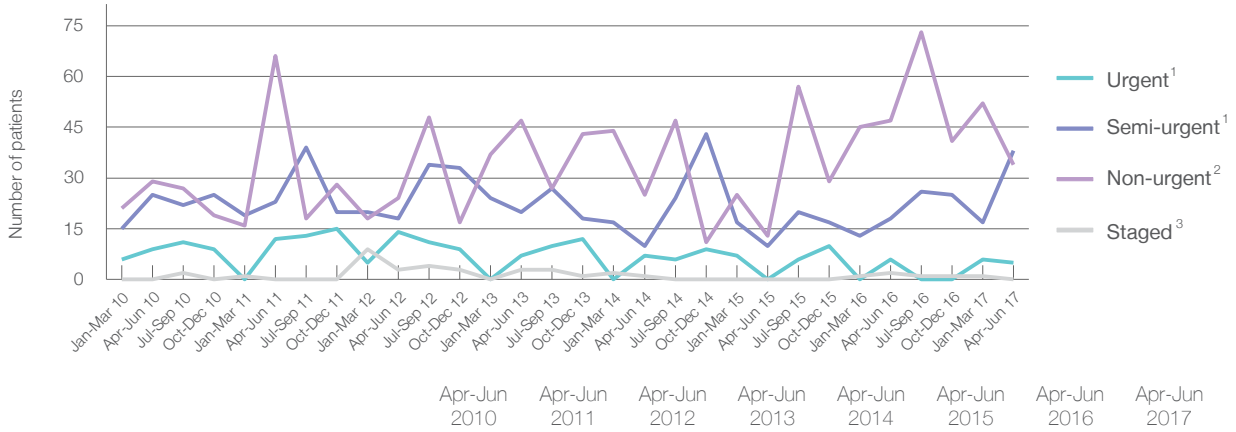

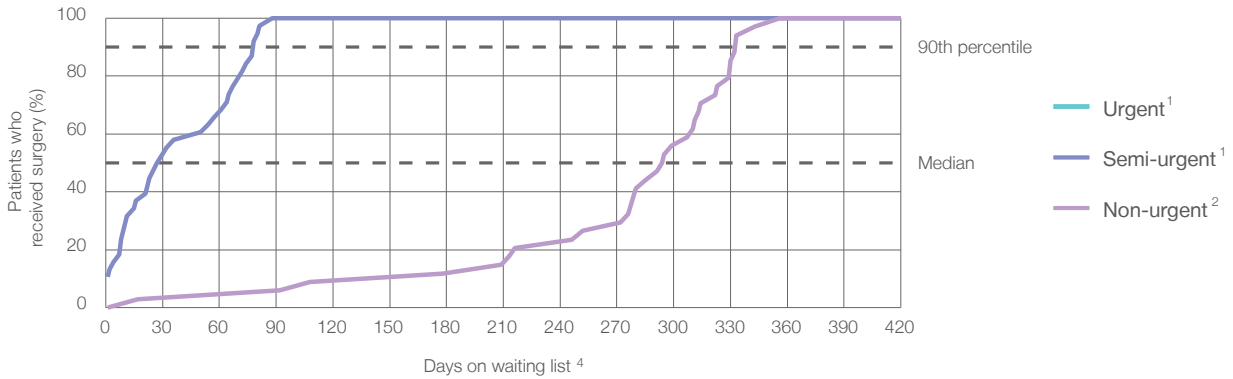
Inverell District Hospital: Time waited to receive elective surgery

April to June 2017

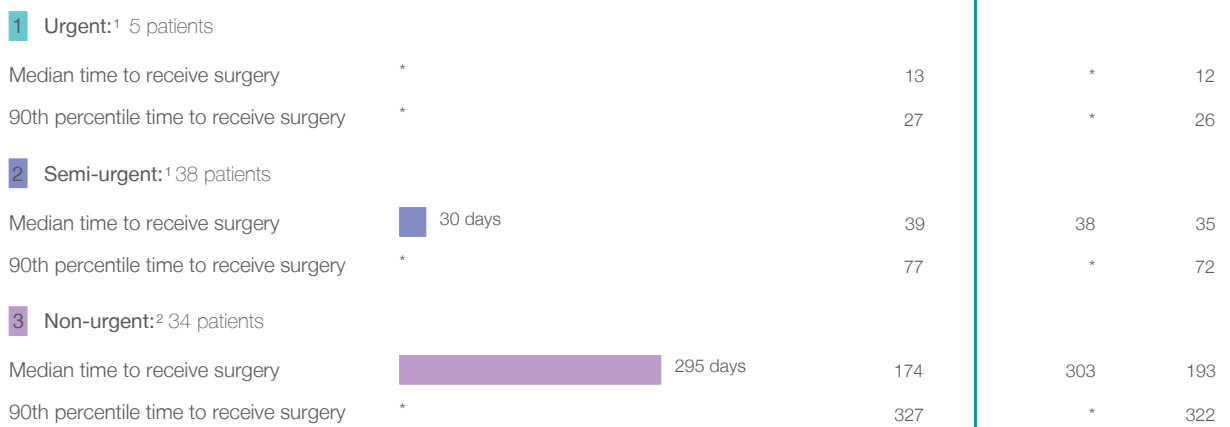
Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

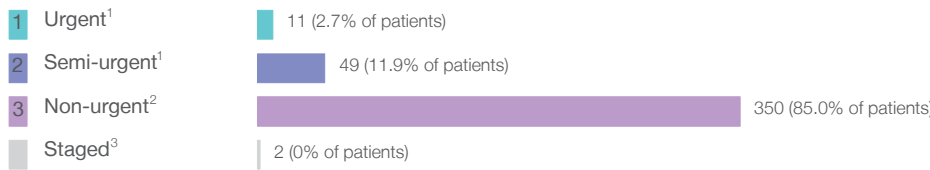

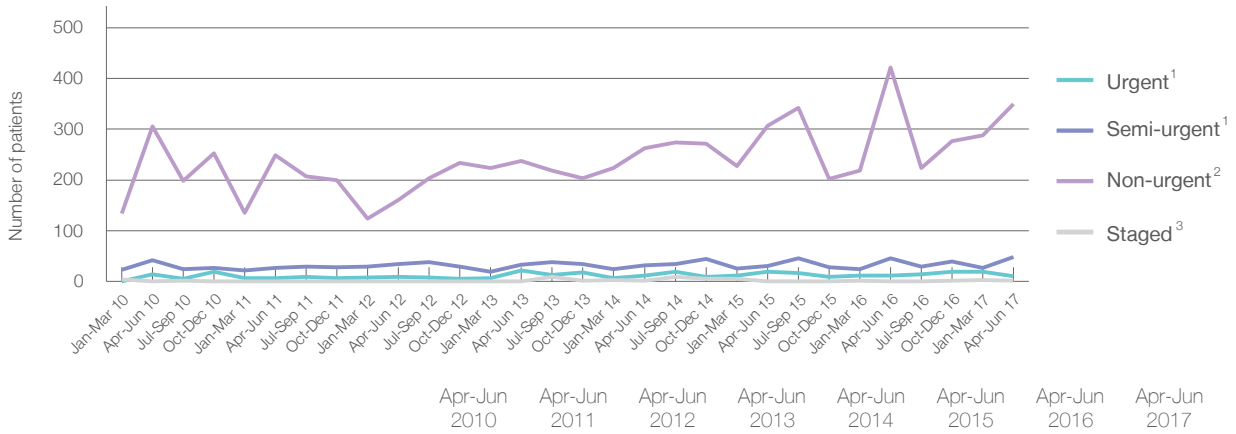

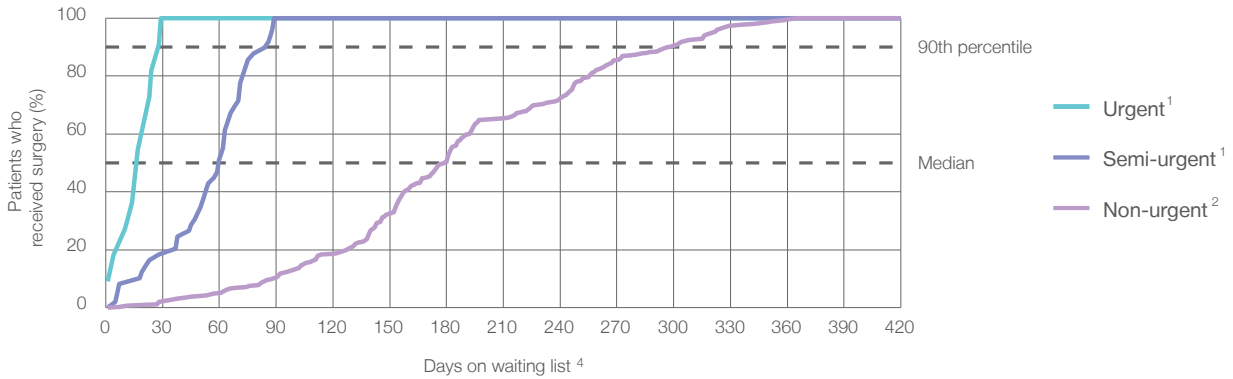

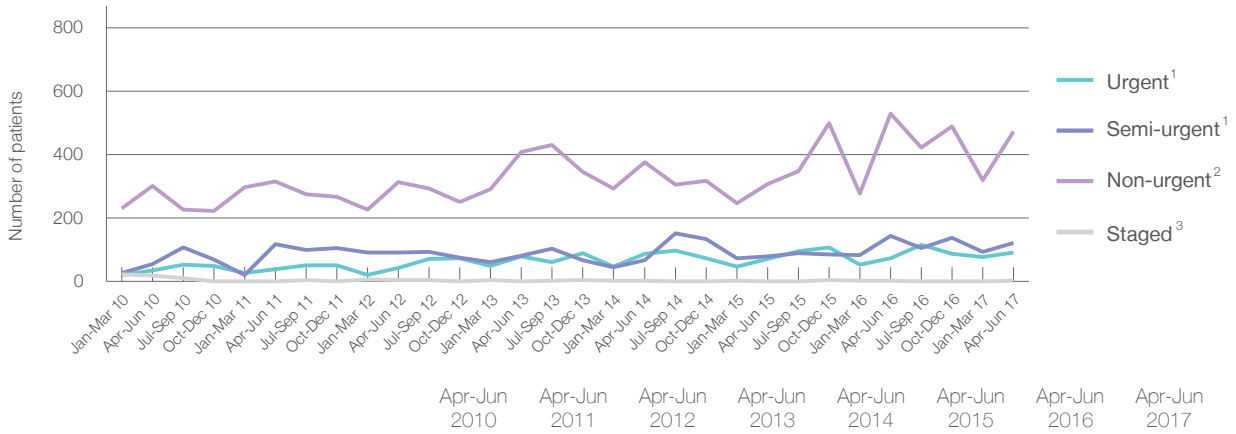

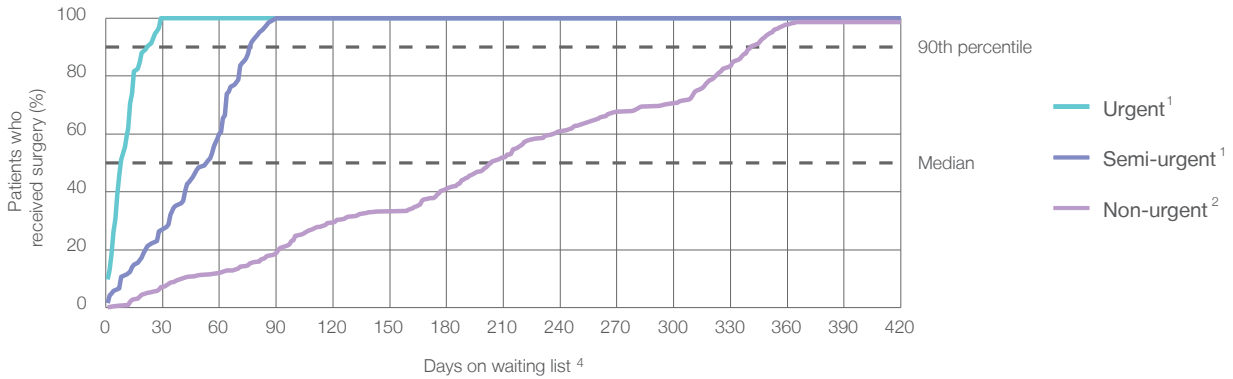

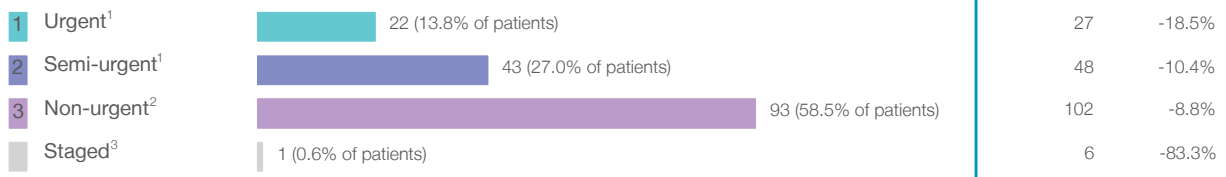

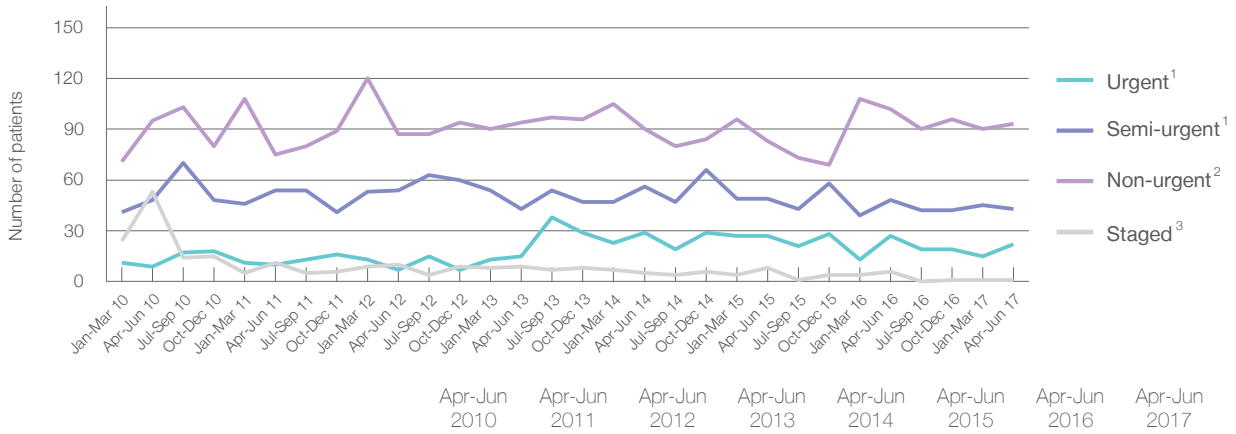

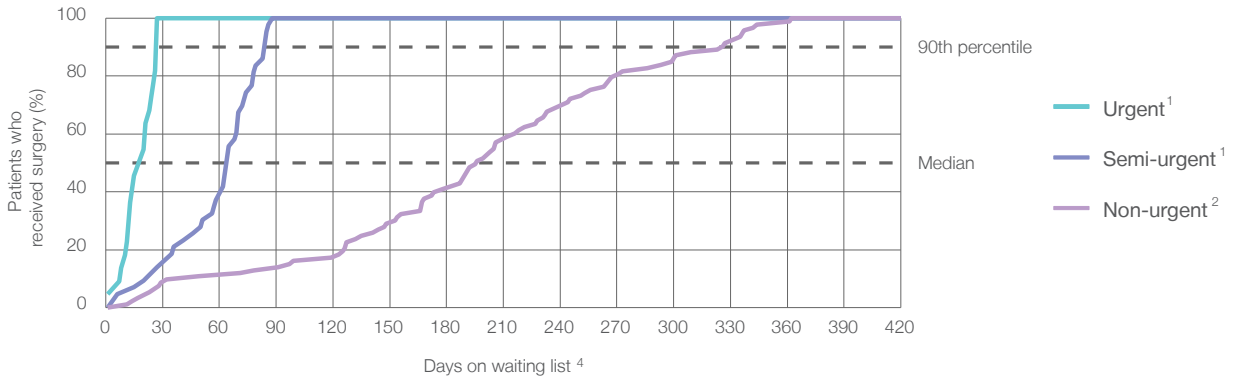

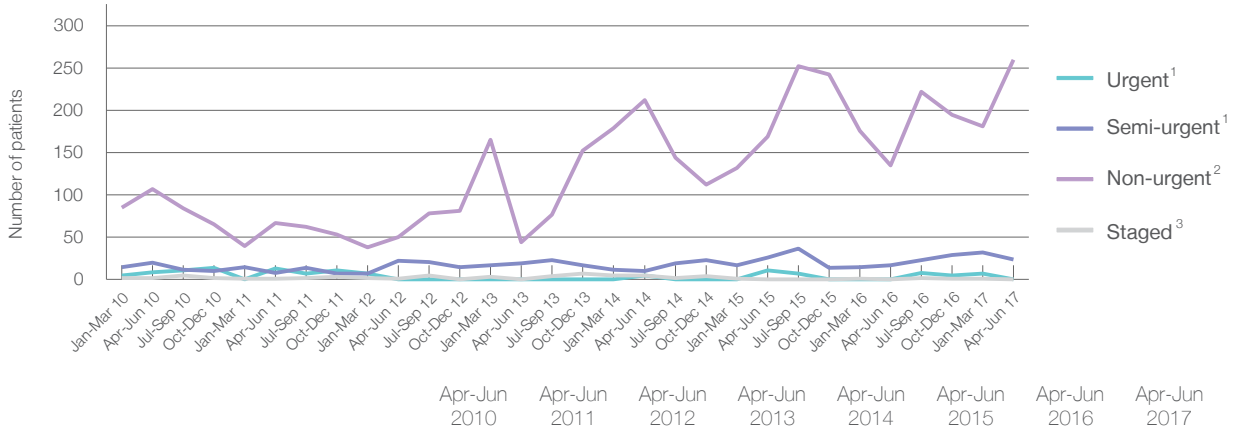

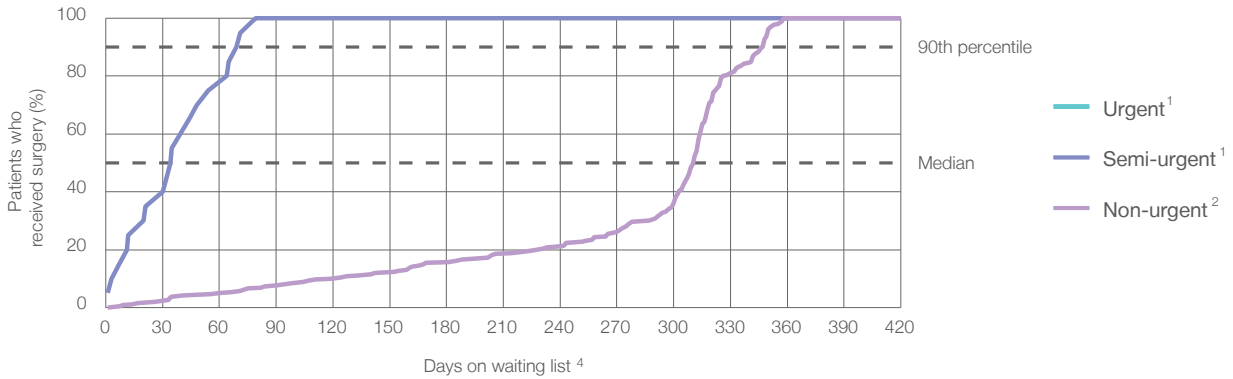

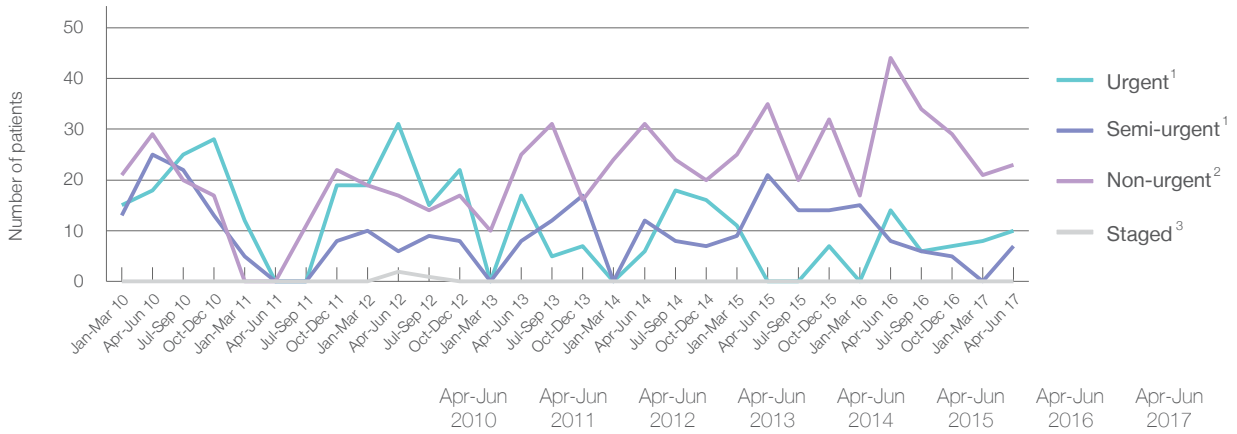

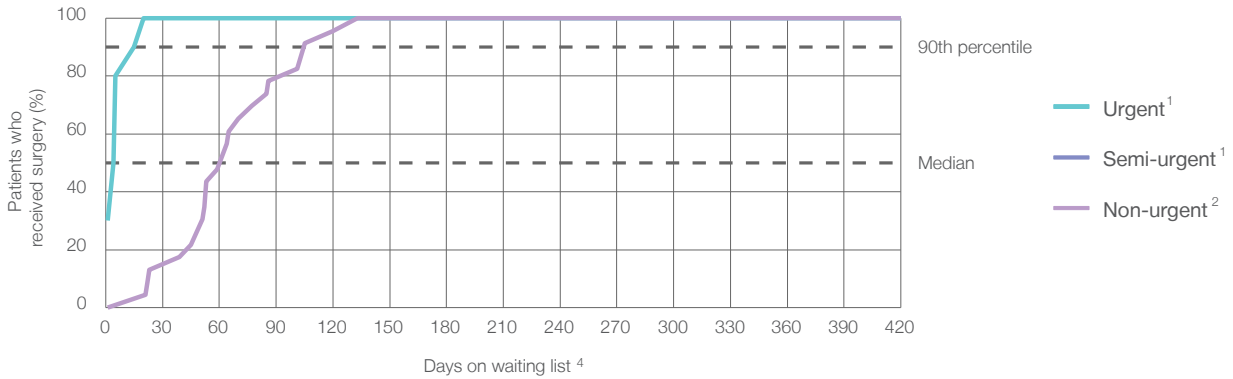

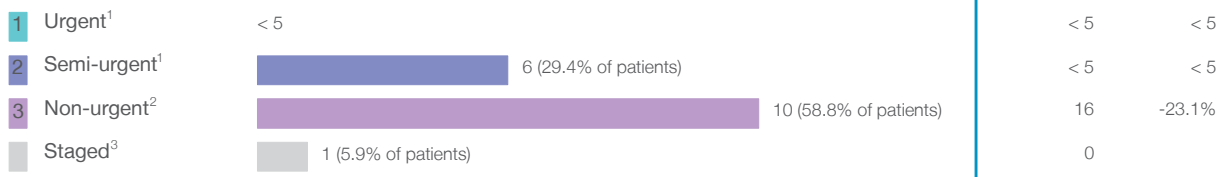

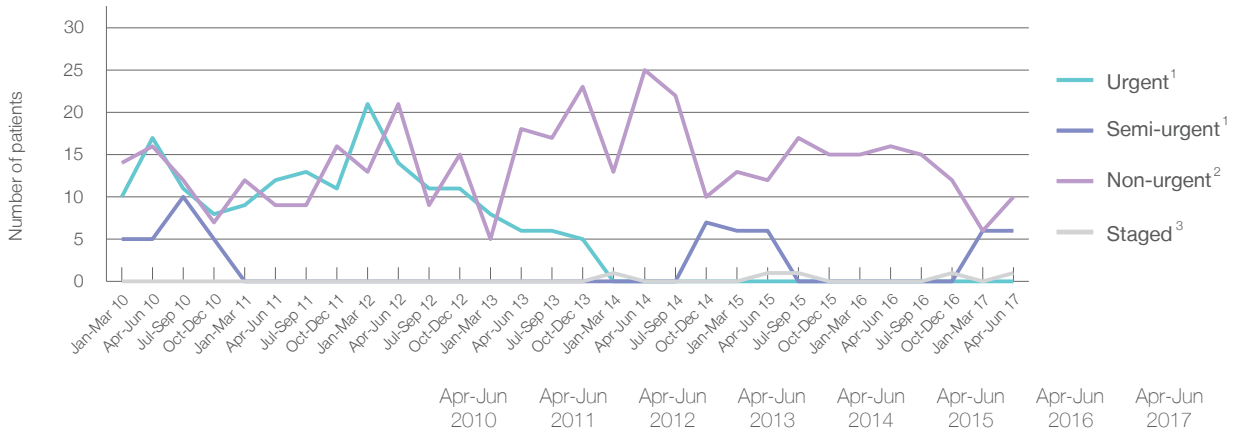

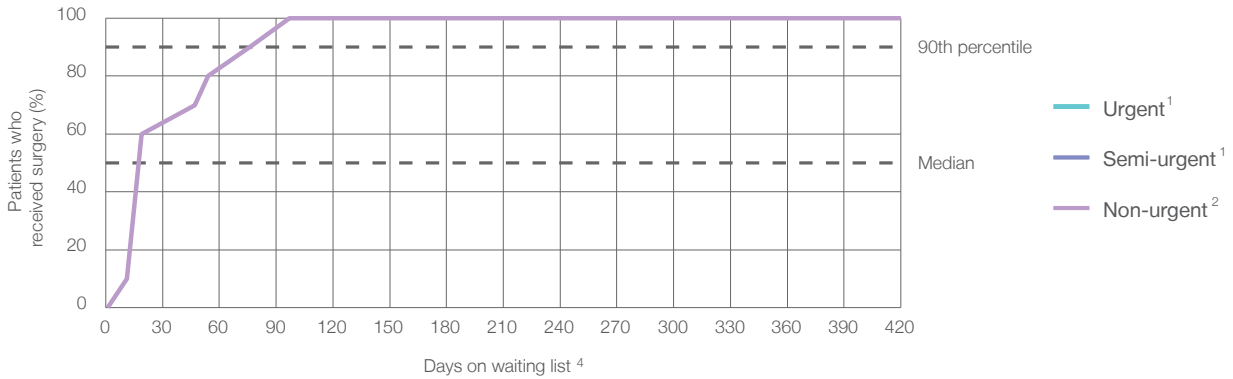

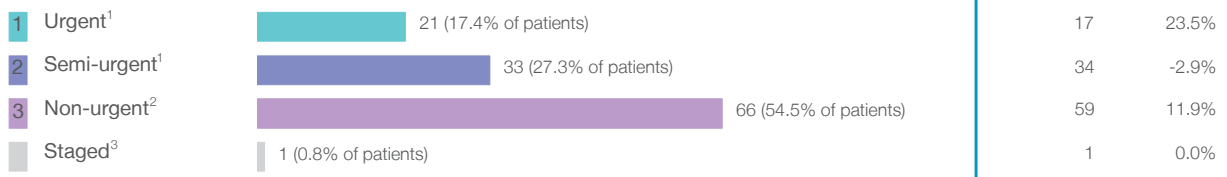

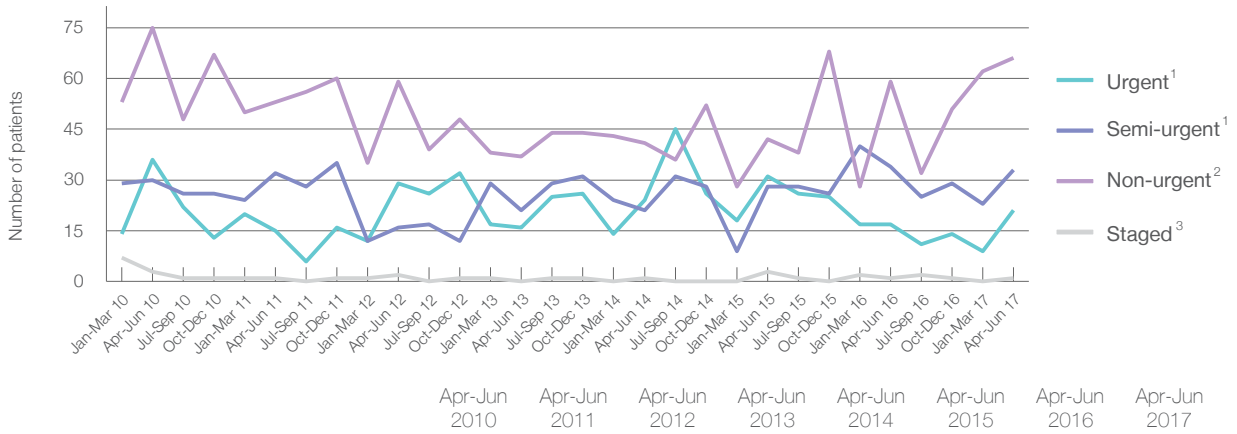

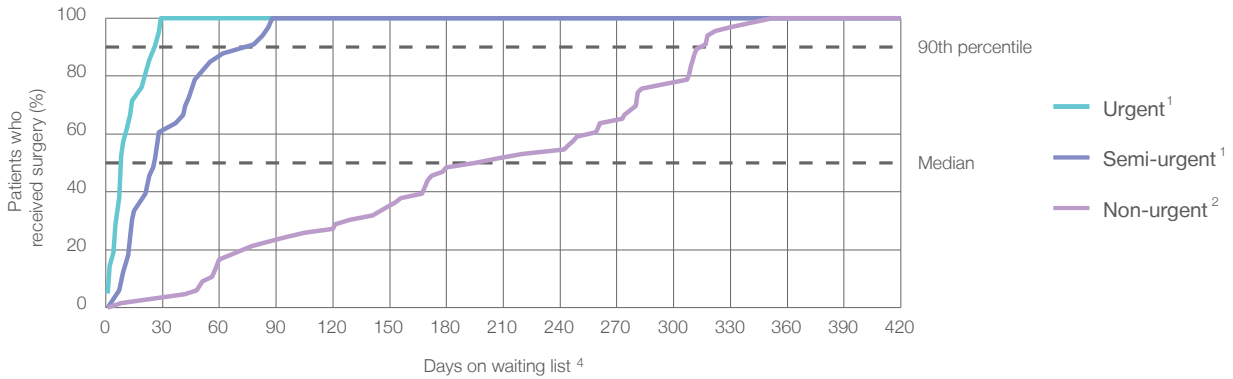

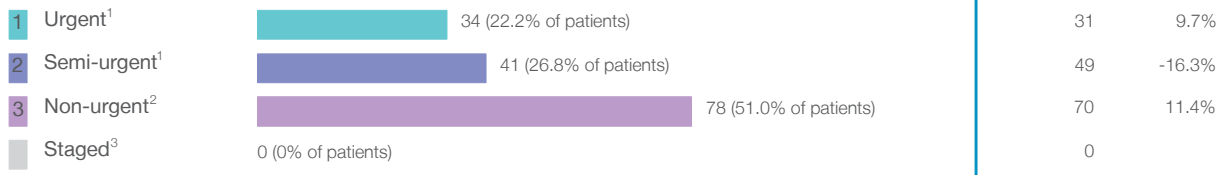

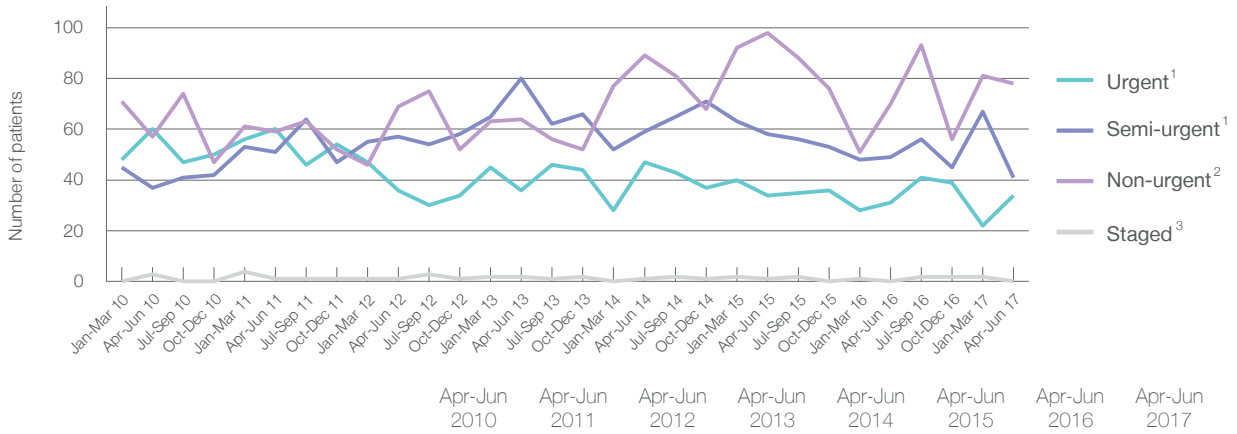

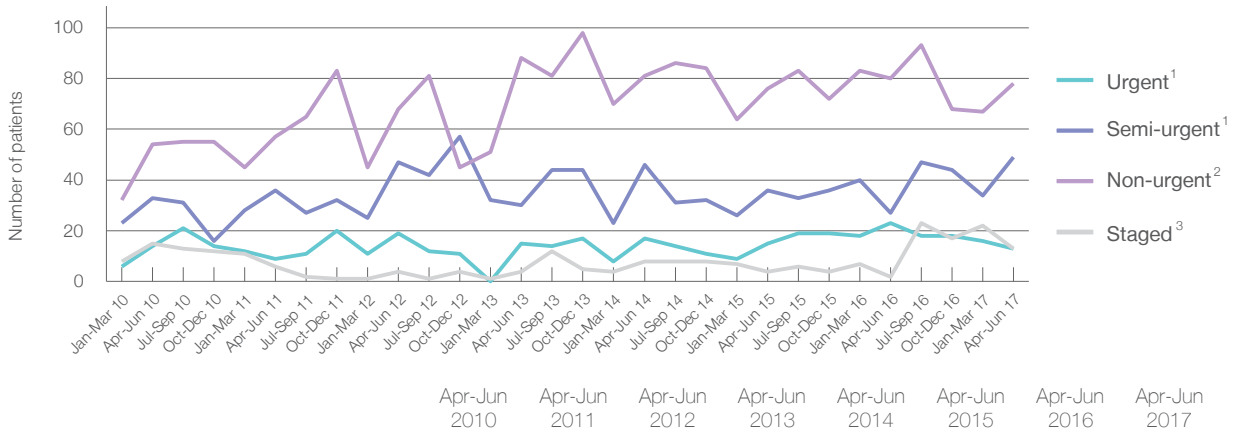

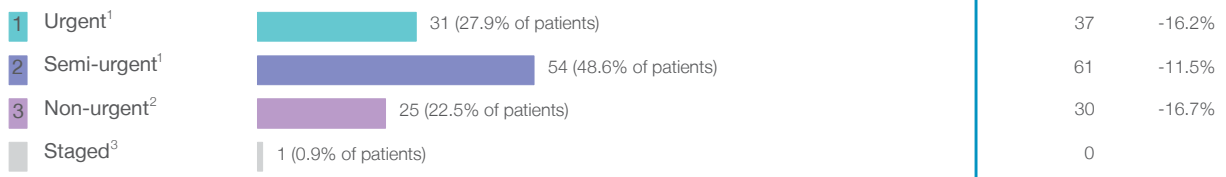

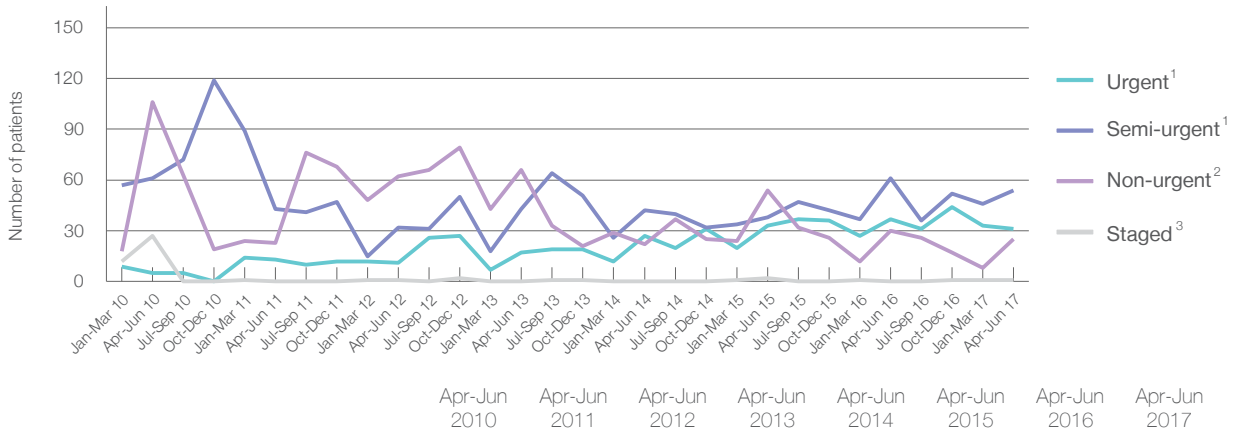

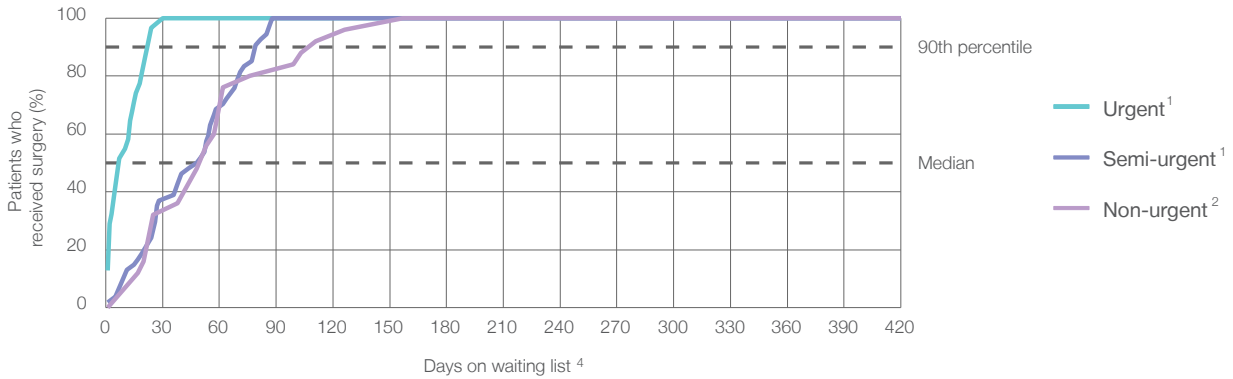

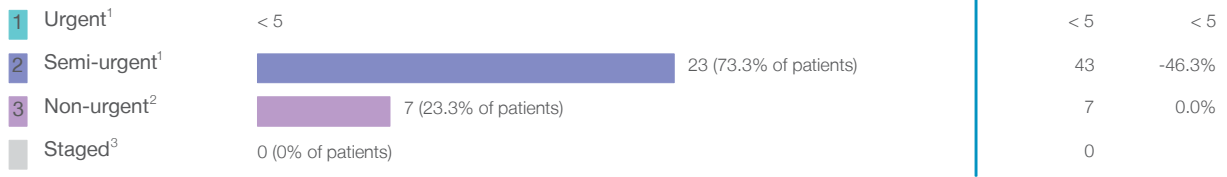

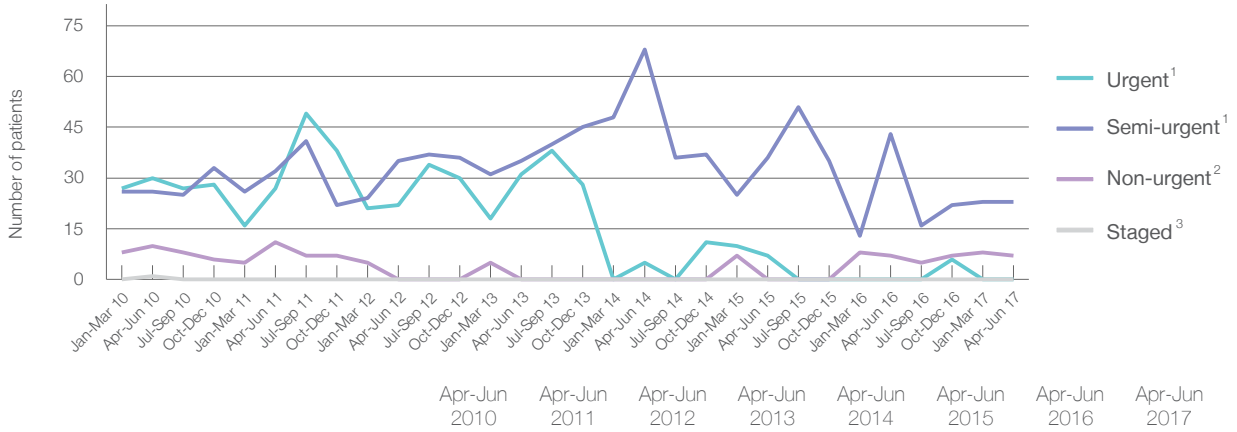
Narrabri District Hospital: Elective surgery performed

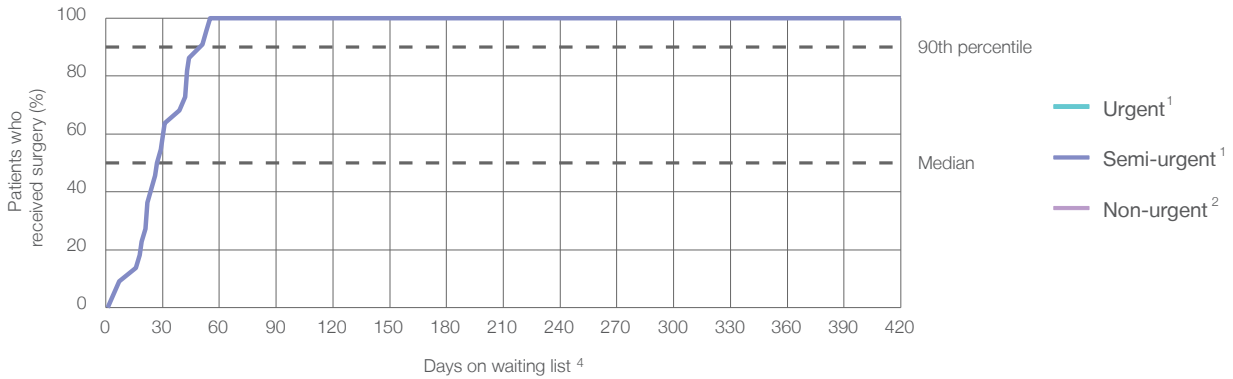

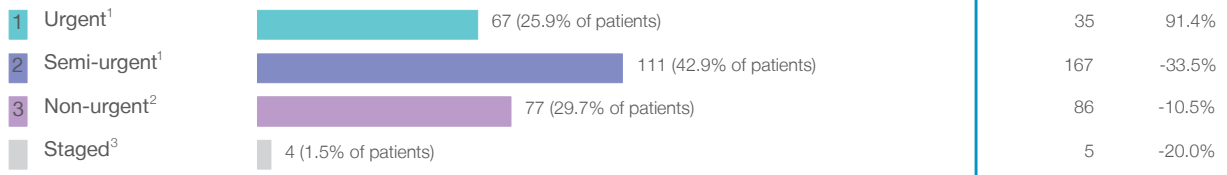

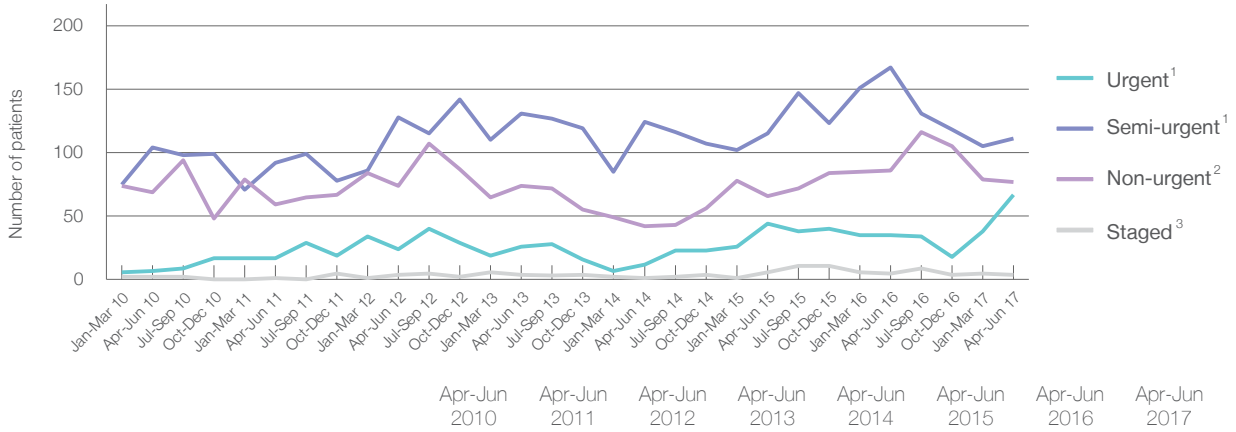

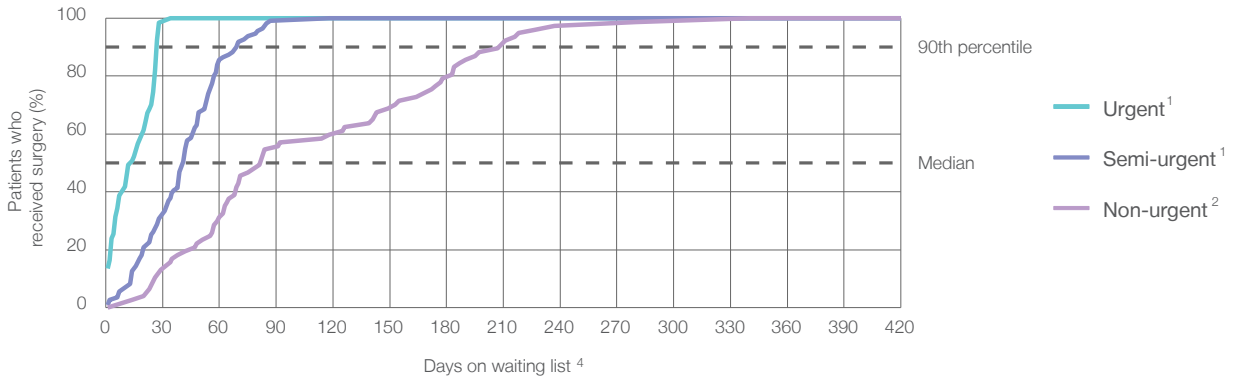

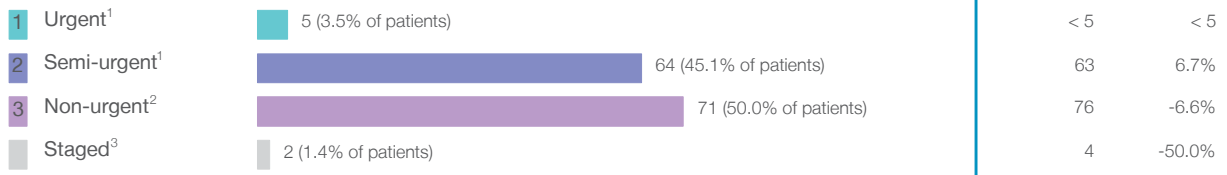

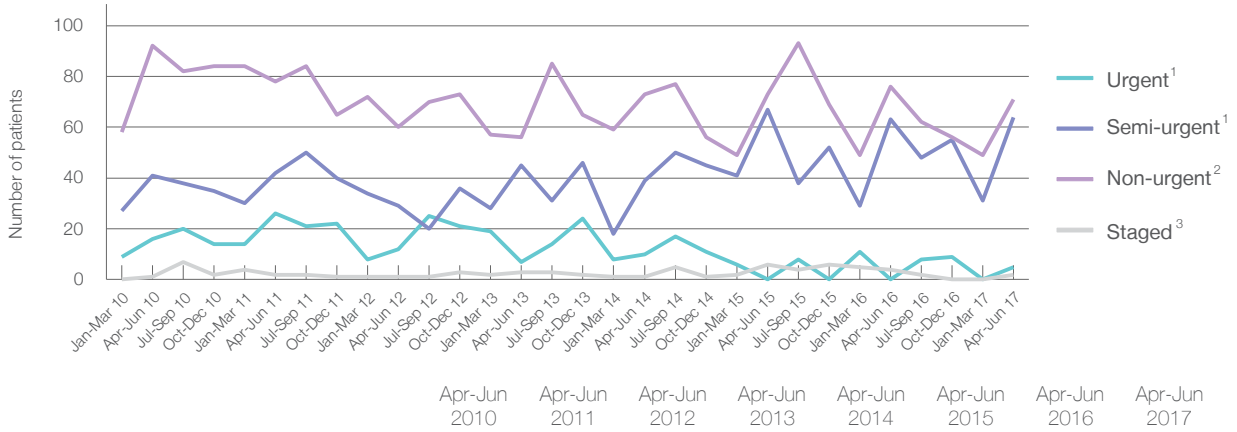

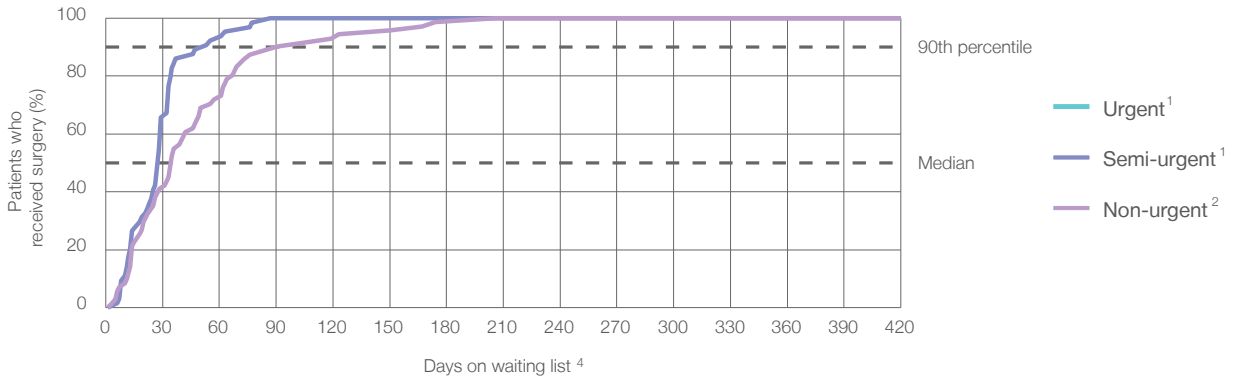

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)









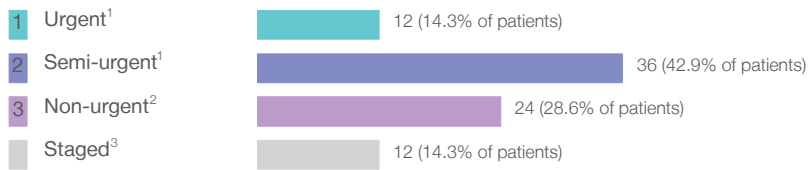

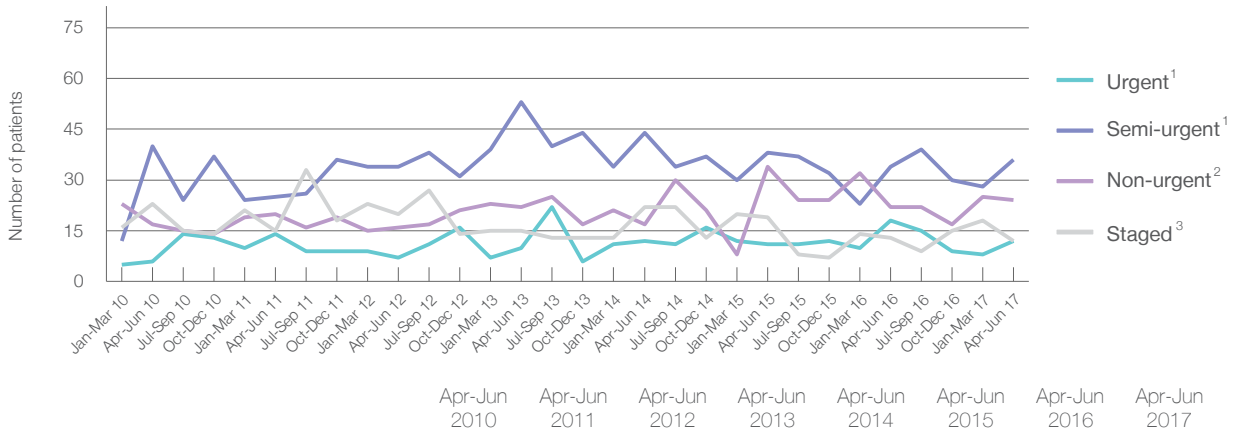

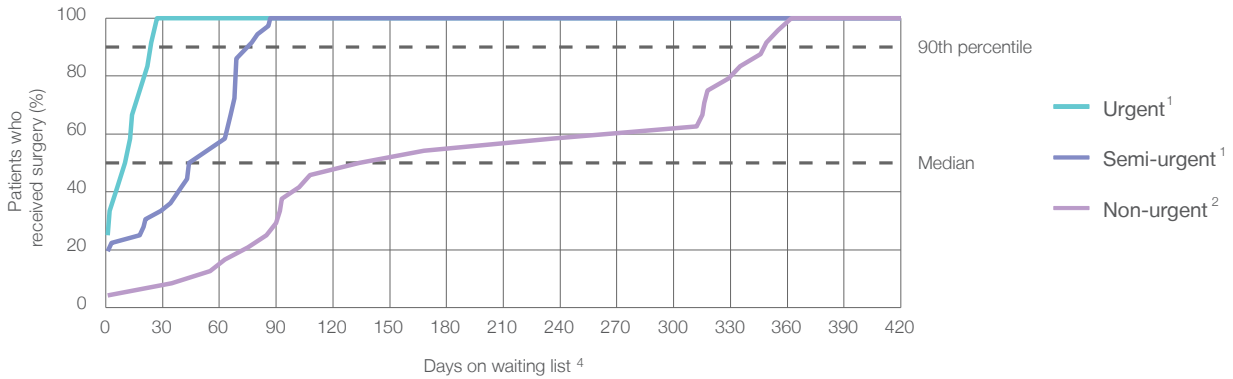

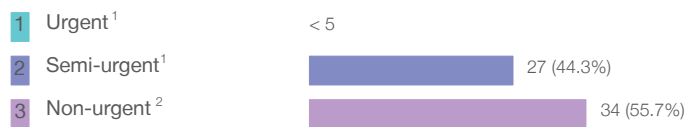
