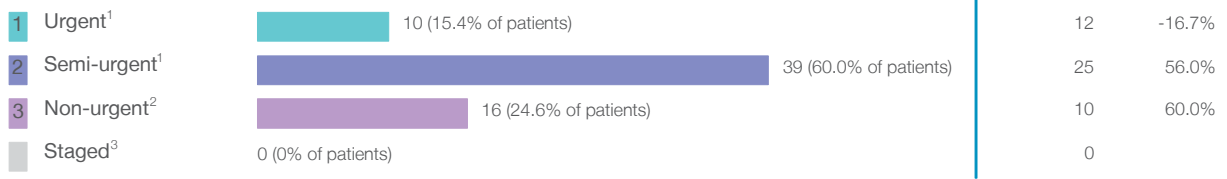

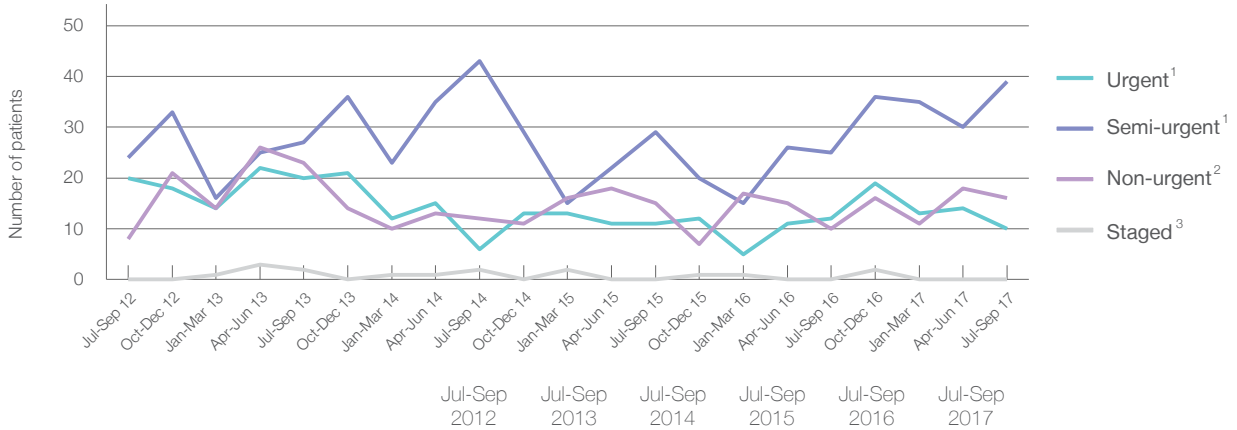

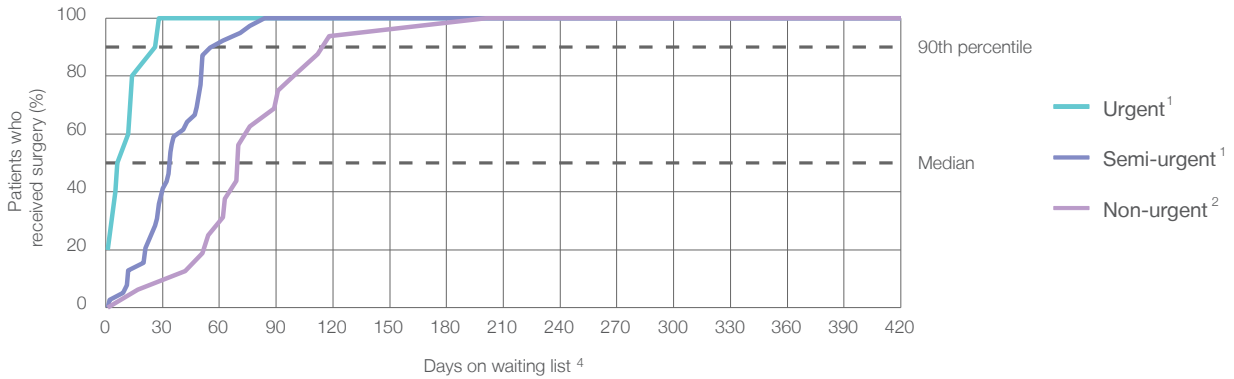

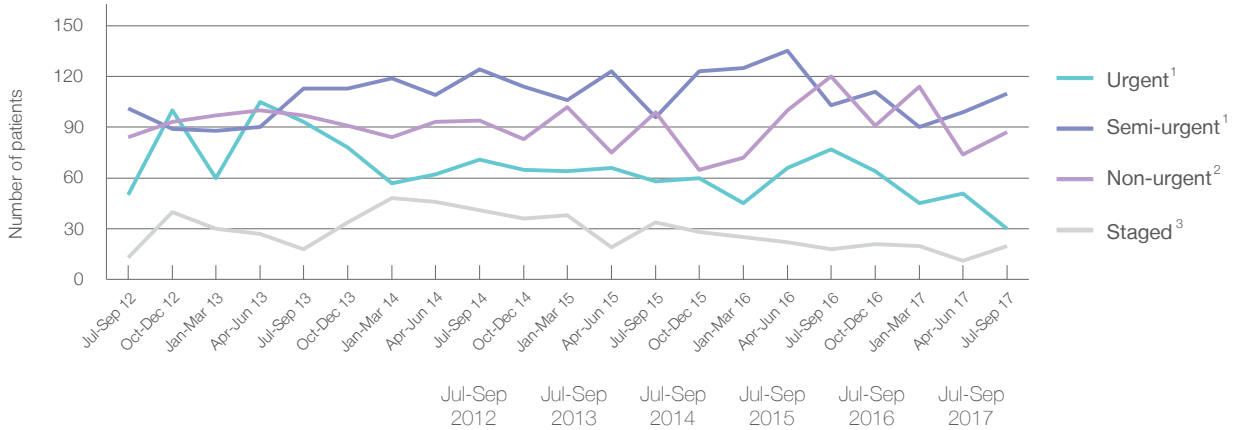

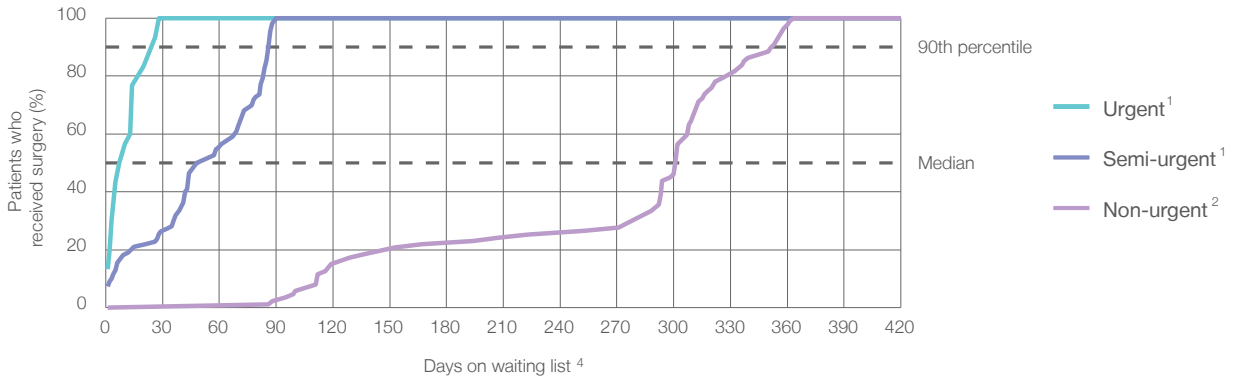

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)











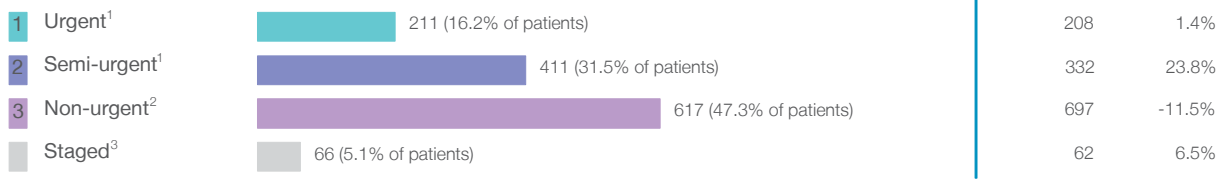

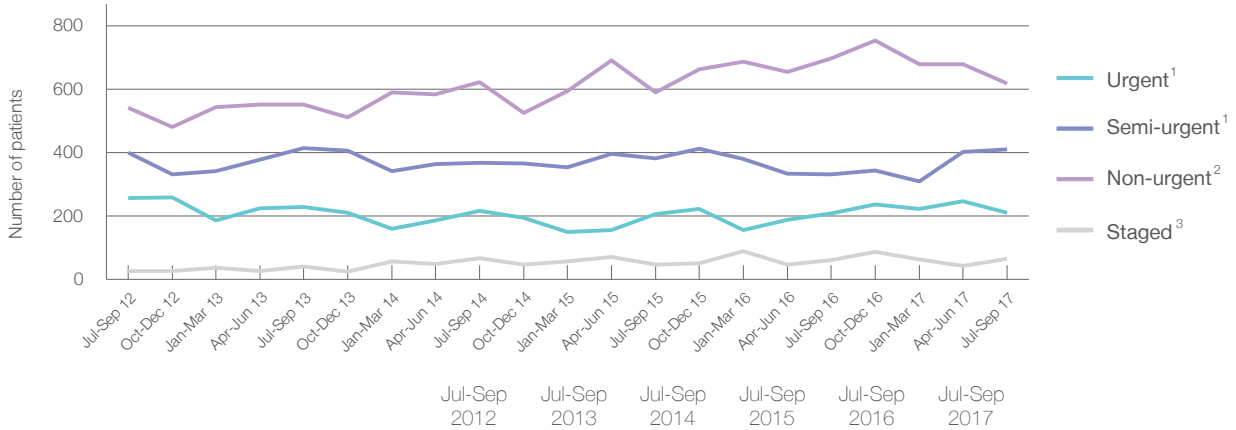

Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, July 2012 to September 2017



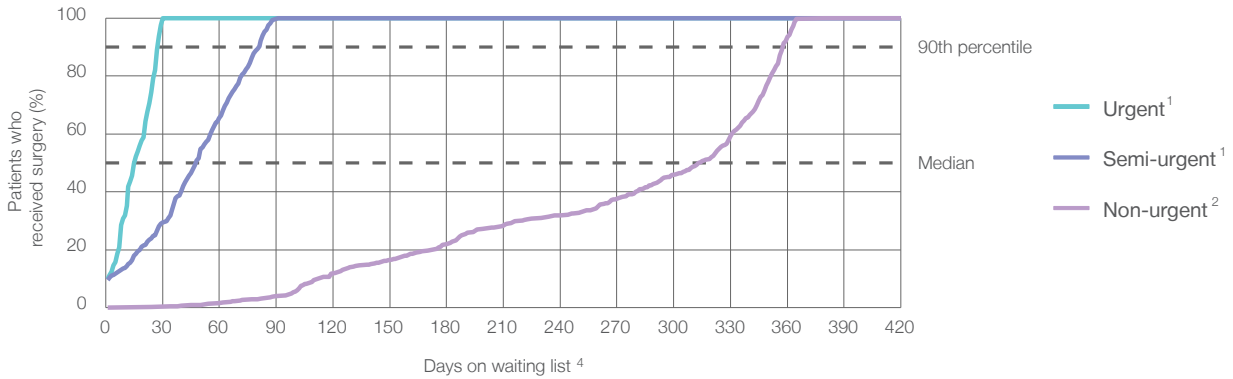

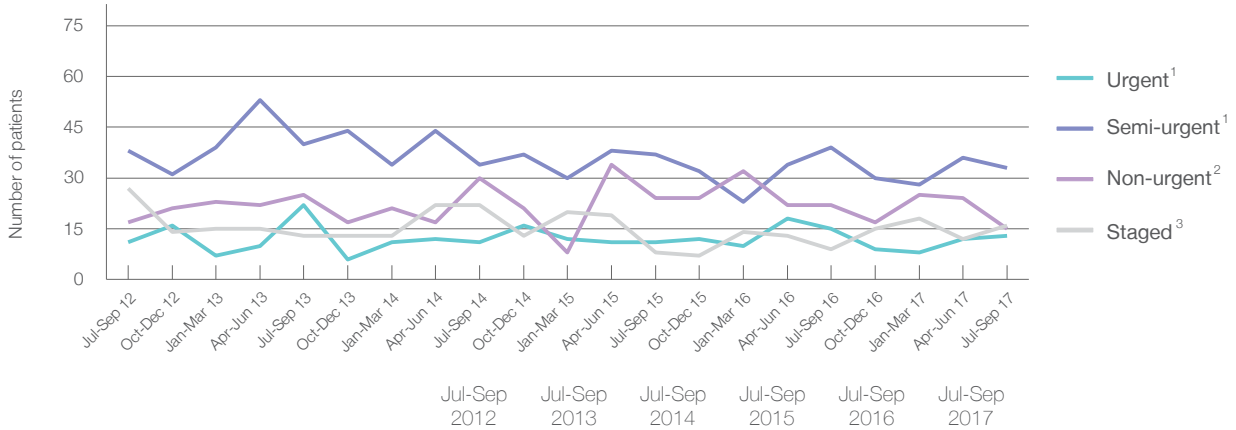



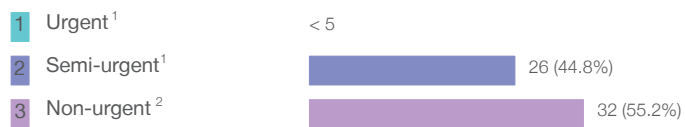
