

Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2013 to March 2018





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Wagga Wagga Rural Referral Hospital: Elective surgery performed January to March 2018




Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2013 to March 2018





Patients who received elective surgery by urgency category by quarter, January 2013 to March 2018




