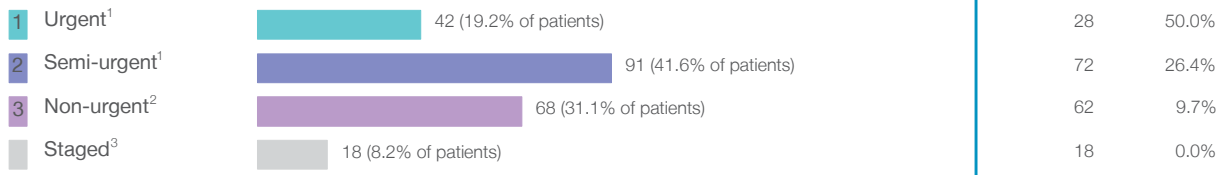

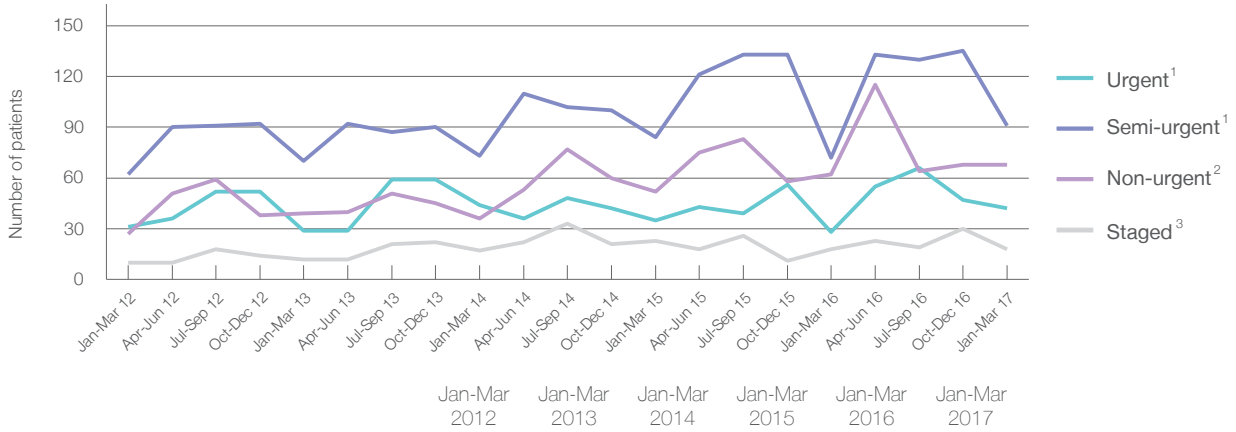

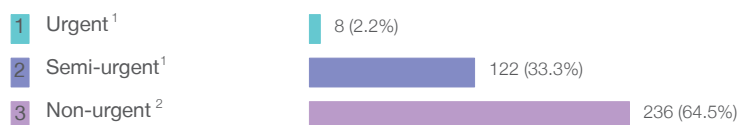

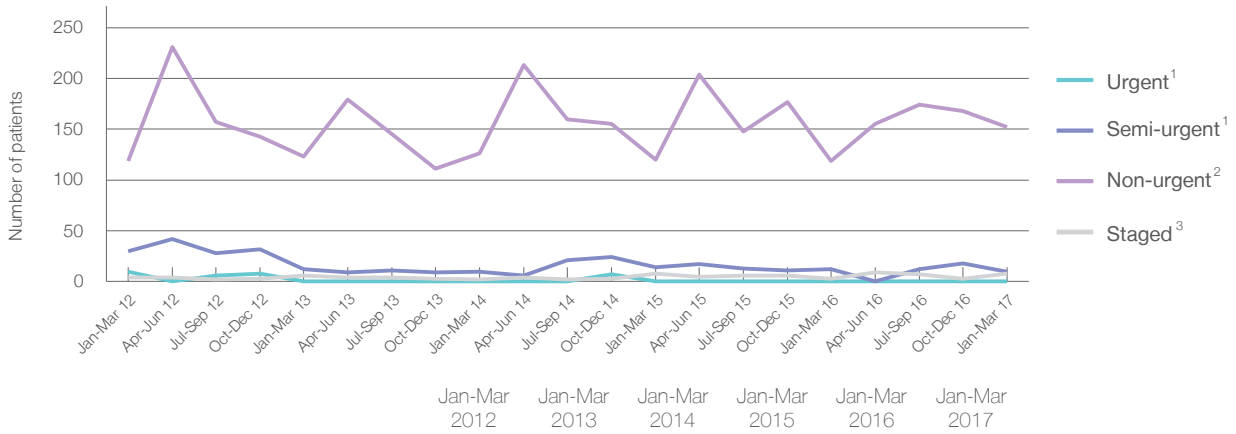

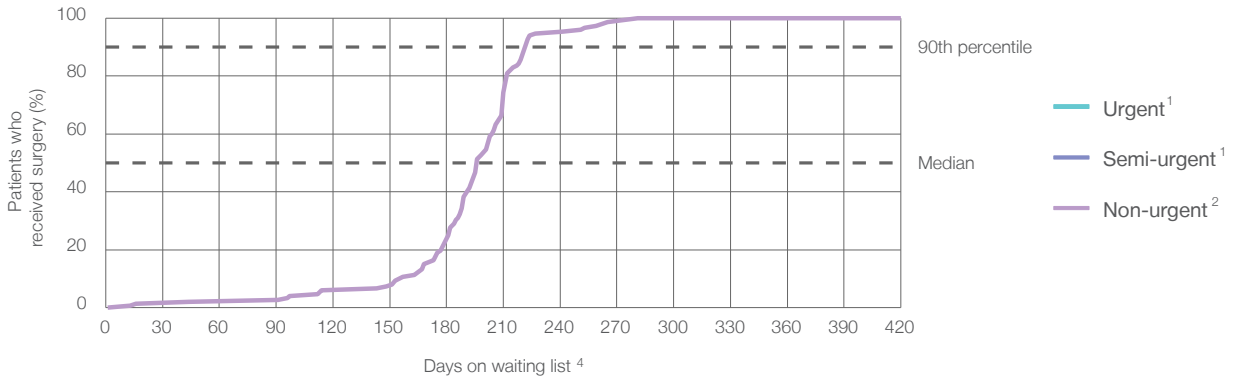

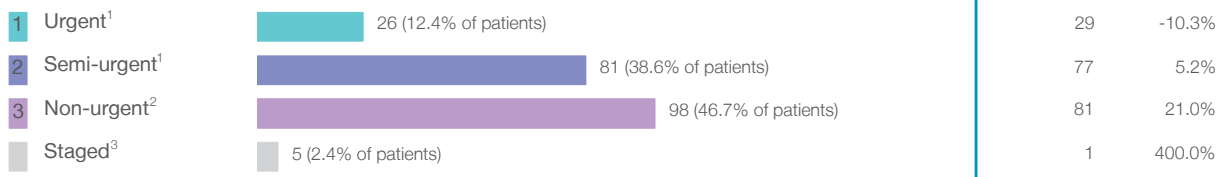

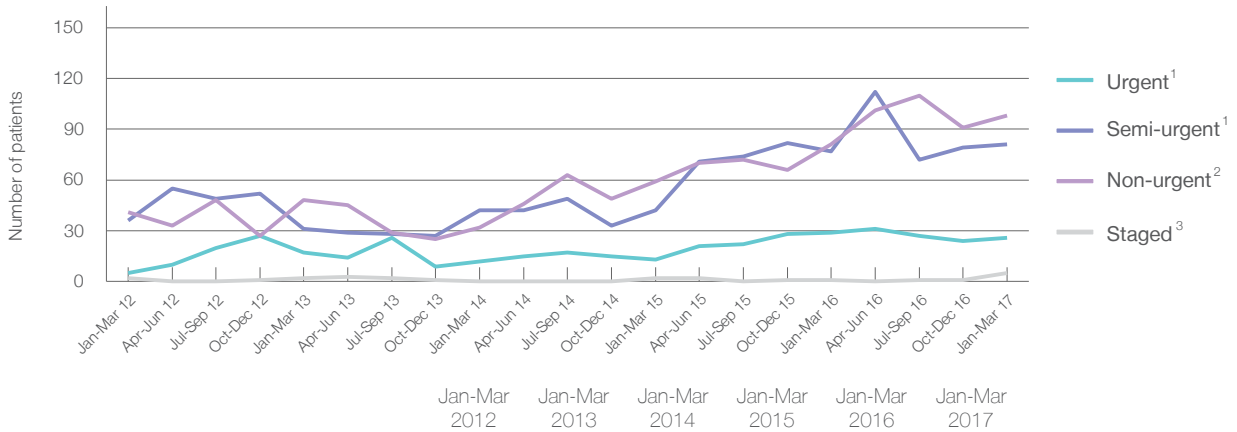

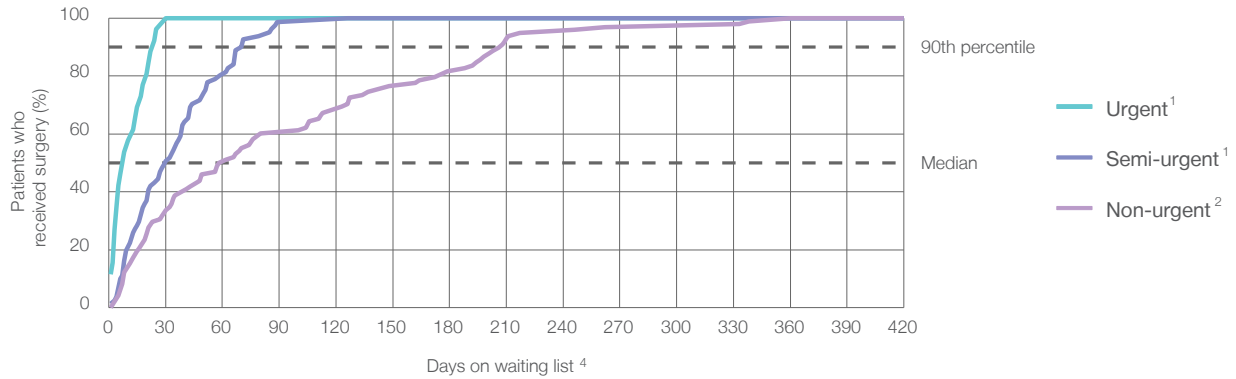

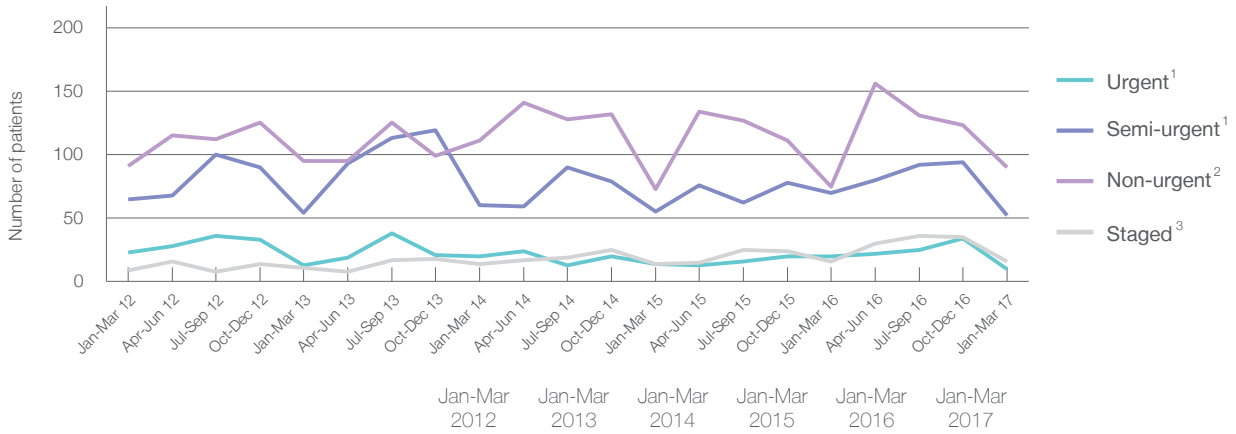

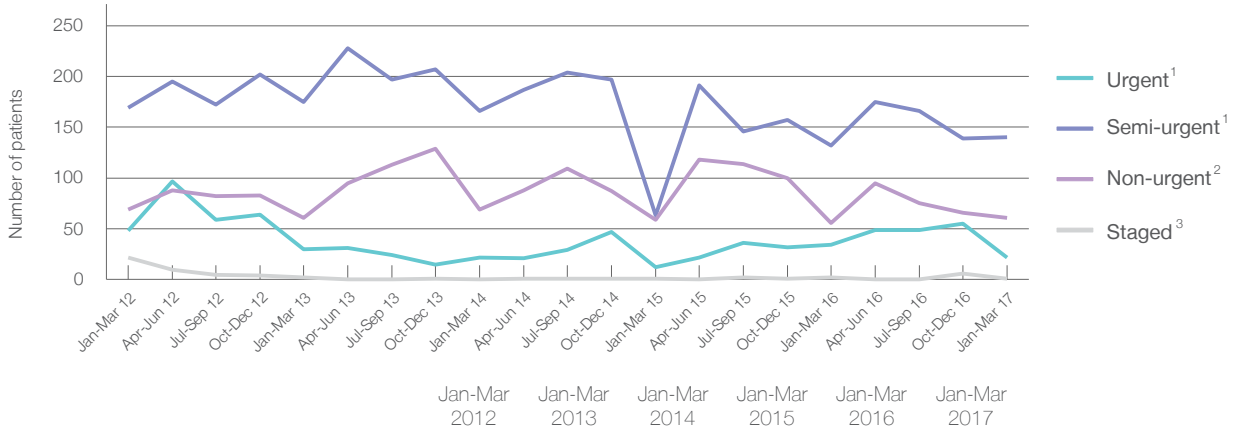

Percentage of patients who received elective surgery by waiting time (days)




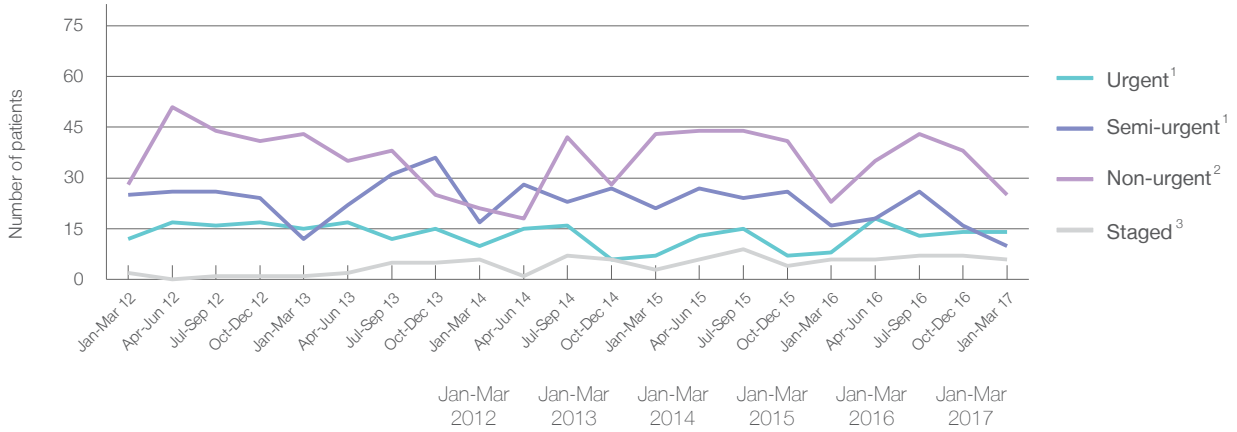

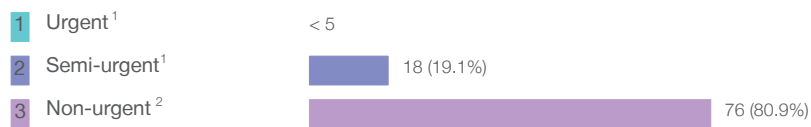

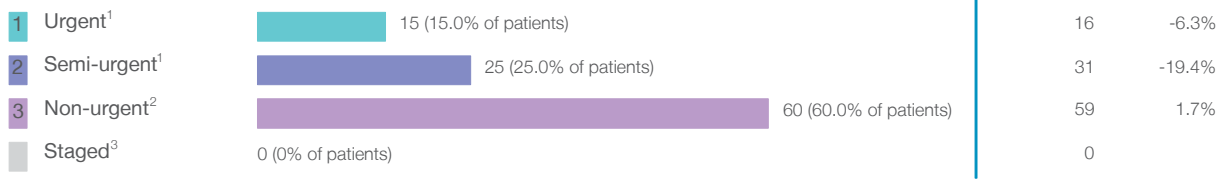

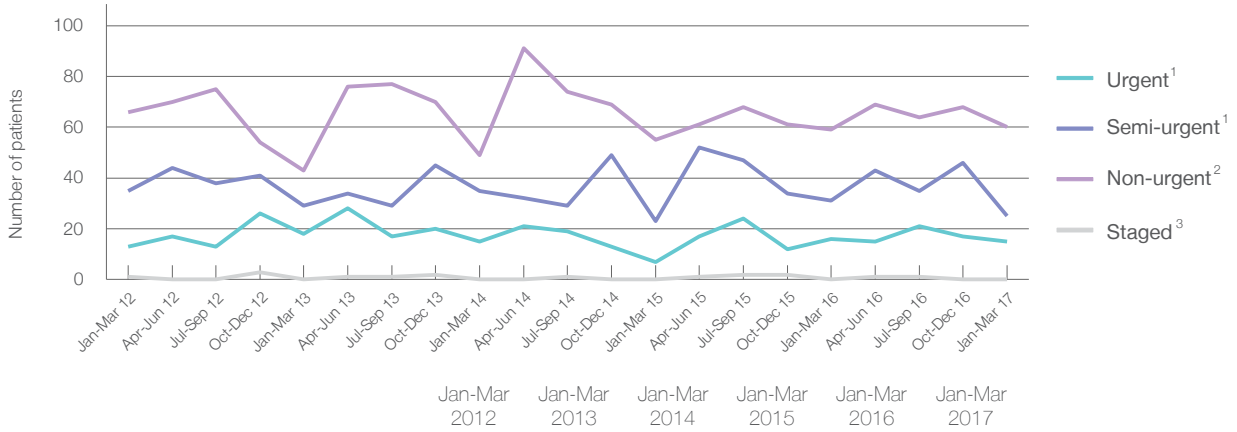

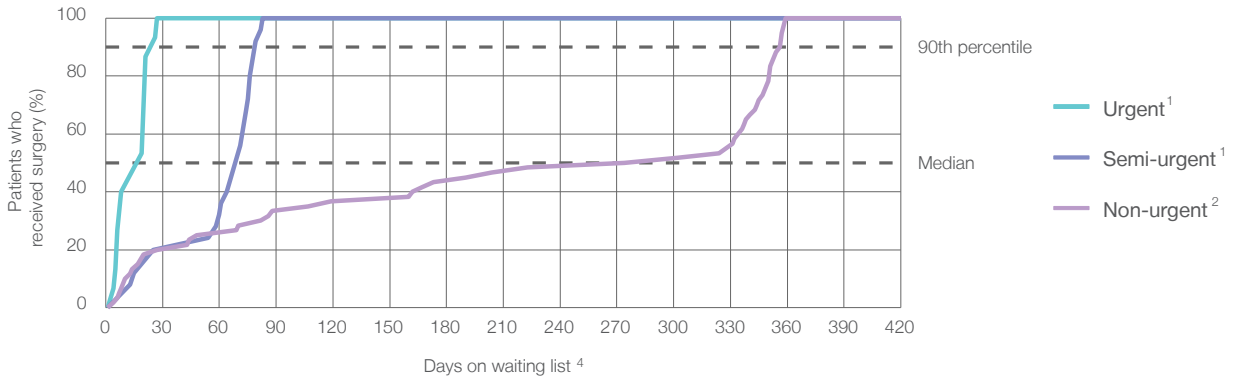

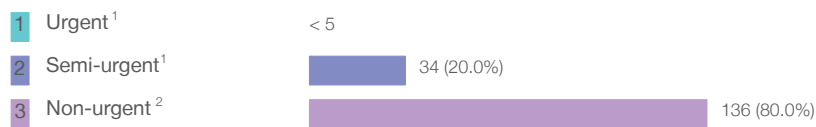

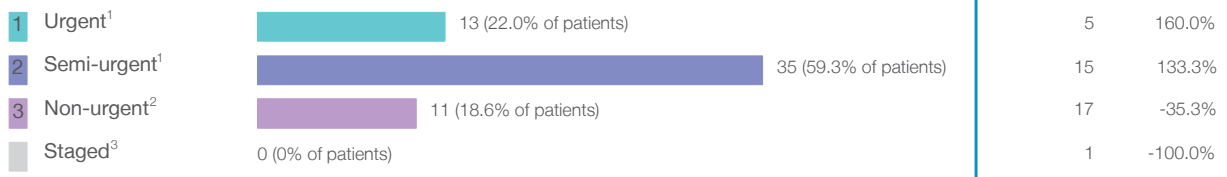

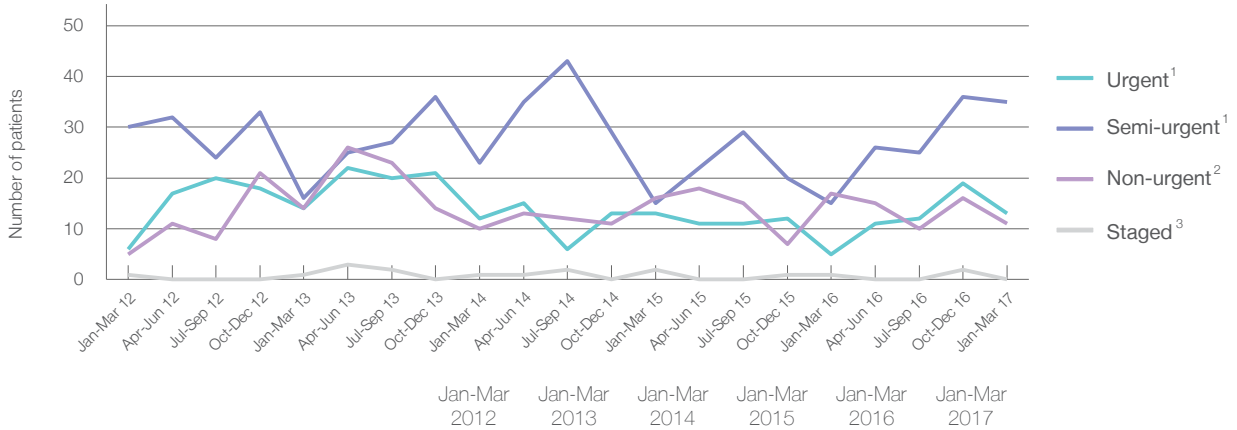

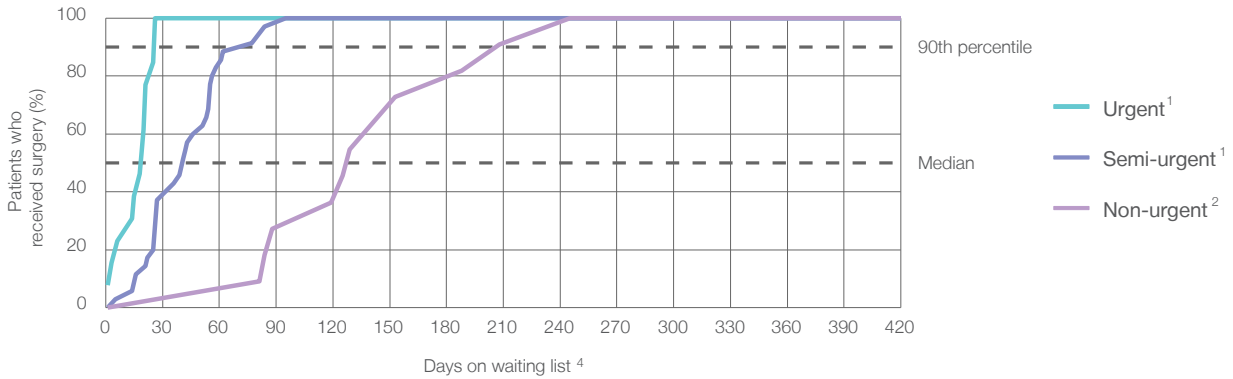

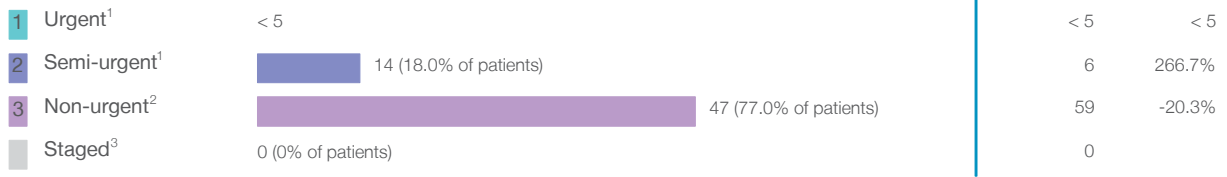

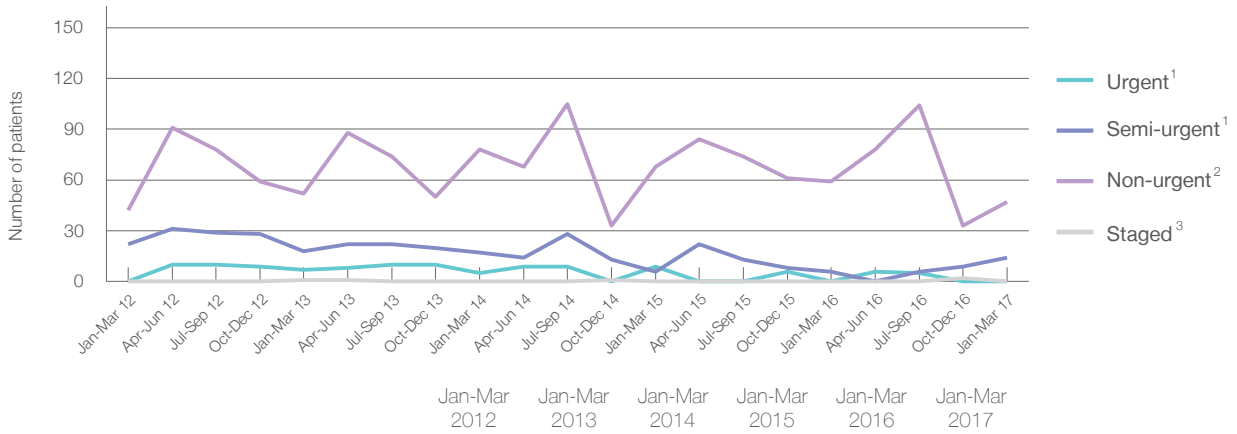

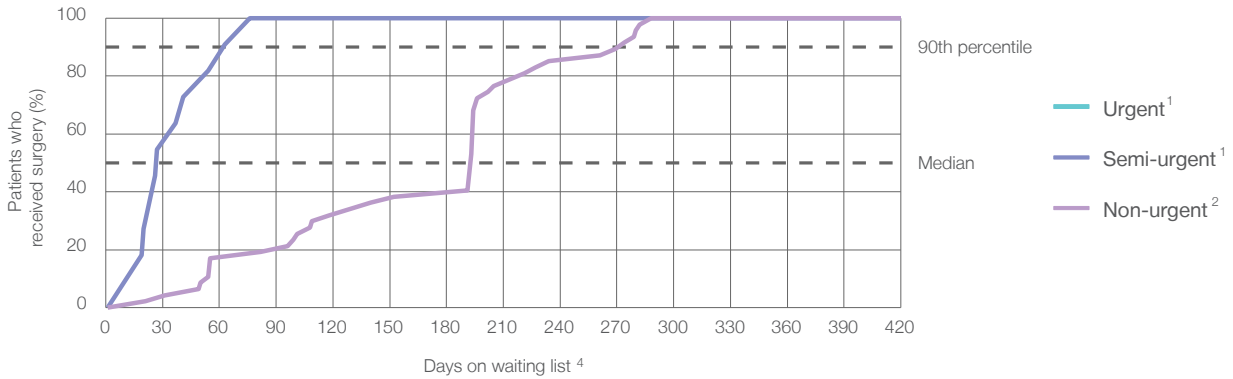

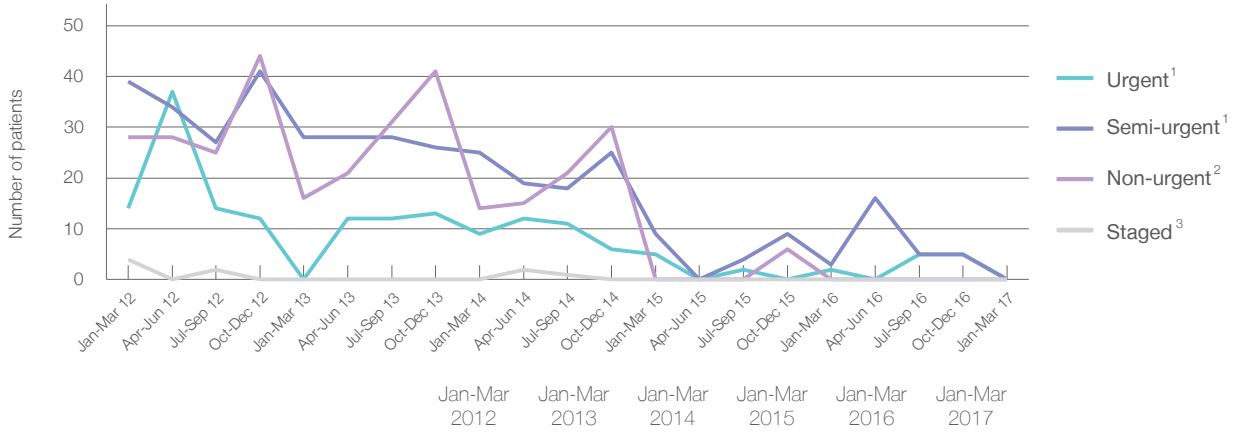

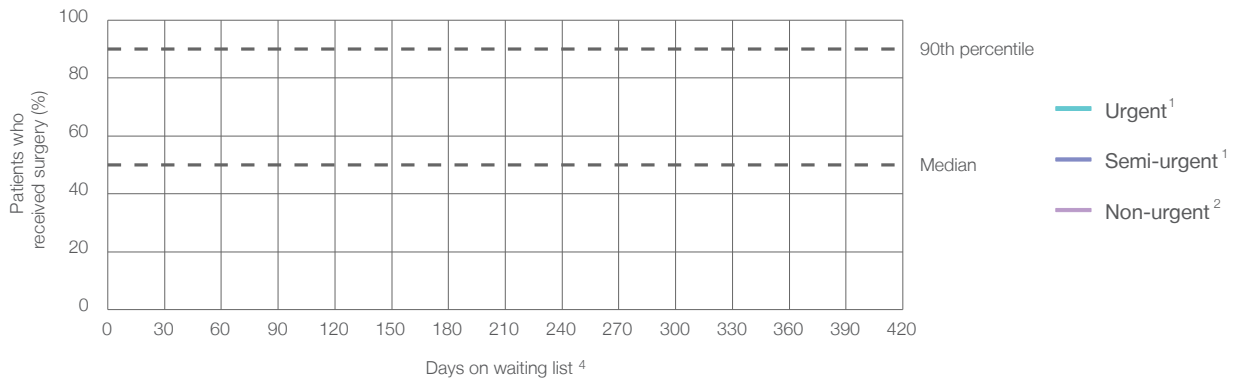

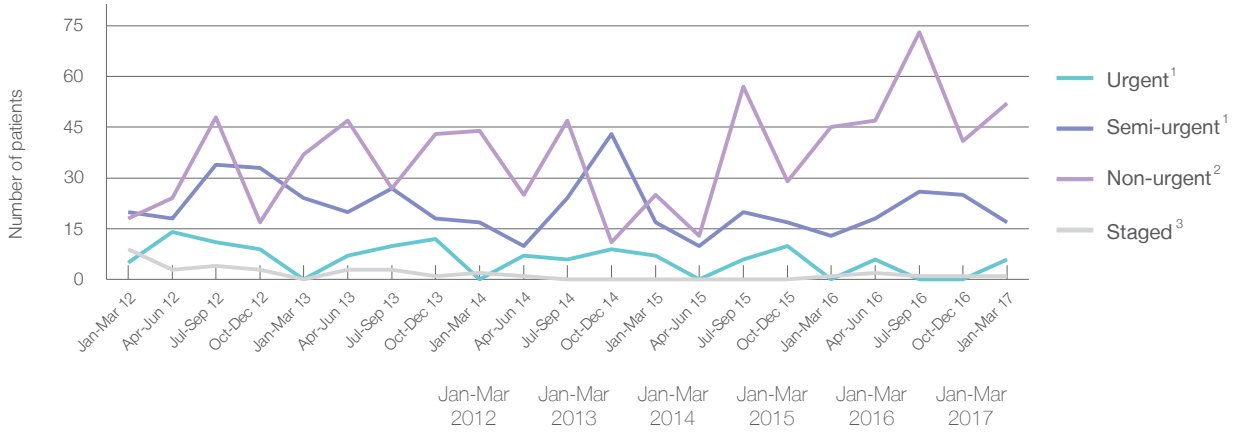

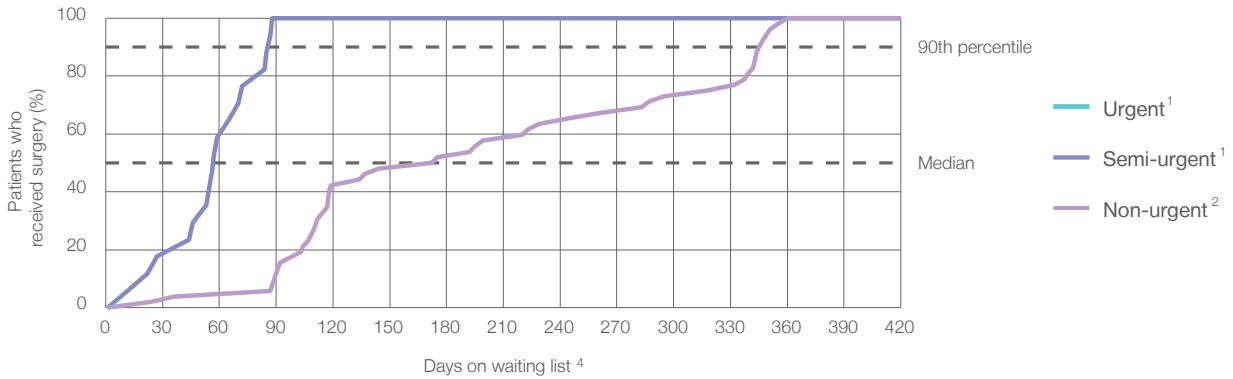

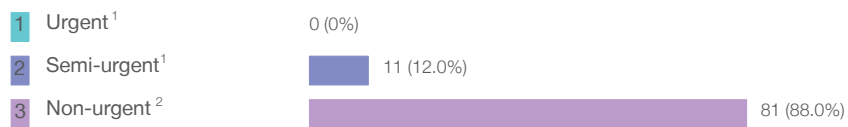

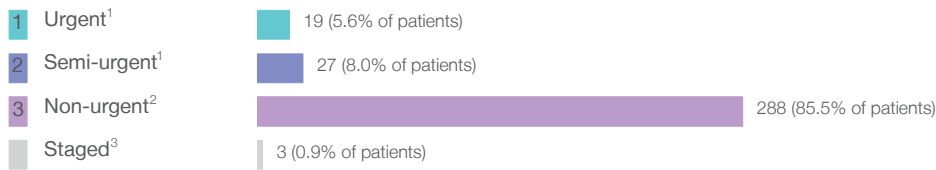

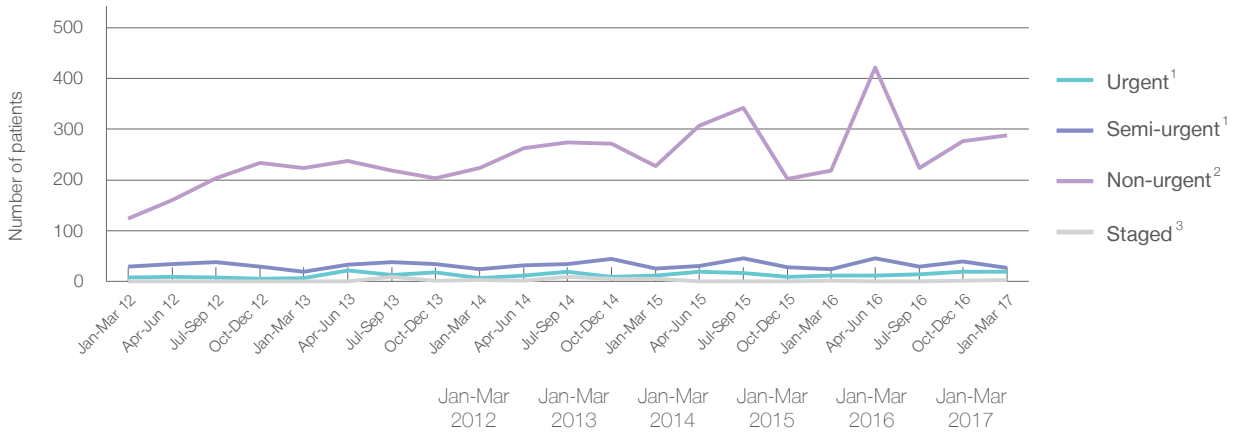

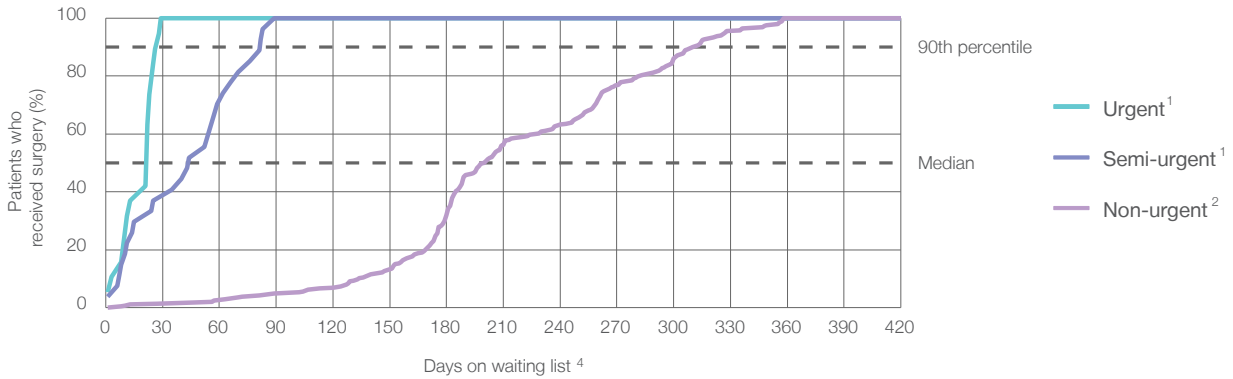

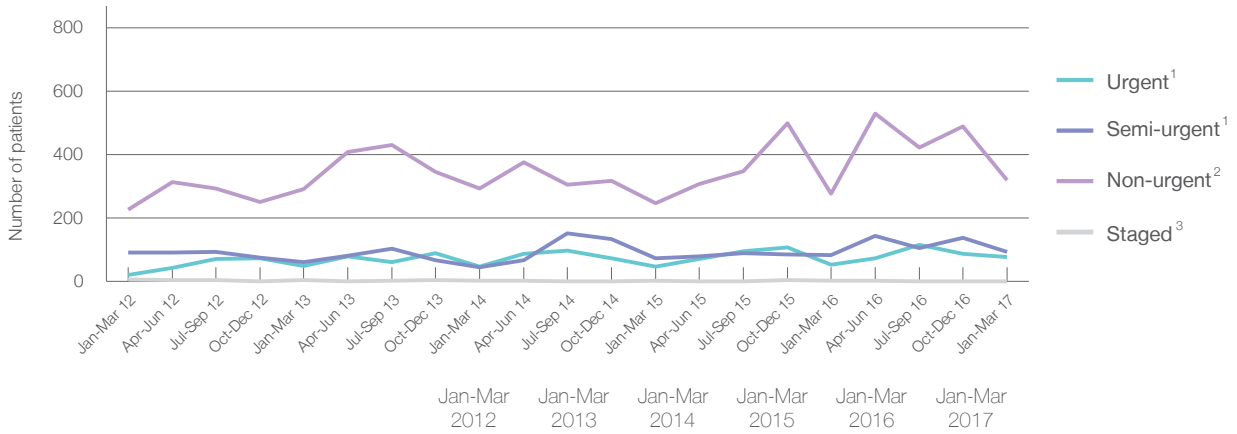

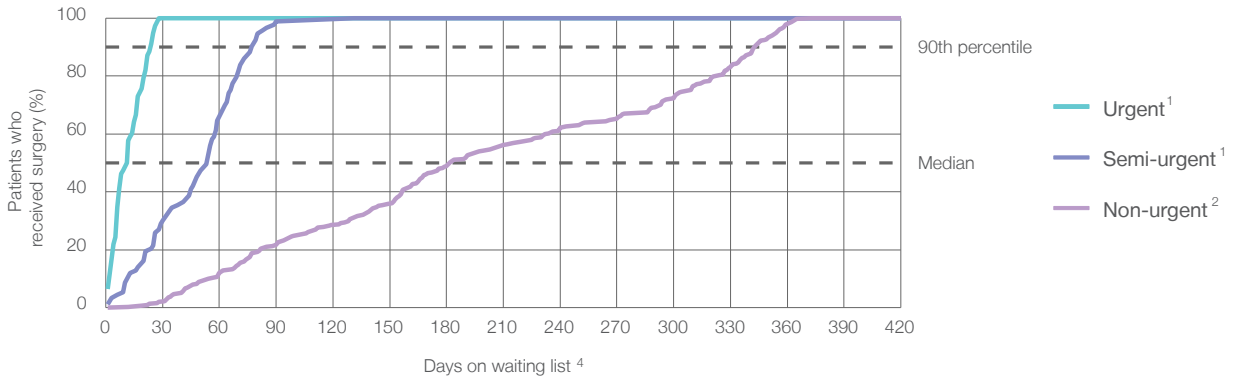

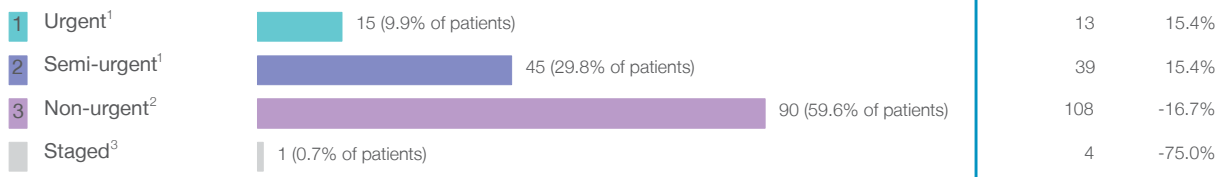

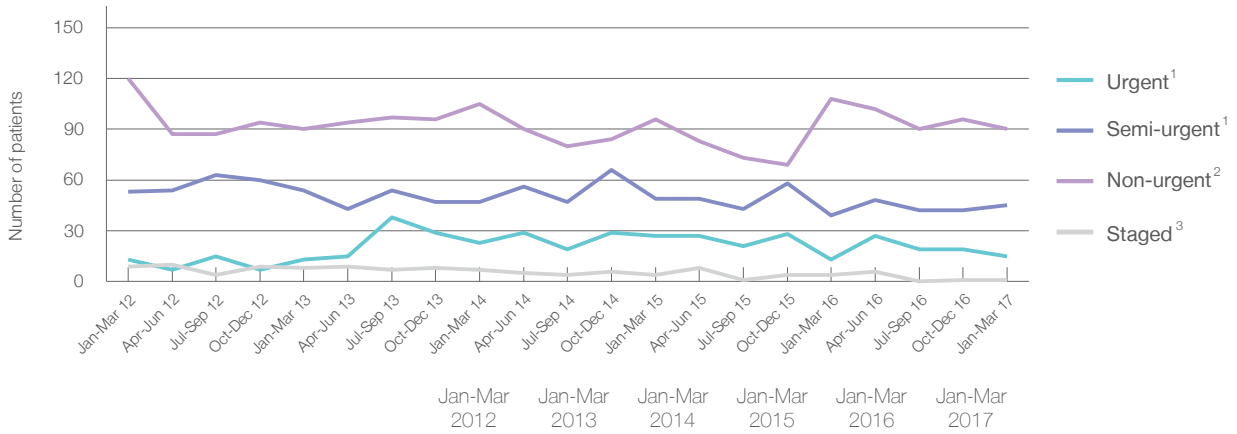

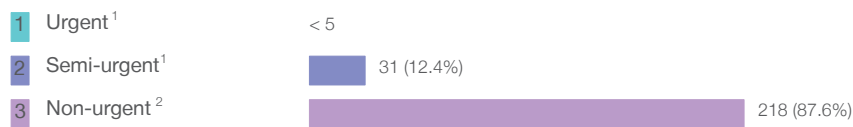

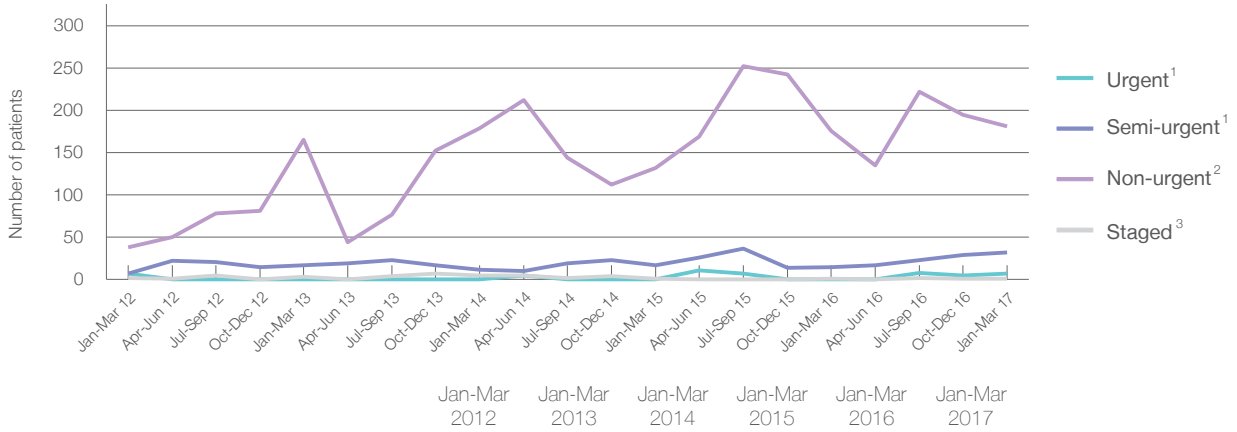

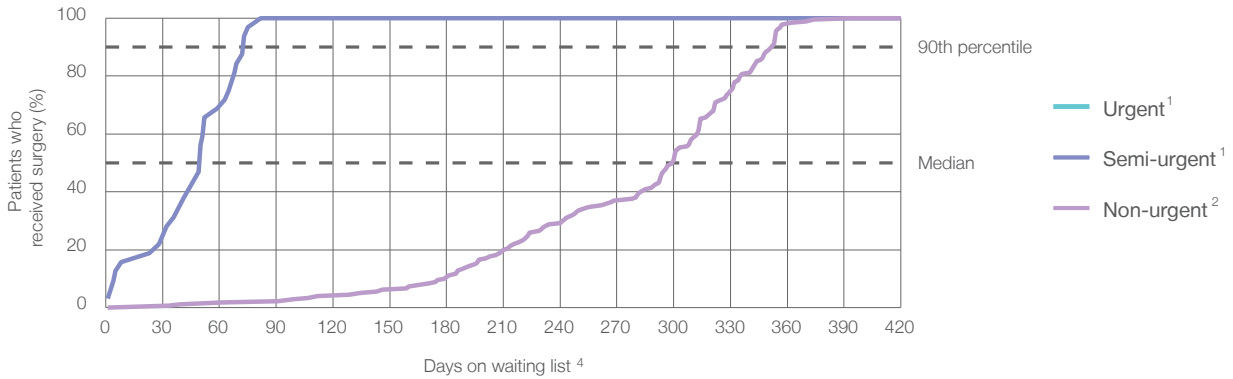

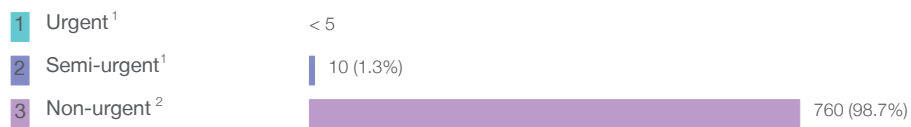

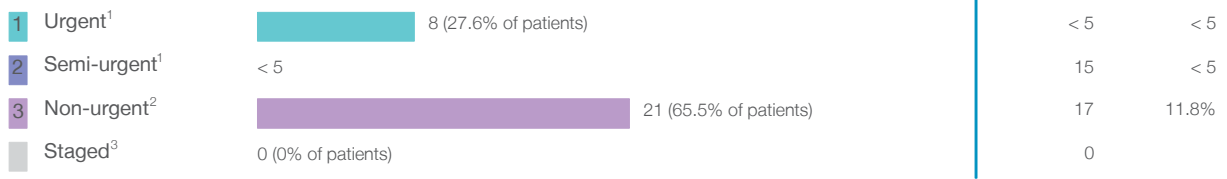

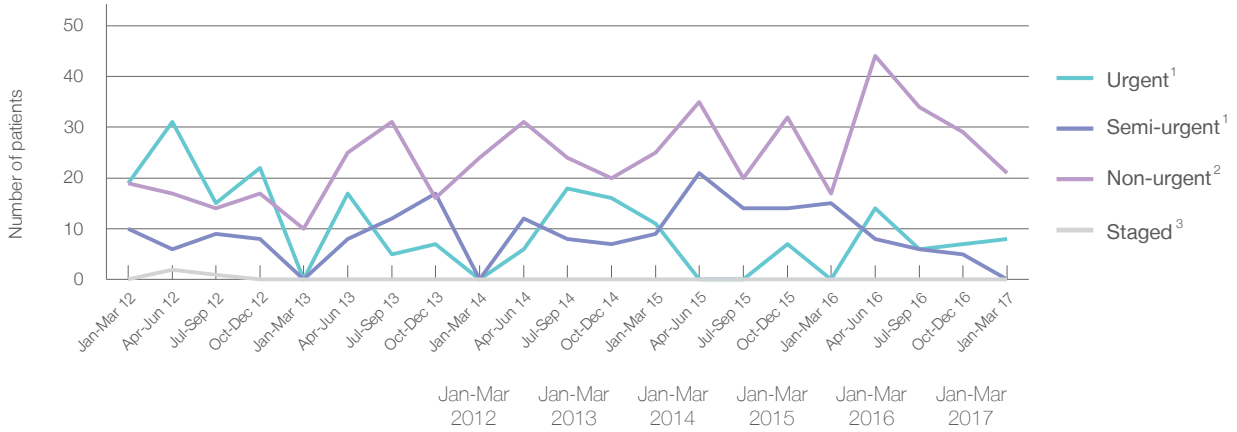

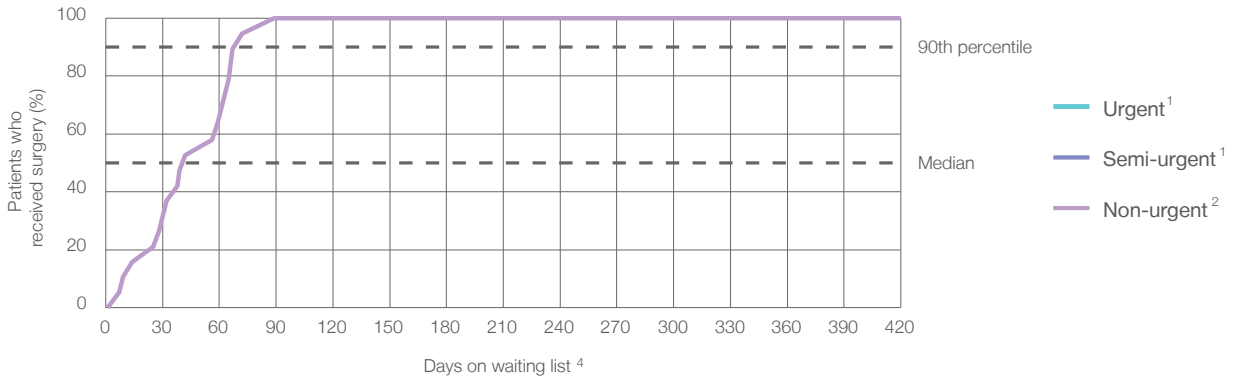

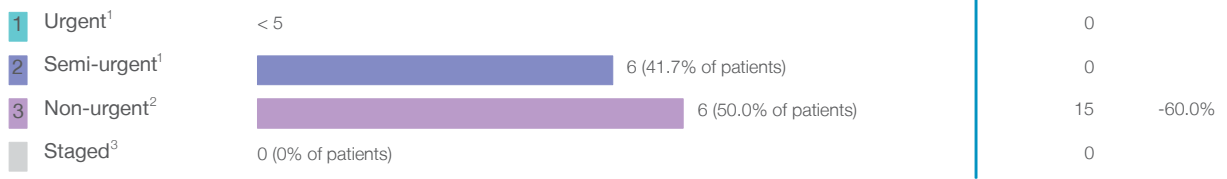

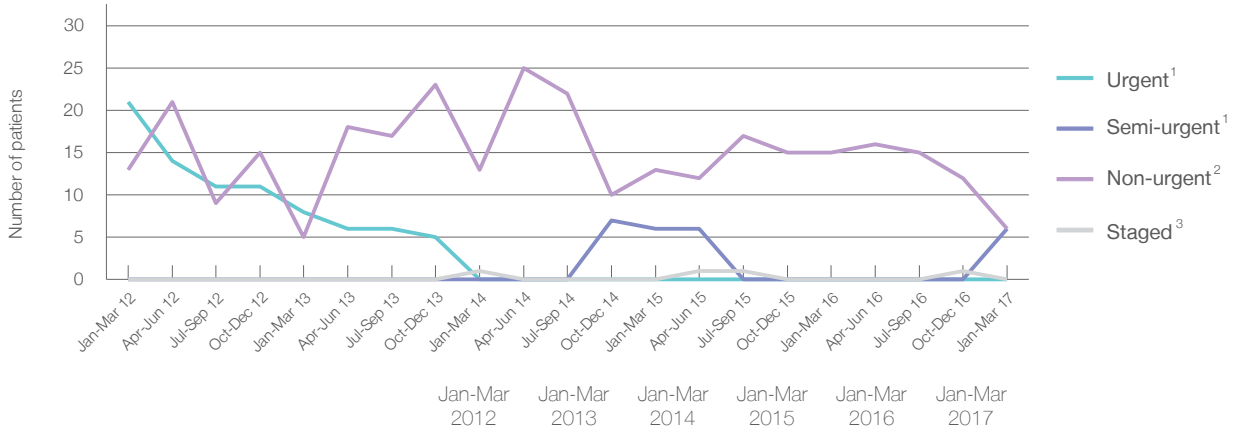

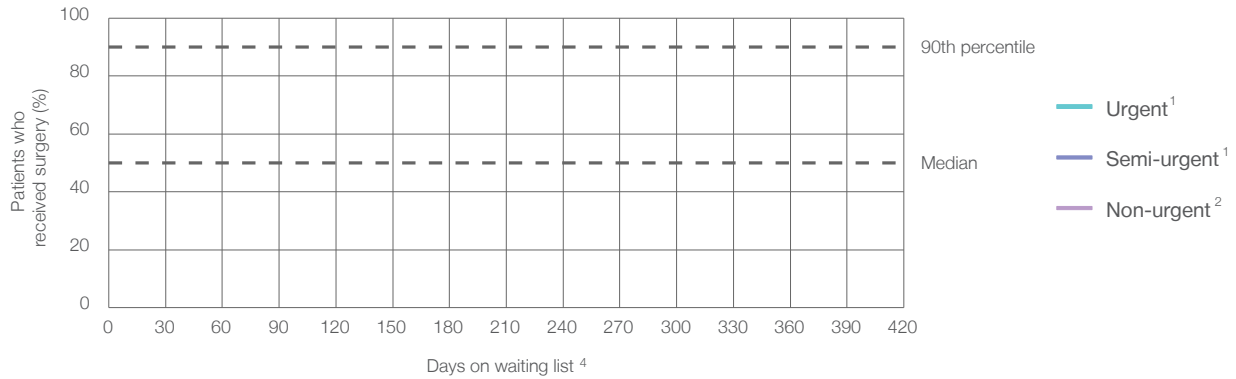

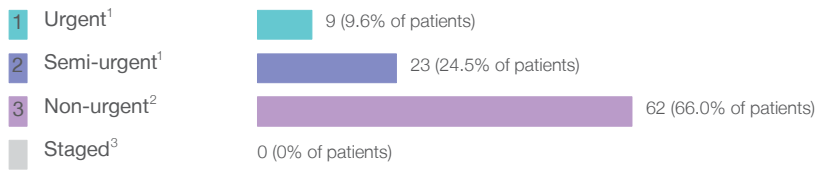

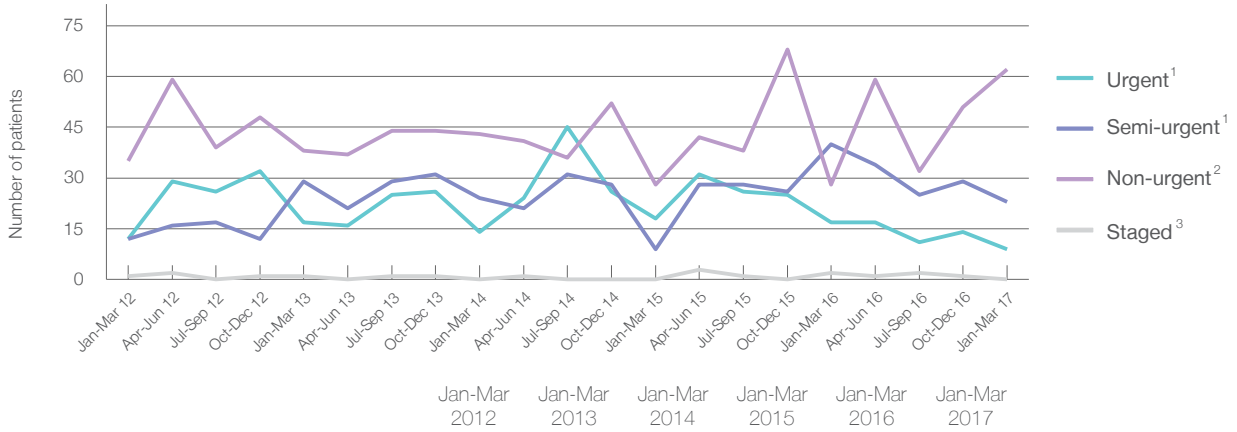

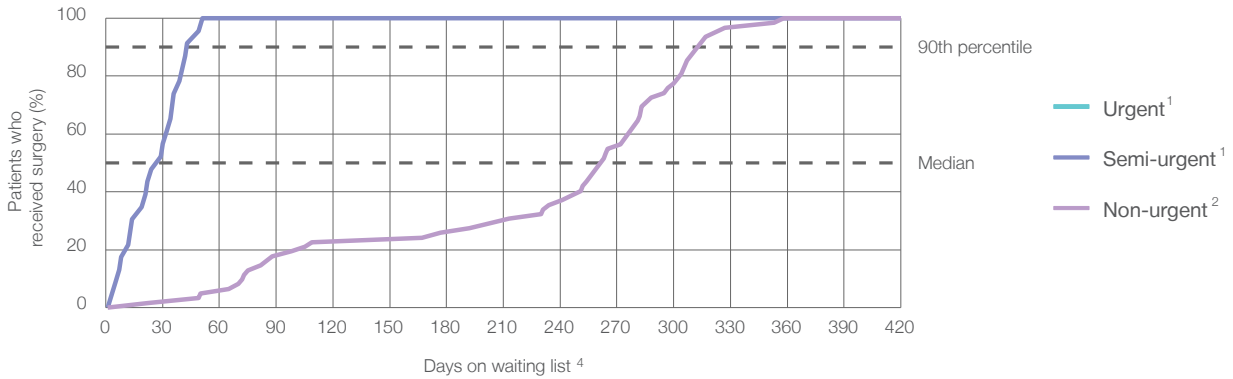

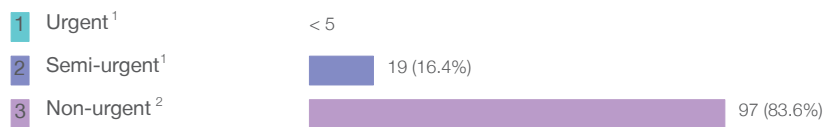

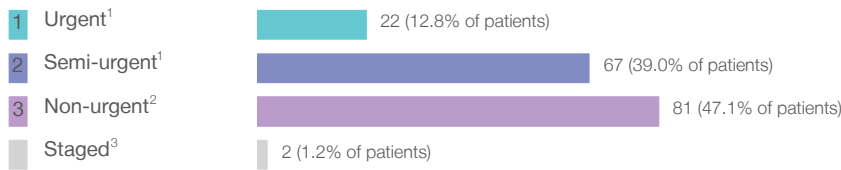

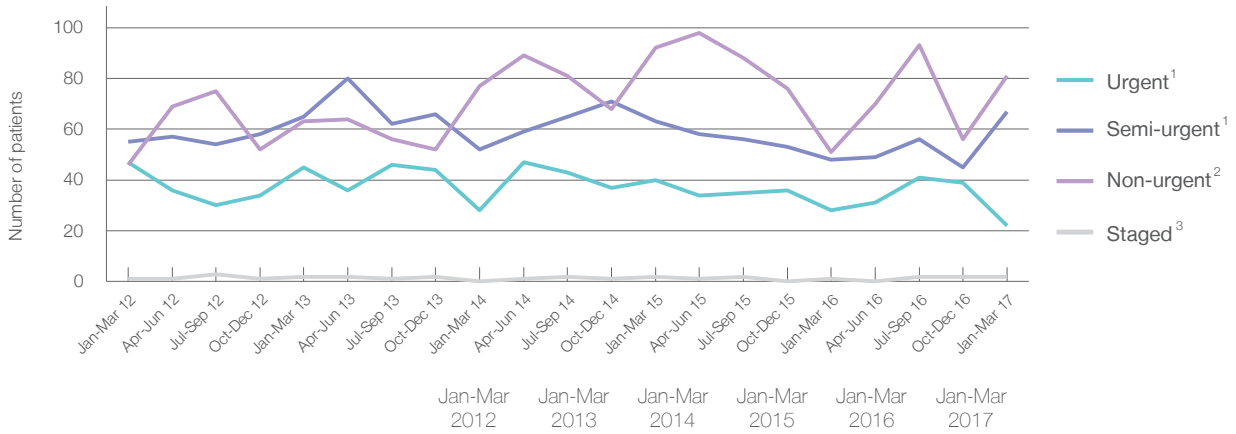

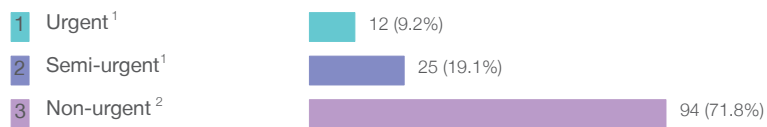

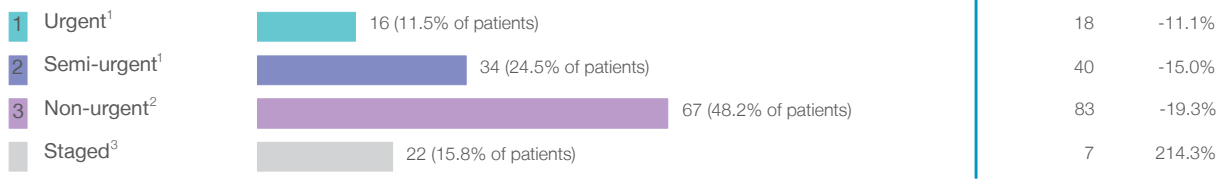

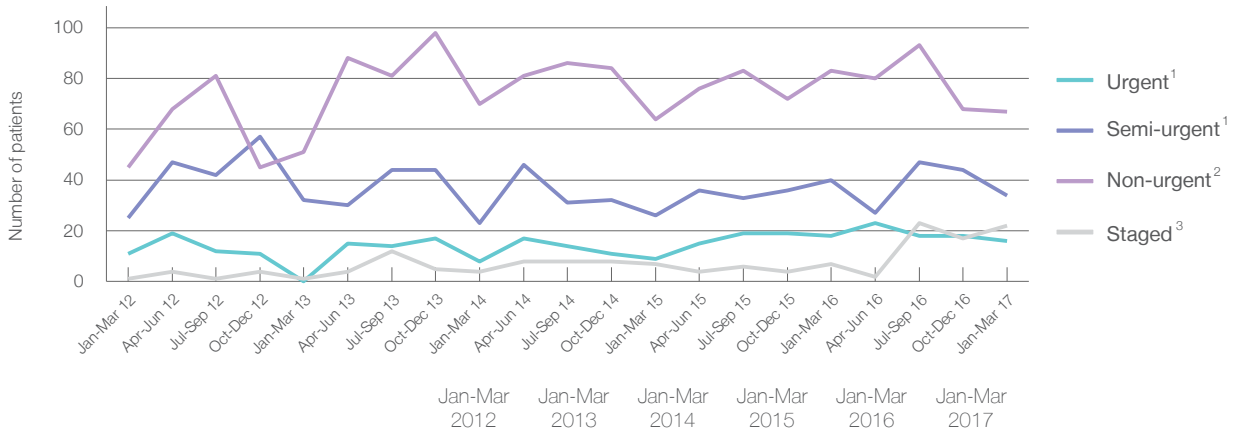

Mudgee District Hospital: Time waited to receive elective surgery

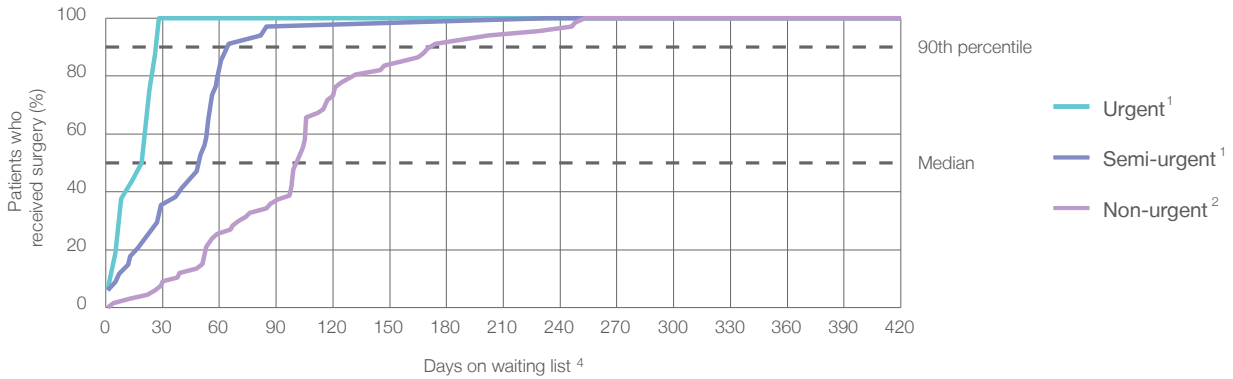



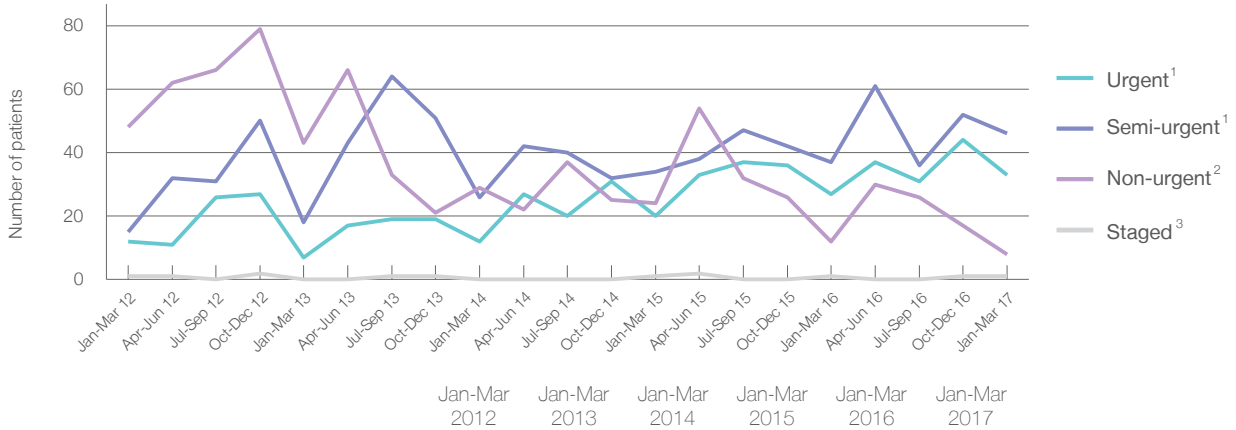

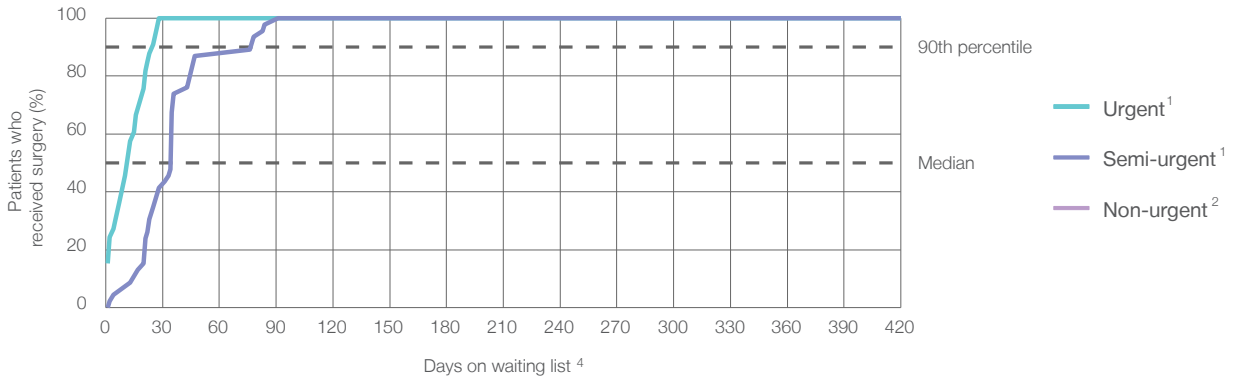

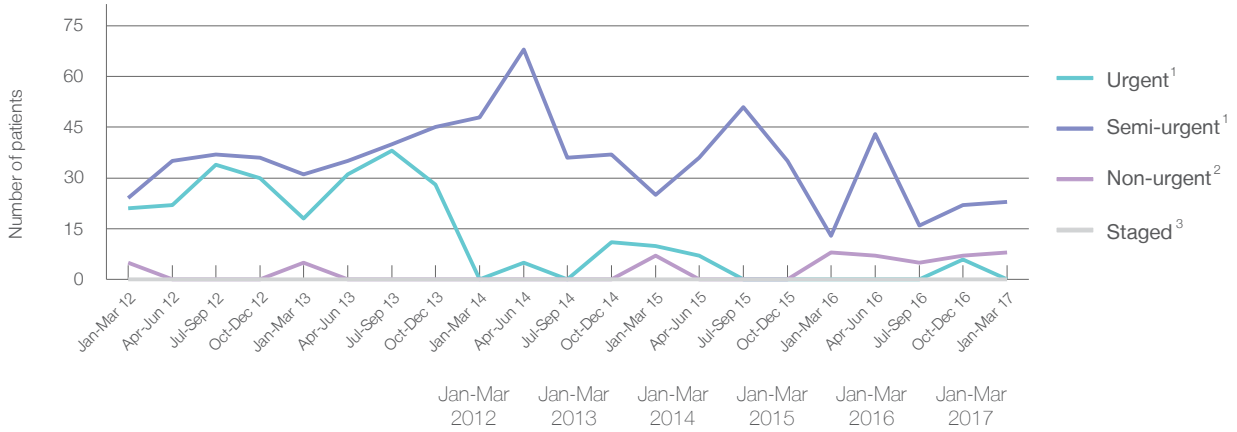

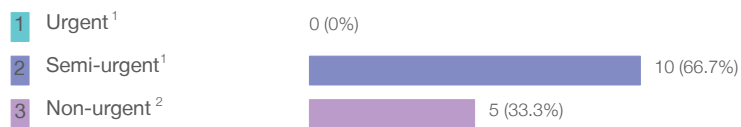

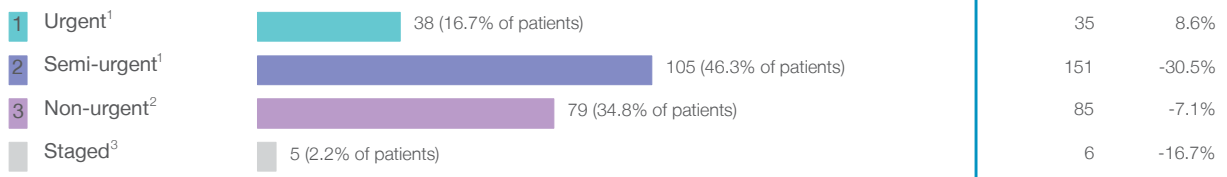

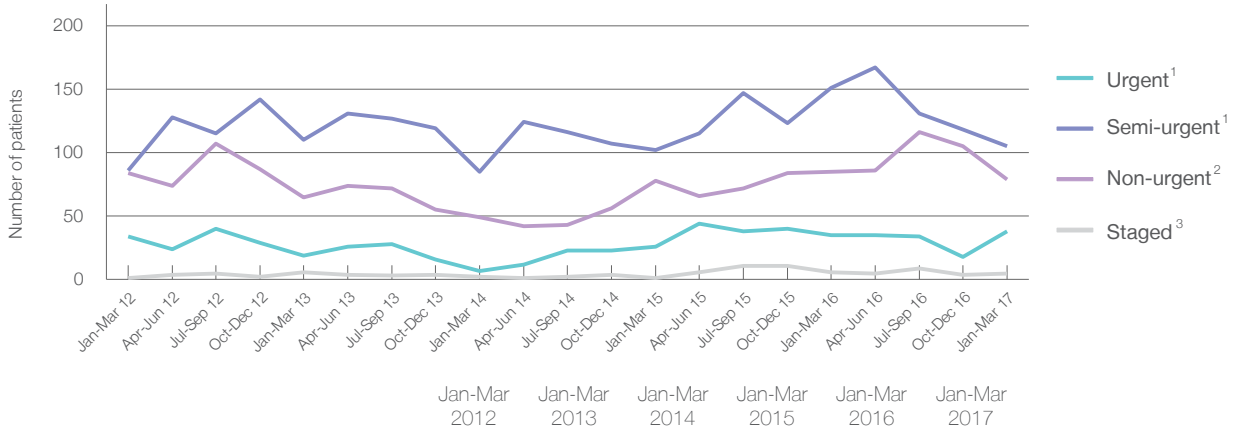

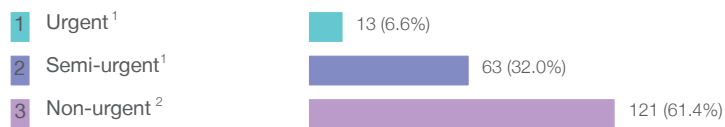

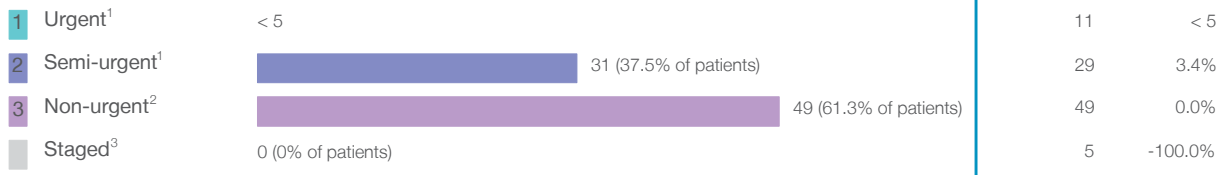

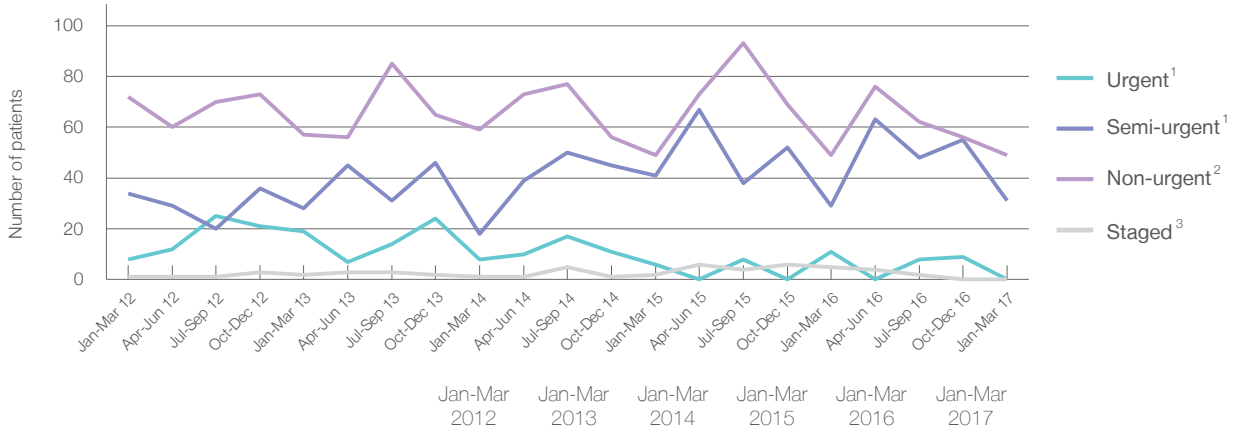

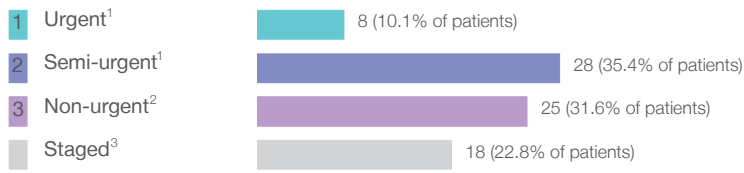

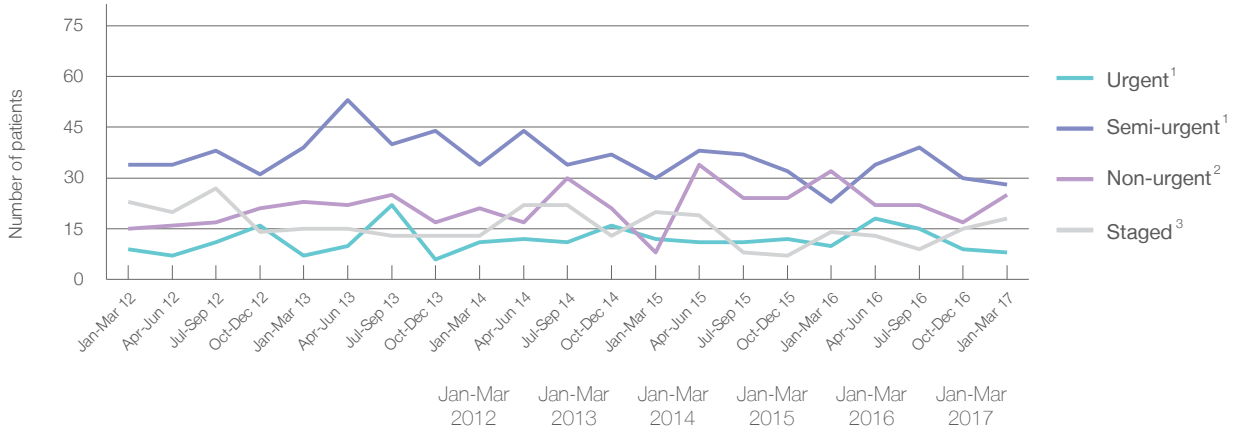

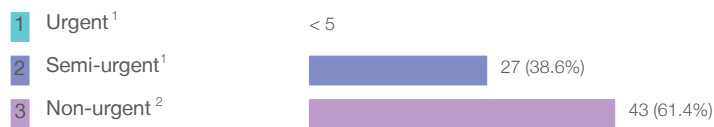
