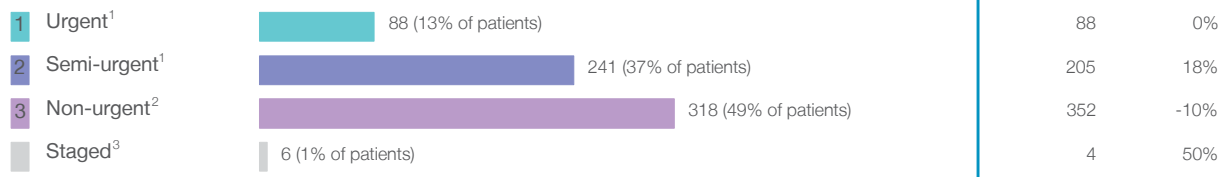

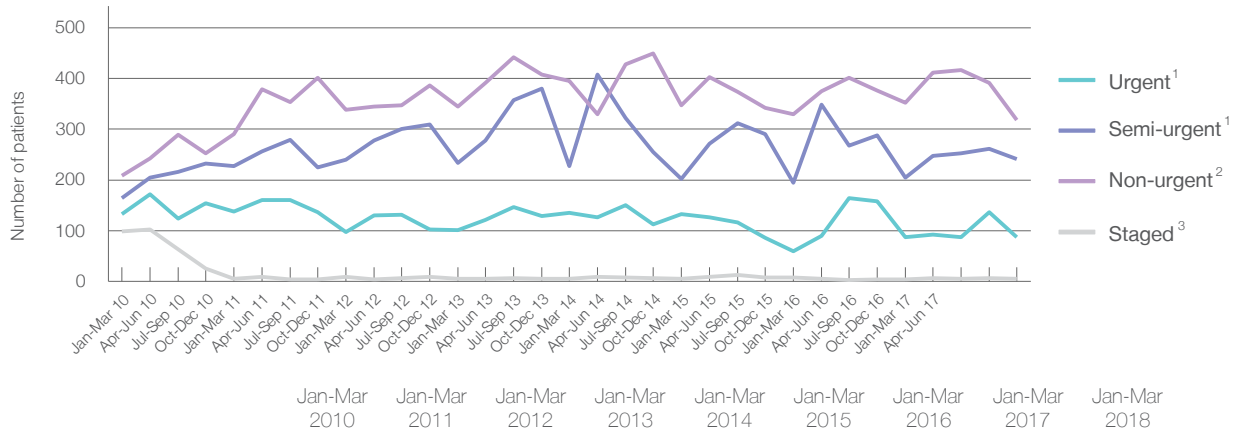

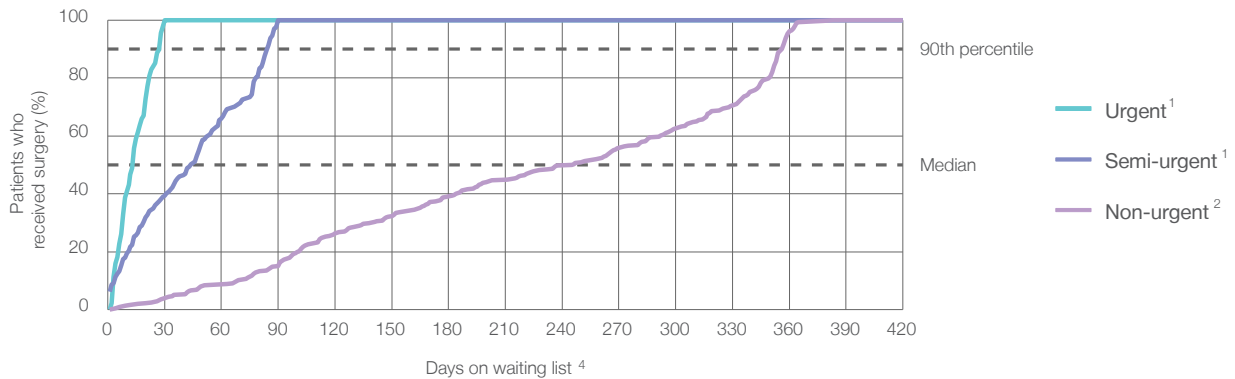

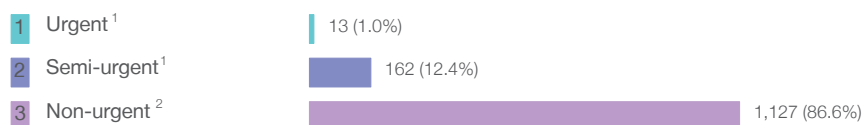

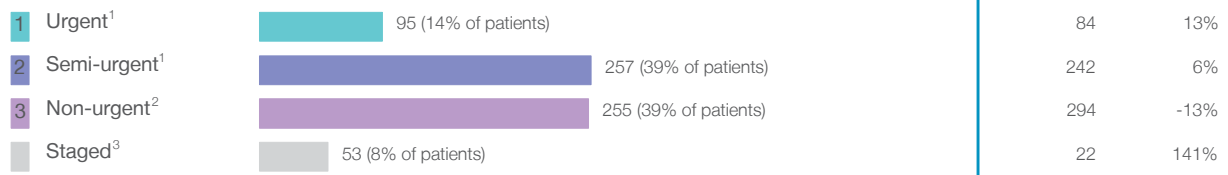

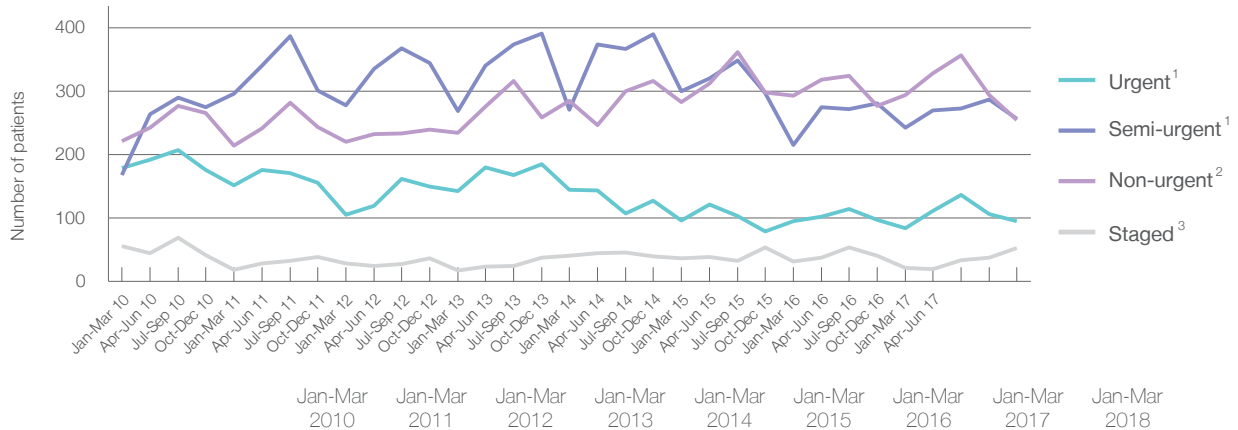

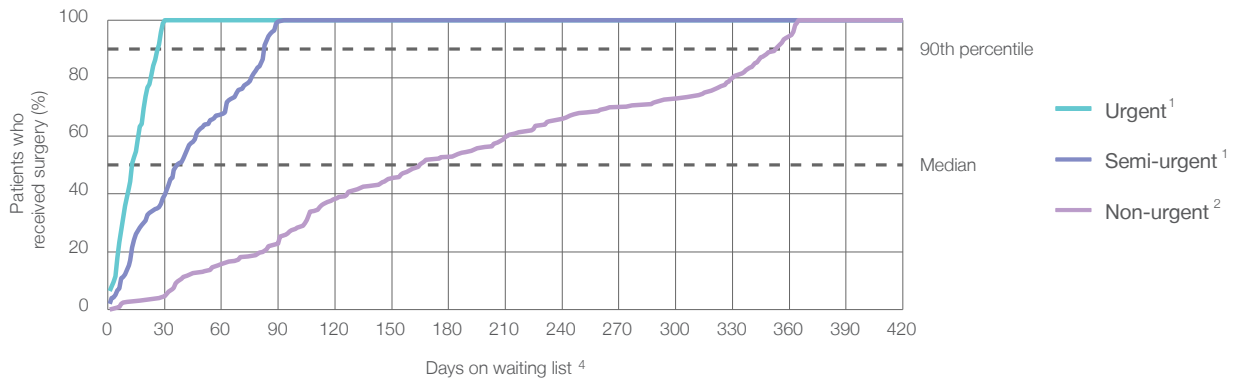

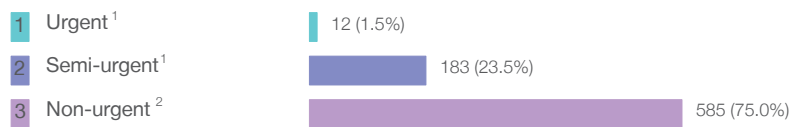

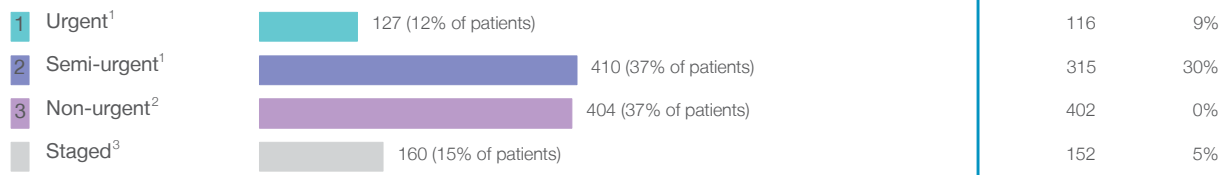

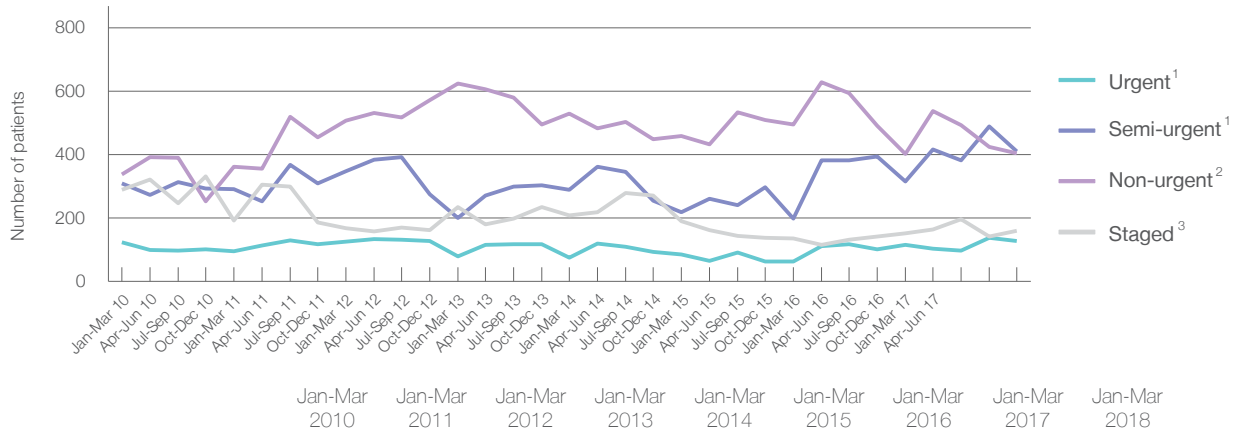

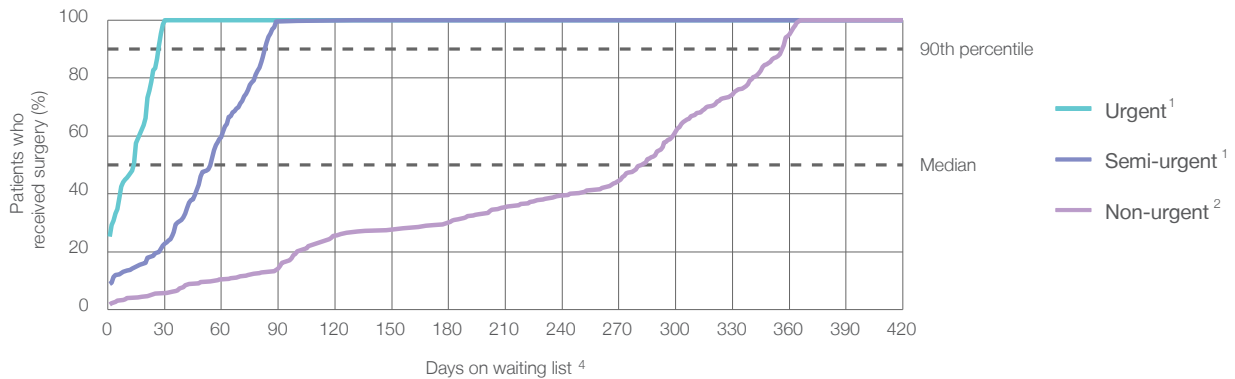

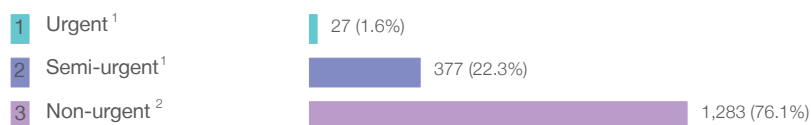

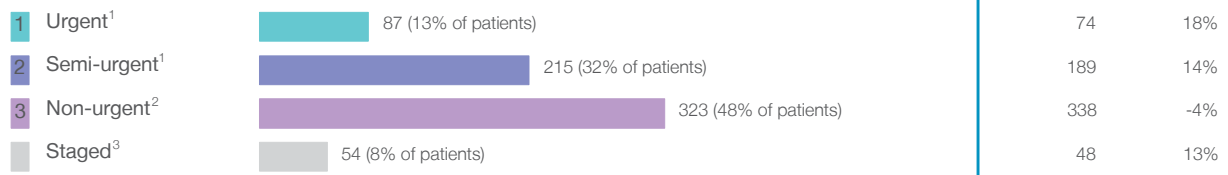

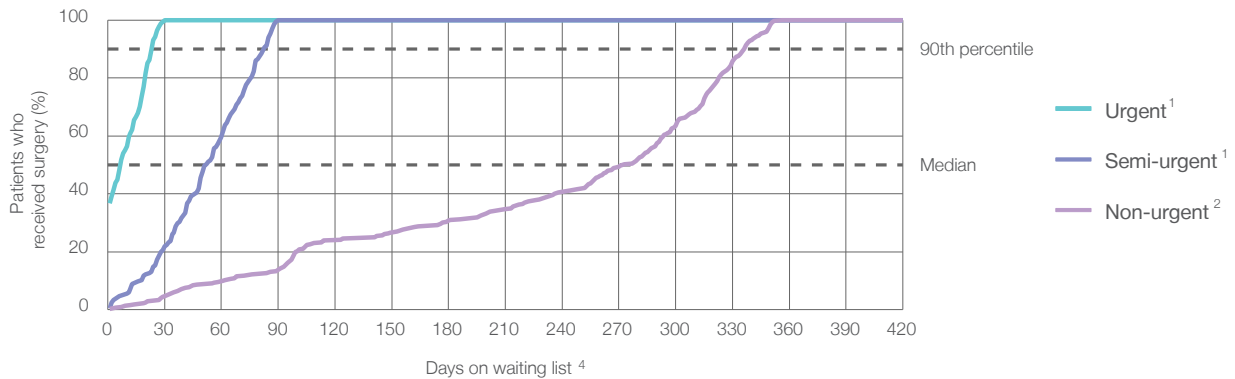

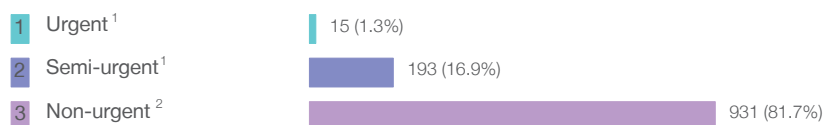

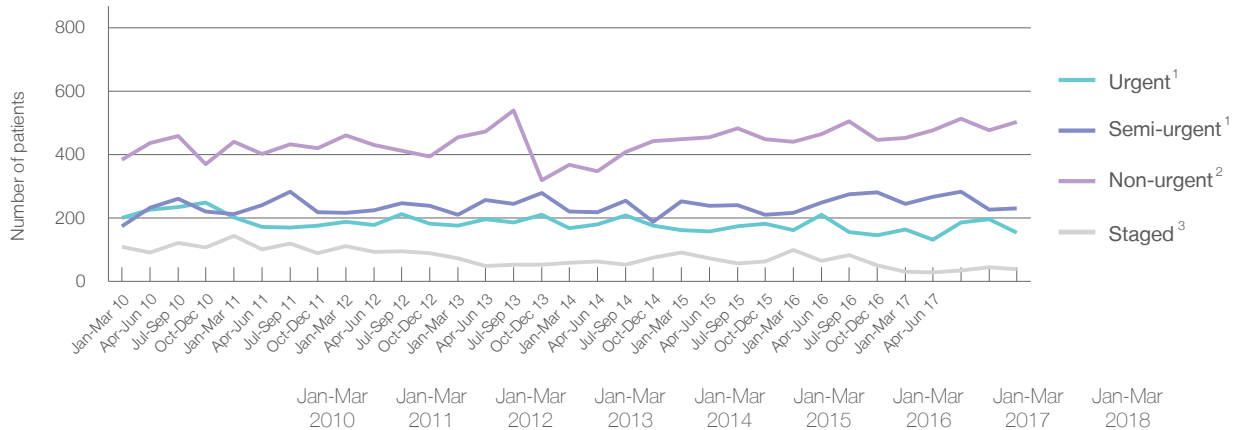

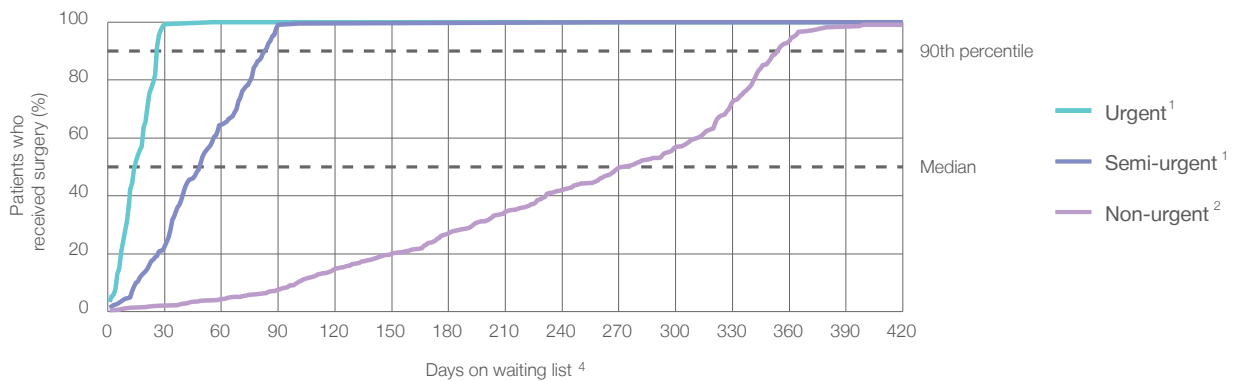

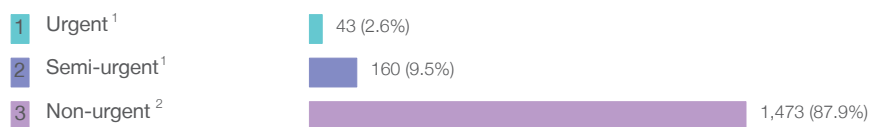

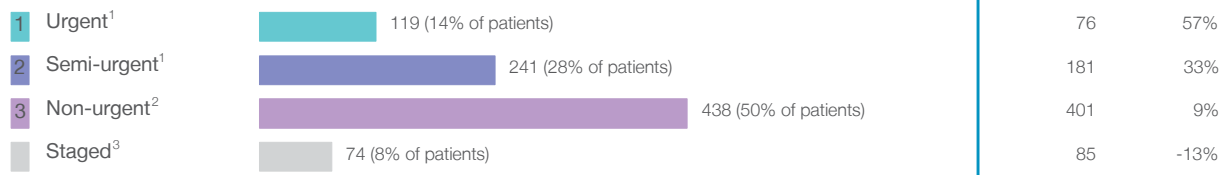

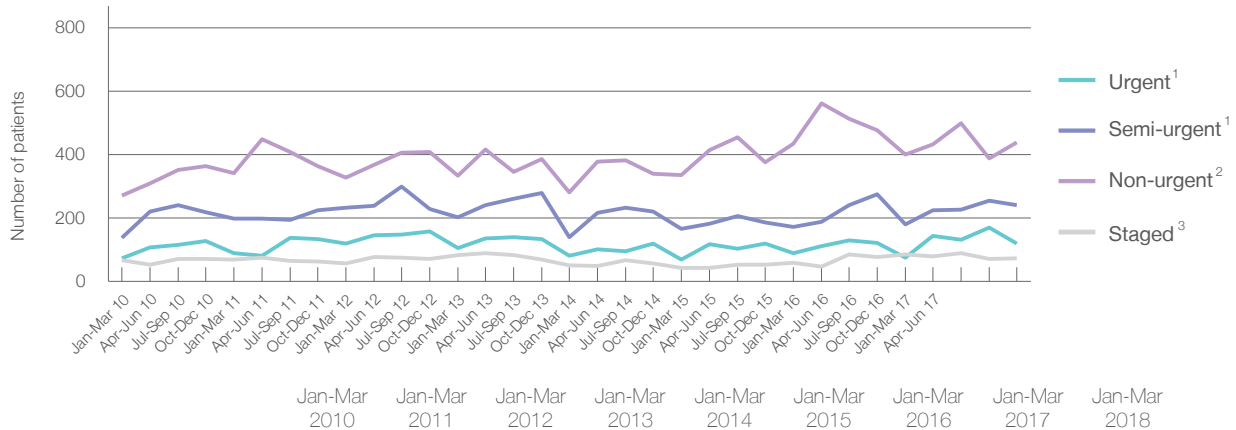

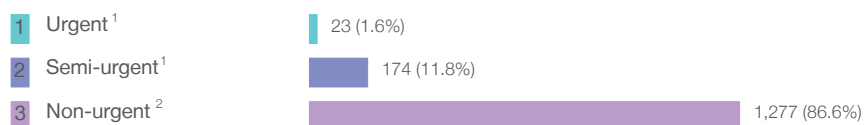

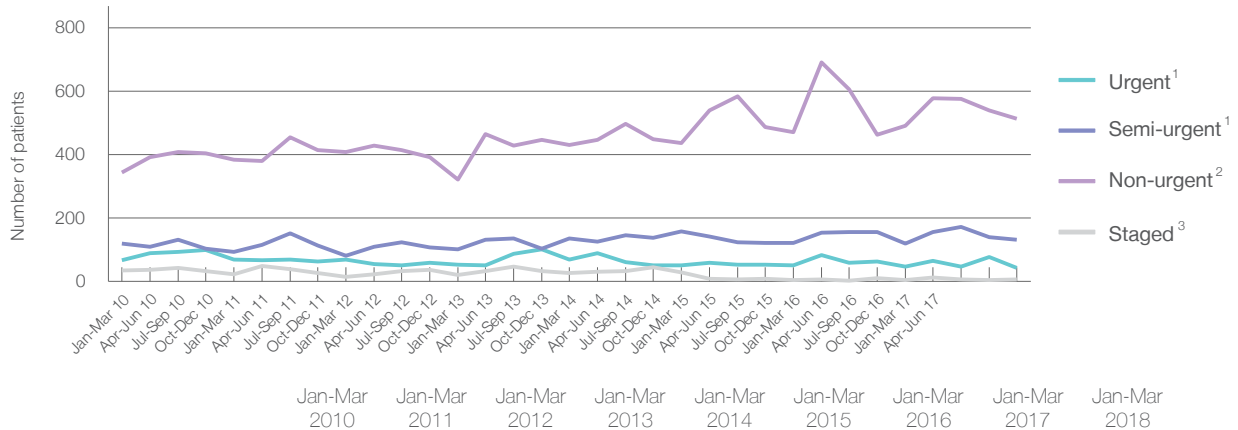

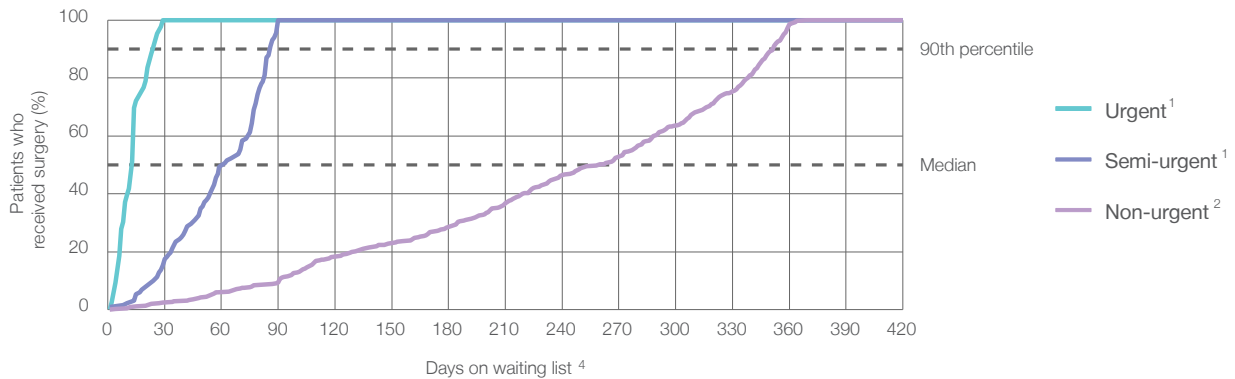

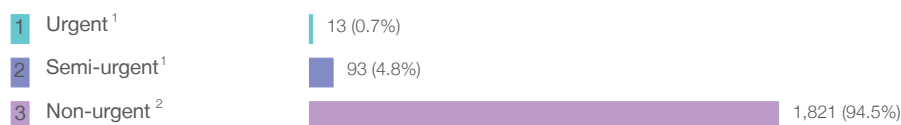

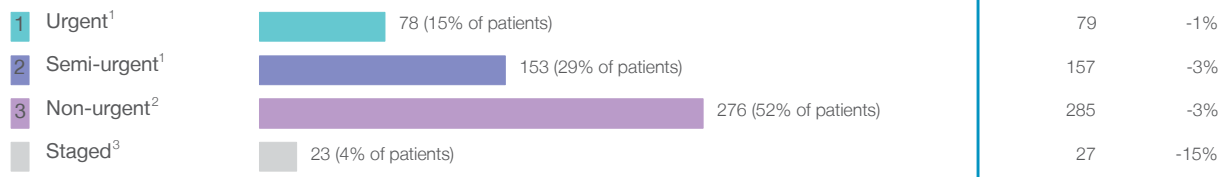

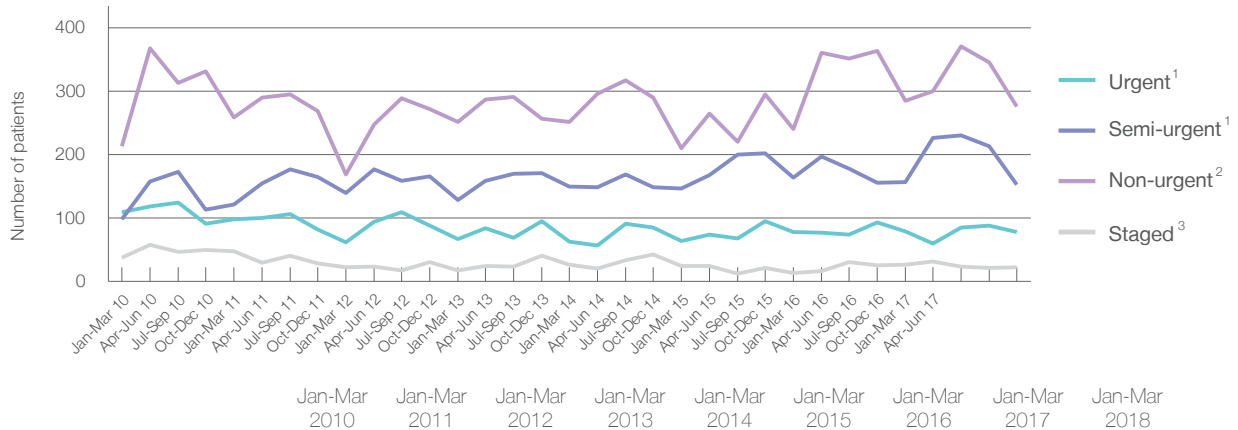

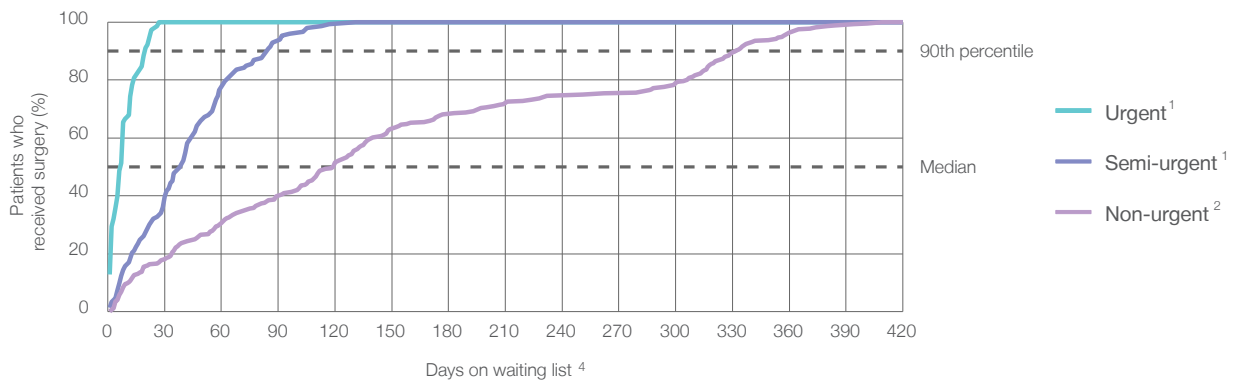

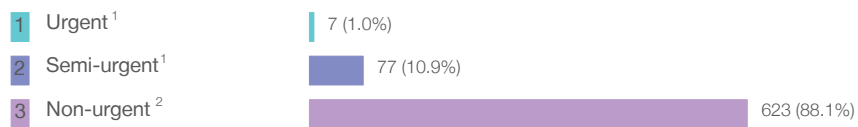

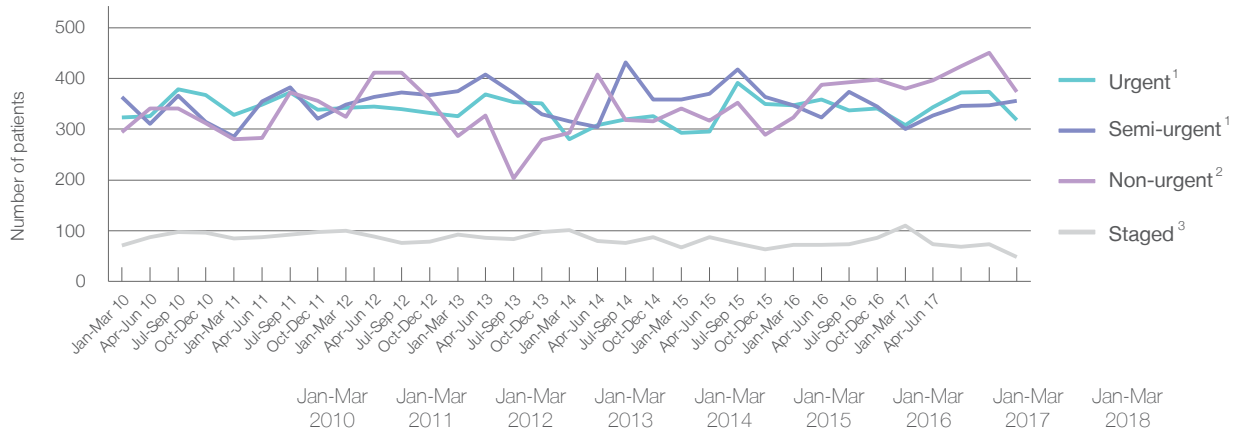

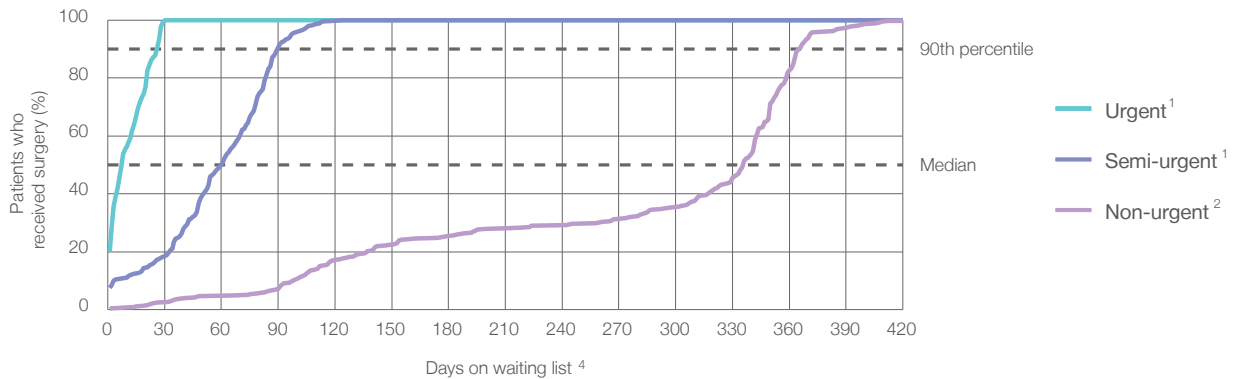

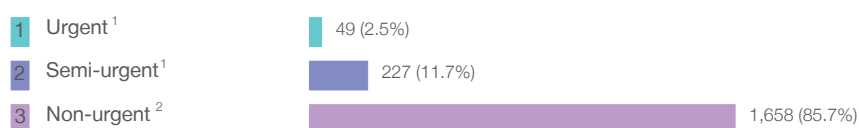

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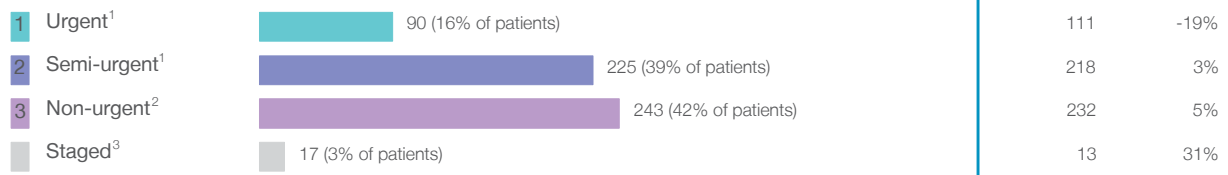

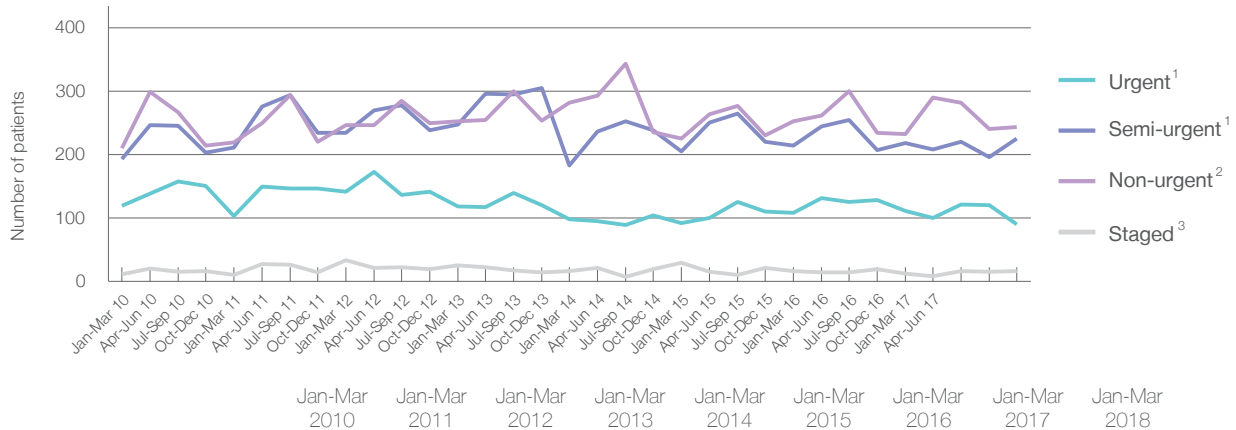

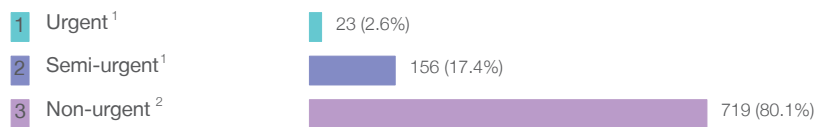

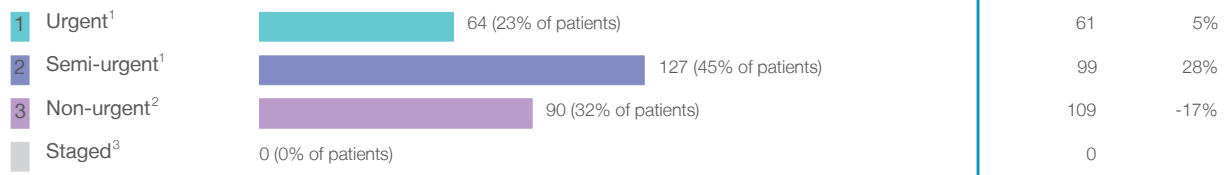

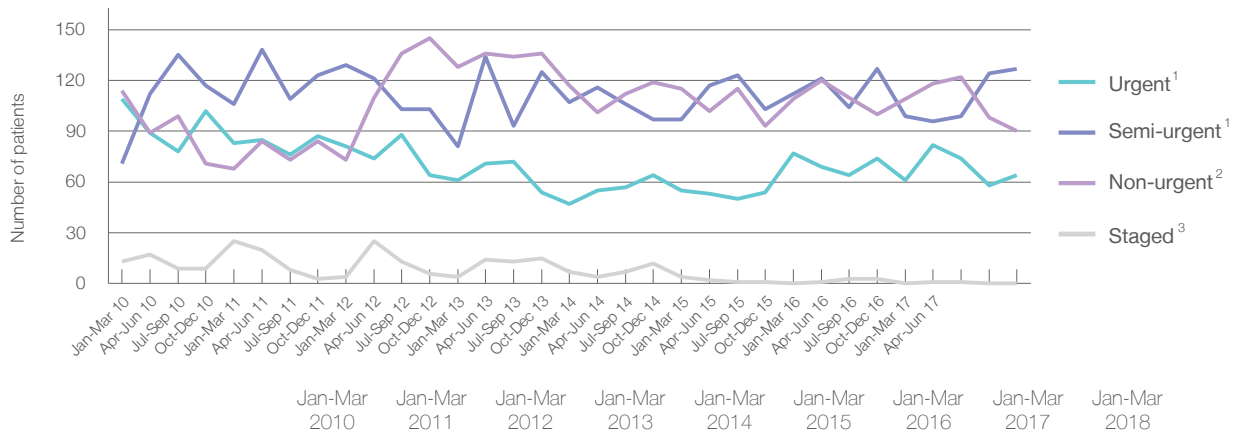

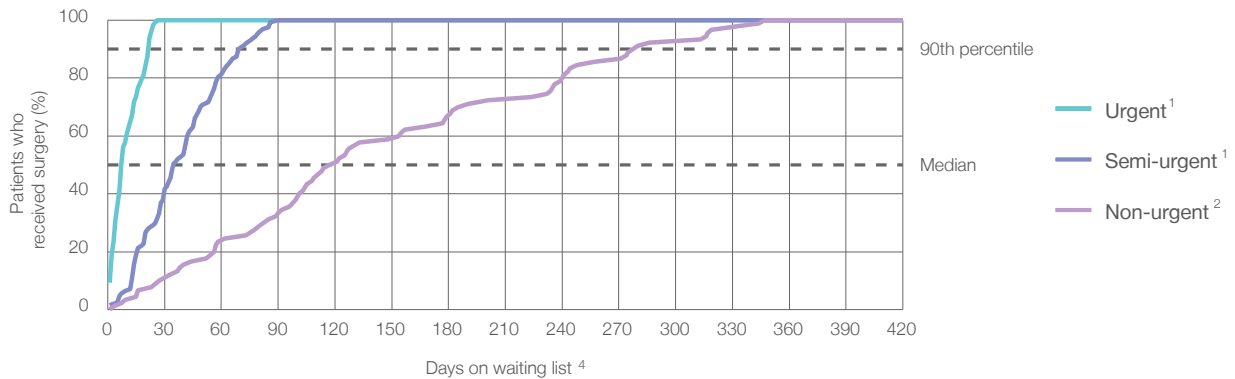

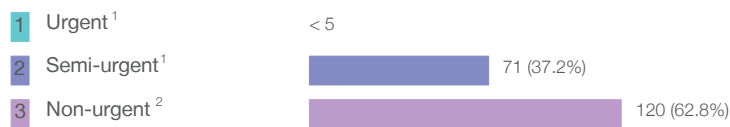

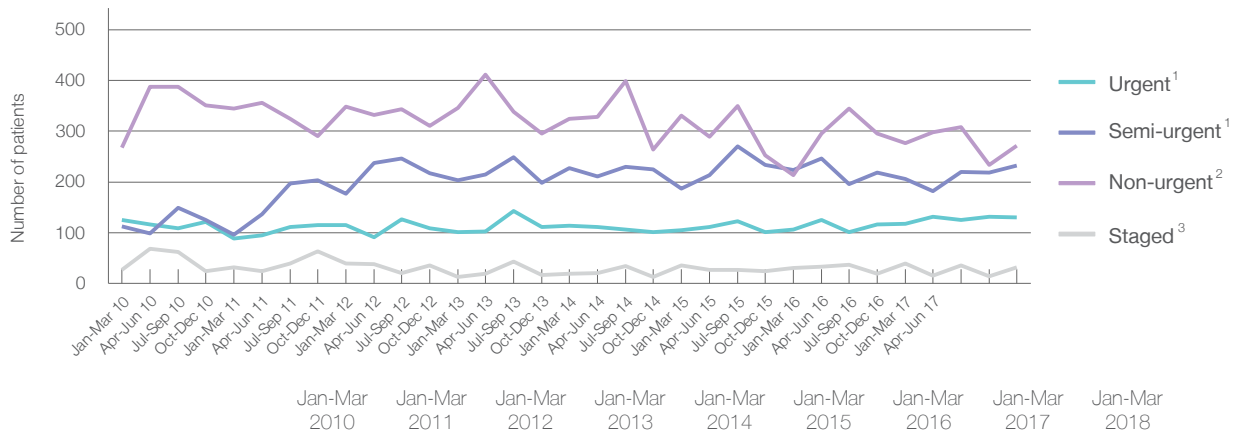

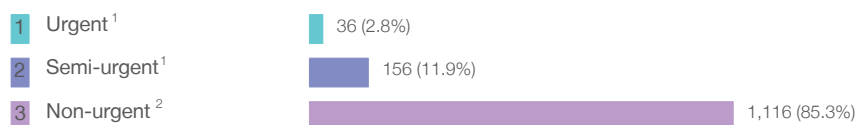

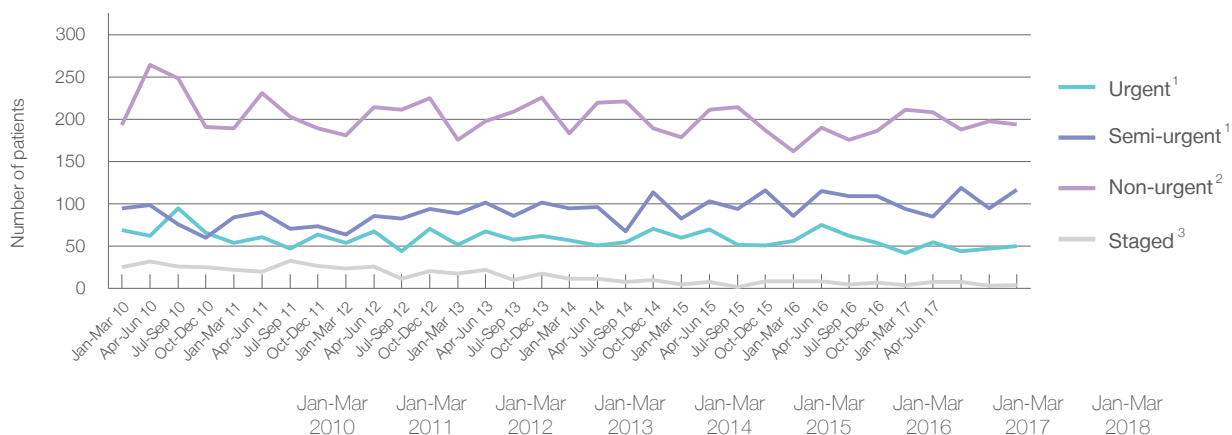

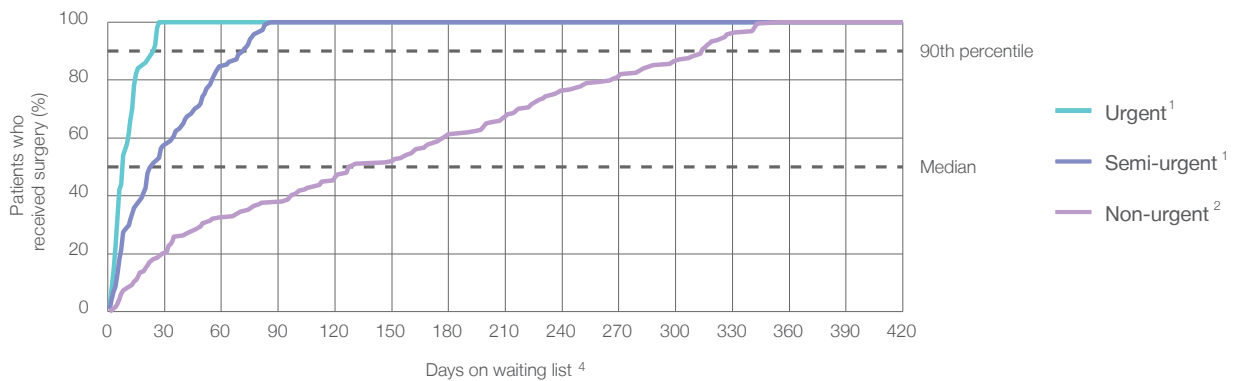

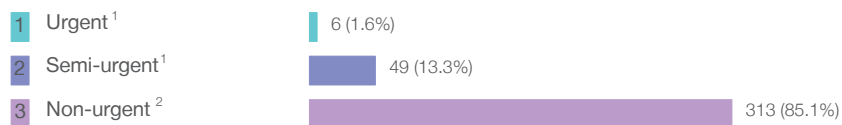

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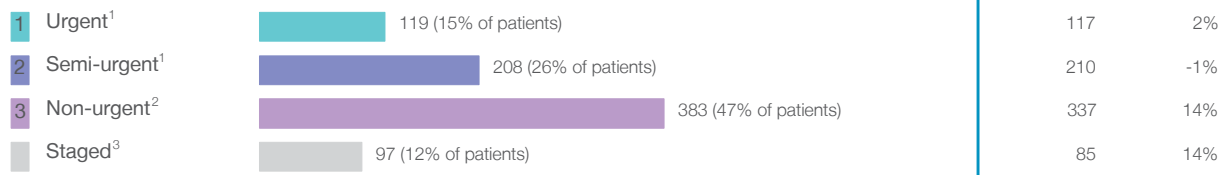

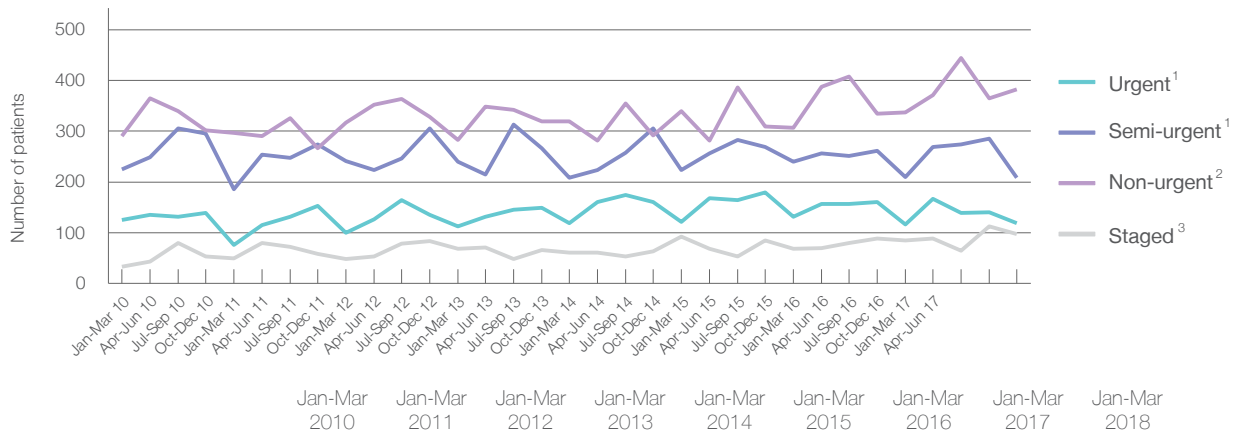

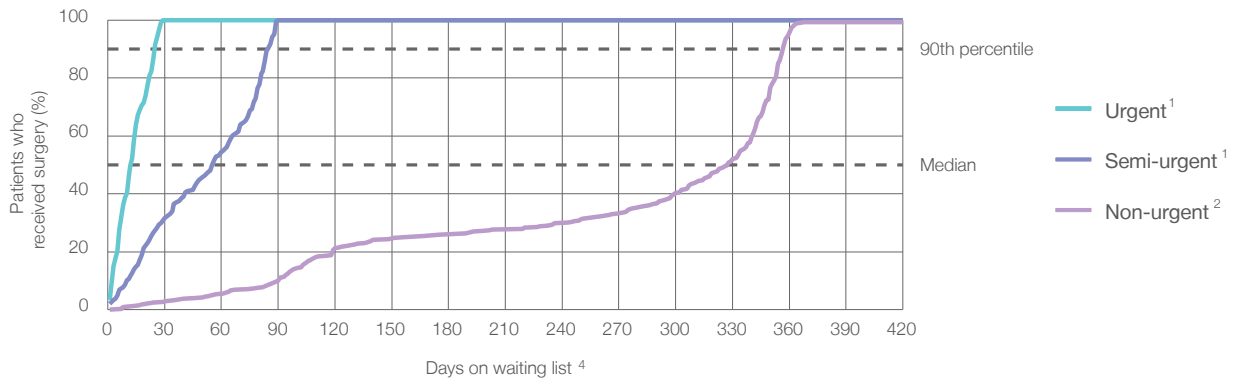

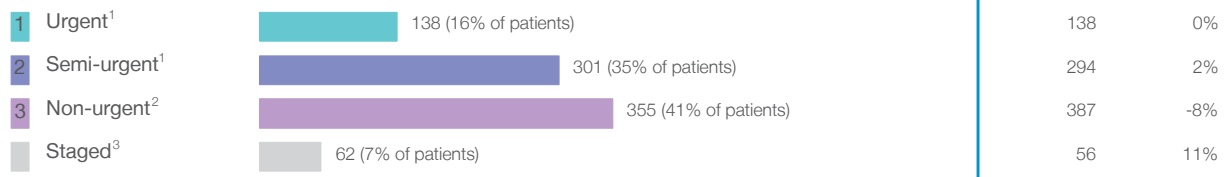

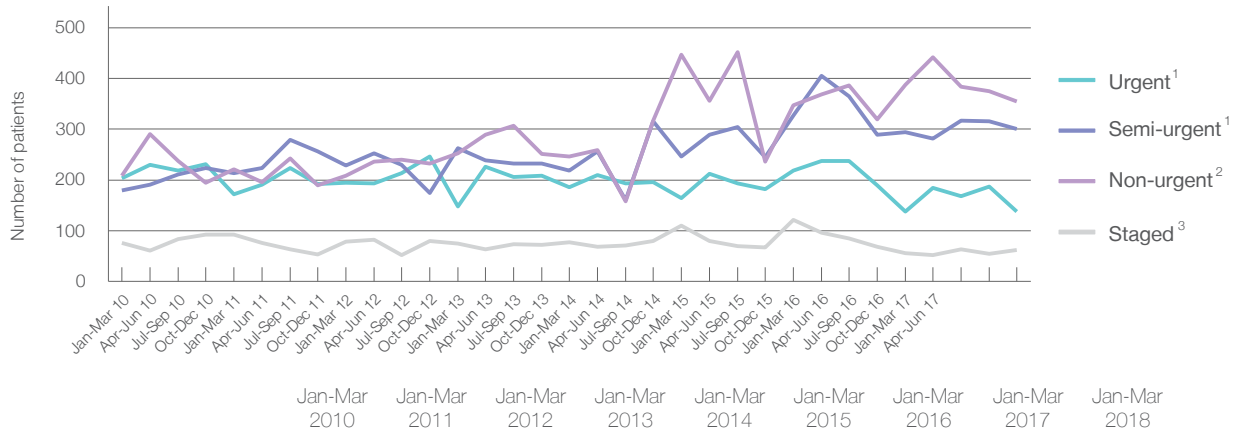

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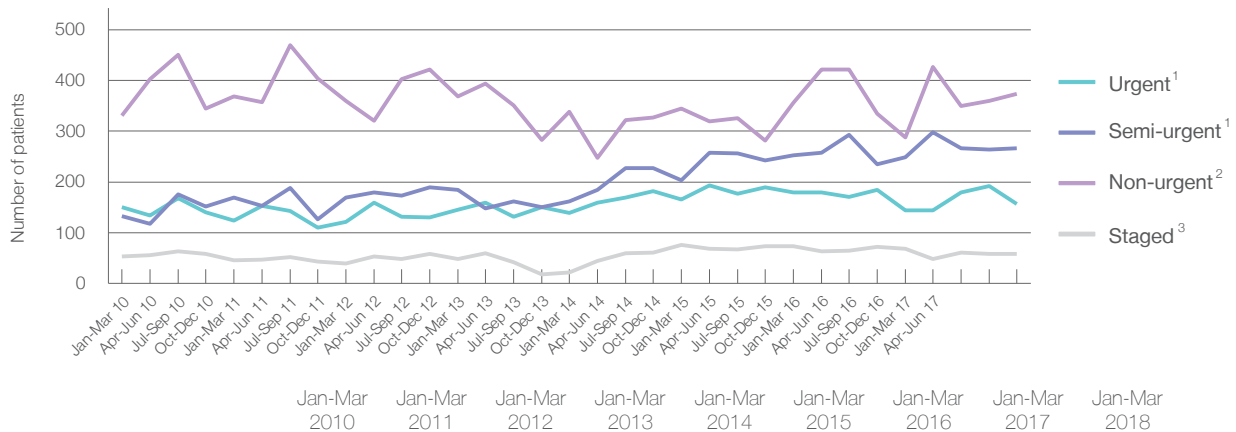

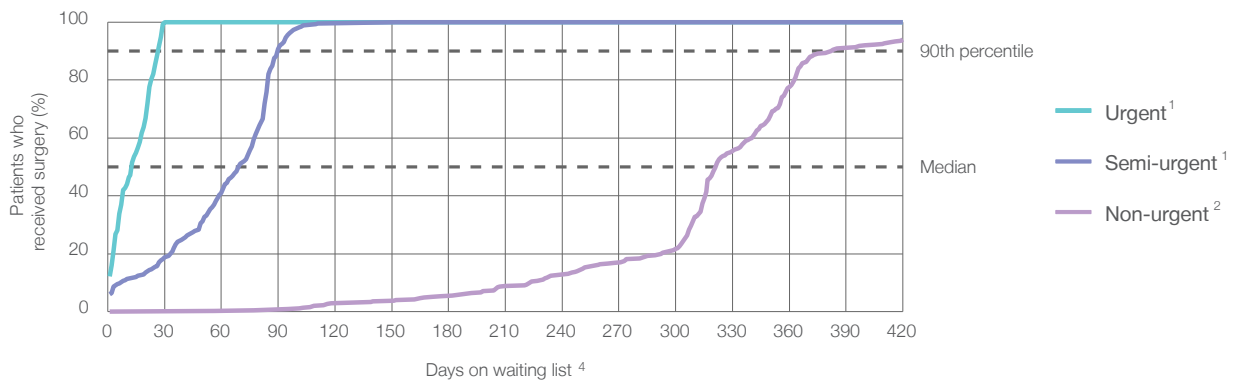

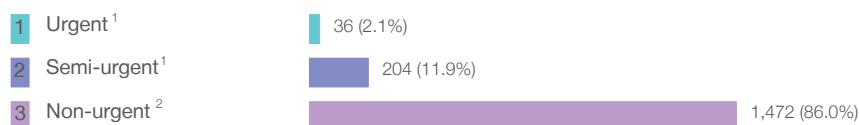

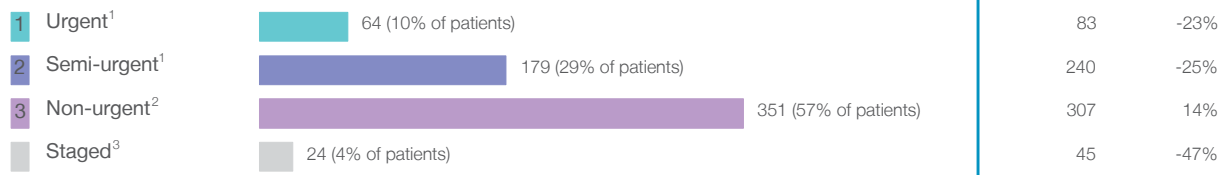

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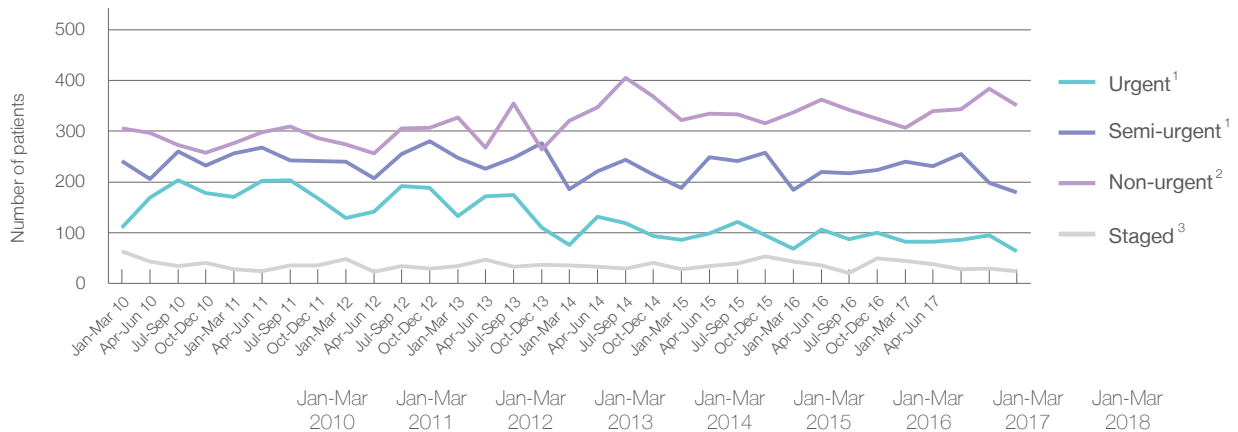

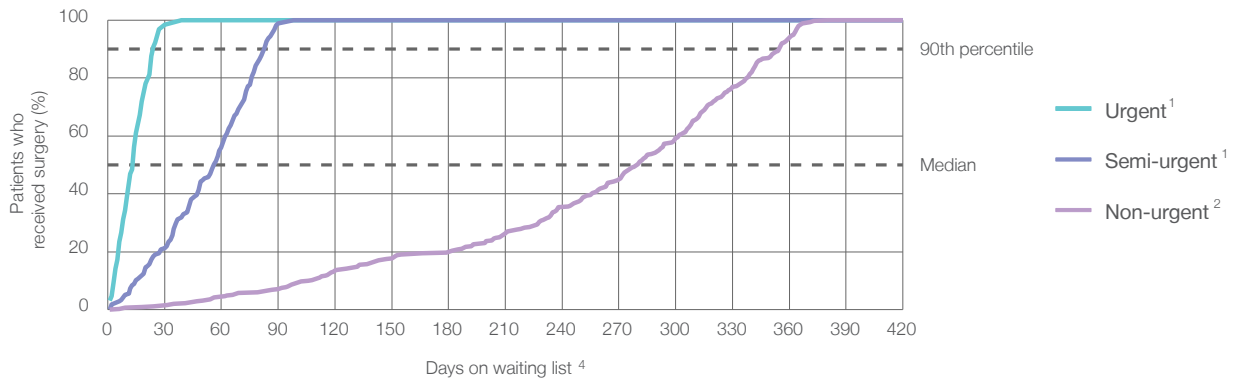

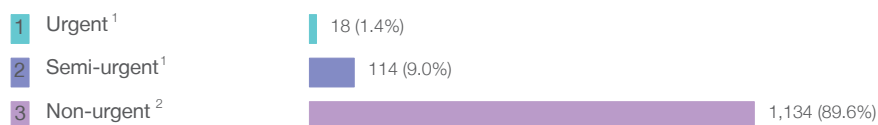

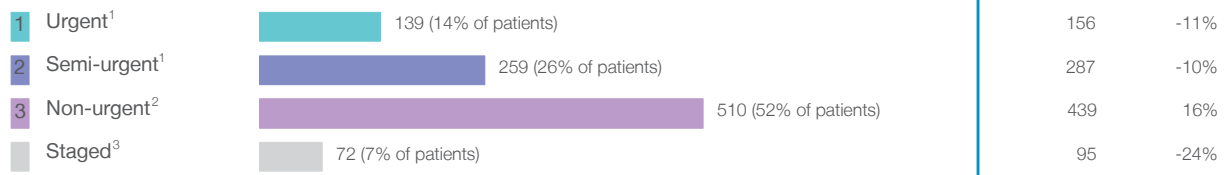

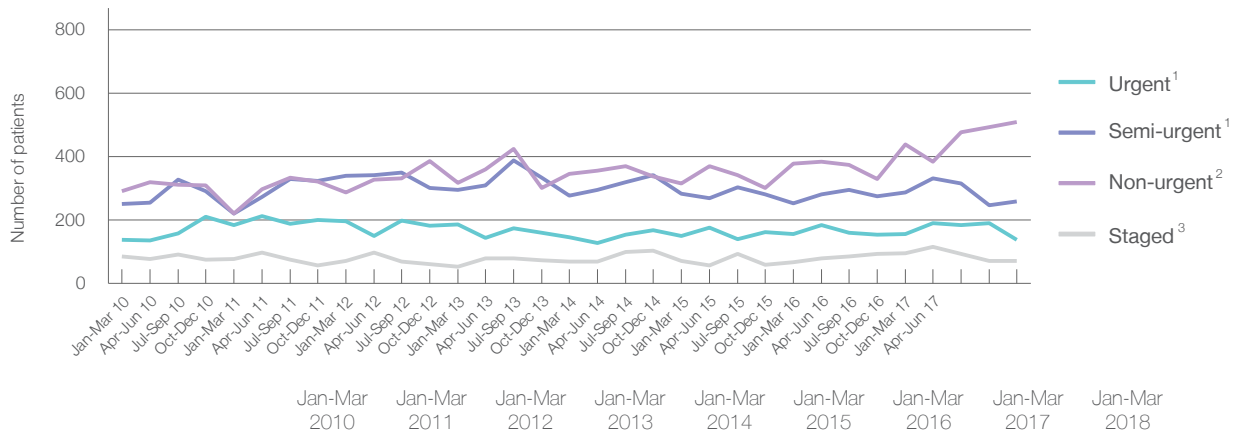

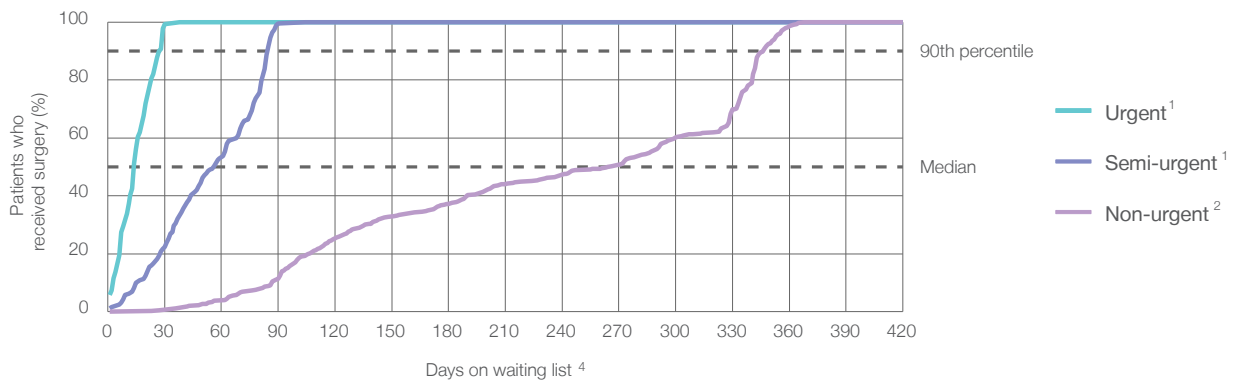

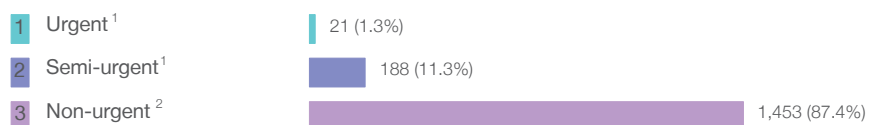

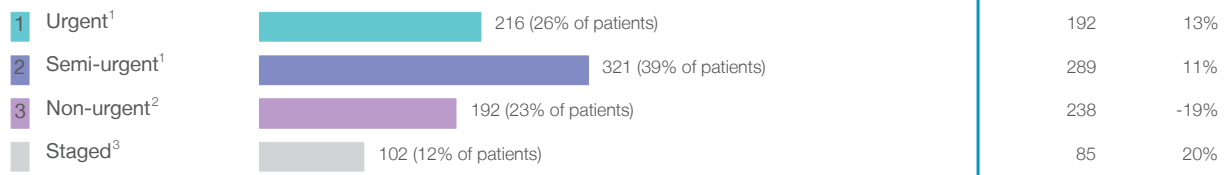

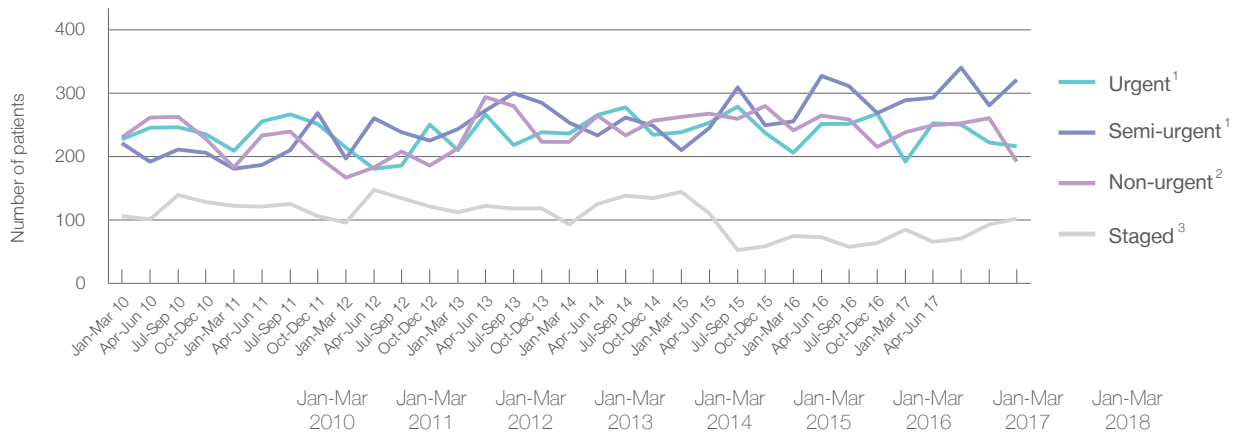
The Tweed Hospital: Elective surgery performed

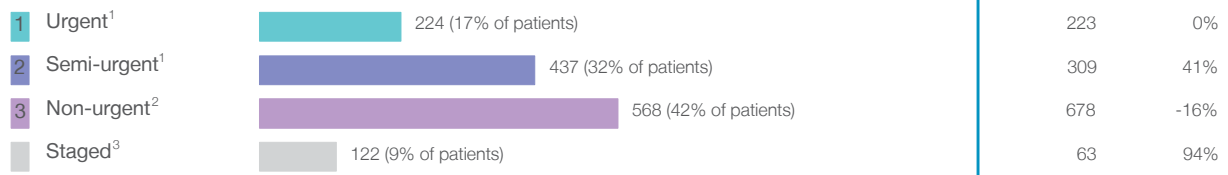

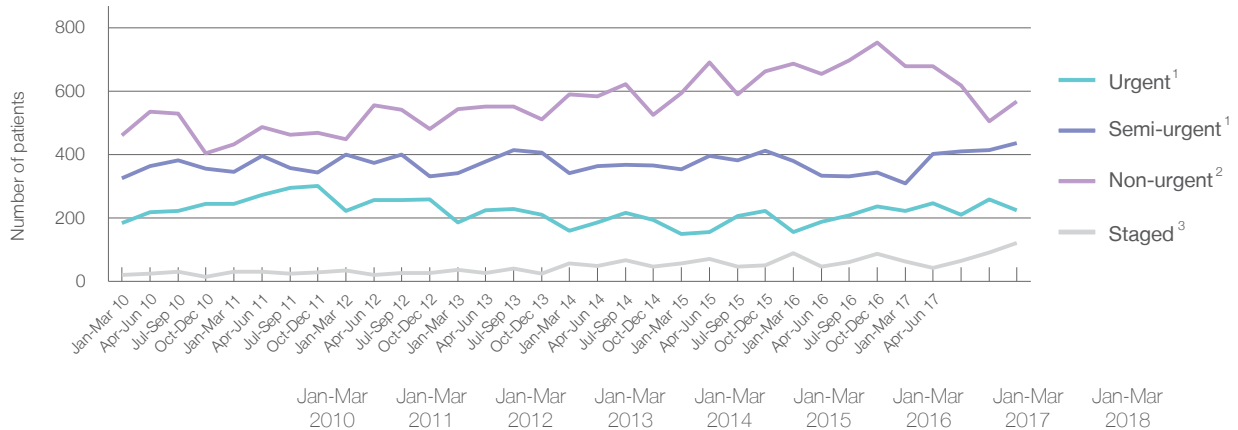

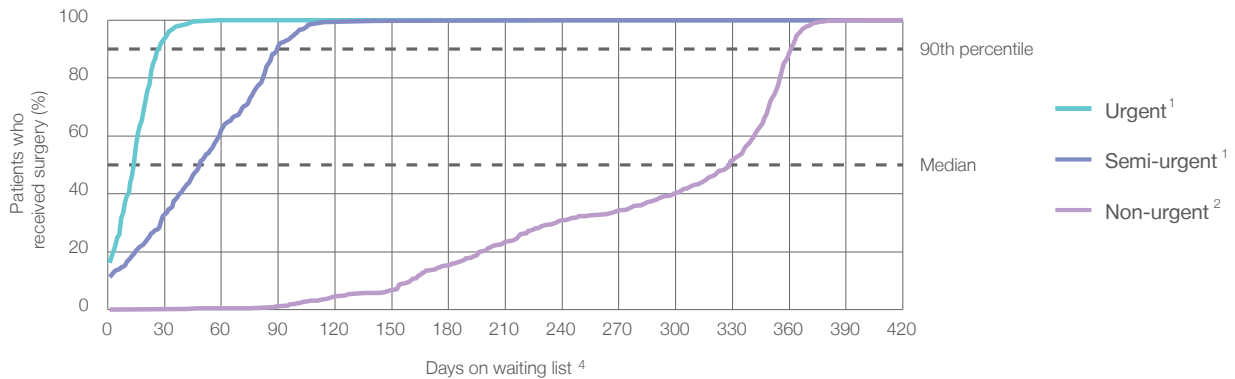

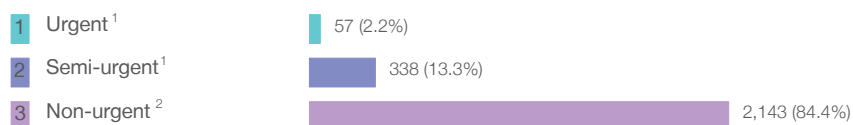

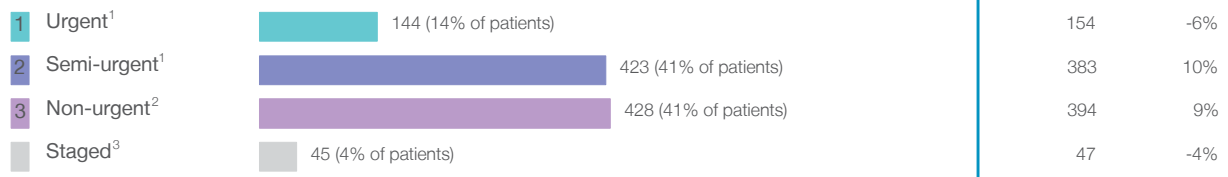

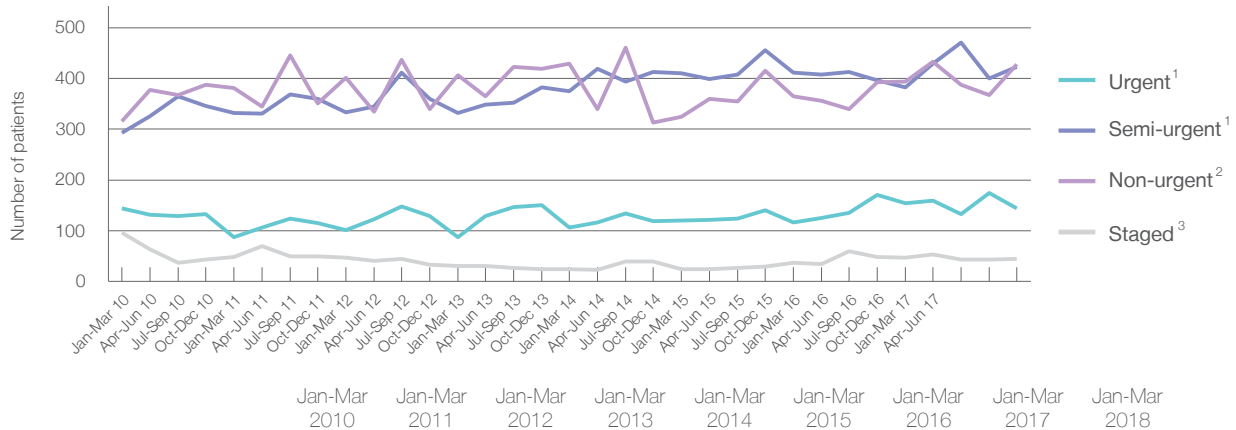

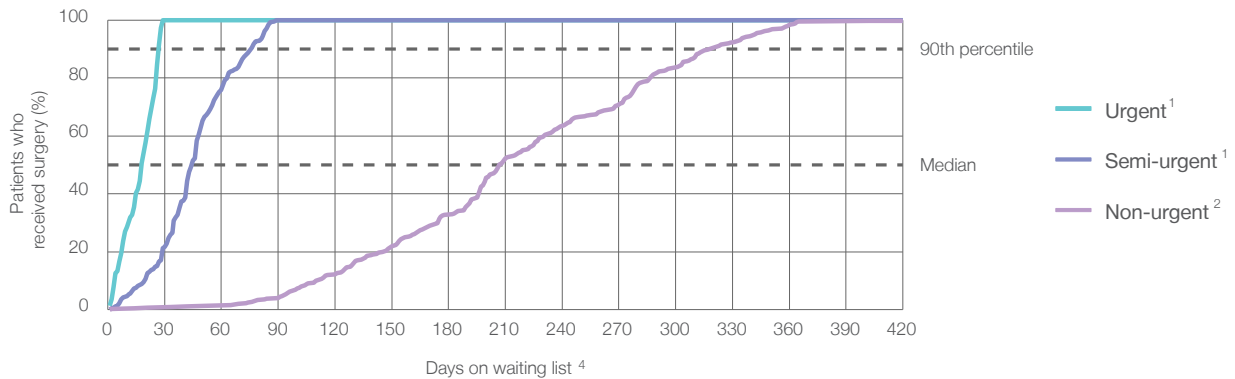

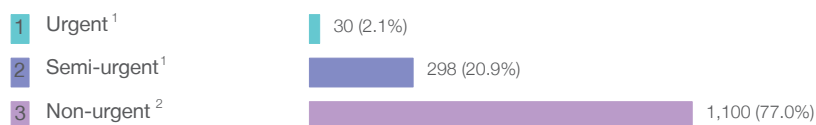
