## Hospital Quarterly – Activity and performance in NSW public hospitals, January to March 2015 (Volume 6, Issue 1)

The Bureau of Health Information has corrected the following data in the report *Hospital Quarterly – Activity and performance in NSW public hospitals, January to March 2015*.

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In *Figure 14 – Average length of stay for all completed overnight admitted patient episodes, by peer group, January to March 2015*, the peer group C2 hospital result has been corrected to four days (previously 3.8 days).

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In *Figure 31 – Percentage of patients leaving the emergency department within four hours of presentation, by peer group, January to March 2015*, the peer group results have been corrected as follows:

- Peer group A1 hospitals result – 65% (previously 66%)
- Peer group B hospitals result – 74% (previously 75%)
- Peer group C1 hospitals result – 79% (previously 80%)
- Peer group C2 hospitals result – 87% (previously 88%).

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*Figure 32 Percentage of patients leaving the emergency department within four hours versus percentage point change since same quarter last year, hospitals by peer group, January to March 2015*, has been corrected to include the result for Tumut Health Service (99%, an increase of one percentage point compared to the same quarter last year).
