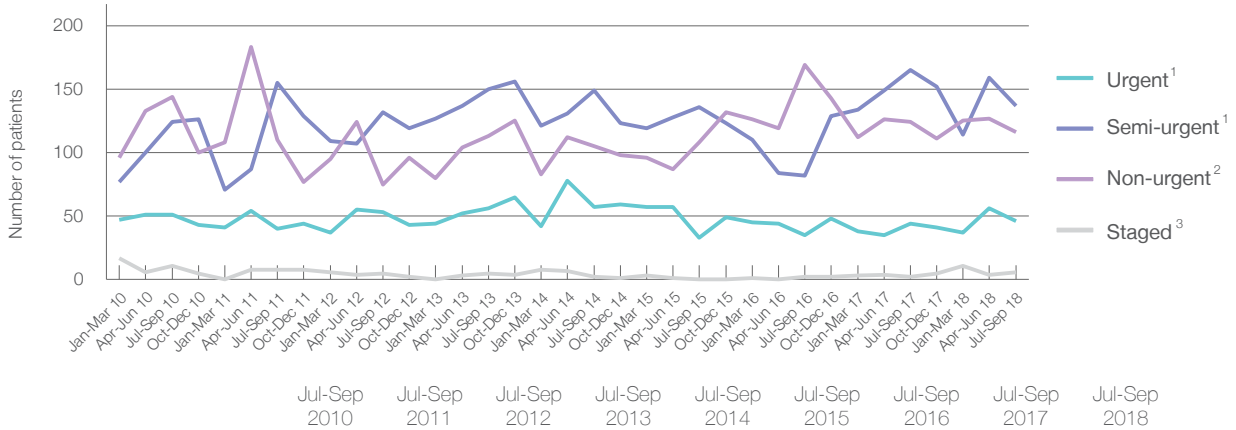

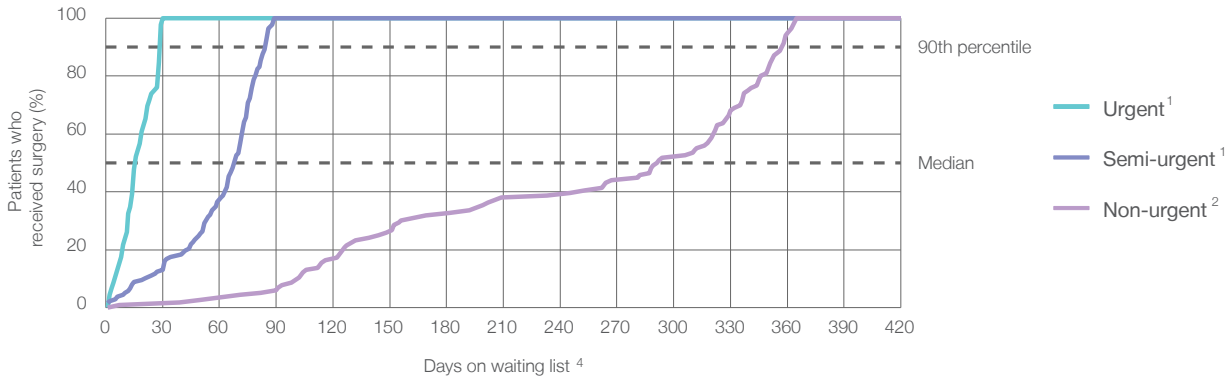

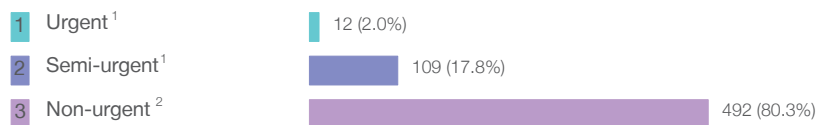

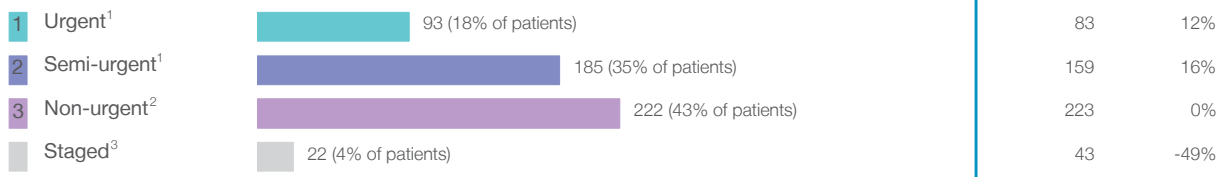

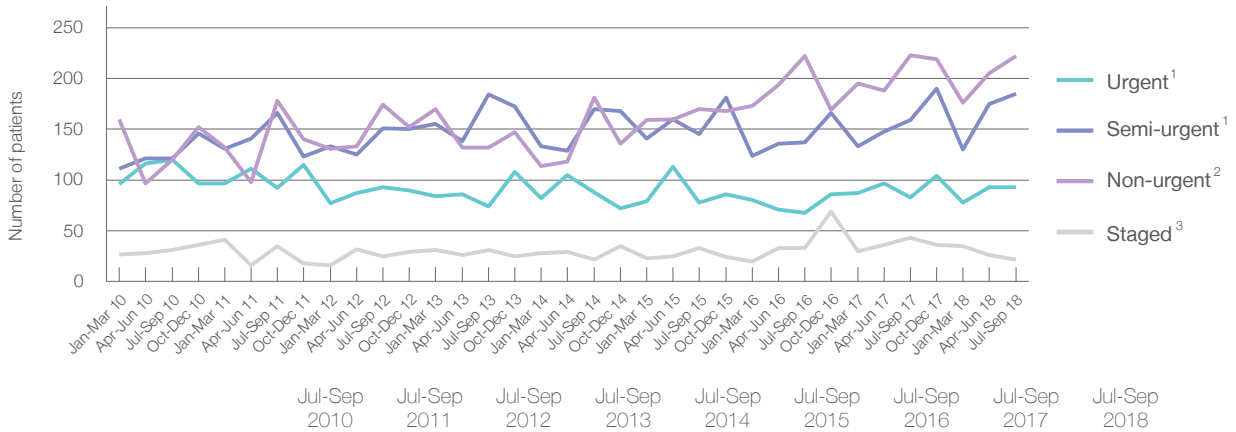

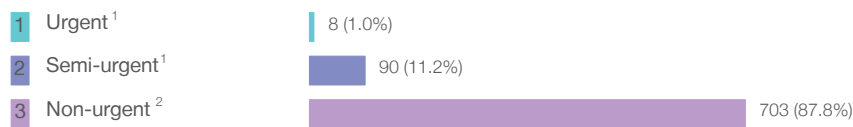

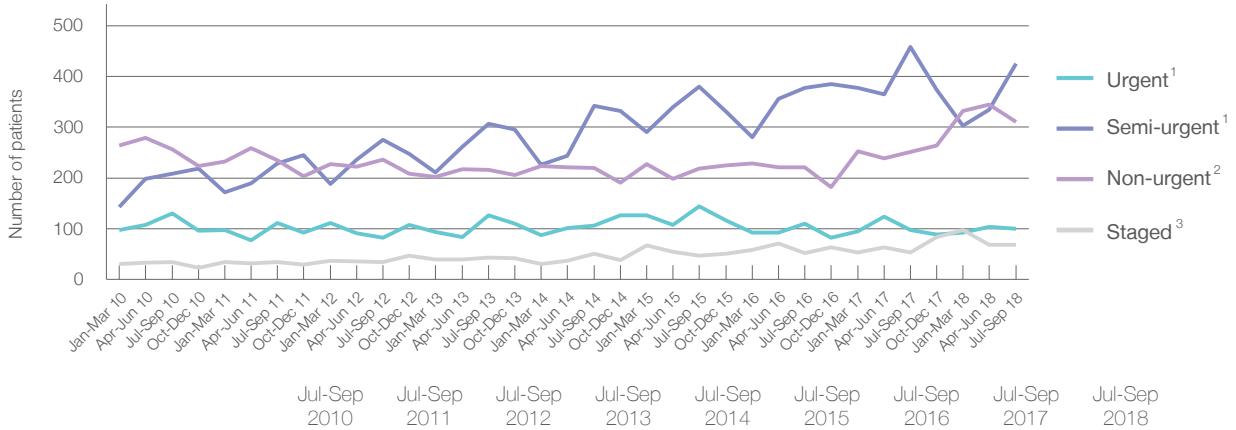

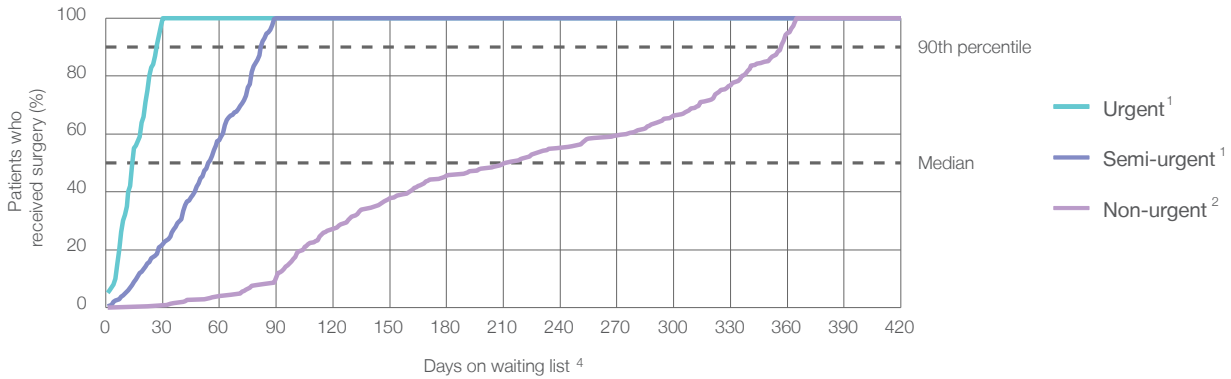

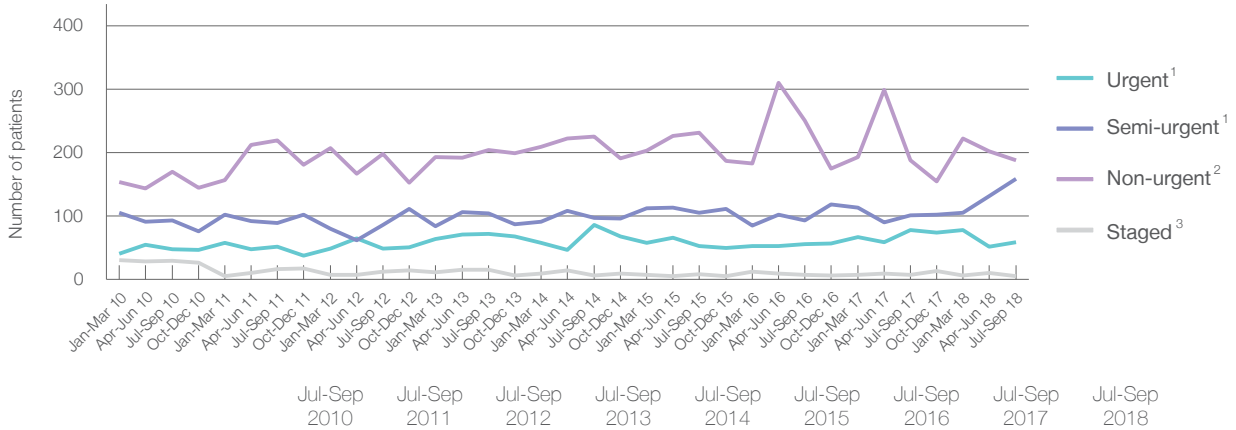

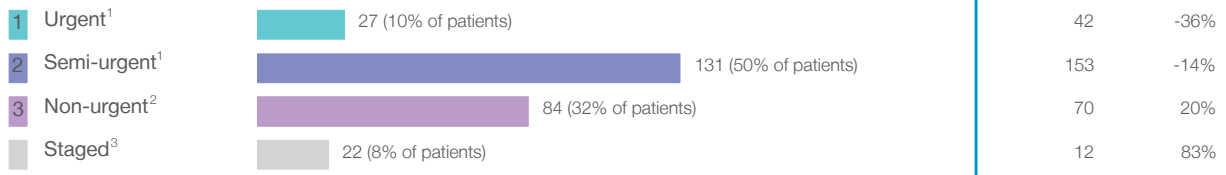

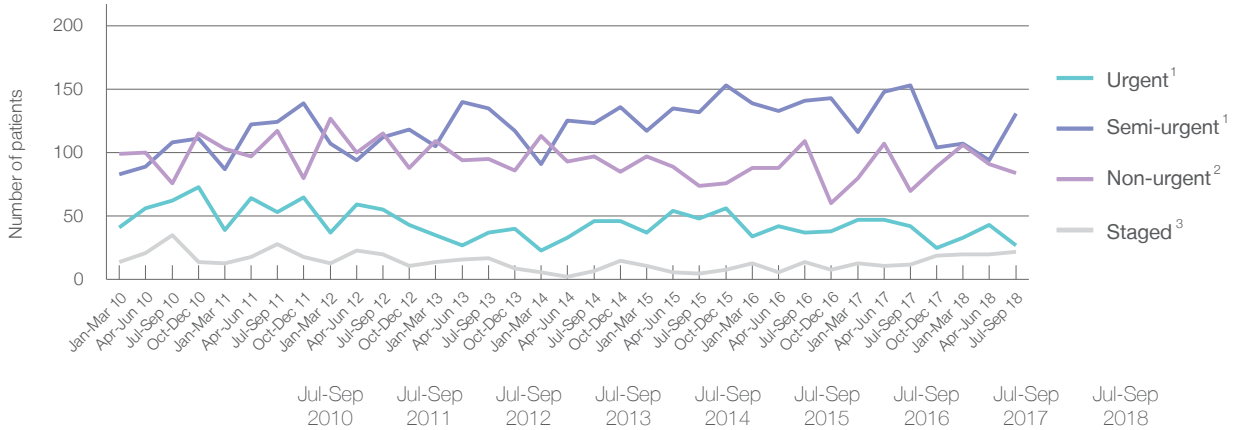

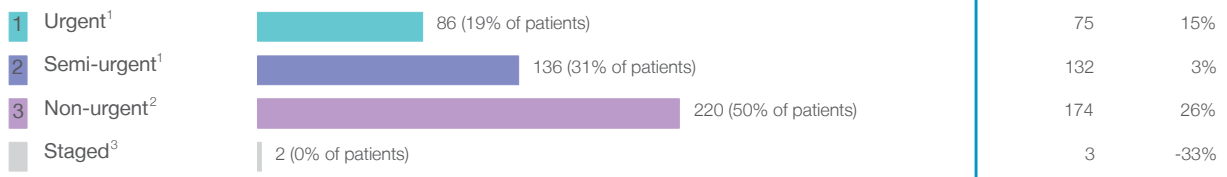

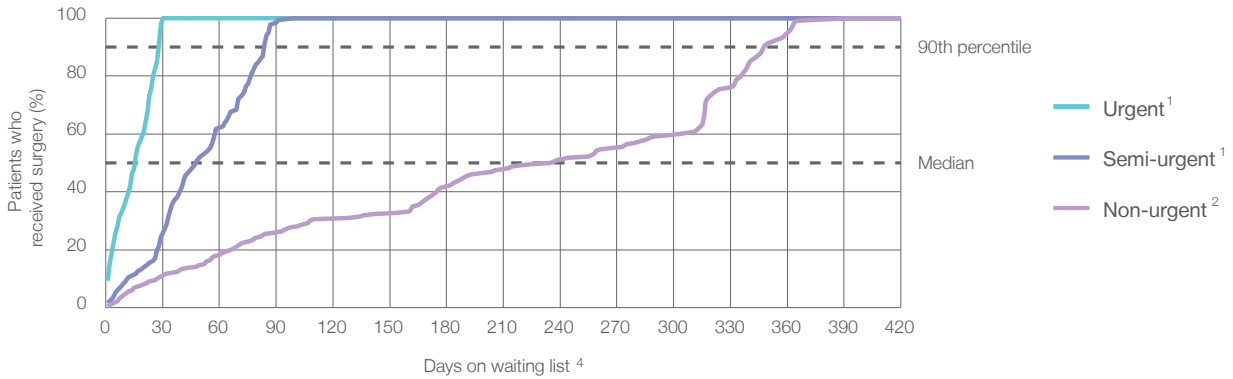

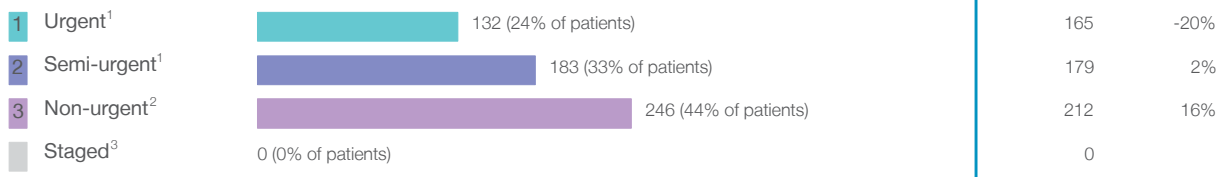

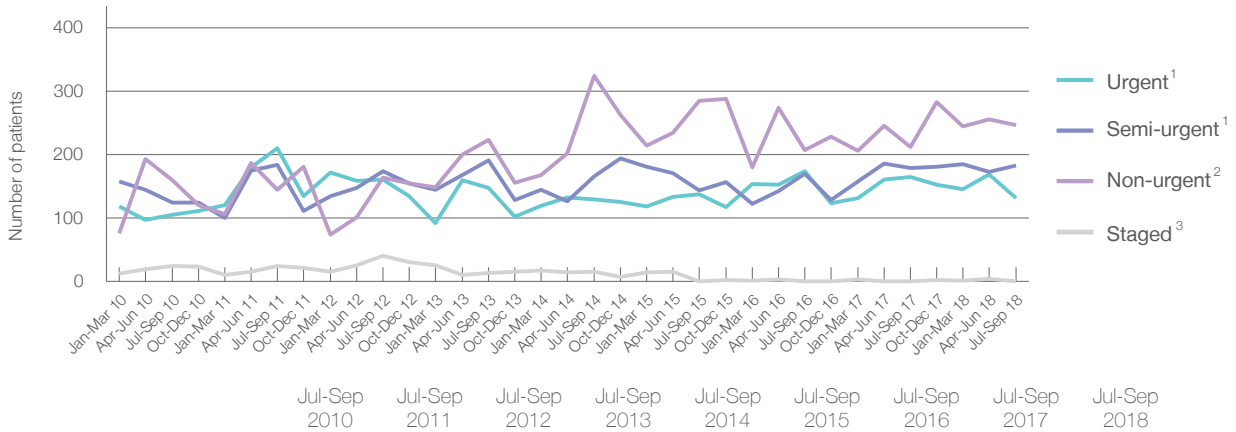

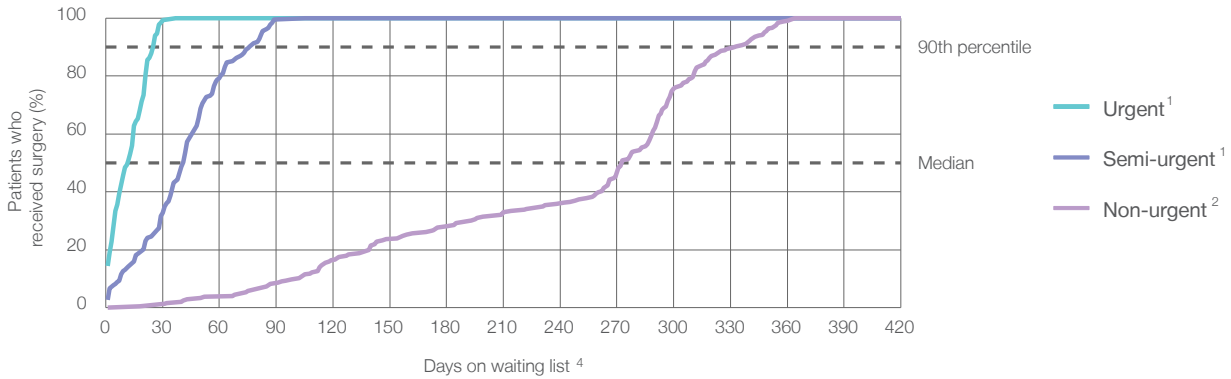

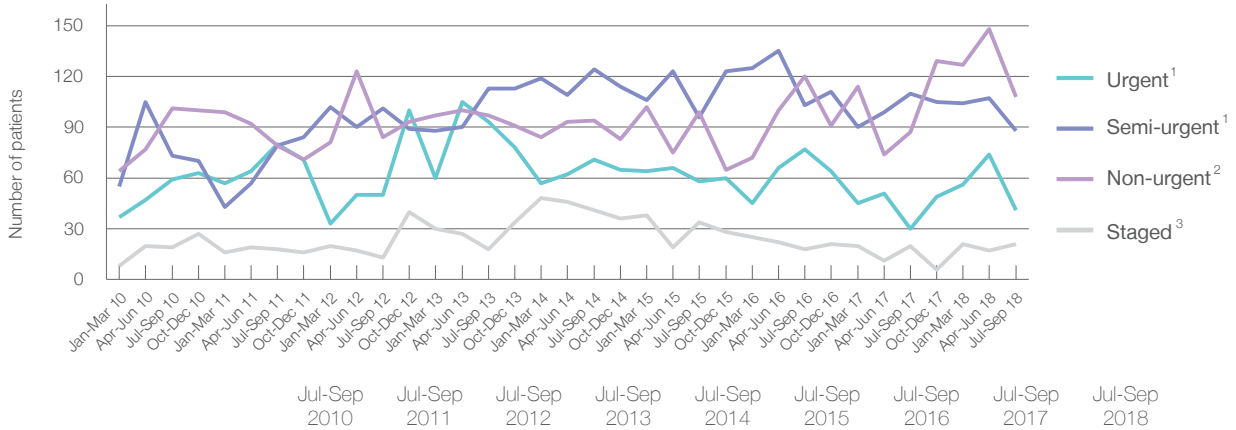

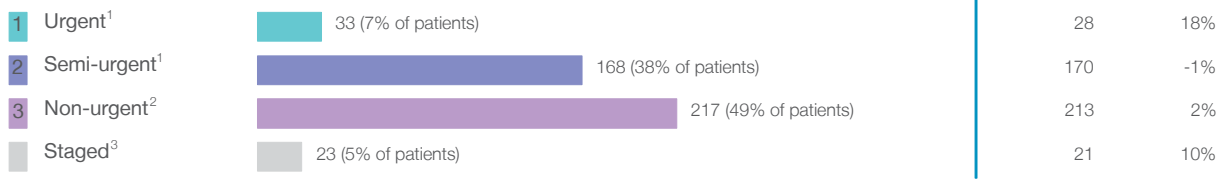

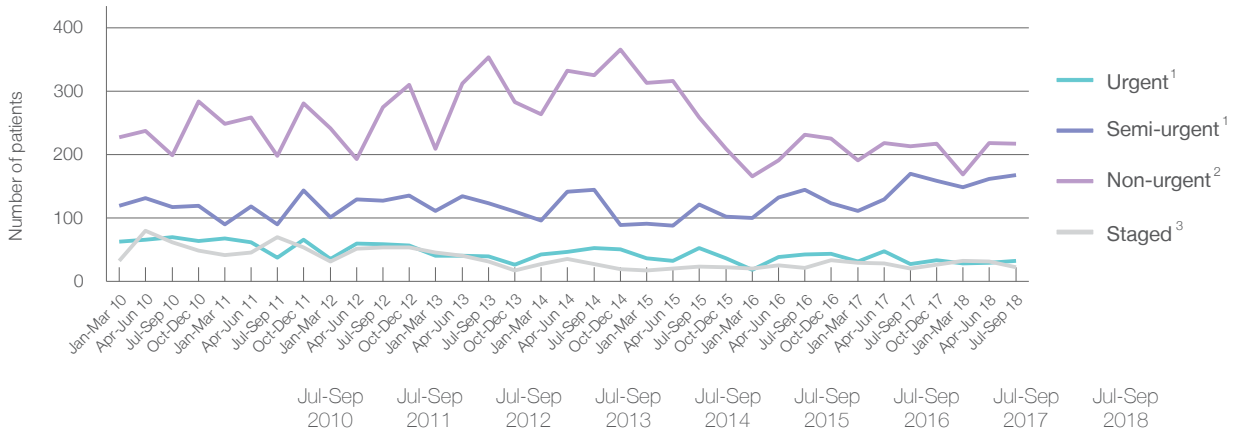

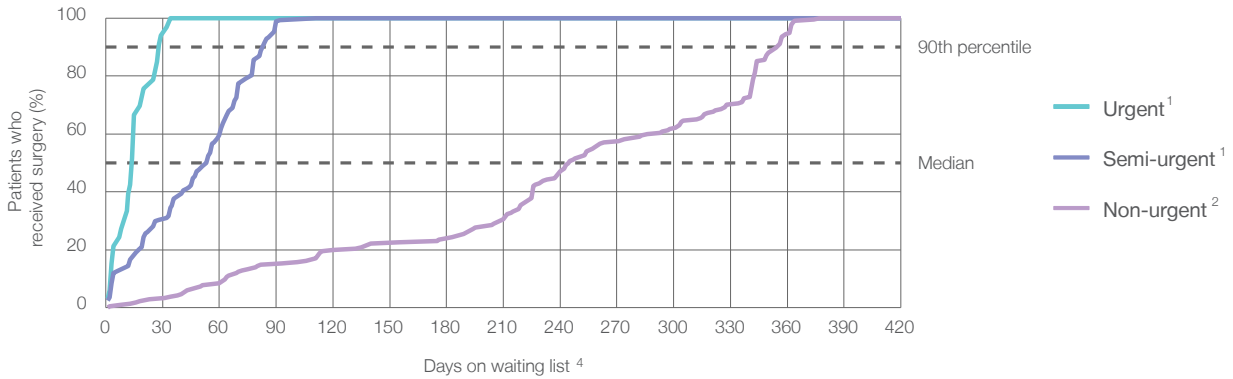

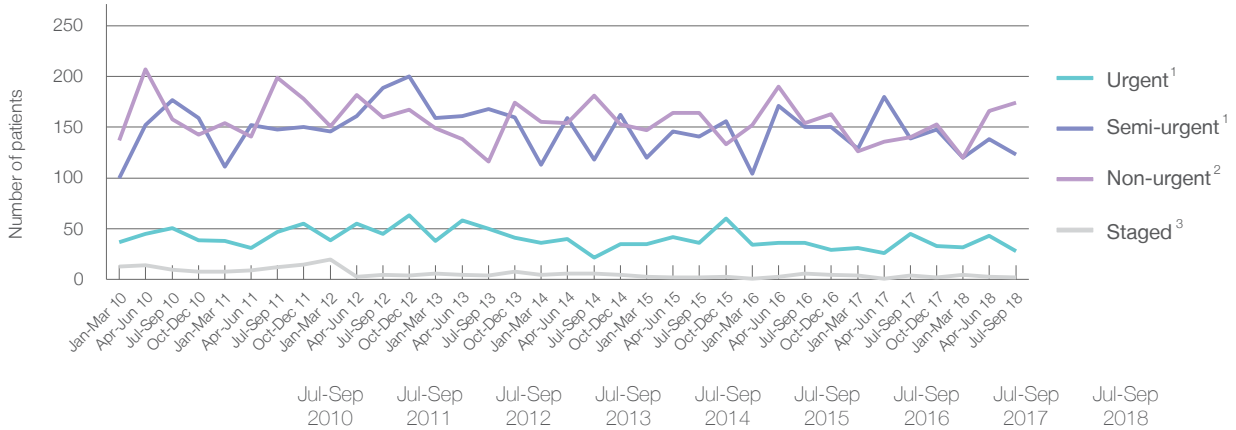

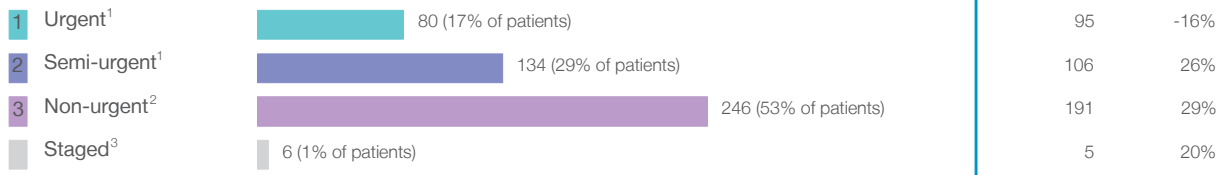

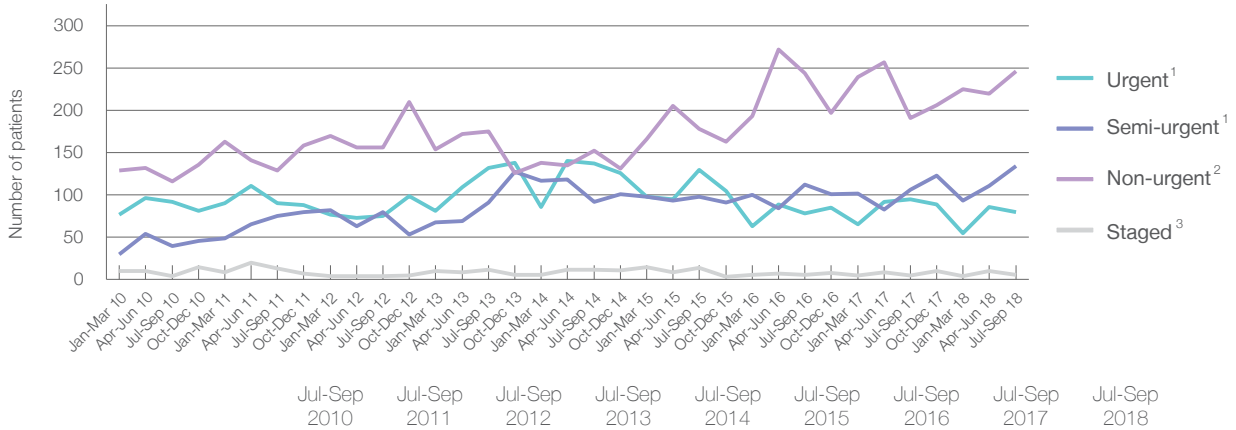

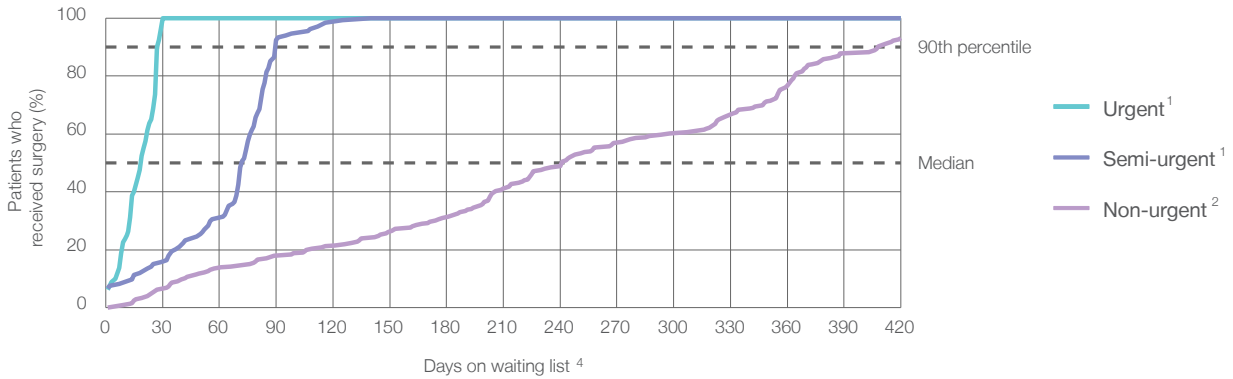

July to September 2018

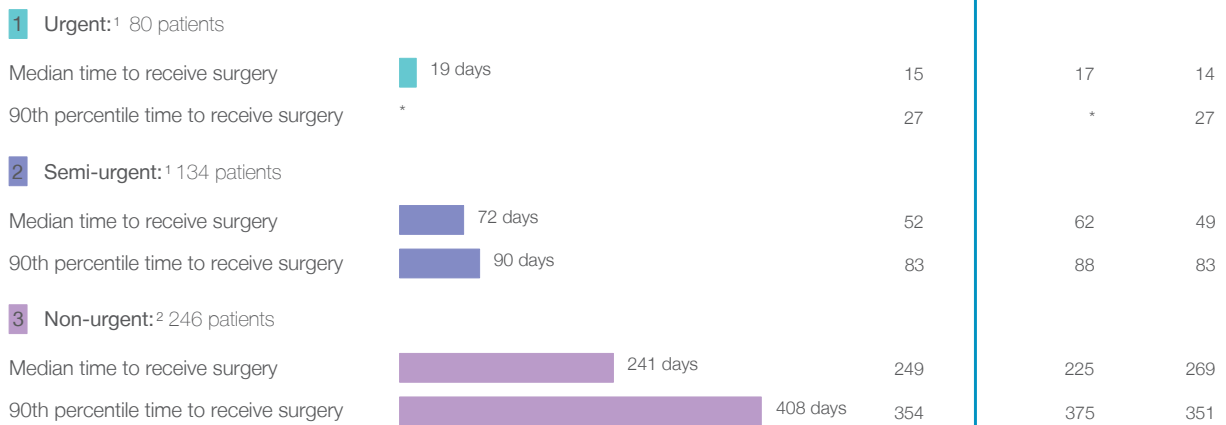
### Percentage of patients who received surgery within the clinically recommended timeframe

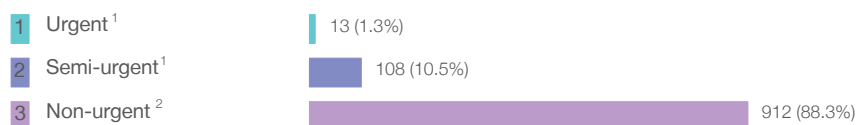
